

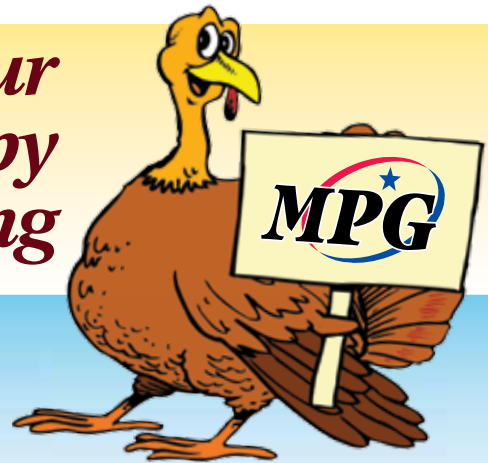

# Bigger Than Basketball

*Kings Representatives Describe An Amazing Sports Future*

**RANCHO CORDOVA, CA (MPG)** - The Cordova Community Council and Rancho Cordova Chamber of Commerce hosted their November luncheon on Friday, November 18, holding annual elections and welcoming Sacramento Kings Ticket Sales Director Justin Petkus. Acting as Kings ambassador for the event, Petkus presented Council members and guests with an engaging presentation on the state of the Kings and the organization's vision for the future.

Petkus launched into the scope of planning for the new Golden 1 Center, explaining how the Kings, under new owner Vivek Ranadivé envisioned the new facility as offering the community something, "Bigger than basketball."

According to Petkus, Golden 1 has been awarded the highly-coveted Leadership in Energy and Environmental Design (LEED) Platinum certification. The building was designed with energy savings in mind and incorporates the very latest in green technologies, utilizing and producing solar energy to run the entire structure.

Another goal, said Petkus, is to make Golden 1 a destination location. To that end, the building itself is a single part of an overall plan to generate economic growth for the entire region and revitalize and incorporate downtown businesses with shopping, hotel accommodations, restaurants and opportunities for tourism. The Light Rail that runs through Rancho Cordova provides easy access for all patrons, eliminating the hassle of parking and traffic jams.

Calling Sacramento the nation's "Farm to Fork" capital, Petkus pointed out that concession vendors were selected with that movement in mind. "Farm to Fork" incorporates locally grown and produced goods sourced from, in this case, Northern California. Area farms, ranches and chefs can now offer customers the freshest products with small carbon "footprints."

Supporters tout "Farm to Fork" as a win-win for consumers and small businesses alike.

Beyond basketball, Golden 1 Center is also slated to host a multitude of future events. Everything from rock concerts to a permanent art collection will be happening at the facility. There is even an app which allows users to climate control public sections of the building, heating and cooling it to the crowd's liking. The very latest safety measures and design technologies such as facial recognition software, handicap accessibility and communal areas have been planned and put into place.

Petkus also discussed the future of sporting events in the Sacramento area, which

will provide superlative marketing tie-ins for the Sacramento Republic soccer team, the King's newly purchased controlling interest in the Reno Bighorns basketball team and even a possible return of the Sacramento Monarchs and the WNBA.

Golden 1 Center, the Kings organization and the Sacramento area itself, are just beginning to see the payoff from this grand plan. While it has been a bit of a bumpy journey, Petkus says ticket sales are booming already. The wait list for season tickets is up and running. Petkus estimates the list will likely grow to five years wait. With Sacramento poised as the next national sports hub, Kings fans might want to get them while they're hot. ★

## Information Regarding Propositions 64 and 67

**RANCHO CORDOVA, CA (MPG)** - California voters approved Propositions 64 and 67 during the November 8, 2016 election. The City of Rancho Cordova wants to be sure our residents understand how they will affect our community.

Proposition 64 was passed to legalize the recreational use of marijuana in California effective immediately. The proposition does not generally change the current regulations relating to marijuana in the City of Rancho Cordova. For example, it is still illegal to grow marijuana outdoors anywhere in the City, and it is still illegal to smoke marijuana anywhere in the City where smoking is prohibited.

Proposition 67 prohibits large grocery stores, pharmacies, convenience stores, and liquor stores in the City of Rancho Cordova from providing single-use plastic bags to customers effective immediately. Stores must charge 10 cents for recycled and reusable bags, and the fee goes into a special fund to cover the cost of the bags and to educate consumers.

Rancho Cordova shoppers can bring their own reusable bags to avoid paying the fee. Pick up a Rancho Cordova branded bag at the City's booth at the upcoming Cordova Community Christmas Tree Lighting on Sunday, November 27!

