From Mather Air Force Base to Rancho Police Department

RANCHO CORDOVA, CA (MPG) - Rancho Cordova resident Karen Donovan moved to our community with her late husband, Don, in 1959 from Hastings, Nebraska. The two were looking to join family in what was at the time the new and small community of Rancho Cordova.

In 1960, Donovan's husband worked at the Rancho Cordova Post Office and a spouse of one of his co-workers worked at Mather Air Force Base. Donovan learned about the base and became interested in working there. So, she took the typing test, passed after the second round, and started her new job.

At the time, the base was an aerial navigation training school and much of the information being processed was classified. Donovan remembers having an officer oftentimes seated next to her dictating as she typed. After around one and a half years, she was promoted to secretary to the Commander of the 2034 Communication Squadron. She stayed in that position for 32 years until Mather Air Force Base closed in 1993.

"I loved being a secretary and all the different people I was able to work with," Donovan remembers. "I built a lifetime of friendships at Mather Air Force Base and am still in touch with three of the bosses I worked with."

When the base closed, Donovan began volunteering at Kaiser Permanente Sacramento Medical Center. One day, her

daughter called to tell her that she'd heard the Sacramento County Sheriff's Department was opening its first service center in Rancho Cordova, and encouraged her to start volunteering there. Donovan decided to start volunteering with the Sheriff's Department on September 1, 1993. Two thoughts made her decide to stop volunteering with Kaiser after volunteering in both jobs for a couple years.

"I thought why drive when I could work in my own community," she said. "And I'd rather work with young hunks than old ladies."

For the next 25 years, Donovan has volunteered to serve the Rancho Cordova

community through a variety of responsibilities. At the Sheriff's Department, she helped with administrative duties such as entering statistics for the gang unit, in addition to participating in ride-alongs and prison tours at San Quentin State Prison and Folsom State Prison.

Now at 85 years young, Donovan is giving back at the Rancho Cordova Police Department (RCPD) by helping with administrative duties. She assists the Traffic Unit by entering all citations including those for driving under the influence (DUIs) into the database and filing traffic collision reports. Donovan logs and completes

quarterly reports for trespassing notices, processes paperwork and citations for charged shoplifters, takes phone messages from the Red Light Ticket Line, and maintains statistics for the Crime Suppression Unit. In addition, she is the go-to person at RCPD when anyone needs a proofreader!

Donovan has built great relationships with the officers over the years. She has been honored to see many get promoted and then come back in other ranks.

"I am so grateful to be able to volunteer at the Rancho Cordova Police Department," said Donovan. "I've always said I

Kings Draw Second Pick in NBA Draft Lottery

SACRAMENTO, CA (MPG) - In what will be arguably the most important draft in Sacramento Kings history, the odds have already bounced in their favor. They made the biggest jump in Tuesday night's lottery, moving all the way from the projected seventh overall pick to the second slot behind the tank-happy Phoenix Suns. It is the first time in the modern lottery era that the kings have held a top three pick.

But with a long, dismal history of draft selections recently highlighted by Jimmer Fredette, Thomas Robinson, Ben McLemore and Nik Stauskas, does it even matter at all? For what it's worth, this is a deep draft class headlined by Deandre Ayton out of Arizona, Luka Doncic out of Real Madrid, Jaren Jackson out of Michigan State, Marvin Bagley III out of Duke and Trae Young out of Oklahoma, to name a few. The talent is definitely there.

The Suns appeared to have their sights set on Ayton all season long as they gloriously tanked. He looks ready to make an immediate impact in the league and keeping him in the state of Arizona makes sense. However, Suns new head coach, Igor Kokoskov, was Doncic's head coach when he won the 2017 EuroBasket title and is big on his guy. This may change things in the Kings' favor yet again heading into the draft.

The Kings have a lot of options, but if Ayton fell to the number two pick Sacramento would have no choice but to

Assemblyman Ken Cooley's Economic Bill 2596 Passes Through Committee

RANCHO CORDOVA, CA (MPG) - Assemblyman Ken Cooley (D-Rancho

Cordova) announced that his AB 2596 successfully passed the Assembly Jobs, Economic Development, and the Economy Committee.

AB 2596 requires the Governor's Office of Business and Economic Development to lead the preparation of the California Economic Strategic Plan, outlining

economic goals for the state, identifying impediments to those goals, and evaluating the effectiveness of the state's current economic development programs.

