## IRS Warns of "Tax Transcript" Email Scam

**WASHINGTON (MPG)** - The Internal Revenue Service and Security Summit partners warned the public this week of a surge of fraudulent emails impersonating the IRS and using tax transcripts as bait to entice users to open documents containing malware.

The scam is especially problematic for businesses whose employees might open the malware because this malware can spread throughout the network and potentially take months to successfully remove.

This well-known malware, known as Emotet, generally poses as specific banks and financial institutions in its effort to trick people into opening infected documents. The Summit partnership of the IRS, state tax agencies and the nation's tax industry remind taxpayers to watch out for this scam.

However, in the past few weeks, the scam masqueraded as the IRS, pretending to be from "IRS Online." The scam email carries an attachment labeled "Tax Account Transcript" or something similar, and the subject line uses some variation of the phrase "tax transcript." These clues can change with each version of the malware. Scores of these malicious Emotet emails were forwarded to phishing@irs.gov recently.

The IRS reminds taxpayers it does not send unsolicited emails to the public, nor would it email

a sensitive document such as a tax transcript, which is a summary of a tax return. The IRS urges taxpayers not to open the email or the attachment. If using a personal computer, delete or forward the scam email to [phishing@irs.gov](mailto:phishing@irs.gov). If you

see these using an employer's computer, notify the company's technology professionals.

The United States Computer Emergency Readiness Team (US-CERT) issued a warning in July about earlier versions of the Emotet in

Alert (TA18-201A) Emotet Malware. US-CERT has labeled the Emotet Malware "among the most costly and destructive malware affecting state, local, tribal, and territorial (SLTT) governments, and the private and public sectors." ★

# Flying Jets in the Air Force was a Childhood Dream Come True

I was born in the small town of Bigfork, in northern Minnesota, just two weeks before Pearl Harbor and the start of World War II. As a 1 year old, I enlisted in the Army Air Force ( see picture) in 1942, and became the youngest pilot in WWII, to fly every COMBATE MISSION in a Dipper! It's A JOKE ! In real life, at 5 years old, I flew in my first Real Airplane. It was called a Cessna 172, built with water skis attached under it, to allow the plane to land on water. The State of Minnesota is known as the Land of 10,000 Lakes and that's where We took off from, a Lake called Vermillion. The plane was owned by a family friend, it had a propeller, and could carry four passengers. It was Red and Blue and it was the most Beautiful Airplane I had ever seen. At 5 years old, they wouldn't let me fly it, but I was ready and willing. There was something about needing a license, but I was too young to understand. At that time, I had a Great Imagination, and" I WAS THE PILOT"! WE took off from Lake Vermillion, not far from my home town of Cook, and flew over what seemed like all 10,000 Lakes. It was some of the most Beautiful landscape on Earth! I WAS HOOK ON FLYING THEN AND THERE! At 5 years old, I knew I wanted to be a Pilot. Like a lot of young boys, I loved building all types of model airplanes, out of wood and glue. My friends and I would have contests on who could build the best model airplanes. I WAS THE BEST!

At two years old my family and I moved to Seattle Washington to a Government Housing Project. It was 1943 during World War II and

both my father and mother worked at Todd Shipyards, near downtown Seattle. My mother was one of the first "Rosie the Riveters", while she helped to build ships during the war. We lived in a two-story, government-built home, and my two sisters and I had numerous other kids to play with. I had a Great Childhood and the best part of living in Seattle was that we lived near the BOEING AIRPLANE CO. The BOEING Company designed and built some of the Greatest Airplanes in the World, during World War II, including the B-17 and the B-29, which helped win the war. Later, after the war, they built the B-47, the B-52 and one of the Greatest civilian passenger airliners ever designed and built, the 707 JET airliner. The Boeing 707 revolutionized the civilian world of JET travel. These aircraft were all built in the Seattle area, and as a child, I was mesmerized as these aircraft would fly overhead. I wanted to fly ever one of them. This was my heritage, growing up in Seattle, where many Great Airplanes were first built.