# Local Author, Jane Daly, Publishes New Book

**RANCHO CORDOVA, CA (MPG)** - Local businesswoman Jane Daly has been an active part of Rancho Cordova's professional circles for sixteen years. What many may not know is that she is also an author whose second book has just been published.

From nine to five Daly is the branch manager for First Bank in Rancho Cordova. In her off-hours, she is also mother, wife, sister, daughter and writer. Daly's first book, drawn from her own journals, is an honest, heart-rending look at a mother's struggle to cope with the loss of a child.

Her second endeavor is also deeply personal, taking readers through the tribulations and joys of being a caregiver. In Daly's case, she is the primary caregiver to her mother, a situation that many with aging parents can relate to.

Daly began her career as a bank secretary and worked her way up, pausing her business career to raise her family. She returned to banking, but writing has always been a part who she is. "I have to be doing something creative in my off-time," said Daly of her writing. Working affords her the opportunity to satisfy her logical self, but writing allows her to express her

creative side, "embracing the two different sides of my personality," she said.

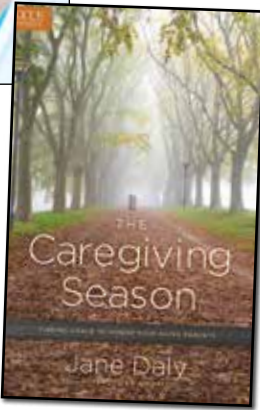
That blending continues nearly seamlessly in how Daly goes about her days. Bank president and author, she also is a long-time Rancho Cordova Chamber of Commerce member and regularly volunteers her time for a variety of causes. Daly's faith is also part and parcel of who she is. It grounds her as much as it uplifts her.

Melding her private and public personas has been a bit of a

journey for Daly. "It's taken me a bit of time to kind of get used to that," she commented. Honesty with self, she finds, is the best policy. "If you're not honest in your writing it's going to come across as giving a pat answer. For instance, in the first book that I wrote, on a mother's loss of child, I went through all of the emotions, the anger, the disappointment. I wrote about that pretty honestly in my book.

"It's something that I have to be real about. And the same thing about the book I just finished about caregiving. My feelings. This is me. Not about what others did and didn't do. And lot of it is about my relationship with my mom. This is my perception."

Daly has already begun work on her next book and her two published works, *Because of Grace: A Mothers Journey from Grief to Hope* and *The Caregiving Season, Finding Grace to Care for Your Elderly Parent* are both currently available online. ★

Hillside is an 8-acre neighborhood park located in the Sunridge/North Douglas area in Rancho Cordova. The park features playgrounds, a play field, a basketball half-court, covered picnic areas and a "play

hill" with concrete and steel tube waterfall slides, a rope ladder and other play structures. Hillside park also includes water-conserving no mow grass and drought-tolerant native plants.

The park site offered unique design challenges including

steep slopes and an adjacent detention basin. CRPD staff and Stantec worked together to arrive at a solution that worked with the existing landscape. Hillside is the 36th park in the District and opened in June 2016.

Those who wish to change the electoral process in this country, and either change or eliminate the Electoral College, need to do it in a law abiding way. That will take longer than they want, but the changes they are demanding now will not be successful without going through the necessary steps. Having a closed mind and trying to force what they want with violence doesn't work in this country. They are having a temper tantrum and saying "they want what they want, when they want it". It reminds me again of the Andy Griffith show in which his son gets down on the floor and starts kicking his feet and yelling. Andy asked him what he was doing and his son said, "I'm having a temper tantrum." Andy said, "Oh, okay. Let me know when you're done, and don't hurt yourself." I hope those who are after change understand that life doesn't work instantaneously. Building a Veterans Village, or creating a new city does not happen just because you want it to.

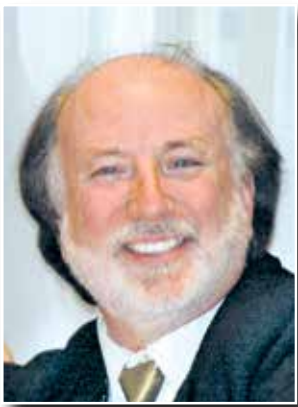

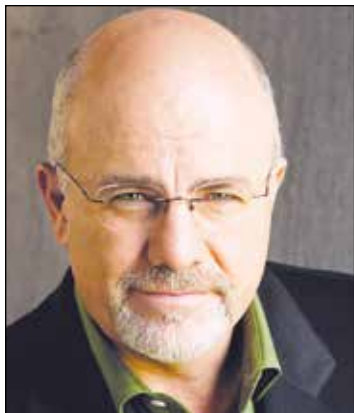

## Health insurance options

Dear Dave,  
My husband and I are self-employed, and we currently pay almost \$1,000 a month for health insurance. I've heard you talk about the potential for rates to increase as much as 40 to 60 percent next year. Are there other options, such as just saving the money in case of medical emergencies?