Although California is the sixth largest economy in the world and home to several billion-dollar industries, the state also faces critical economic

development challenges. The state's economic prosperity is concentrated in a few key metropolitan areas, creating inequities in the state's growth. California has consistently been identified as a challenging place to do business due to regulation, cost, complexity, and high barriers to entry, and the state's lack of statewide

economic development strategy has continually impeded its ability to set and work towards clear priorities.

"It is important that California utilize data and analytics to best examine our future competitiveness," said Assemblyman Cooley. "I am authoring AB 2596 because I think it's the best path forward

to releasing the energies of small and large companies to grow the state's economic future."

Economic development leaders throughout California support the bill. It is sponsored by the Bay Area Council, Valley Vision, and the Greater Sacramento Economic Council.

Women's Empowerment Receives \$25,000 from Save Mart to Improve Lives of Homeless Women

SACRAMENTO REGION, CA (MPG) - Save Mart Companies C.A.R.E.S. Foundation recently presented Women's Empowerment with a grant for \$25,000 to support health and employment programs for homeless women. Funds will provide weekly domestic violence support groups, cooking and nutrition classes, and wellness and recovery groups. Funds also will support onsite employment specialists and social workers who help homeless women secure employment, regain housing and create a healthier lifestyle.

"The majority of our students are survivors of domestic violence, and many struggle with substance abuse, mental health challenges, diabetes and high blood pressure," said Lisa Culp, executive director, Women's Empowerment. "We believe that employment is the best long-term solution to ending homelessness, but securing a job first starts with ensuring you can be a healthy, active employee. We are so grateful to Save Mart for continuing to prioritize the health of homeless women and children in our community."

Women's Empowerment was featured on NBC's The TODAY Show in 2015 for offering the most comprehensive job-readiness program in the Sacramento area designed specifically for women who are homeless and their children. The award-winning organization

has graduated 1,503 homeless women and their 3,600 children. Last year, 92 percent of graduates found homes and 77 percent found jobs or enrolled in school or training. The program combines self-esteem courses, job training, health classes and support services to help homeless women across diverse ages, races and cultures. Senate Republican Leader Bates and Senator Nielsen Respond to Governor's May Budget Revision

SACRAMENTO REGION, CA (MPG) - Today, Senate Republican Leader Patricia Bates (R-Laguna Niguel) and Senator Jim Nielsen (R-Tehama), vice chair of the Senate Budget and Fiscal Review Committee, responded to Governor Jerry Brown's 2018-19 budget proposal.

The Governor's May Revision outlines a record breaking \$199.3 billion state budget. While it is good news that a growing economy has increased state revenues, Senate Republicans agree with the Governor that what goes up must come down, and applaud the increased funding proposed for the state's "Rainy Day" savings.

The Governor rightly acknowledged that the state is over-extended, despite the record revenues. With unfunded liabilities of over \$200 billion for pensions and retiree health care, Senate Republicans agree with the

call for caution.

Senator Nielsen, Vice Chair, Senate Budget and Fiscal Review Committee:

"With nearly \$9 billion in surplus moneys, it is clear that the new taxes recently levied on the people of California were entirely unnecessary."

"The Legislature must refrain from the dangerous temptation to spend on permanent programs that we cannot afford when our state faces another inevitable economic downturn. Now is the time for fiscal discipline. Investing in our rainy day fund savings and our infrastructure, including our water infrastructure, should be the priorities."

Senate Republican Leader Bates:

"While it is clear that the state cannot afford to go on a spending spree, I do hope that the final budget the Governor signs this year will fund priorities such as

expanding efforts on infrastructure and homelessness. There must be a focus on addressing our growing public safety crisis. We should eliminate the rape kit testing backlog and increase efforts by the state Department of Justice to remove guns from dangerous individuals."

"Senate Republicans also believe that the state should release a total of \$3 billion in voter-approved K-12 school bonds in the 2018-19 fiscal year, and include budget language to require at least \$3 billion in construction and repair projects to be awarded to schools that need these funds in 2018-19. If the Governor is unwilling to release voter-approved bond funding, the state should immediately commit part of the growing budget surplus to school construction and modernization projects."

North State Lawmakers Thank Governor for Proposed Funding to Protect Levees

SACRAMENTO REGION, CA (MPG) - Senate Budget Vice-Chair Senator Jim Nielsen (R-Tehama) and Assemblyman James Gallagher (R-Yuba City) issued the following statement on the Governor's revision of his budget proposal:

"We thank the Governor for

heeding our and our constituents' call to fund the repairs of the damaged levees. The increased funding of \$125 million for levee repair and maintenance is welcome news to our communities.

