# Fall Art Show Dazzles

*This Year's Show Showcases over 100 Works*

**RANCHO CORDOVA, CA (MPG)** - Anything Goes! is the theme of the Rancho Cordova Fall Art Show, sponsored by Cordova Community Council. Out of nearly 150 artworks submitted on any subject for the Fall Art Show, over 100, by 56 local artists, were chosen to be displayed at the Rancho Cordova City Hall on Prospect Drive. A crowd gathered on Thursday October 13 to see the art and visit with the artists at the reception.

"I've been going to receptions for 35 years and this is one of the best," said Robyn Slakey, jurist for this show. "Whoever put it together did a very nice job . . . It was just very well handled and very well presented."

Slakey said she was impressed with the quality and variety of the art submitted for this show. She herself works in many mediums, including ceramics, pastels, watercolors, also glass work and mosaic. "My husband always says, 'Just narrow it down to the top five.' Then for our anniversary, he gave me chain saw carving lessons."

Vincent Bode is one of the artists in this show. Two of his drawings hang in the show, both done in terra cotta pencil. One, titled "Memorial," truly is what it is titled, being done in memory of close friend Doug Dunn, who passed away last year. The drawing shows Dunn with his wife Angelina and their two sons Eli and Andrew, dressed up as swash-buckling pirates. The family had planned to dress that way for Halloween last year. Bode's other drawing is of his great-granddaughter

Lauren Guttie, now 11, who attends Erlewine Elementary School in Sacramento. Titled "Hagan Park Fairy," it shows her looking up at a fairy perched on her finger.

A graphic artist and illustrator, Bode is also a retired air traffic controller and printer. When asked what he likes most about making art, he said it is, "the adventure in thinking it, getting an idea, and seeing it to its end." He calls his small home studio the cockpit studio because it is confined but neat, with everything in its place. "I learned to fly a Cessna 150 before I ever drove a car," Bode said, "and when you get in (the studio), you're there."

Bode has some practical advice for those who want to take up an artist's life. "If you want to be in art, I'm going to go back to what my teacher said, keep it in your face," Bode said. "If you're going to paint, just paint."

Bri Rose, 16, signs her work B Rose and has two portraits in the show, one done in watercolor and the other, acrylic and watercolor. Currently a senior at Cordova High School, she played rugby, but wanted a creative outlet as well. She started drawing and painting in 2014.

Most of her work is in black and white, as is her portrait of actor and writer James Franco. "I'd like to be like him because he does it all. He inspired me because I not only want

to paint and draw, but I'd like to be a director, I'd like to make music, like I want 'all of the above,'" Bri said. She is especially interested in film and movies. Her other portrait is in color, of Mexican artist and painter Frida Kahlo. Bri admires Kahlo because that artist's whole life was so difficult and physically painful.

When she graduates from high school Bri plans to attend junior college, and then would like to go on to film school, maybe something like Tisch School of the Arts. Her ancestry is Portuguese, and she would like to live in Portugal someday.

## Senator Gaines Rips California's Business Climate On Verizon Closure

**SACRAMENTO, CA (MPG)** - Senator Ted Gaines issued the following statement on the closure of the Verizon customer service center in Rancho Cordova and the 1,000 jobs lost as a result of that closure:

"Who can be surprised by this? California is doing everything it can to drive businesses out of the state. Sky-high workers compensation costs, painful energy costs driven by unchecked environmentalism, and now a minimum wage shooting up by 50-percent in the next few years, it's little wonder that Verizon is packing up."

"A study this year showed 9,000 California businesses had relocated or expanded out of state recently. Sacramento recently lost Campbell's, Waste Connections, and now Verizon. Those are more than statistics and stories; each one is a tragedy for families who are paying the price for California's anti-business policies."

"Just today, Silicon Valley legend Hewlett Packard announced that it would be laying off 4,000 employees. How legislators can push for the expensive and useless high speed rail or keep pushing for ever higher taxes while workers are being pink-slipped by the thousands is amazing to me and needs to stop. Lower taxes and smarter regulations would show businesses that California is not a place to leave, but a place to grow and invest. I'd rather see that than Verizon's tail lights."

Fix A Pothole...  
Build An Interchange!