Dear Anna,  
You don't want to go completely without insurance, because you'll get penalized by the government. Remember, when it comes to health insurance, the problem usually isn't

a kidney stone or a trip to the emergency room for a few stitches. The problem is a cancer diagnosis, which ends up costing \$500,000 or more.

You might want to check into an HSA (Health Savings Account) type of plan within the exchanges. Another thing you could look at is one of the medical sharing programs through a Christian organization such as Christian Healthcare Ministries.

But a higher deductible, HSA-type plan might help keep your premiums down. It's sad, but this is what Obamacare has done to independent people like you and me who are self-employed. It's destroying small group plans, and I guess that was their intent. I suppose they wanted to put those companies out of business, so the government could take it over.

# Fun with Purpose Pays Off for Local Girl Scouts

**SACRAMENTO REGION, CA (MPG)** - Girl Scouts may be 104 years old, but the organization continues to deliver relevant, modern experiences that build leaders right here in our community.

This year was an incredible year for local Girl Scouts. Not only did 48 young women earn the highest award in Girl Scouting (the Gold Award), but one local girl earned the prestigious national Girl Scout Medal of Honor for saving a friend's life using skills she learned while pursuing her first aid badge.

"I learned the Heimlich maneuver as a Brownie in third grade," recalls 6th grader Abby Egawa, adding, "I did not think I would ever be faced with an emergency like this, but I do remember thinking to myself that the Heimlich maneuver was important and that I should pay attention." Abby and her grateful friend Rosie Helft were interviewed on local television stations to talk about the harrowing experience and Abby's quick thinking.

Just last month, two young leaders from Sacramento were recognized as "National Young Women of Distinction." Each year, Girl Scouts of the USA (GSUSA) confers special honors on just ten young women who personify the organization's goal of building girls of courage, confidence and character through their Gold Award projects. They are considered the organization's best and brightest young leaders, and the fact that two of them are from Northern California is an unprecedented honor.

Ayana Watkins, a senior and student body president at Christian Brothers High School, planned and executed a symposium for 200 underserved Sacramento youth entitled "Education Matters in Black Lives," to address the issue of the academic Achievement Gap and the need for educational support to ensure the success of African American youth.

Her symposium included a collegiate panel of students of color and a YouTube channel

that carried her message on a digital platform. Ayana believes that education is an antidote to poverty and social injustice. Through the successful implementation of her Girl Scout Gold Award project, Ayana has made a difference in her community and changed the world through education. "I learned that my voice matters and that I can make a difference in society," she said. "I was able to create something that could address an issue, benefit others and make a positive change."

Leyna Reynolds set her sights on making California roadways safer for new drivers. Noting the high number of accidents involving inexperienced drivers, Leyna developed a program by which new drivers could post "Student Driver" decals to let other drivers know there is a newbie behind the wheel. Leyna created the decals and distributed them through a teen driver advocacy group (Impact Teen Driver) and at local driving schools and insurance companies. She even developed a partnership with Mothers Against Drunk Driving!

She worked with California Assemblymember Kansen Chu, who introduced Assembly Bill 2322 to make these decals available to all permit holders while they practice their skills. She has been able to testify before the California Legislature in support of the bill. "The Gold

Award experience helped me to grow myself as a person," says Reynolds, who plans to major in international relations after graduating from C.K. McClatchy High School next June. "I learned that, with enough perseverance and hard work, anyone can change the world." Even though it didn't pass this year, the author of the bill plans to reintroduce it next year.