As a child and teenager, I lived and breathed the vision of flying JETS! When I went on to college at Central Washington University in Ellensburg, I joined the AIR FORCE ROTC (Reserve Officers Training Corps) program. As a junior at the college, I qualified to enroll in a ROTC flying training program for FREE! It was a civilian flight school and my first instructor was Vern, who owned the small airport just north of the University. I will always remember Vern, as he taught me how to fly BACKWORDS, in a small Cessna 150 Fixed Winged Aircraft. It was an Extremely Dangerous maneuver where you have to have a very strong headwind of over 60mph. You turn the aircraft

into the wind while you are flying around one hundred feet over the concrete taxiway, with the sun overhead. You have to be able to see your aircraft shadow on the ground and with full flaps and the aircraft stall warning horn blasting in your ear, you will see the shadow of the plane moving backwards. I don't know of any other pilot who has lived thru this type of maneuver, but I was able to check it off my TO DO list. It was extremely

dangerous, and yes ,I never told the Air Force or my mother about this, so I hope you will keep it to yourself.

Vern not only taught me how to fly, but he became like a father to me. He flew crop duster aircraft for a living and latter he was killed when his plane hit a power wire and crashed. He won't be forgotten! Thanks to Vern, I was able to get my Civilian Pilots License, at the Air Force's expense. I and the Air Force needed to know if I had the Right Stuff to fly. I loved every minute I flew with Vern ,as he was an excellent instructor and human being.

The day I graduated from Central Washington and ROTC, in 1966, I was sworn into the U S AIR Force as a 2nd Lieutenant. This was during the Vietnam War and they needed Pilots. I received orders to report to Williams Air Force Base, located just outside of Phoenix Arizona, to start my one year of Pilot training. I had just got married, so Mary and I went looking for an apartment near Williams Air Force Base. We found an apartment and two little kittens and so we were ready for our Next Big Adventure! I spent one of the Best Years of my life in Pilot Training at Williams AFB, learning to fly the Air Force T-41 propeller engine aircraft and the

T-37 and T-38 JET Trainer aircraft. In all three aircraft we were taught the basic flight school air maneuvers, but in the T-41 and the T-37 we were taught how to recover from an actual SPIN, one of the most dangerous flight situations a pilot can be in. The T-41 was designed to recover from a SPIN, on its own, but we needed to know how to recover from it, just in case! It was one of the most dangerous parts of the flight school, and many students could not deal with it, and Washed Out. I lost some good friends that I had made in my one year in pilot training, but I loved Spin Recovery and all types of aerobatics.

One of the reasons I had no problems with Spin recoveries is that as a child, I had gone to the State Fairs and rode on all the wild and scary rides. Little did I know I would be preparing for flight school. I loved flying Jets and the T-38 was the Rocket Ship of Jet trainers. It had two very powerful jet engines and could fly faster than Mach 1 or the speed of sound. With permission from the control tower, my flight instructor could get approval for a high speed take off and climb, and I still remember the event, like it was yesterday. It took my breath away when my instructor pushed both engine throttles to max afterburners and we went down the runway and he pulled back on the control stick and we were going straight up at Fantastic Speed, before we were half-way down the runway. We were at 40,000 feet altitude in what seemed like seconds. It's something I will always remember, as well as the first time I flew Faster than the SPEED OF SOUND, or Mach 1. As a student, we were never allowed to go Mach 1 while we were flying Solo or without or instructor. Well, I needed that Solo thing on my bucket list of memories, and one day I got it. I went Mach 1 while

SOLO, but don't tell anyone. I might get in trouble. The Mach meter was on the dash and it was about the size of a silver dollar and it had a needle that pointed straight up. When you go through the speed of sound, the needle just twitches a little, indicating that the T-38 was a very stable aircraft at that speed. The T-38 Jet Trainer was the SPORTSCAR of airplanes, and it still flies today in the Air Force, after over 50 years. It left me with some Great Memories.