Gold River residents may be aware of Measure B, which is on the ballot for your consideration this November. It is a component of the Sacramento County Supplemental Transportation Sales Tax Expenditure plan. That's a small plan to tax you, the resident of Gold River, for the next 30 years, what appears to be a way to raise some money to fix potholes and do some maintenance for our community. Well actually, it's for the whole county, and it is to be implemented from 2017 to 2047, a mere nearly half-life span of time.

We all like nice streets to drive on, right? No one likes potholes, right? Right. But caveat emptor,

buyer beware. Conveniently embedded in Measure B is a not-so-apparent project amongst many that you've probably heard of.

Ready for this? You'll be paying for the City of Rancho Cordova's Parkway Interchange, which was approved by the City Council last year to be located in Eureka Village. This massive behemoth of a project will accommodate some 100,000 cars daily, with all the noise, exhaust emissions, and loss of property value affecting all of Gold River. So not only will you get a project you don't want in Gold River (approved mostly because of political strong-arming)...guess what? If Measure B is approved,

you're going to be paying for it too!

It was supposed to be paid for by the City and developer funds, but since savvy developers won't build in Rancho Cordova's sphere of influence, the City is having a difficult time raising money to build the interchange that will serve their own development only. There is no project benefit to Gold River at all. So, keep in mind the next 30 years of additional taxation for you, your children, and grandchildren. If you don't want an interchange in the backyard of Gold River, take appropriate action. Tell a friend too.

# Historic Look at Mather Air Force Base

**RANCHO CORDOVA, CA (MPG)**

- Mather Air Force Base was the only navigator/ bombardier training base in the Air Force in the 1960’s thru the early 1993’s. The base, at the time, was assigned to Air Training Command, and closed around 1993. It is now a Sacramento County Airport with mostly civilian aircraft using the facilities. Cargo aircraft like UPS and others are currently the largest users of the Airport.

The Air Force Base first opened in 1917, during World War I, for early pilot training. During World War II, Mather was also a large pilot training base, with many of the trained aircrew, sent to the Pacific area of conflict. When I first received orders to Mather AFB in 1971, I was an aircraft maintenance officer, assigned to the Chief Of Maintenance office. At that time, we had 99 old and obsolete T29 twin propeller engined aircraft used for the navigator training mission.

Shortly after I arrived, our

mission changed and we were told by Headquarters that we were to ship out the old T 29 aircraft to other bases and prepare to receive 19 all new T 43 twin jet training aircraft. It was a modern version of the BOEING 737 civilian passenger airliner. This new navigator trainer aircraft represented a giant leap in student training. Prior to receiving the T 43 aircraft, I was made project officer to help prepare for its arrival. I needed to design a flightline parking plan for 19 very large aircraft, which had never been done before. Mather was the only air force base that had T 43 aircraft assigned. Around the same time, I was also assigned as project officer for the new, much smaller T 37 twin jet engine aircraft, which was to be used to train one navigator student with one pilot/ navigator instructor, sitting side by side. The T 37 jet aircraft was the same type aircraft that I flew in Pilot Training at Williams AFB in Arizona, back in 1966.

The T37 was added to the training program to give new students the feel of navigating a

small aircraft. The much larger T43 student training aircraft was set up inside with a number of navigator stations that could train a very large class of students, at one time. This aircraft had a long range and could fly all the way to the east coast and back, giving realistic navigator training to the students. Not only was Mather the only American student navigator/ bombardier training base in the Air Force, it also trained foreign students, at times.

When this picture was taken, I was an Aircraft Maintenance Control Officer. As Project Officer for receiving these new T 43 and T 37 jet training aircraft, I was in the center of the major shift in aircraft technology, going from propeller aircraft to jets, and the product of a much better trained navigator student. I later became Chief of Maintenance for a short time, before returning to civilian life. I have GREAT MEMORIES of my five year assignment to Mather Air Force Base and that’s what life is all about. ★



One of the most annoying traffic problems in the City of Rancho Cordova is the light rail crossings at Mather Field Road and Zinfandel Drive. It is very hard for people who are going south on either of those two roads when there is a train (or two) that seems to bring the crossing arms down long before the train gets there. Even more difficult is when the train finally gets through and the traffic cycle starts again for the traffic going north. It is easy to wait between 5 - 10 minutes to finally go south on Mather Field Road or Zinfandel Drive. I wish Regional Transit would set the traffic signals so the timing could be equal going both ways.