Ayana and Leyna were honored at a national celebration in Philadelphia and received national recognition as well as college scholarships. 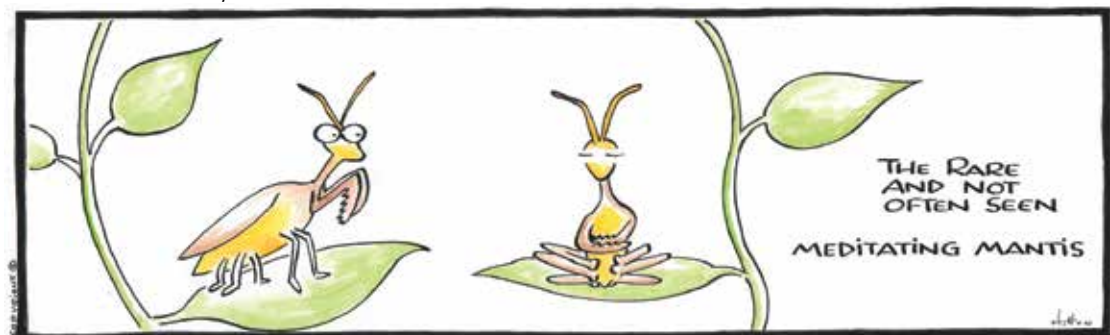

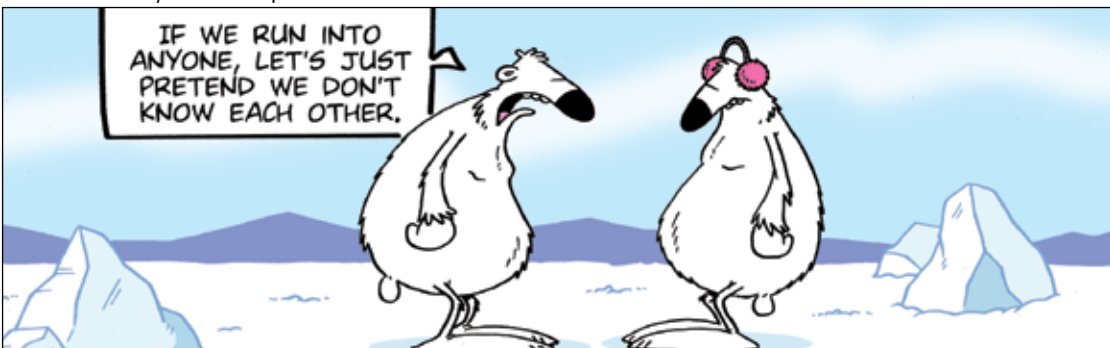

**2 Things to Do to Get "ME" Time During the Holidays**

The holiday season is notorious for inciting panic in women and if they don't know how to deal with that shoulder-burdening aspect of this time of year, they're destined to miss what the holidays are really all about...PEACE, JOY, HARMONY.

I was recently asked to appear on a local television talk show in Portland, Oregon, to talk about the free day I have in my weekly plan. To bring up this topic, this time of year when most women who work outside their homes can barely find a free hour let alone a free day each week seemed absurd!

Today it seems we women are more concerned about recharging our cell phones than about recharging ourselves. Then she said, "I had this discussion with my husband a couple of months ago. I told him I either needed to cut back my hours at work (which would mean less money for us) or he needed to pitch in and help. He's a longshoreman and gets paid for full-time but often works half-time. He didn't like either choice, but he said he'd try and help more. I gave him a month to see if he actually would help more. When he didn't, I cut back to only three days a week instead of five and it has really helped me! Now I get a break from work in the middle of the week so I can clean and keep up the laundry and I can enjoy my weekends with the family instead of catching up all that gets behind.

He thought for a minute and responded, "Oh, right, well yeah, I have to get up in the attic and get all the boxes down for my wife. Oh and I put the tree in the stand and put the angel on the top."

Well now, isn't that so special? There are two things you need to do if you want free time during the holidays.

1) Learn to delegate and give up control of having things exactly the way you want them. 2) Be willing to eliminate activities that aren't fun. For example, I quite writing and sending Christmas cards at least 20 years ago. Instead, every card I receive goes on a "calling" list. Since I love to talk on the phone I take time to sit and call each one. I don't shop, I give cash with humor and flair with my Stick it Right on the Money Gift-giving kit and using ideas I have in ELM Everybody Loves Money which gives fun ways to give cash which are available on my website. That's it! Delegate and eliminate.

Then 30 minutes later, they turned the men loose at an all-you-can-eat buffet. Compared with men who were given a placebo, the men who had consumed cayenne reduced their food intake by 16%. Third, it actually requires energy to eat hot peppers. That's right. That's because the heat you feel when you eat chili peppers takes energy to produce. That's why Dr. Jones adds cayenne capsules to her daily health and nutrition program. And especially with any large holiday meal, she finds ways to also consume some cayenne.

2) **DON'T SKIP MEALS.** Make sure to eat something every 3-4 hours so you won't get famished and end up eating more than necessary.

3) **BRING HEALTHY SNACKS.** While shopping or in the car, healthy snacks help your blood sugar not to plummet.

