California Law Allows Time Off to Vote on Election Day

SACRAMENTO REGION, CA (MPG) - To help ensure voters can get to the polls on Election Day, June 5, California law allows workers to take up to two hours off work to vote if they are unable to during non-work hours.

"Californians should make a plan now for how they will cast a ballot on Election Day," Secretary of State Alex Padilla said. "Every registered voter has a right to cast their ballot before the polls close. If you can't make it to your polling place outside of working hours, you have the right to take time off to vote, without a loss of pay."

California Elections Code section 14000 allows workers up to two hours off, without a loss of pay, to vote if they do not have enough time to do so in their non-work hours. The law requires workers to notify their employers two working days before the election if they need to take time off to vote.

Polling places are open between 7:00 a.m. and 8:00 p.m. on Election Day.

Also, every California employer is required to post, in a visible location, a notice informing employees of their rights at least 10 days before an election. This volunteer-based program relies heavily on community support, with individuals giving their time to serve grieving children and their families.

Volunteers will receive training beginning July 31, 2018. The program itself is held 2 evenings a month from September to May. To learn more about becoming part of the healing process, members of the community are invited to an informational night hosted by Snowline.

Metro Fire Conducts Range Management Vegetation Burn

MATHER, CA (MPG) - The Sacramento Metropolitan Fire District, as part of a collaborative effort with the Sacramento County Regional Parks Department and the Center for Natural Lands Management, conducted a 100 acre range management burn at the Mather Wetlands on May 30. The Mather Wetlands is located near the intersection of Kiefer Boulevard and Zinfandel Drive in Sacramento County southeast of the Mather Airport.

This range management burn was permitted and approved through the Sacramento Metropolitan Air Quality

Management District and the Sacramento Agricultural Commissioner's Office, pending satisfactory atmospheric and fire weather conditions.

The Center for Natural Lands Management works on behalf of the Sacramento County Regional Parks Department to ensure the long range health of the Mather Preserve and together with Metro Fire applied fire to the lands to eliminate noxious vegetation and promote the regrowth of native plant species. Meanwhile, Metro Fire personnel conducted vegetation and wildfire training preparing for local incidents within the County and statewide.

This activity is part of the



Sacramento County Regional Parks Department countywide 2018 Fire Fuel Reduction Plan which will see manual fuel removal, creation of fuel breaks and fire roads, grazing by goats and sheep, and fire application to various lands by Metro Fire and the Sacramento Fire Department in an effort to reduce out of control wildfires in Sacramento County.

Detectives Investigate Rosemont Area Homicide

RANCHO CORDOVA, CA (MPG) - On May 30, 2018, at 12:22 a.m. the Sacramento County Sheriff's Department received multiple calls regarding gunshots being fired in the 9200 block of Lilibet Avenue within east Sacramento County. Additional calls were received indicating there was an unresponsive male lying on a sidewalk near the same location.

Sheriff's deputies immediately responded and upon their arrival

located a male victim who had sustained multiple gunshot wounds. Deputies attempted life-saving measures including first aid and CPR but were unsuccessful in their attempts. Personnel from the Sacramento Metro Fire District arrived on scene and pronounced the victim deceased.

Investigators have tentatively identified the victim as being a 26-year-old male. At this point, there is no known motive for this crime and homicide investigators will be on-scene throughout the morning attempting to determine

what lead up to this incident.

The identity of the victim, in this case, will be made available by the Sacramento County Coroner's office after notification has been made to his next of kin.

RANCHO CORDOVA, CA (MPG) - I went to Mather the other day to see the progress being made with the expansion they are making as they add to the original Mather hospital. The changes in the front of the Mather Hospital/Clinic, which is next door to the Mather VA Hospital, makes the building look like new. Our VA system at Mather is caring for 17 state counties and 40,000 square miles, and serving over 250,000 veterans. The future of the VA hospital at Mather is very bright, and I am very glad it is expanding. Even though there may be fewer joining the military than there were in the past, the veterans from World War II and the Korean, Vietnam, Gulf, Iraq and Afghanistan Wars are living longer, and they continue to need the care the VA offers them, and that they deserve.