I also have great memories of Williams AFB and pilot training. I had completed all but two weeks short of one year, and my Graduation. I was on my last SOLO flight, flying above 22,000 feet, practicing my maneuvers, when my worst nightmare happened. Unknown to me, I had a sinus infection and both of my ears were blocked, from the infection. The aerobatics I was practicing in my assigned area, had caused me to lose my hearing, and caused extreme dizziness. Flying without an instructor, I had a hard time controlling my T-38 and I knew I had two choices. I could pull the ejection handles and bail out or try and fly the plane back to the base. I decided to declare an EMERGENCY and asked for a strait in approach. I could NOT hear any radio calls, so I hoped they heard my Distress Call. I found the airport in the distance and tried to get to it. I had a hard time controlling the aircraft and as I got close to the runway, I was thinking I was going to have to bail out, OR DIE, but a Voice SPOKE TO ME. It said WE ARE WITH YOU! I landed somehow. I was told later they had got my Emergency Call and when I was coming in on final approach, my wings were wobbling badly, and it didn't look like I was going to make it. At the last second, the wings leveled out, and I had a beautifully smooth landing.

I remember at the time I was coming in on that final landing approach, I was very dizzy. I had read a book called something like GOD IS MY CO- PILOT, and I felt that Presence, and I will never forget It. I wasn't able to complete flight school, do to my medical problems. Later, after I left the Air Force, my wife and I built and operated THE FARMHOUSE DAYCARE / PRESCHOOL and ran it for 25 years.

Looking back, I would highly recommend military service to any young student. And if flying is in your blood, GO FOR IT. I can say to everyone, FOLLOW YOUR DREAMS, and may GOD BLESS YOU ALL! HE WAS MY CO-PILOT AND STILL IS!

**RANCHO CORDOVA, CA (MPG)** - Our Cordova Community Christmas Tree Lighting was a tremendous success with a much larger group of people than we had last year. My wife and I really enjoyed having our kids and our grandkids there enjoying the evening. The popularity of the event shows how many people are passing information on to others and how many things are done in Rancho Cordova. So many events are free for the public to share and enjoy. Many wonderful things were done in our community before we became a city, such as parades, Kids Day in the Park, and forming the food locker. Since we became a city, we have been able to multiply events to take pleasure in, and we are also helping neighborhoods with some basic things, like repaving roads and repairing sidewalks. As a city, we are taking care of ourselves in ways that only a city can do.

Something that was, and still is, one of the most important ways of running our City is being able to work together on our entire City. When we first became a city in July 2003, *The Sacramento Bee* printed an editorial about our City Council, and I am going to quote part of that editorial, "Watching City Council sessions may not be the highest

form of entertainment, but take a glimpse the next time you come across a Rancho meeting. There is something unique and refreshing about how this council is conducting business. Most elected officials get into the unfortunate habit of talking at each other, or to the television camera. Rancho Cordova isn't doing that (at least not yet.) The deliberations are more like civic conversations. Council members seem to genuinely respect and like one another." *The Sacramento Bee* editorial also said, "There is a profound and accurate sense on the new council that it has just one chance to set the compass for Rancho Cordova."

We have, I believe, been able to continue conducting business with respect for each other and actually enjoy each other's company. We have gone through some hard personal times as well. For example, we lost Dave Roberts, one of our first council members and also our first Mayor, who died of a heart attack on April 16, 2004. Then we lost another council member on April 20, 2017 when Dan Skoglund, the person we originally chose to finish Dave's term, also died of a heart attack. Another original council member, Ken Cooley, left the City Council when he decided to run for the Assembly seat and represent us in the State Capitol. He was elected, and I believe he is doing a great job representing us and all the citizens in the 8th Assembly District. That leaves three originals on the Rancho Cordova

City Council today and five citizens out of the 21 running for the five city council seats who were chosen when the people voted to become a city in November 2002. All three of us "originals," Linda Budge, David Sander and Bob McGarvey, and the two "new" members continue to keep the civil conversations that are held in our City Council meetings. That will continue to be our goal far into the future. I like to think that our current conversations at council meetings are discussions in which we are talking to each other, forget the cameras, and get business done.