4) **HAVE SOMETHING SMALL TO EAT.** That's before you go out, especially to a holiday party or big dinner so you don't arrive with a voracious appetite.

5) **DON'T HANG OUT NEAR THE**

**FOOD** during holiday parties and large gatherings where there are tables of food.

6) **DON'T JUST EAT TO BE SOCIAL.** Choose wisely what food you hold in your hands while talking to others at holiday gatherings.

7) **KEEP YOUR BODY HYDRATED** with purified water. We often confuse hunger with dehydration.

8) **START ALL MEALS WITH HIGH-FIBER FOODS** to fill your stomach. Fiber is your secret weapon to weight control.

9) **EAT SLOWLY.** Put down the fork between bites. Make a meal last 30 minutes so your brain's satiety center gets the signal when you are full.

10) **MAKE SLEEP A PRIORITY.** Lack of sleep causes your body to hold on to all of the calories you eat and strengthens your desire for junk foods.

So go ahead and enjoy this wonderful time of the year, but remember all that extra gym work you'll have to do in January if you're not a little careful. ## Cordova Boys Soccer Preparing for Season

**RANCHO CORDOVA, CA (MPG)** - Cordova High School boys soccer head coach Eric Mc Cahon has been adjusting his players to the change of seasons.

The Lancers, along with the rest of the Sierra Valley Conference and the Sac-Joaquin Section, have played boys soccer during the fall season for more than three decades. But two years ago, the section approved a measure to move high school boys and girls soccer to the winter season. This is in hopes of setting up state playoffs that is already set such as football, volleyball,

cross-country, boys and girls basketball and track and field.

“The toughest part of the switch to the winter was the long layoff between competitive contests,” Mc Cahon said. “But I feel we took full advantage of the long off-season.”

Part of the Lancers’ off-season workouts was Mc Cahon running full summer strength and conditioning program. Those workouts were extended into the fall season “to maximize the boys’ physical development,” the coach noted.

“This also allowed the boys extra time to bond and develop a better team chemistry,” Mc Cahon said. “I hoping the extra time in training will translate

to better chemistry on the field, too.”

This season, Mc Cahon has plenty of key players returning from the fall 2015 team that earned one of the conference’s three playoff berths. Cordova finished the 2015 season with a 5-3-2 record in the SVC and 12-10-3 overall mark. In the midfield are Bernardo Valdez, Antonio Ortega, Pedro Garcia and Eugene Kharamtsova in the midfield. Playing as one of the fullbacks is Eder Gamez. Kevin Bejines returns as the team’s goalie.

“I feel one of the main

strengths of this team is experience,” Mc Cahon said. “Having so many returning players from a playoff team should serve us well in tough matches.”

Newcomers for Cordova are juniors Oscar Natalio, who will start on defense, plus Izayjah McKinney and Erick Hernandez. All of them played on the fall 2015 frosh-soph soccer squad.

“The team is also very well balanced throughout all positions the field,” Mc Cahon said. “It’s a very versatile team, with many players able to play multiple roles in many different

spots on the field.”

Next Monday, the Lancers scrimmage at Burbank of Sacramento. Then Cordova plays for real on Tuesday, when it hosts River City; game time is scheduled for 6 p.m. at Lancer Stadium. Then on Thursday, Dec. 1st, Cordova plays an afternoon game at Jesuit; start time is 3 p.m.

The Lancers continue their preseason schedule with eight more pre-season games, plus competing at the Del Campo Tournament a week before Christmas.

“I feel we have a non-league

schedule that sets up well to prepare for league,” Mc Cahon said. “Two tough matches right off the start with River City, and Jesuit on the road. The Del Campo tournament presents some challenging matches well. I like having a team that is tested before heading into league play.”

Plus, the Cordova varsity boys and girls soccer teams will host a doubleheader; on Jan. 3rd, 2017, the squads will host Laguna Creek of Elk Grove. Cordova boys start SVC action on Jan. 12th at Rosemont. ★

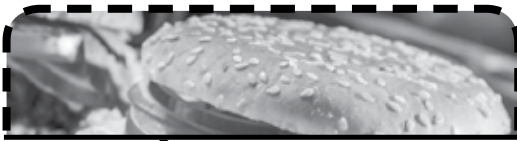

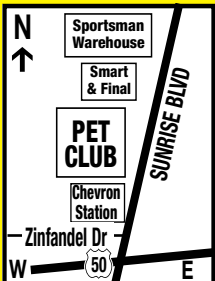