Now the next 50 apartments of the Mather Veterans Village are in the beginning stages of their infrastructure, and they will be built in a very similar way as the first 50 apartments.

And Another Thing ... *Past, Present and Future*

It may possibly be completed sooner after seeing what was possible when they built the first 50 apartments. The two-story building (phase 2) is also being worked on, so they can offer more offices or classes on the first floor and around 50 temporary beds for the veterans. Those beds will not be permanent, but they will be places for the veterans to stay as they learn what is available to them at the VA Hospital and what help they can receive at the Veterans Village. Next door to them, they will also find the Volunteers of America manning the Veteran Family Services, the Veterans Service Center, and the Sacramento Works Career Center and the Mather Job Center.

And another thing that is going on in Rancho Cordova is the end of the school year for those who are graduating from elementary school to middle school, middle school to high school, high school to community two-year college, community college to university, etc. Many more people are getting their college degrees than in the past, but many have to begin their lives with very large student loans. Our Promise Program in Rancho Cordova helps many students finish the first year in college not in such debt.

And last Monday, we celebrated our 12th Memorial Day at Mather. It was a wonderful

event that gave us all an opportunity to thank our veterans and their families for the tremendous sacrifices they gave to protect our freedoms and our liberty. While we honored and thanked all members in all branches of the service as part of our ceremony, our theme this year was to also give extra thanks to the military chaplains who also are in great peril at times when they are in the thick of a battle on land or on a ship that is being hit by torpedoes from submarines. The keynote speaker this year was Chaplain Michael Garren from the VA Northern California Health Care System. He had an amazing story which comes from a book in which the USS Dorchester which was destroyed by German torpedoes. The name of the book is The Four Chaplains, and it tells the story in where four chaplains comforted and helped the men who were trying to abandon ship. All four gave out their own life jackets, and eventually went down with the ship.

Many things in our keynote speaker's speech were amazing, and I am so very glad that we are having the Memorial Day and Veterans Day ceremonies being videotaped so everything can be seen by everyone who wishes to see and hear them but couldn't be there.

Held at Mather Airport and presented by the California Capital Airshow (CCA), Positive Altitude featured aviation professionals from all walks of flight sharing colorful airplanes, helicopters, first responder vehicles, military assets and more as they offered students interactive experiences that opened their eyes to potential careers.

After winning an essay contest in which they described a time that they overcame a hardship, ten students were awarded an introductory flight lesson with a certified flight instructor. For many students this was their first opportunity to fly in an airplane, and certainly their first time as a co-pilot! 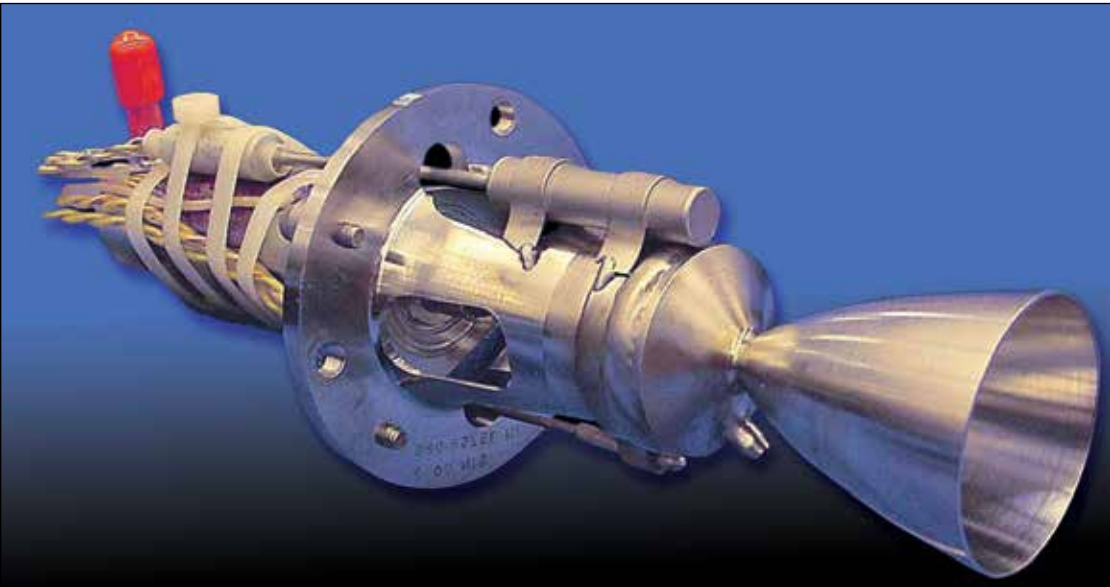

