

Sign Up for **Emergency** Notifications

RANCHO CORDOVA, CA (MPG) - The City of Rancho Cordova has a new way for you to be notified by phone, text or email in the event of an emergency in Rancho Cordova. All it takes is the click of a button and a few simple steps!

Visit Sacramento-Alert.org and select the "Sign up" tab in the gray toolbar. Then follow these steps:

- 1. Provide your personal information and select a username, password, and security question.
- 2. Select how you'd like to be contacted including cell phones, alternate numbers, text, emails and even landlines.
- 3. Register one or multiple addresses to get alerts about the places that mean the most to you, such as your home address, work address, your parent's address or your children's school. This system is used throughout Sacramento County, Placer County, and Yolo County, so you are covered wherever you go.
- 4. Select the type of alerts you'd like to receive. The City suggests you subscribe to the "Emergency" category and "City of Rancho Cordova" that can be found under the "Sacramento County" category. If you live or work in another area, you should sign up for alerts in those areas as well.

Flower Festival Promotes Unity and Education

RANCHO CORDOVA, CA (MPG) - Saturday afternoon was the occasion for the Bathukamma Festival of Flowers Celebration at Bear Hollow Elementary in Rancho Cordova. Hosted by the Sacramento Telangana Association, the festival was open to the public. Families and individuals of all ages came out and opened the traditional Indian celebration to the community, featuring music, dancing, free food and warm welcomes for all who attended.

The festival honors and promotes a sense of community and has special significance to the state of Telangana in India. "The main theme of the festival is female empowerment, flowers and family. We hope this festival takes us through a journey of integrating multicultural (sic), arts, [and] environmental protection in our community," said Anil Kondakrindi, one of the festival's prime organizers and Vice President of the Sacramento Telangana Association.

Women have a pivotal role in the proceedings by collecting and arranging special flower arrangements which

history buffs, historical groups, Boy Scout Troop 363, Folsom, El Dorado & Sacramento Historical Railroad Association, local government officials and dozens of vintage automobiles, vendors and exhibits.

Beginning in Roseville, a caravan of approximately 60 cars, trucks and vintage emergency vehicles proceeded along a predetermined route culminating at Mills Station. The building has been a vital part of the Rancho Cordova community for a century, serving at various times as a train station, general store, soda fountain, dance hall and allround center for civic functions.

Rancho Cordova Mayor David Sanders set the tone in his remarks to the assembled crowds by taking attendees on a "time traveling" adventure. It was Sanders' initial research that revealed Rancho's Folsom Boulevard was initially known as part of the Lincoln Highway, so named in tribute to Abraham Lincoln. The original planners envisioned the Lincoln Highway as a network that would united the country from coast to coast just as President Lincoln had united the country in the sad wake of the Civil War.

Officially designated now as Rancho Cordova's "Heritage Corridor," the weekend celebration marked the unveiling of a new 4-sided monument memorializing the spot's significance as a railway, Pony Express stop, community center and historic building. Kudos were given to current City Council member Linda Budge as having been instrumental in saving the building from certain devastation in recent decades. Thanks to Budge's crusade, initial renovations stabilized the structure, which now, thanks to new funding obtained in large part by Supervisor Don Nottoli, will soon undergo further renovations to ready the venerable for

building for new life for future generations.

Situated along Folsom Boulevard and Mather Field Road, Mills Station is one of very few historical buildings left in Rancho Cordova. Others include the Sheepherder Inn, the American River Grange, one farm house and the Pfingst Station along the railroad on Folsom Boulevard.

The opening of Highway 50 markedly improved travel time for drivers traveling eastwest through the Sacramento area, but it also initiated a death knell for many businesses that depended upon vehicle traffic for their livelihood. Coupled with the closure of Mather Air Force Base, the fortunes of businesses, citizens and the community in general became victims of the downturn that continued for decades.

Thanks to champions such as Budge and Nottoli, the incorporation of Rancho Cordova as a city and the vastly unsung efforts of local citizens, businesses, community organizations and gritty determination, Rancho Cordova is at last beginning to emerge with a new identity that incorporates the heritage of the area, making Rancho Cordova a place that knows what it is today and what it can be tomorrow.

Recent improvements implemented by the city to beautify Folsom Boulevard in Rancho Cordova, along with ongoing shopping, new housing and shopping development have improved the corridor in recent years. The designation and celebration of the road as Rancho's very own "Heritage Corridor," championed by the City Council, Cordova Community Council, Rancho Cordova Historical Society and other groups continues to bolster the city's image as a place to live, play, visit and do business in a vibrant city with small town appeal.



Cooley's Bill to Expand Foster Youth Access Signed by the Governor RANCHO CORDOVA, CA (MPG) in need of their services. even housing stability," said

- Assemblyman Ken Cooley's (D-Rancho Cordova) AB 2417 was signed in to law by Governor Brown this afternoon. AB 2417 expands foster youth access to court appointed special advocates, known as CASAs. These are volunteers who are appointed by a judge to provide one-on-one mentorship and advocacy to abused and neglected children who are under the jurisdiction of the juvenile court. Children with court appointed special advocates have demonstrably better long-term outcomes: they are more likely to find a safe permanent home, half as likely to reenter the foster care system, and have far greater success in school. However, there are currently not enough CASA volunteers to advocate on behalf of the foster children

CASA programs are required by law to fingerprint each volunteer to screen for a criminal background before allowing them to mentor and advocate for youth. Non-profit organizations that serve children do not have to pay the California Department of Justice fees for background checks, but CASA programs are currently excluded from this benefit. This places an undue financial burden on this critical child advocacy program.

AB 2417 enhances foster youth access to CASA volunteers by including CASA programs in the existing fee exemption that other child-focused non-profit organizations enjoy.


