Mather still impacts the community as a civilian airfield, training pilots and helping packages shipped by carriers like FedEx and UPS "get there overnight." It is home to veterans who need medical care or a place to live, the exciting annual California Capital Airshow, a quiet afternoon fishing at Mather Lake or swinging the clubs at Mather Golf Course. RANCHO CORDOVA, CA (MPG) - Hundreds of Cordova High School families, alumni, faculty and students gathered Friday to celebrate the achievements of the Class of 2018 during the school's 54th commencement ceremony in Lancer Stadium.

# SacRT Awarded \$12 Million to Expand SmaRT Ride Service **On-Demand Microtransit Seen as Solution for Underserved Areas**

SACRAMENTO REGION, CA (MPG) - SmaRT Ride microtransit service may be coming to a neighborhood near you, thanks to a \$12 million grant to expand the ondemand, neighborhood-friendly bus service to twelve Sacramento communities. The Sacramento Transportation Authority (STA) recently awarded the discretionary grant to the Sacramento Regional Transit District (SacRT) to promote shuttle service in residential and commercial areas that are underserved by public transit.

"We are grateful to have the support of the STA for our SmaRT Ride program, which could very well change the nation's transit industry should innovative programs like SmaRT Ride continue to flourish," said General Manager/CEO Henry Li. "Implementing new approaches to solve mobility challenges is an exciting endeavor and our SmaRT Ride service is

proving to be an excellent solution."

The STA Board of Directors voted unanimously to award the \$12 million

funding and is guided by a Transportation Expenditure Plan.

"It was a logical decision given SmaRT grant, which comes from Measure A Ride's incredible success in such a short

amount of time," said STA Chair and City of Sacramento Councilmember Jeff Harris. "I'm pleased the STA had the foresight to save the funding until a viable opportunity presented itself. We are committed to providing public transportation to areas that are underserved by transit, and we believe SmaRT Ride has the potential to be the answer to this longstanding challenge."

SacRT is in the process of developing the new service, with the Historic Franklin Corridor and South Sacramento communities identified as the next phase for SmaRT Ride. Service is expected to start in late July. SacRT planners will work with the STA to identify the boundaries of each new phase of the service roll-out. The grant funding is expected to cover operational costs for the next 2-1/2years.

SmaRT Ride has only been in operation since February 12, when it was *Continued on page 3*

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The Connector closes a rural-to-suburban connectivity gap by transforming 34 miles of two-lane rural roads into a state-of-the-art, four-lane expressway connecting the communities of the City of Elk Grove, Sacramento County, City of Rancho Cordova, City of Folsom and El Dorado County

MATHER, CA (MPG) - The Capital SouthEast Connector Joint Powers Authority today announced the award of \$20 million in grant funding through the California Transportation Commission's (CTC) Local Partnership Program (LPP) available through Senate Bill 1, the Road Repair and Accountability Act of 2017. The funding is a boost to the expressway project, which has widespread benefits throughout and beyond the Sacramento region. The Connector received the third largest statewide funding award of close to 90 grant applications for projects throughout California.

"We are very pleased with the California Transportation Commission's recognition of the exceptional benefits the Connector will provide to rural communities, goods movement and traffic safety throughout the greater Sacramento region, as evident in their decision to fully fund our grant request of \$20 million," said Derek Minnema, executive director of the Capital SouthEast Connector JPA. "We're also grateful for the overwhelming continued project support and are excited to move this project forward thanks to this funding."

Earlier this year, the Sacramento Transportation Authority ranked the Connector as it's No. 1 regional transportation project pursuing funding through the CTC's LPP grant program.

This funding award comes at a critical time for the project. The Connector was one of only two California projects, and the only rural project, that applied for federal dollars through the Infrastructure for Rebuilding America (INFRA) grant program that received LPP funding. The \$20 million grant by the CTC will increase the capacity to strongly leverage state dollars if federal funding is awarded.

With funding through the LPP grant, \$40 million in needed roadway improvements in Elk Grove, Folsom and Sacramento County will begin.

The Connector closes a rural-to-suburban connectivity gap by transforming 34 miles of two-lane rural roads into a state-of-the-art, fourlane expressway connecting the communities of the City of Elk Grove, Sacramento County, City of Rancho Cordova, City of Folsom and El Dorado County. The new expressway will provide instant regional congestion relief to downtown Sacramento, provide parallel capacity to Highway 50, and an evacuation route for the southeastern part of Sacramento County. Project benefits also extend beyond the region as the Connector has been identified as a key project within California's Central Valley Major International Trade Region, and will connect three U.S. Department of Transportation's Primary Freight Network Routes that are the backbone of goods movement within the Central Valley.

The Connector JPA was formed in December 2006 and includes Sacramento County, El Dorado County and the cities of Elk Grove, Folsom and Rancho Cordova. It is responsible for the Connector's planning, environmental review, engineering design, development and construction.

Ridership on the service has jumped by more than six times since its inception, and the response from the community has been overwhelmingly positive. "I am very thankful we have the resources to provide quality, on-demand ride share services to our most vulnerable populations." said STA Director and Sacramento County Supervisor Sue Frost. "Providing curb-tocurb service for an affordable price is a tremendous accomplishment, and we look forward to watching the service expand region wide.

The cost to ride is only \$2.75 per trip, \$1.35 for those eligible for discount fare (seniors, students and persons with disabilities); or, riders can use their SacRT monthly pass. The lowcost makes SacRT's SmaRT Ride more affordable than a traditional ride-hailing service, which could cost riders more than five times the amount for a similar trip. The on-demand service is also generating a significant amount of national attention due to its innovative nature. The pilot is proving to be an exceptional model for other transit agencies who are adopting similar programs.