And another thing that makes me worry is watching the cars who ignore the signs on the road at the light rail crossings that say “STOP HERE”. Every day, you see people ignore the painted signs on the road and park on that very narrow space between the closest train track and the pedestrian crossing. According to the DMV, it is illegal to park on the road and block the pedestrian crossing; it is also illegal to almost cross the railroad tracks and leave the tail end of the car crossing the railroad tracks. Most of today’s cars are long

enough that they both block the pedestrian crossing and have the tail end of the car blocking the tracks. Crossing the railroad tracks going north at Kilgore Road is even more dangerous because there are no signs at all that either say “STOP HERE” or “WAIT HERE.” According to the California DMV, you should never stop on railroad tracks, and that includes having only part of the car crossing the tracks after you stop.

There seems to be no time limit for property owners who own homes that have been burnt down to take care of their piece of property. There have been different homes in Rancho Cordova that have been burnt and have been marked with signs saying it is unsafe for anyone to enter the building. Then the owner, the insurance company or the bank has to decide when (or if) they are going to repair or replace the home. Some buildings in the past have been burnt and then stood alone with nothing being done to them for years. People who own homes close to the burnt home expect something to be done in a reasonable time, but usually that hull of a scarred building will stand there for months or years. It lowers the property value of the neighboring homes as the home continues to deteriorate because nothing is done to it. We have new tools at our disposal to help the City speed up the process of getting things done with these types of properties, and I will pass on more information about

them. These tools are now being used by our City Manager, Code Enforcement team, and other departments.

I was asked the other day by a local resident if I knew what was being done on the property at the corner of Bear Hollow Drive and Airpark Drive in the Stone Creek development in Rancho Cordova. I know there are many people who would like to have seen a grocery store or other retailer there, but it is going to be a project for the military. The California Military Department and the California Air National Guard are moving forward with a project to construct a headquarters on that property. The proposed project would be about 300,000 square feet of office space used primarily for administrative functions.

The property boundaries are Bear Hollow Drive on the east side of the property, with Airpark Drive and the North Mather Boulevard on the north and south side of the property, and the creek that runs parallel to the Stone Creek Community Bike Trial on the west side of the property. You can see that creek if you turn east off of Femoyer Drive and keep driving. The California Military Department is preparing an environmental document for the proposed development. We will see more as the designs and plans move closer to final completion. I will keep you informed.

The Secret to Being Organized  
**Pam Young's Corner**  
4 Ways to Use Your Imagination to Get Back on Track

Because we're human we get tempted by foods (and other things) that we know aren't especially good for us. It's just not fair that foods that aren't good for us, taste so darn good!

Been on the SES Diet lately (Summer Eating Spree Diet)? You know, too much potato salad and too many corn on the cobs, hot dogs, hamburgers, potato chips, s'mores, sodas, beers, cupcakes and crackers and more. They're all the treats of summer picnics, camping and barbecues and we associate these fun times with those fun foods. And you probably have it in your mind that those times without those treats just wouldn't be fun.

Usually we get back on track because there's something in the future, compelling us. Maybe it's a health problem and your doctor says you need to eat healthy and exercise or you'll drop dead pretty soon. Maybe it's just a wedding approaching and you're one of the bride's maids and you don't want to be the fattest one. Or, maybe you're planning a vacation and you want to have energy to walk a lot. The decision is the first part of the turn and then you have to have the motivation to make the turn and that's where a compelling reason kicks in.

Maybe it's time to go into your imagination booth (by closing your eyes) and use your imagination to get back on the right track. You can take me with you, using these 4 suggestions.

1. While you're in your booth, imagine the feeling when you've turned the corner on an intension to lose weight. Turning the corner is the hardest part of an intension, because you have to put the brakes on the momentum of doing the opposite of your intension,

before you can get going in the right direction and into the freedom of eating a healthy diet again.

