Rancho Cordova Library Has a Really Cool New Look

RANCHO CORDOVA, CA (MPG) - Many changes greeted patrons who returned to the reopened and newly remodeled Rancho Cordova Library. The first change patrons who showed up Monday, October 1 noticed was that the library was open. Rancho Cordova Library joins several other county libraries offering Sunday and Monday service. The new hours will provide more opportunities for patrons to use and enjoy all the library has to offer, which is considerable. Every Sunday afternoon through November, Sacramento Anime Society will present classic and modern anime movies.

"Patrons have asked for

Sunday hours for twenty years," said Jill Stockinger, MLS, Library Supervisor, who expects traffic and circulation to increase. Currently, she said, they are in the top five for circulation out of the 28 system-wide libraries. The top two, she added, had already been open six days a week.

Patrons may find that some of their favorite materials have been moved. Biography has its own section as does urban fiction, graphic novels, and other genres, another feature Stockinger said patrons requested. Newspapers have their own shelves, and foreign language books have been alphabetized by language. The Friends of the Library book sale has moved to an alcove with better lighting, replaced by

Lucky Day and new releases. The self-checkout has been relocated opposite the circulation desk and offers more privacy.

Gone are the brightly colored walls and mustard shelving. A hint of green colors the walls, and all shelves have been repainted oyster. Each book, CD, DVD, and other shelved materials were removed and reshelfed during September's month-long closure. Hard surface flooring replaces carpet in front of the high traffic circulation desk, which also sports new countertops and ergonomically correct workstations.

"Staff is thrilled with the remodel and most patrons walking in love it," said Stockinger.

One new feature that excites



Stockinger very much is the wheelchair accessible catalog station. A shelf slides out so that the wheelchair can fit under and patrons can access the catalog themselves instead of requiring staff assistance.

Rancho Cordova Library is one of only three system-wide with "We Speak" communication tablets available for non-verbal or less-verbal

Locals Experience the Barrel District

RANCHO CORDOVA, CA (MPG) - The Rancho Cordova Chamber of Commerce, with sponsorship support from the City of Rancho Cordova, hosted the inaugural Barrel District Experience on October 6, 2018. The fundraising event gave ticket-holders access to private parties at the nine businesses in Rancho Cordova's Barrel District: Gold River Distillery, J.J. PFister Distilling Company, Thin Line Brewing Company, ol' Republic Brewery, Old Hangtown Beer Works, Fort Rock Brewing, Claimstake Brewing, Burning Barrel Brewing Company, and Strad Meadery.

Sheryl Smith, owner of Smith Real Estate Services, Inc. (a local small business in Rancho Cordova) and Chamber of Commerce board member, originated the idea of the Barrel District Experience and chaired the event. The

Chamber of Commerce partnered with eight local businesses that donated food for the Barrel District Experience: Pocket Deli, Go 4 Pizza, Mod Pizza,

Petali, Chick-fil-A, KP International Market, Parkwest Casino Cordova, and Yarbrough's Catering. Rancho Cordova locals Stephanie and

Ken Miller visited J.J. PFister Distilling Company as their fourth stop in the Experience. The Millers had never been to the distillery before the event and, Stephanie said "it has a great showroom, a great ambiance." Stephanie was the winner of J.J. PFister's Experience giveaway: two tickets to a Sac Republic game and a bottle of gin.

Gail Keck, co-owner of J.J. PFister Distilling Company, said the Barrel District Experience "is a great program for Rancho Cordova to be doing, it's very proactive and is a very positive image for the District." The distillery offered samples of gin and vodka cocktails, and Keck said her favorite was the gin cocktail, which surprised her because she is not typically a gin drinker: "It hits your tongue with a taste of juniper, and then bursts into your mouth with other flavors."

10th Annual CruiseFest Lights Up the Streets

SACRAMENTO REGION, CA (MPG) - Sacramento's largest block party celebrating cars and car culture shut down Fulton Avenue between El Camino and Marconi Saturday, October 6. For a few hours, people set aside concerns, put down signs, and left protests outside of the 10th annual CruiseFest, because, it seemed from the smiling faces, laughter, and dancing in the streets and parking lots, everyone loves a block party with cars. And there were cars to be seen, touched, admired, purchased, and to bring back memories. Metropolitans, Porsches, Fords, Chevys, Pontiacs, Plymouths, Jeeps, and even dune buggies showed off their best. Not all of the 360 registered vehicles cruised. That number, up from 2017, was forty cars shy of the cap, according to Fulton Avenue Association Executive Director Melinda Eppler.