# SouthEast Connector Secures \$20 Million Grant Don Nottoli Speaks Out **Against Delta Tunnels**

RANCHO CORDOVA, CA (MPG) Sacramento County District 5 Supervisor Don Nottoli was May's Cordova Council luncheon speaker, addressing a number of topics throughout the state, county and City of Rancho Cordova, but none more important than Governor Jerry Brown's push to destroy the Delta.

While Nottoli took the time to express his pleasure for the progress and success that Rancho Cordova and Mather have made over the recent years and thanked those who helped pave the way, he was hot on the topic of the Delta tunnels.

"It's been a very long battle and we have a governor who is very focused on two particular projects, being the high speed rail and the construction of the Delta tunnels," he said. "It has been a very high priority and certainly our local government has pushed back while they can but it has recently been taken out of the hands of legislators."

"They continue to forge ahead," Nottoli exclaimed. "And as recently as yesterday the Metropolitan Water District of Los Angeles (and other Southern California water districts) came together and, with a new body, have formed the Delta Conveyance Design and Construction."

According to the Department of Water Resources: "The Delta Conveyance Design and Construction Authority (DCA) has been formed as a Joint Powers Authority by the participating public water agencies. It will be charged

with final design and construction of WaterFix facilities, under the oversight of DWR. This model will allow the State and the public water agencies funding the project to assign roles and responsibilities that align around a shared vision to safely and transparently design and build WaterFix."

"They will design the project and build it in our front yards. To me it is tremendously insulting, let alone injurious to our communities," declared Nottoli. "It will over time be a slow degradation of our Delta communities. With an emphasis on Farm to Fork and our environment and on recreation

and on many other aspects of the Delta...generations of families will be displaced."

Referring to the project as a "water grab," Nottoli urged those in attendance to get involved. "If you get an opportunity, if you're talking to a legislator, if you get a chance to write a letter (do so)," he said. "I don't think we'll get a chance to vote on it anytime soon, they've done a really good job of keeping it away from the ballot. To me it's wrongheaded, it's misguided and probably in my work as a county supervisor one of the most challenging issues that I've ever encountered."



Similar to other ride-hailing

as Microtransit by TransLoc, is connected to proprietary software that allows bus operators to pick-up and drop-off passengers in an efficient manner. have chosen to serve in the military.

Among those choosing college after high school, 30 students are the first in their families to do so. The Class of 2018 earned a combined \$37,000 in local scholarships to further their educations, and three students stand to receive educational benefits from the military worth a combined \$265,000.

Forty students finished in the top 10 percent of their class. Sixty-seven students took one or more rigorous International Baccalaureate (IB) Diploma Programme classes in their final

years of high school, while 20 students earned full IB diplomas. Additionally, 44 students

earned California State Seal of Merit Diplomas, and another 51 met or surpassed the requirements to earn State Seal of Biliteracy awards.

Friday marked Principal Dan Anklam's eighth and final year as Cordova High's leader. Next year he will take over leadership of Mitchell Middle School, where he began his teaching career 30 years ago.

Anklam called the Class of 2018 a group distinguished by its response to change: The implementation of the IB Programme, new facility modernizations on

campus, and a rapidly evolving world around them, just to name a few.

"The Class of 2018 modeled class, decorum, and dignity," Anklam said. "The Class of 2018 not only experienced and lived change, they thrived in change. Learning to cope with, work with, and embrace change is an essential skill to becoming fully formed adults."

We're always trying to save time and energy, but for what? 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



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


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#### Teach them while they're young

Your son is at a great point in life to learn how to make money behave. Even in his situation, when he's still living at home, there are plenty of things he can include in a budget. There's gas for his car, along with maintenance and insurance. He'll need to save a little money — maybe even for college — and I'm sure he'll want some spending cash,

Sit down, and teach him how to make a written budget by figuring out the upcoming month's income and expenses ahead of time. Also, make sure he knows how to properly balance and

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reconcile his bank account.

It's still your responsibility to provide him with the basic necessities at this point. But I love your willingness to teach your son how to handle money intelligently. The sooner he learns some basic money management principles, the sooner he'll be able to handle his finances responsibly in the real world!

#### Controlling your cash Dear Dave,

I work long hours, and I make pretty good money. The problem is the money from my paychecks always seems to disappear before the end of the month. I know part of the problem is grabbing quick meals between extra shifts, and eating out a lot after work, because I'm usually too tired to cook when I get home. How can someone who has very little free time start gaining control of their finances? -Sheila

#### Dear Sheila.

No matter how little free time you think you have, or how tired you are, you *must* make time do a written budget every month. This is essential. Making a budget for the month ahead isn't a

lot of hard work, and it really doesn't take long. When you give every dollar a name before the month begins, you're taking control of your money instead of allowing a lack of it to control you.

Start with the income you know is predictable. If that isn't possible, look back over the last few months and find the minimum amount you brought home during a month over that period of time. This will be the basis for your budget. Once you've established a baseline income, you can write down and prioritize bills and other expenses. Just remember, restaurants are not a priority!

When you make a prioritized spending plan, and start telling your money what to do ahead of time, you'll have the ability to do what's important with what you've earned!

- Review each CEF grantee's compliance with the city's reporting requirements and make recommendations to exclude noncomplying organizations from future award cycles to the City Council for consideration.
- Any amended or additional responsibilities as determined by a majority vote of the full city council.