Now some of our original population has moved to other places, some have died, and new ones have moved in. Even with those changes, our total population continues to increase every year. It is very refreshing to talk to new residents who come here and tell me of the wonderful news and information they have heard about our City that convinces them to move in to Rancho Cordova. It makes me think about the new homes, new stores, new schools, new parks, etc. that were built in Rancho Cordova in 1953. That brought many people to Rancho Cordova in the past, and our good reputation and new homes, schools, etc. are also bringing them here today.

The next month will be December, and we will continue to work very hard to make sure that the last month of 2018 will be as productive as the first 11 months.

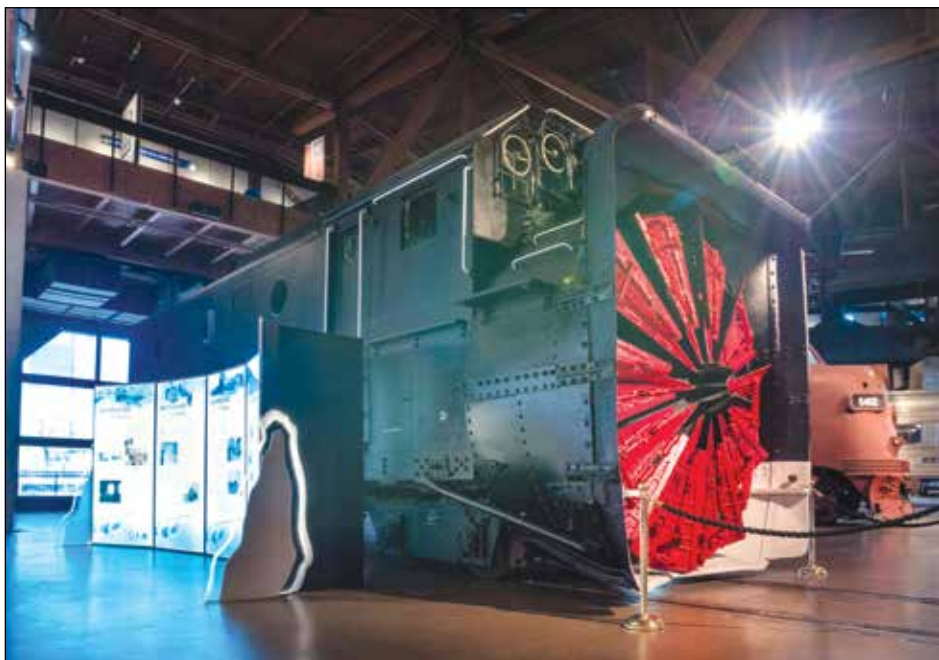

## Historic 1920s Rotary Snowplow and Compelling “Snowbound in the Sierra” Exhibit Returns

### SACRAMENTO, CA (MPG)

- For a limited time, visitors to the California State Railroad Museum have a special opportunity to see a 251,000-pound rotary snowplow from the Museum’s impressive collection along with a compelling exhibit titled “Snowbound in the Sierra.” The SP MW205 (formerly known as SP 715) snowplow on display was built in 1920, converted to electric in 1958, retired by Union Pacific in 2004 and was donated to the Railroad Museum in 2008. Since then, the historic snowplow has been housed in the Shops in the Sacramento Railyards except for short-term displays at the Railroad Museum each winter.

With the historic snowplow as an eye-catching centerpiece, the exhibit highlights the dramatic story of 226 passengers and crew members who were

rescued – with the help of crews working around the clock and seven rotary snowplows – after being trapped on a luxury streamliner locomotive during a massive snowstorm in the Sierra Nevada in 1952. The exhibit includes riveting narrative from passengers and crew, a special kiosk, exhibit case and video along with an interactive game.