Aerojet Rocketdyne Thrusters Help Deliver Cygnus to International Space Station



Each Orbital ATK Cygnus is equipped with 32 Aerojet Rocketdyne MR-106M 7 lbf. small monopropellant hydrazine thrusters (shown above) that fire to perform required in-orbit maneuvers.

SACRAMENTO REGION, CA (MPG) - Maneuvering thrusters supplied by Aerojet Rocketdyne guided Orbital ATK's Cygnus cargo spacecraft to its ninth successful berthing to the International Space Station May 24. The Cygnus arrived three days after being launched aboard an Orbital ATK Antares rocket from the Mid-Atlantic Regional Spaceport on Wallops Island, Virginia.

Each Cygnus is equipped with 32 Aerojet Rocketdyne MR-106M hydrazine thrusters, 20 on the service module and 12 on the pressurized cargo module. These thrusters, each generating seven pounds of thrust, provide attitude control as the vehicle maneuvers itself in orbit to berth with the station.

"Cygnus is another example of the versatility of our MR-106

thrusters, variants of which are used on launch vehicles, Earth orbiting satellites and interplanetary probes," said Eileen Drake, Aerojet Rocketdyne CEO and president. "With more than 3,000 of our MR-106 thrusters flown, this thruster has become the industry workhorse for reaction control propulsion."

The Cygnus also uses a single helium pressurization tank supplied by Aerojet Rocketdyne's ARDE subsidiary. The helium tank is used to pressurize the propellant tanks which feed propellant into the Aerojet Rocketdyne thrusters.

The Cygnus spacecraft typically remain berthed to the space station for a number of weeks, during which time supplies are offloaded and the resulting volume is filled with station refuse. The spacecraft is then released

from the station and steered back into the atmosphere, burning up along with its contents during reentry.

"The Folsom Bass Team started in 1988 as a group of Folsom prison guards who had a passion for bass fishing. In fact, the club meetings used to be held at the prison itself," according to the team's mission statement. "Since its humble beginnings

the membership has grown and we now have members of all skill level and age. FBT's mission is to provide its members opportunities to learn about bass fishing in our local area through monthly meetings and tournaments. We emphasize the camaraderie and fun that comes from the sport of bass fishing."

Now in its 30th year, the team has seen a lot of faces come and go throughout the decades, but one thing remains the same – no one reveals any secrets. "We were all tight lipped back then," said Kris Sisto, an original member and former correctional officer himself. "Now, everybody lies."

The team's next tournament is a two day event on June 2 and 3 at Lake Shasta's Bridge Bay.

STAND-ALONE “SOLO” A FUN RIDE IN THE “STAR WARS” UNIVERSE

SOLO: A STAR WARS STORY
(Rated PG-13)

Cynics might view the latest “Star Wars” chapter, based on the characters created by George Lucas, to be another big payday for the franchise now in the hands of Disney, but “Solo: A Star Wars Story,” focused on a young Han Solo, is likely to be a crowd-pleaser.