"Last year alone, high water events resulted in significant damage to the levees that protect our homes and communities with an estimated \$800 million

in needed repairs. Maintaining and repairing these levees will require an ongoing funding commitment. While more is needed, we are pleased to see the Governor's revised budget includes funding for this purpose."

Reported Sexually Transmitted Diseases Reach a New High in California

SACRAMENTO REGION, CA (MPG) - A record number of Californians were diagnosed with a sexually transmitted disease (STD) in 2017, according to a new report released by the California Department of Public Health (CDPH). More than 300,000 cases of chlamydia, gonorrhea,

and early syphilis were reported: a 45 percent increase compared to five years ago.

Particularly concerning, in 2017, there were 30 stillbirths due to congenital syphilis in California. This is the highest number reported since 1995.

STDs can cause a number of serious health problems. If left untreated, chlamydia and gonorrhea can cause pelvic

inflammatory disease and lead to infertility, ectopic pregnancy, and chronic pelvic pain. Syphilis can cause permanent loss of vision, hearing and other neurologic problems.

Chlamydia and gonorrhea rates are highest among people under age 30. Rates of chlamydia are highest among young women, and males account for the majority of syphilis and

gonorrhea cases.

"STDs are preventable by consistently using condoms, and many STDs can be cured with antibiotics," said CDPH Director and State Public Health Officer Dr. Karen Smith. "Regular testing and treatment are very important for people who are sexually active, even for people who have no symptoms. Most people infected with an STD do

not know it."

CDPH is collaborating with local health departments and organizations throughout the state to raise awareness. CDPH is working with the California Department of Education and community groups to implement the newly enacted California Healthy Youth Act, which mandates comprehensive STD/HIV prevention education in schools.

Other state efforts leverage innovative strategies such as courses for medical providers and teachers, expedited partner treatment to local clinics, and free and low cost online ordering options for home delivery of condoms and STD test kits. 



Study to Begin Concerning Recreational Waters and E. Coli

SACRAMENTO REGION, CA (MPG) - Every natural water body can be a conduit for pollution, trash, bacteria, algae and microorganisms. Sacramento County and the Sacramento Area Sewer District are collaborating with the California Central Valley Regional Water Quality Control Board (Central Valley Water Board) to fund their weekly E. coli water sampling at nine sites on the American River.

Most E. coli strains are harmless and do not cause human illness. They are the helpful bacteria found in the intestines of mammals – humans, pets, wildlife and birds. Increased levels of E. coli does not necessarily equate to an increased exposure risk for swimmers. E. coli are generally found in all recreational waters.

The Central Valley Water

Board will be conducting a year-long study on the Lower American River to determine the primary sources of E. coli. The study will begin this summer and is designed to more fully understand the primary sources of E. coli and any increase exposure risk to those recreating in the Lower American River.

No water-related illnesses have been reported to the Sacramento County Public Health Division. Anyone enjoying public waterways should:

- Not drink recreational water or use the water for cooking.
- Wash your hands or shower after swimming.
- Not enter the water if you have cuts or open sores, as these are pathways for bacteria to enter your body.

• Avoid algae blooms (brightly colored water) and trash in the water.

• Pay attention and follow any warning signs and postings. Do not access a water body if posted warnings indicate it is not safe to do so.

• Contact your healthcare provider if you have concerns regarding your health after swimming in recreational waters.



Aerojet Rocketdyne has InSight Every Step of the Way

RANCHO CORDOVA, CA (MPG) - From liftoff to landing, Aerojet Rocketdyne propulsion systems are playing a critical role in the NASA InSight Mars lander mission, launched May 5 from Vandenberg, Air Force Base, California, aboard a United Launch Alliance Atlas V rocket.

NASA's latest visitor to the red planet will rely on Aerojet Rocketdyne propulsion systems during the launch, cruise, entry and landing phases of its journey. All of these systems must execute flawlessly and in sequence for the mission to succeed.

"Mars missions, especially those that deliver a lander to the planet's surface, are notoriously challenging, but our team of experienced propulsion engineers is up to the task," Aerojet Rocketdyne CEO and President Eileen Drake said. "Aerojet Rocketdyne engines have flown aboard every NASA Mars mission, including orbiters and landers, since 1975."

InSight, designed to gather data on Martian seismology, will be NASA's first interplanetary mission to launch from Vandenberg; previous missions have lifted off from Cape Canaveral Air Force Station, Florida, where lower latitude translates into added boost for the launch vehicle courtesy of the Earth's rotation. The Atlas V, whose Centaur upper stage is powered by a single Aerojet Rocketdyne RL10C-1 engine, is powerful enough to launch planetary probes from either U.S. coast, depending on their mission mass.