CruiseFest is a car show equalizer welcoming any make, model, year, or type when most shows set criteria based on those or other factors. It's rare to see Porsches in a show alongside Gremlins, the Oscar Meyer Weinermobile, or a replica of the ambulance used in Ghostbusters, the 1984 movie starring Bill Murray and Dan Akroyd.

"It is a true celebration of Northern California's car culture," said Delta Pick Mello, Executive Director of California Automobile Museum.

No car show or street festival is complete without the all-important soundtrack, which was ever-changing along Fulton Avenue. Every few paces, the music shifted from classic to alternative rock courtesy of 96.9 The Eagle and ALT 94.7 to hip hop from a passing muscle car to surf music to classic R&B with a side of Rolling Stones, Bill Withers, and Tommy James and the Shondells.

businesses, and corporations also showed and cruised. Parked along the east side of Fulton, behind a giant blue Volvo with roll cage, were the Oscar Meyer Weinermobile and Planter's Peanuts Nutmobile. Further down Fulton were the Radio Fiyer Red Wagon and Tribute

Team American Graffiti cars.

Vehicles flashed their colors - aqua, metallic flake, red, flames, purple, rust, blue, yellow, and one white car with Marilyn Monroe's image painted on its hood. Others sported colorful rims and wheels. Many had displays showing the vehicle's

restoration. And some highlighted power and what was under the hood. Chrome shone and waxed cars provided an alternate view of the party through gleaming reflections.

As they made the U-turn at Marconi, some cars meandered by, taking their time, slow and proper as a beauty queen coming down the runway. Others strutted, head held high, like top models wearing their designer best. A few made sure to be heard above the music and voices, showcasing their power. And many made the turn with little fanfare.

"I used to drive one of those," said a woman when the purple Gremlin began the southbound journey. "I didn't know they still existed," said a man.

Booths, pop-up boutiques, food trucks, California Highway Patrol, and Sacramento Children's museum lined the street. Asia Market & Restaurants' parking lot became a dance party, courtesy of James Powell and his 1971 Cutlass playing R & B dance tunes from waterproof boat speakers installed in the engine compartment.

At times, the event seemed to be all about the children who could be found at Sacramento Children's Museum's booth in front of the Assistance League's Fabulous Finds on Fulton shop. Molly Mix,

the museum's program manager, was on hand teaching kids how to play the kazoo and use the catapult to launch Leo.

"You're never too old for a kaleidoscope, catapults, or flip car racing," she said.

Also set up there were California Highway Patrol officer Amy Walker and senior volunteer John Harris who were giving teddy bears to children and offering child safety tips and identification information.

Further down, a woman said, "Hey look, it's the Porsche lot. "Every kind of Porsche you could think of," said another.

It seemed like every type of vehicle imaginable was on hand, including a golf cart doubling as the Zombie Outbreak Response Vehicle. This was the event's seventh year on Fulton Avenue and is hosted by Fulton Avenue Association for California Automobile Museum, which showcased many vehicles from its collection.

"We are very grateful to our volunteers and our sponsors, especially the Fulton Avenue Association for supporting and hosting this event," wrote Mello in an email.

Beatles vs. Stones Tribute Show to Settle an Old Score in Sacramento

SACRAMENTO, CA (MPG) - The debate between the Beatles and the Rolling Stones has been going on ever since they first crossed paths on the charts 54 years ago. The argument at the time, and one that still persists, was that the Beatles were a pop group and the Stones were a rock band: the boys next door vs. the bad boys of rock. So who's better? These two legendary bands will engage in an on-stage, throw down - a musical 'showdown' if you will - on October 17 at the Crest Theatre at 7:30 pm courtesy of tribute bands Abbey Road and Satisfaction - The International Rolling Stones Show.

Taking the side of the Fab Four is Abbey Road, one of the county's top Beatles tribute bands. With brilliant musicianship and authentic costumes and gear, Abbey Road plays beloved songs spanning the Beatles' career. They face off against renowned Stones tribute band Satisfaction - The International Rolling Stones Show, who offer a faithful rendition of the music and style of Mick Jagger, Keith Richards and the bad boys of the British Invasion.

Where did the idea for the show come from?