If you go to the grocery store in the next couple of days, just look in the carts rolling around the store and you'll see that the ingredients of carts filled with groceries, are evidence of the cart pusher's condition: healthy or unhealthy.

2. Imagine the feeling when you've turned the corner (you've done it many times) and you're starting to think less about wanting those foods in the SES Diet. Remember how easy it was to eat healthy once it became a habit again. The only hard part is what your mind does before you make the turn, as well as while you're making the turn. But once you've turned, you don't have to think about it anymore. The habit kicks in and you're no longer strapped with decisions to make. That's why when you hear a person say, "I've turned the corner," you know they've "got it."

Here's dialogue between a waitress and a customer who **hasn't** turned that corner.

"May I take your order?"

"Uh, yes, I'll have the hamburger." (Thinks about saying "no bun" but decides that today it's okay, because it's the weekend and, hey, it's date night.)

"And for your side?"

"Uh, oh, why not, fries."

"Anything to drink?"

"A coke, or no a glass of Chablis."

Here's dialogue between a waitress and a customer who **has** turned that corner.

"May I take your order?"

"Yes, I'll have the hamburger, no bun, salad and water please."

3. In your imagination, fast forward to October 24th and think

how your clothes won't hurt anymore and how much easier it'll be to exercise, because you'll be back at the gym regularly. See yourself in a cute workout outfit. Feel how good that feels. Hear someone say, "You look great!" Feel the joy of your body responding to healthy food and exercise.

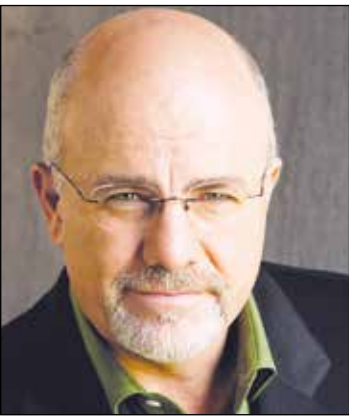
4. Imagine a compelling reason. Be outrageous and it'll spark the interest of your inner child. (Once you're in partnership with that important part of you, you're chances of really changing are very good.) So, for example, you could imagine you're in prison and you've got sensors all over your body and if you don't exercise, it's reported to the warden, and if you don't get 20 days of exercise in the next month, you'll be put into solitary confinement. If you eat sweets, it's recorded. If you go off your intention in any way, it's reported. And if you have a good report, after a month, you'll get paroled, but you still have to have the sensors on for monitoring and if you violate parole, you'll go back to the slammer.

That's just a suggestion. You can probably think of a better one, and if you do, I hope you'll share it with me. [pam@pamyoung.org](mailto:pam@pamyoung.org)

## Travel medical insurance?

Dear Dave,

My fiancée and I are planning a Caribbean honeymoon cruise after our wedding. Do you think it would be a good idea to purchase travel medical insurance?

—Tim

Dear Tim,

Normally, I would say travel medical insurance falls into the gimmick category. But if you're concerned about it, I would suggest double-checking your current policy through your provider to see exactly what you've got and how far it extends in terms of coverage compared to any risk factors you may be facing.

The only reason I can think of as to why your current health insurance wouldn't cover you is that you may be out of the country during portions of the cruise. In most cases and areas, I believe, out-of-network considerations will still apply in the Caribbean. But check with your insurance company for verification and details on that, too.

I've never bought travel medical insurance, and we've gone on two cruises already this year. Just do your homework ahead of time, and make sure you'll have the coverage you need in the locations you're going. Congratulations, Tim!

# Growing Old On the Streets is America's Dirty, Little Secret

Commentary by AMAC

The homeless are the invisible denizens of America's cities, says Dan Weber, president of the Association of Mature American Citizens. "But, the dirty little secret that has only come to light recently is the fact that the elderly are among the fastest growing populations living on the streets," he reports.

The Department of Housing and Urban Development told Congress last year that there were more than 300,000 homeless Americans 50 years of age or more, 20% more than there were in 2007.

A recognized expert on the issue of the growing number of older individuals who are on the streets is University of Pennsylvania Professor Dennis P. Culhane. He says that in 1990 "the peak age of adults who were homeless was 30" and that today the peak age is 55.