That Alden Ehrenreich as Han has no tangible physical similarity to a younger version of Harrison Ford, a beloved figure who could not easily be substituted by another actor, is relatively

immaterial given that he plays the role with a familiar cocky swagger and self-confidence.

When we first meet Han he is a street urchin living in the intolerably totalitarian state of servitude to the hideous Lady Proxima (voiced by Linda Hunt) running a slave labor camp on the desolate industrial planet of Corellia.

Self-assured enough to believe that he can pilot any purloined vessel, Han boldly attempts an escape in an exciting levitated speeder chase in the company of his girlfriend Qi’ra (Emilia Clarke). Circumstances conspire to foil their mutual fight.

Eluding the stormtroopers on

his own, Han finds his only viable option to flee is to join the Imperial Army. Talking his way off the hellish Corellia, there’s a nice tidbit about how Han the street person gets his last name courtesy of military enlistment.

Vowing to become a pilot so that he may return one day to rescue Qi’ra, Han’s scheme is delayed for about three years while serving as an infantry soldier for the Empire, fighting a senseless battle that looks doomed to failure.

This reluctant call to duty causes him to fall in with dodgy officer Tobias Beckett (Woody Harrelson) and his partner Val (Thandie Newton), who are running a band of smugglers planning a heist of a highly volatile super fuel known as coaxium.

Before “Solo” kicks into the high gear of a heist caper on a dangerous mission of a train robbery in a snowy mountain pass,

Han meets his soon-to-be lifelong friend and co-pilot Chewbacca (Joonas Suotamo) under a less than desirable situation fraught with menace.

While Han is a maverick scoundrel with a good heart, he and Chewbacca, demonstrating impressive skills, are recruited into illicit activity by the temperamental Beckett for the sole purpose of repaying debts to the odious Dryden Vos (Paul Bettany).

What Han wants more than anything is to own an airship and he figures that his share of the coaxium bounty will allow him to fulfill his dream and return to Corellia. As often happens with a criminal scheme, things just don’t work out as planned.

Getting on the wrong side of Dryden Vos leads to some surprises on his space yacht filled with the beautiful people, one of whom turns out to be Qi’ra, now

elegantly dressed as the second-in-command to Vos, much to Han’s dismay.

That Western appearance theme is vividly on display when Han saunters into a saloon at Fort Yspo and ends up in a rigged card game with notorious gambler Lando Calrissian (Donald Glover) before returning later for a bet in which he wins the coveted Millennium Falcon.

With the help of Lando’s cruiser, Han convinces Vos that his compatriots should live to see another day if they can steal raw coaxium on the mining planet of Kessel.

As a reluctant partner, Lando exudes mystery as the suave rogue who has a great sense of humor in his scheming persona.

What might be missing for many aficionados of the franchise is that there is no truly villainous character of any stature like Darth Vader or even Supreme Leader

Snoke. We have to satisfy ourselves with Lady Proxima and Dryden Vos, neither of which is all that remarkable.

It may not matter much to “Star Wars” fans to note that “Solo” was a troubled production, rescued by director Ron Howard who had to redo most of the film when the producers fired the pair of original directors in mid-shoot for being too loose with the essential elements.

To Howard’s credit, the dangerous escapades for Han, Chewbacca and assorted allies are filled with endless twists and turns, insidious betrayals, forceful showdowns, and close calls where many scenes are one cliffhanger after another.

“Solo: A Star Wars Story,” surviving bumps in the road during filming, turns out to be a credit to the franchise and could lead to a sequel. ★

Former Teacher Sentenced for Attempted Possession of Child Porn, Use of Concealed Camera

DATE: April 30, 2018
CASE: Scott Macmillan (Case #17FE001087)
PROSECUTOR: Deputy District Attorney Bruce Chang, Cyber Crimes Unit

The Honorable Robert Twiss sentenced Scott Macmillan to 30 days county jail, 3 years probation and required him to register as a sex offender. On October 19, 2017, Macmillan pled no contest to attempted possession of child pornography, attempted use of a concealed camera to take photos of an adult victim for sexual purposes, and use of a concealed camera to take photos of a minor for sexual purposes.