"Music fans never had a chance to see the Beatles and the Rolling Stones perform on the same marquee," said Chris Legrand, who plays "Mick Jagger" in the show.

"Now, music aficionados can watch this debate play out on stage."

The Sacramento show is part of a 125 stop tour of the U.S., Australia and Canada and has been touring since 2011. The show also performs long term residencies for a number of the Harrah's Casino properties. The production includes some of the more popular songs from the two rock pioneers and covers the scope of their musical careers, although the set list for Satisfaction usually includes Rolling Stones songs up to the 1980s.

"They certainly have more pop songs but we're a really great live show. The fans are in for an incredible night of music!" says LeGrand.

During the two-hour show, the bands perform three sets each, trading places in quick set changes and ending the night with an all-out encore involving both bands. The band members have their outfits custom-made, since avid fans know exactly what the Beatles

and Stones wore onstage during different time periods in their careers. There's a lot of good-natured jabbing between the bands as well.

"Without Beatlemania, the Stones might still be a cover band in London," said Chris Overall, who plays "Paul."

"There's no question that the Beatles set the standard."

The audience naturally enjoys top shelf tributes to two legendary bands in the same evening. Like The Idaho Statesman said: "If you see only one tribute show, see this one...smart and loads of fun."

"It's just a fun time and a cool back-and-forth nonstop show," Overall said.

"We're going to bring it all. It's going to be an evening of high-energy music," said Legrand.

"Beatles vs. Stones - A Musical Showdown" comes to the Crest Theatre on Wednesday, October 17 at 7:30 pm. While enjoying a beer at ol' Republic Brewery, David Sawyer was impressed with the Experience and suggested that highlighting the Barrel District will likely bring more money into the city: "The future of Rancho Cordova is brighter today than it has been since Mather closed. Forward thinking individuals have created an event that has room to grow."

Strad Meadery officially opened for business just 18 hours before the start of the event, and many attendees had been eagerly anticipating their opportunity to taste the sweet honey wine. Dana Dresner said, "It's been my favorite stop out of all of them...I've been waiting forever for it to open."

Dan Slort quipped that he is

the "owner and dishwasher" of Strad Meadery. He first started in a location on 16th Street in Sacramento, but when he wanted to expand they just wouldn't work with him to find suitable space in a timely manner. He talked with City Halls in a few different surrounding areas, but he said Rancho Cordova went out of its way to make it as easy as possible for him to get the space he needed. "Rancho Cordova City Hall has been awesome," he said.

Each batch of mead is unique because it's made from local Sacramento wildflower honey. "If you have allergies, drink two cups of mead every day for a year. And then after a year, you won't have a job... I mean, allergies," Slort joked.

Tony Drexel's visit to Strad

Meadery was long awaited and much anticipated; he had been calling for weeks to find out when the tasting room would be open. Drexel summed up his Barrel District Experience: "It's been a fantastic adventure; very well organized and well executed."

The inaugural Barrel District Experience was an extremely successful fundraiser for the Chamber of Commerce and highlighted many local Rancho Cordova businesses. Kate and Mark Reuter enjoyed the Experience so much that they're already planning to purchase pre-sale tickets for next year's event as soon as they go on sale.

Shaun Bailey said, "It's been a fantastic journey. Let's experience it again with a time machine!" ★

patrons. It also boasts the only collection of Korean language newspapers and books that are donated by the Sacramento Valley Korean America Community. Children's books include Russian, Spanish, Korean, and Braille. And the general DVD collection is a global smorgasbord featuring films in Swedish, Tagalog, Malaysian, Hungarian, and many others.

Not all changes could be completed during the closure. A new Veterans Resource Station is being fitted to the space and will be installed when it arrives, she said, but it is currently open Tuesdays and Thursdays from 12:30 p.m. - 4:30 p.m. and staffed by trained volunteers and veterans. Quarterly meetings with staff from Congressman Ami Bera's office help remove roadblocks for veterans and their families.

"We serve more vets than any other city in California," said

Stockinger.

Volunteers are an asset in other areas and include Jesuit High students assisting elementary school students with homework, book shelve, and Friends of the Library member who run the book sale and donate funds for new books and additional library programming.

"We could not do all our programming without the Friends," said Stockinger.