Weber is calling on all candidates for election and re-election in November and those in the private sector to recognize the fact that more seniors are homeless than ever before and to take to heart the needs of "these hapless lost souls. Focus on their plight and let the truth be told, loud and clear. Everyone needs to pitch in if we are to solve this problem, which only grows bigger with each passing day."

Some would blame the spike in homelessness among older Americans on the swiftly aging population. But, Weber says, it has more to do with the rising cost of health care and health insurance, the lagging economy, the impact of such diseases of old age as cancer and Alzheimer's and, perhaps the most damaging cause of all, the lack of affordable housing.

"In fact, talk to any health provider who deals with the homeless and they will tell you that there has been a dramatic shift in recent years in the illnesses from which

they suffer. It used to be that the homeless suffered mainly from drug abuse and mental illness. Nowadays they are more likely to have the chronic diseases of old age," Weber notes.

Mel Martinez and Allyson Y. Schwartz are the co-chairs of the Bipartisan Policy Center Senior Health and Housing Task Force. Martinez is a former U.S. Senator from Florida and Schwartz is a former Congresswoman from Pennsylvania. They published an Opinion Article in U.S. News and World Report last month in which they concluded that "preventing and ending homelessness among older adults should become a major national priority in the United States. By setting goals to end homelessness; increasing available low-income senior housing; and by understanding that the challenge requires participation from public and private partners at all levels, we can and will find ways to ensure that all U.S. seniors have the shelter and security that they deserve."

Meanwhile, Margot Kushel, professor of medicine at

University of California, San Francisco, is an expert on the elderly who become homeless. She says that providing them with housing is the key to fixing the problem. "A lot of these people have been healthy their whole lives. But it doesn't take long for their health to plummet once they're homeless. Once someone is housed, depression often lifts, stress fades away, infections heal. It's instant."

Says Weber, "everyone has his own set of priorities, but one thing we all have in common is that we are all growing older. It's one of the hardest things we will all do in this life and so we should have compassion for those who need our help."

# The Cruel Irony of Hillary Clinton's "Pro-Women" Stance

Hillary Clinton is campaigning that she, of all the candidates, is the one who is a "champion for women and girls" specifically because, among other things, she protects "women's reproductive health" and "confronts violence against women." Her primary talking point is that she has worked 30 years for women and children. The media and various groups accept this claim without examining just how illogical it is and without considering the cruel irony.

Let's look at Mrs. Clinton's assertion that she is a champion of girls and women. Hillary Clinton is a Planned Parenthood, pro-abortion advocate. No one denies that. Her stance has become more and more strident. She no longer uses the phrase of years ago that abortion should be "safe, legal and rare." "Rare" is gone from that trio to be replaced by "publically funded." She is advancing abortions. She is ardently pro-abortion.

Think about what this means. The number of abortions in the United States since Roe v. Wade is over 58,000,000. The distribution of boys to girls in live-birth statistics gives a slight edge to boys: 51 percent boys to 49 percent girls. Assuming that the sex ratio (boys to girls) for children

aborted is roughly the same as for live births, this means that just under 29,000,000 girls have lost their lives to abortion since 1973. One can quibble about these numbers, but the fact remains that millions of girls' lives have been snuffed out while they were still in the womb.

At least for these pre-born girls, Mrs. Clinton can hardly be said to be their "champion." In fact, the policies that she advocates continue to make possible the taking of the lives of these innocents by the abortionists' instruments of destruction—scalpels and suction.

If this is not violence against women, one has a hard time imagining why it isn't.

For the unborn girls this is, of course, an unspeakable tragedy. They will never experience the safety of their mother's or father's arms. They will never have an infancy, a girlhood, a youth. They will never play as a tomboy with the neighborhood children, they will never learn to read or write, wear a frilly dress, sing a popular song, kick a winning soccer goal, or attend a prom. They will never graduate from high school, marry or themselves give birth to children. Those opportunities are irrevocably denied them, often because of the press of careers of their mothers, the irresponsibility of their fathers, and

sometimes, mere inconvenience.

For American society, abortion is also an immeasurable loss. For these unborn women do not become our teachers, nurses, business leaders, civic volunteers, our scientists, astronauts, sports heroes, mothers, grandmothers, church members, etc. And they do not and cannot become our U.S. senators, secretaries of state, or even our presidents.