The historic snowplow and exhibit help give Museum visitors an understanding of the various snow removal methods used by the railroad to allow for year-round locomotive use. While Museum guests will learn how cumbersome, arduous and dangerous snow removal on the railroad can be and how the preferred methods have changed over time, they will also gain insight into the critical role they played in saving lives and clearing the path for freight and transportation. Rotary snowplows were often used by the railroad as a very

last resort – such as was the case for the City of San Francisco locomotive highlighted in the exhibit – due to the incredible expense involved. Rotary snowplows only moved five to ten miles per hour, had high fuel costs and required an elite crew. It is estimated that less than 200 rotary snowplows still exist throughout the world today.

Currently on display in the Museum’s Roundhouse, the rotary snowplow and companion “Snowbound in the Sierra” exhibit will remain on public view through March 2019. Viewing the exhibit and locomotive are included in Museum admission: \$12 for adults; \$6 for youths ages 6-17; free for children ages 5 and under. ## Get Ready for Taxes:

Here's How the New Tax Law Revised Family Tax Credits

WASHINGTON (MPG) - More families will be able to get more money under the newly-revised Child Tax Credit, according to the Internal Revenue Service.

This is the third in a series of reminders to help taxpayers get ready for the upcoming tax filing season. Additionally, the IRS has recently updated a special page on its website with steps to take now for the 2019 tax filing season.

The Tax Cuts and Jobs Act (TCJA), the tax reform legislation passed in December 2017, doubled the maximum Child Tax Credit, boosted income limits to be able to claim the credit, and revised the identification number requirement for 2018 and subsequent years. The new law also created a second smaller credit of up to \$500 per dependent aimed at taxpayers supporting older children and other relatives who do not qualify for the Child Tax Credit.

“As we approach the 2019 tax-filing season, I want to remind taxpayers to take advantage of this valuable tax credit if they are eligible to claim it,” said IRS Commissioner Chuck Rettig. “Tax reform changed the tax code significantly and doubling the Child Tax Credit is an example of how the changes impact taxpayers.”

Here are some important things taxpayers need to know as they plan for the tax-filing season in early 2019:

**Child Tax Credit increased**  
Higher income limits mean more

families are now eligible for the Child Tax Credit. The credit begins to phase out at \$200,000 of modified adjusted gross income, or \$400,000 for married couples filing jointly, which is up from the 2017 levels of \$75,000 for single filers or \$110,000 for married couples filing jointly.

Increased from \$1,000 to \$2,000 per qualifying child, the credit applies if the child is younger than 17 at the end of the tax year, the taxpayer claims the child as a dependent, and the child lives with the taxpayer for more than six months of the year. The qualifying child must also have a valid Social Security Number issued before the due date of the tax return, including extensions.

Up to \$1,400 of the credit can be refundable for each qualifying child. This means an eligible taxpayer may get a refund even if they don't owe any tax.

For more information, see Publication 972, Child Tax Credit, available soon on IRS.gov.

### New Credit for Other Dependents

A new tax credit — Credit for Other Dependents — is available for dependents for whom taxpayers cannot claim the Child Tax Credit. These dependents may include dependent children who are age 17 or older at the end of 2018 or parents or other qualifying relatives supported by the taxpayer.

During the upcoming tax-filing season, the IRS urges taxpayers to use the agency's Interactive Tax Assistant to see if they qualify for either of these credits. To find out more, visit IRS.gov. ★