The library's calendar is filled with programming for just about every interest, but there's a special emphasis on garden events like the monthly garden club for adults. The October program featured Judith Yisrael of The Yisrael Family Urban Farm who demonstrated how to make Swiss chard pesto and beet hummus. Teen librarian Susanna Wesenfeld hosts the monthly event and said she's glad to be back at the library so she can return to the gardening programs with children and teens that take place in the Read & Feed Garden.

Basil, tomato, eggplant, squash varieties, corn, and sunflowers are among the crops grown and harvested by young patrons. Following story time, children and parents are invited to the vegetable garden for hands-on garden activities. Older kids, she said, attend garden lab where they learn vertical gardening and composting. Their first task, since the library had been closed for a month, was to remove dead plants and begin composting.

Wesenfeld is launching an after school book club on October 17, a story walk on October for patrons to "follow and read story pages throughout the library and then go to the garden." STEM activities, Minecraft, and Read to a Dog are some of the other programs she hosts. For additional information, visit: www.saclibrary.org or www.saclibrary.org/Locations/Rancho-Cordova. 





SHOULD I WATCH GOD FRIENDED ME ON CBS?
Question: Seeing ads for *God Friendened Me* and I immediately think of *Kevin (Probably) Saves The World*, with Jason Ritter as Kevin, which I liked a lot but the show never made it to a second season. So for that reason alone, and not wanting to invest my time in something that might not click (regardless of “God” having a part in this one), combined

with the familiarity factor, I probably won’t even tune in to sample it. Unless you’ve seen previews and highly recommend. —Michael
Matt Roush: I hear a lot of this sort of comment this time of year, from people who’ve been burned by cancellations and are wary to commit to new programs. In this case, I’d advise taking a leap of faith, especially if this is your type of show. *God Friendened Me* has some

similarities to *Kevin*, though the premise doesn’t seem nearly as convoluted, and not unlike Jason Ritter, the lead, Brandon Micheal Hall has plenty of charisma as the atheist who keeps getting messages from a mysterious “God” account. (Bonus: *Scandal*’s Joe Morton plays his pastor dad.) Another plus: *God* seems more compatible to CBS’s schedule—the network of the long-running *Touched by an Angel*, let’s not forget—than Kevin ever did on ABC, and it’s in a cushier Sunday time period, so while there’s never any guarantee of success, I’d expect this to have a better chance at a decent run.







Lancers Romp Riles Up Homecoming Crowd

SACRAMENTO, CA (MPG) - What better way to entertain a packed house on Homecoming night than with the 77-13 rout the Cordova High School football team performed October 5 against Florin.

The Lancers lit up the scoreboard behind an explosive offense (364 yards on 22 plays) and a clamp-down defense (only seven first downs allowed and five forced turnovers).

"It was nice to actually get all cylinders clicking," Lancers head coach John McCoy said. "We haven't done that until tonight. We were able to run the ball some games, we were able to throw the ball some games – but tonight we were able to do everything."

The victory brings Cordova to 3-5 overall and 2-0 in Greater Sacramento League play.

"Coming into the game, we knew they were going to be short-handed. Our thing was, we wanted to play against ourselves,

not the level of competition," Cordova assistant coach Charlie Ruiz said. "We wanted to reach our potential. ... We did what we were supposed to do."

Johnele Sanders finished 7 for 8 passing with 194 yards and two touchdowns through the air to go with three scores on the ground.

Alvin Banks caught four passes for 105 yards, including a

screen pass he transformed into a 58-yard touchdown.

"We caught them on a blitz," Ruiz said of that play. "Johnele just floated it over the defenders hands, we got a great block on the outside and Alvin did what he does. It was awesome."

Jaylen Jones scored on runs of 22 and 26 yards while Raymond Fite had a 30-yard touchdown jaunt.

Sanders had touchdown runs from 33, 5 and 7 yards – that last one on 4th-and-inches.

"I'm excited because our main guys – Jaylen, Ray, Alvin, Johnlele, Jeremiah – had great games," Ruiz said.

Defensively, the Lancers allowed just 174 yards while creating opportunities with turnovers.

Dashawn Bradley hauled in

a pair of interceptions while Dumaurier Hackett and Kelton Stevens both forced fumbles.

Jeremiah Bankett and Fite each scooped up fumbles and rumbled to the house, with returns of 48 and 55 yards respectively, and Trevor Dix recovered another fumble.

Andrew Turner and Elijah Jenkins each had sacks and Ki Allen blocked a punt.