A society's public policies and public officials should be evaluated by how they treat the most vulnerable of their citizenry. Unborn babies are the most defenseless of "cubs" who have no way to protest or grasp their maltreatment through the amniotic fluid that envelops them. Their hands cannot fight off aggressors nor are their voices able to cry for protection.

In the name of all that is decent, it is time to end this outrage. What is absolutely clear is that millions of girls have been deprived of their womanhood by the very ones who claim to be their "champion." What a cruel irony.

Cordova Football Rallies to Beat Union Mine

RANCHO CORDOVA, CA (MPG) - In the first half of last Friday's Sierra Valley Conference road game, the Cordova High School football team produced many points.

But the Lancers trailed 26-25 at halftime on a slick field on Union Mine's field in El Dorado. That changed in the second half that led to Cordova posting a 53-26 win over the Diamondbacks.

The victory keeps Cordova (2-0 in the SVC, 5-2) in the thick of the conference title race with El Dorado and Liberty Ranch, which faced off also last Friday in Placerville in which El Dorado won 27-24. El Dorado is also 2-0 in the SVC, 6-1 and Liberty Ranch 1-1, 5-2.

Leading the Lancers' ground game against the D'backs was senior running back Deante McCullough, who had 19 carries for 204 yards and four touchdowns. His yards, alone, doubled the D'backs' total rushing yards at 83.

"Our running game was working," said Cordova head coach Darren Nill, whose Lancers had 271 rushing yards. "That's where the big difference came from, our rushing game in lousy weather. He (McCullough) was knocking off some big chunks (of yards)."

The Lancers' three other TDs came from running backs Kelechi Njoku, who had two, and Kenneth Haney, who accounted for the other. They combined for 61 rushing yards.

The start of the third quarter showed signs of the game going into the Lancers' favor. Union Mine received the second half opening kickoff, but went three and out on offense. Then Cordova scored its lone touchdown in the quarter for the lead.

"From then on, the wind kind

of left their (Union Mine) sails," Nill said.

Despite the ball being wet and the field slippery because of rainstorms hitting earlier in the day into the early evening hours, Cordova controlled the game from the offensive standpoint in the final two quarters that resulted in points or long possessions, keeping the ball out of Union Mine's hands.

In the first half, part of the D'backs' success was based on the between quarterback Mike Griffiths and Eschleman. The duo accounted for all of their

team's touchdowns.

"That kid (Eschleman) is something special," said Nill of the D'backs wide out. "He took advantage of us a couple of times."

Total offensive yards for Cordova was 462 yards; 271 on the ground and 191 in the air. Lancer quarterback Xavier Johnson completed 13-of-19 passes for 191 yards.

On defense, Lancer line-backer Yusef Pugh led the team in tackles with 11. Haney, a middle linebacker, had nine and

defensive back Bryan Estrada eight.

The Lancers were without the services of six starters on both sides of the ball. Two because of injury and four who were suspended for what Nill described as "conduct detrimental to the team." He praised the guys who started in place of all the starters for doing their assigned jobs.

"They guys rallied," Nill said.

In the frosh/soph game, Cordova also improved to 2-0 in the SVC with a 20-12 win over Union Mine. The Lancers lost all of their non-league games before the start of conference play.

Tonight, Friday, Cordova will play its final regular season home game at Lancers Stadium when El Dorado pays a visit. The Cougars' high-potent offense averages 36.6 points per game, but defense is responsible for giving up 22.3 points per game.

"They are a lot bigger than us, and we are a lot quicker than them," said Nill of El Dorado. "I think they are going to do some things to exploit their size. And we're going to go after their secondary that we think their defensive backs are not as good as our receivers. So we're going to go after them."

Cordova, which closes out the regular season with road games at Liberty Ranch and Rosemont, and El Dorado are scheduled to kick-off the varsity game at 7:30 p.m. ★

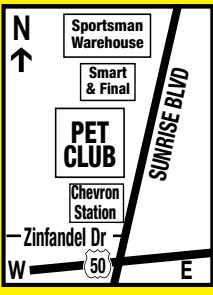