Macmillan was a teacher at Heron School in Natomas. Several students noticed he appeared to be taking photos of female students' private parts with his cell phone. Some students started watching Macmillan and managed to record him as he used his phone to record a 12-year-old student under her desk. One student notified school authorities, who notified the Sacramento Police Department. Police found Macmillan's phone in his car with multiple images of what appeared to be the chest and genital areas of girls. An adult staff member also reported that Macmillan had approached her with his cell phone as if he was trying to take a photo or video under her skirt.

Career Criminal Convicted for Attempted Murder of Officers

DATE: May 18, 2018
CASE: Justin Hurst (Case #16FE017117)
PROSECUTOR: Deputy District Attorney James Wax, Career Criminal Prosecution Unit

Justin Hurst was convicted by a jury of attempted murder and assault with a semi-automatic firearm on a peace officer, reckless evading of a peace officer, possession of an assault weapon, possession of a short-barreled shotgun and four counts of felon in possession of a firearm. The jury also found true enhancements that Hurst intentionally discharged a firearm and that he knew and intended to fire at peace officers.

On September 1, 2016, two Citrus Heights police officers contacted Justin Hurst, who was asleep in a parked vehicle. Hurst was on Post-Release Community Supervision and had a felony warrant. Officers directed Hurst to keep his hands on the steering wheel, but he instead sped away and led the officers on a high-speed chase in a residential neighborhood. During the chase, Hurst fired multiple rounds at the officers. Hurst crashed his car into a resident's fence,

and was taken to a hospital to treat his injuries. A search of his car revealed 13 cartridge casings, four firearms and boxes of ammunition.

Additional allegations that Hurst has a prior 1999 strike conviction for first-degree burglary and three prior convictions for being a felon in possession of a firearm will be determined at his sentencing hearing.

If those allegations are found true, Hurst faces a maximum sentence of 42 years to life in prison. Sentencing is set for June 29, 2018, at 2:00 p.m. in Department 21 before the Honorable Steve White.

Defendant Convicted of Multiple Child Sexual Assault Charges

DATE: May 18, 2018
CASE: Andrew G. Young Jr. (Case #13F07569)
PROSECUTOR: Deputy District Attorney Brian Morgan, Special Assault & Child Abuse Unit

Andrew Young Jr. was convicted by a jury of 7 counts of committing lewd and lascivious acts on a minor under the age of 14, and one count of committing a lewd and lascivious act on a minor under the age of 14 with force. The jury also found true that Young had suffered a prior conviction for committing a lewd and lascivious act on a minor under the age of 14.

The victim was a family member who was between the ages of 12 and 13 when the sexual assaults were occurring.

Young faces a maximum sentence of 440 years to life in prison. Sentencing is set for June 15, 2018, at 1:30 p.m. in Department 27 before the Honorable Steven Gevercer.

Defendant Convicted for Sexually Assaulting Two Family Members

DATE: May 23, 2018
CASE: Robert Dew (Case #17FE000718)
PROSECUTOR: Deputy District Attorney Monica Robinson, Special Assault & Child Abuse Unit

Robert Dew was convicted by a jury of eight counts of committing lewd acts on a child under the age of 14. The jury also found true a multiple victims allegation.

In 2016, Dew sexually assaulted a family member when she was 5 years old. During the course of the investigation into the assault, it became known to law enforcement that Dew had also sexually assaulted another family member from 2000 to 2002.

Dew faces a maximum sentence of 22 years in prison. Sentencing is scheduled for June 29, 2018, in Department 11 before the Honorable Trena Burger-Plavan. ★