Cordova has a bye October 12 before hosting Natomas in league play October 19. ★

RANCHO CORDOVA, CA (MPG) - Recently infused with a sizeable donation from Brooks Sports Inc., the Cordova High School cross country team is poised to win its first league title in nearly 50 years.

Last week the Lancers received \$14,500 worth of gear and funds from Brooks Sports, according to Cordova coach Josh Gruver. That came about because the Lancers' participation and enthusiasm caught the attention of 2018 Boston Marathon medalist Shadrack Biwott.

After meeting Gruver at a track meet and seeing the Lancers out on their practice trail, where the Folsom resident regularly runs, Biwott sent a letter to Brooks that led to the donation.

Brooks Sports donated newly designed uniforms as well as two pairs of shoes to each runner – along with socks and headbands – and an additional \$2,000 toward entrance fees.

"The kids deserve it 110 percent," Gruver said. "They've proven they can show up, at practice and beyond. It's a great group of kids."

Biwott met with the team last week when representatives from Brooks traveled from Seattle to make the donation.

"They were blown away," Gruver said of his runners hearing from Biwott, who

finished third in the 2018 Boston Marathon. "The runners loved talking to him."

Gruver, who graduated from Cordova in 2010, is clearly proud of the Lancers.

"This team is the strongest at Cordova since the 1980s," said third-year coach Gruver. "That is huge. If we win league, it would be the first time since 1983."

Sophomore Michaela Laret leads the Lancers varsity girls team, winning the Greater Sacramento League Meet No. 1 with a time of 20 minutes and 53 seconds. Temara Fletcher, Nevaeh Williams, Angela Dong and Laina Carnes rounded out a first-place team finish at that meet.

Senior Mason Trujillo placed fourth at the league meet with a personal best of 17:08, with Gavin Sullivan and Enrique Angulo-Sanchez right behind him in fifth and sixth respectively. Caleb Lynch and Carlos Rodriguez rounded out Cordova's second-place finish.

Gruver noted top JV runners Isaac Sanchez, Jose Rico, Amanda Brown and Arista Chauhan – who "carries the heart of the team in terms of attitude and work ethic," the coach said.

The team cumulatively has the highest grade-point-average of any team sport at the school with a 3.5, according to Cordova communications and community engagement director Daniel Thigpen. ★

Men's Soccer

RANCHO CORDOVA, CA (MPG) - Despite allowing a gift goal in just the second minute of play, the FLC men's soccer team rallied for three goals of their own to defeat a quality Santa Rosa team on Friday afternoon at Falcon Stadium, 3-2. The Bear Cubs entered the match in a tie for first place in the Big 8 with Delta, three points ahead of the third-place Falcons. After the early hiccup, the Falcons unleashed an offensive attack of their own that resulted in two quick goals within a minute; Mouad Zehnoui tallied the first one with a perfectly placed high, looping shot that bounced over the Bear Cubs' center back (the goalkeeper had strayed too far out to defend) to tie the score. Less than a minute later, Adam Ratto attacked the right sideline, then centered a pass that found Miguel Medina in front of the goal for his 12th goal of the season and a 2-0 Falcon lead. The Falcons' third goal came from Adam Ratto – his second of the season – and gave the Falcons a 3-1 lead. The Bear Cubs added a second-half goal that made for some anxious moments, but ultimately the Falcon defense held strong to secure the win. The Falcons improved their record to 10-1-1 overall

and are now tied for second in the Big 8 (with Santa Rosa) at 3-1-1. They'll host Clovis on Tuesday in a non-conference match at Falcon Stadium at 4:00 pm.

Women's Soccer

The Falcons took advantage of a Hat Trick by sophomore Alhan Bakideh to roll past host Modesto on Friday afternoon, 3-1. The Falcons actually started slowly on Friday, allowing the Pirates to take an early 1-0 lead and still trailed by that score at halftime. Coach Donny Ribaudo then moved goalkeeper Izzy Chinchay to forward (with Hunter Casperson now in goal), which energized the offense with hustle and aggressive attacks. The three goals by Bakideh give her seven for the season and was her second hat trick of 2018 (the first came against Solano).

With two matches to play before they reach the halfway point in their Big 8 schedule, the Falcons are in third place and just one point behind Santa Rosa. They will travel to Pleasant Hill on Tuesday to face an always-tough Diablo Valley squad (8-3 overall, 4-3 Big 8) at 3:30 pm.