During its six-month transit to Mars, InSight will be guided by eight Aerojet Rocketdyne cruise engines, which will make precise burns—some preplanned,

others as necessary—to ensure an accurate orbital arrival to the red planet. These engines are contained in four Rocket Engine Modules, each consisting of one MR-111C and one MR-106E, generating one and five pounds of thrust, respectively.

InSight will rely on six pairs of Aerojet Rocketdyne MR-107N engines, each engine generating 50 pounds of pulsed thrust, to bring it to the Martian surface in a controlled manner. Before touchdown, the engines will have to steer InSight clear of the parachute, lest it come down on top of the lander. Once that is accomplished, the thrusters will slow InSight to a speed of about 10 kilometers per hour,

enabling a soft touchdown.

New Year to Bring New Faces to Folsom Cordova Schools, District Office

RANCHO CORDOVA, CA (MPG) - Beginning in the next school year, several Folsom Cordova sites will be welcoming new leaders who look forward to the opportunity to grow the achievements of our schools and to build strong relationships with our students, families, and staff.

The Board of Education approved the following selections at its May 10 meeting:

**Director of Athletics:
Peter Maroon**

This newly created District position will support student athletes, athletic programs and school staff by supporting the use of athletic facilities, ensuring compliance of programs, and serving as a liaison between site athletic directors, administrators, booster programs, families, and other related groups. Maroon has served for the last decade as the principal of Mills Middle School in Rancho Cordova. In previous roles, he has served as the athletic director for Folsom High School (2000-2006), vice principal at Folsom High School, teacher at Folsom Middle, and he also has coached football and basketball at Folsom High.

Principal, Mitchell Middle School: Dan Anklam

Anklam, who has served as the principal of Cordova High School since 2010, will become the new principal at Mitchell Middle School.

He fills the vacancy that will be left by Jim Huber, Ed.D., who was recently selected as the District's new Director of Curriculum and Instruction. At Mitchell, Anklam will continue to support the campuswide International Baccalaureate Middle Years Programme, whose students continue on in the program at Cordova High. Anklam began his teaching career in 1988 at Mitchell before moving on to Cordova High, where he spent the last 25 years of his career.

Principal, Cordova Gardens Elementary: John Bliss

For the last four years Bliss has served as the principal of Folsom Middle School, and he fills the vacancy at Cordova Gardens that will be left by outgoing Principal Karen Redfield, who is retiring. Bliss joined Folsom Cordova in 1998 as a teacher at Cordova High School. In addition to his tenure at Folsom Middle School, Bliss has previously served as a vice principal at Folsom High School.

take him. The 7'0", 260 pound, 19-year-old averaged 20.1 points, 11.6 rebounds and 1.9 blocks in his freshman year. "Elite physical tools, soft touch at the rim and a promising jump shot make Ayton the likely top pick," according to SI's latest Top 100 Prospect Rankings. "His sheer size and strength presents a matchup problem for

most any defender, and he may be the most athletic 7-foot prospect to come along this decade." Ayton would be a no brainer for Sacramento, as it is extremely rare to find a 7-footer with his arsenal. But it surely won't be that easy, it never is for a Kings organization that hasn't reached the playoffs or finished with a winning record since 2005-2006. ★

iFest Brings Many Cultures Together

RANCHO CORDOVA, CA (MPG) - Thousands of people took a trip around the world May 12 -- but they never left Rancho Cordova.

Rancho Cordova's international festival -- iFest -- returned to Village Green Park for an eleventh year with a visual carnival of color, global wine and beer tasting by KP International Market, a lively llama walk and stunning Quinceanera, attracting enthusiastic crowds.

On a picture perfect day, visitors hitched rides aboard a pedicab, learned about animals from around the world, had their arm tattooed with henna art or took a swing at a Mexican piñata. An estimated 3,000 people visited iFest 2018.

Chinese Lion Dancers snaked about the amphitheater and Ukrainian Bandura musicians strummed away.

The highlight of the event was a spectacular Quinceanera celebration -- the traditional 15th birthday party for young women in Mexico. Waltzing with their fathers in fabulous ball gowns and backed by dozens of dancers from the Folkloric Group of Victoria Mendoza, the grand finale was not only a tribute to the fascinating culture of Mexico, but a nod to the 15th anniversary being celebrated by the City of Rancho Cordova this year.

"iFest is about cultural understanding and appreciating our differences, as well as celebrating our common values," said Shelly Blanchard, executive director of the Cordova Community Council, producer of the event. "Everybody learns something new at iFest."