# Bald Eagle Presentation for Effie Yeaw

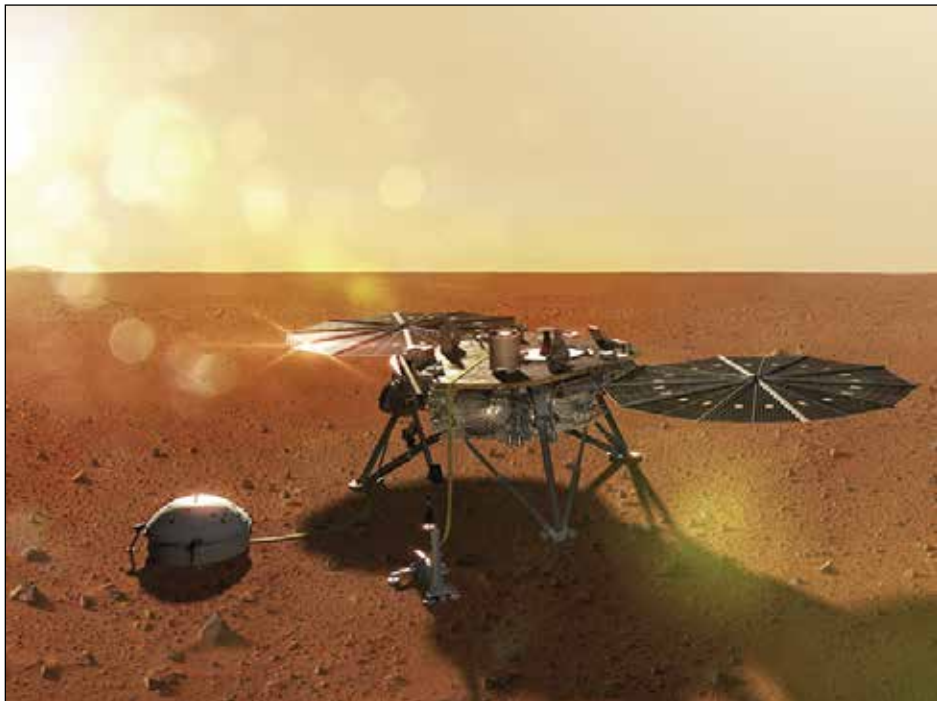

# InSight Now On Mars

*Aerojet Rocketdyne Propulsion Delivers to Planet's Surface*

**REDMOND, WA (MPG)** - Using sophisticated propulsion devices provided by Aerojet Rocketdyne, NASA's Mars InSight lander successfully touched down on the surface of the red planet Nov. 26.

The final phase of InSight's descent was powered by 12 Aerojet Rocketdyne MR-107N 50 lbf engines, providing variable pounds of pulsed thrust throughout its descent, which began firing after the lander jettisoned its parachute and heat shield. The engines maneuvered the craft clear of the falling parachute before bringing it gently to the Martian surface, where it will gather data on the planet's seismology, rotation and internal temperature.

"We provided propulsion for every phase of this important NASA mission, from launch to landing," said Eileen Drake, Aerojet Rocketdyne CEO and

president. "A mission like this leaves no margin for error and our systems successfully performed their critical roles as expected."

Mars InSight began its journey May 5 with its launch from Vandenberg Air Force Base, California, aboard a United Launch Alliance Atlas V rocket. Aerojet Rocketdyne supplied the RL10C-1 main engine and 12 MR-106 reaction control thrusters for the rocket's Centaur upper stage, as well as helium pressurization tanks for the vehicle's first and second stages.

During InSight's roughly six-month cruise to Mars, four Aerojet Rocketdyne MR-106B thrusters, each generating four pounds of thrust, kept the probe on target via five trajectory correction maneuvers. Meanwhile, four MR-111C thrusters, each generating one pound of thrust, kept the craft stable and pointed in the right direction.

These same thrusters provided the final trajectory and pointing adjustments as the lander approached the Martian atmosphere. Aerojet Rocketdyne also supplied two helium pressurization tanks on the lander.

Mars InSight will study the deep interior of Mars, examining in depth its crust, mantle, and core. Aerojet Rocketdyne engines have flown aboard every successful U.S. Mars mission, including orbiters and landers. Additionally, Aerojet Rocketdyne propulsion systems have taken NASA probes to every planet in the solar system and even beyond. The agency's two Voyager probes, which launched in 1977, are equipped with Aerojet Rocketdyne thrusters. Voyager 1 is in interstellar space, while Voyager 2 is in the heliosheath, the outermost layer of the heliosphere. ★