"Foster kids face obstacles that affect their long-term education, job prospects and Assemblyman Cooley. "AB 2417 expands access to CASAs that provide foster youth vital support and services they need to transition into independent adulthood."

"We applaud Assemblymember Cooley for his leadership and Governor Brown for his approval of this simple legislative change which will result in more children in foster care having the caring advocacy of a Court Appointed Special Advocate," said John Lipp, CEO of the California CASA Association. "This represents a great savings to our local CASA programs that they will leverage to recruit, train, and supervise CASA volunteers, whose advocacy improves and transforms the lives of abused and neglected children."

AB 2417 will take effect January 1, 2017.


You have to humble yourself and ask for help from those who are gifted in areas you're not, and

Get yourself out of it Dear Dave,

I make \$2,100 a month after taxes, and I have accumulated \$46,000 in credit card debt. My husband makes more than I do, but he won't help me. He says I got myself into this mess, so it's my job to stop being irresponsible and fix it on my own. Do you have any advice?

Dear Peggy,

You've got a load of debt hanging over your head right now, but I think you've got bigger problems than that. You told me you're married, yet it sounds to me like you two are living entirely different and separate lives. This seems more like a roommate situation than a healthy, loving marriage.

I don't like your husband's attitude, but he does have a valid point in one respect. You were irresponsible with money, and now you've got a pile of debt on your hands. My big question is this: Where was he while all this was going on? Were you hiding it from him? And where was the communication and decision making, financial and otherwise, couples should engage in?



Married people can't live this way and win in their relationship or with money.

The two of you desperately need to seek marriage counseling together. This relationship is on the rocks. You and your husband obviously have no trust or respect for each other, and there's a definite lack of communication, unity and shared goals. I don't know what happened to bring things to this point, but the preacher didn't pronounce you guys a joint venture when you got married; he said you were now one.

A little maturity, extra work, and living on a simple budget will go a long way toward fixing most personal finance issues. But your marriage is in big trouble, Peggy. Please seek help!

Why save before paying off the mortgage? Dear Dave,

I just read *The Total Money Makeover*, but I'm still unclear as to why you recommend saving for an emergency fund and retirement before paying off your home. Shouldn't a house be paid off as quickly as possible, since it's a liability?

Dear Mark,

I appreciate the fact that you're asking questions and thinking

things through. But please don't fall into the trap of thinking of your home as a liability. That mindset is way off base, in my opinion.

Your house is definitely an asset; it's the mortgage that's a liability. Some folks may try to position a house as a liability simply because it costs you money. But the truth is your home will make you more money than it will cost you over time. Therefore, it is an asset.

Some of the saddest situations I've seen in all my years of teaching are seniors who have paid-for homes and nothing saved or invested. Money isn't the most important thing on earth, but it is a fact of life. That's why I encourage people to build an emergency fund of three to six months of expenses and begin saving for retirement before they tackle paying off their homes.

Then, after all that is addressed, take every dollar you can scrape together and put it toward paying off your mortgage as fast as possible. Good question, Mark!

New CFR Report Distorts Facts and Aims to Crush U.S. Energy Revolution

Commentary by David Williams

A new report from the Council on Foreign Relations is music to the ears of environmental activists. It claims to show that if the federal government ended its "preferential" tax treatment of the oil and gas industry, public revenues would jump by billions and climate change would slow considerably.

This is pure fantasy. The report's methodology is fundamentally flawed, confusing tax deductions with subsidies and completely overlooking the vital role oil and gas plays in the American economy.

Subsidies are a direct transfer of money from the U.S. Treasury to a private company. American oil and gas companies receive zero -- that's right, zero -- subsidies.

What these firms do receive, however, is the same tax treatment as all other businesses, which, in part, allows them to deduct certain operating expenses. This deduction is typically used to offset the substantial costs of drilling and preparing wells -- and that's a good thing. These deductions encourage energy companies to grow and create jobs.

And the biggest tax benefits aren't going to Big Oil. Back in 1975, federal lawmakers partially repealed a tax code

Depletion," which allowed fossil fuel producers to deduct the deprecation of their reserves. Only small and independent operators are now allowed to make such write-offs. ExxonMobil, Shell, and other large oil companies cannot. Likewise, credits such as the Enhanced Oil Recovery Tax Credit and Well Tax Credit are almost exclusively used by small and mid-sized operations.

These facts have been lost on both the media, which regularly repeats the myth that energy companies receive special tax treatment, and the White House, which has long advocated for steep tax hikes on the energy industry.

If the CFR report informs policy and the federal government does indeed eliminate tax deductions for fossil fuel producers, the American economy would be deeply damaged. After a decade of steady growth, this sector now supports more than 9 million jobs. It would contract under a heavy new tax burden, eliminating many of these positions and putting Americans all over the country out of work.

The CFR report also claims that ending energy tax "breaks" would help fight global warming, chiefly because it would afford the United States the moral standing needed to effectively pressure other nations to end their preferential tax policies

provision known as "Percentage and shrink their own fossil fuel sectors.

This claim ignores that fact that, counter intuitively, America is leading the world in emissions reductions thanks to the fossil fuel industry.

Thanks to the rapid expansion of America's natural gas sector, electricity plants have switched from coal to gas. Largely because of this migration, America's annual carbon emissions are now at a 20-year low. What's more, fossil fuel companies have poured billions into researching and developing carbon reduction technologies. Since 2000, oil and gas companies have invested more than twice as much as any other industry in such technologies.

This Council on Foreign Relations study claims that oil and gas firms receive special public subsidies. That isn't true. The sector simply benefits from the deductions afforded all other businesses. And these write-offs have helped the industry grow, create economic opportunity, and invest in clean energy technologies. The Council -- and its activist allies -- need to check their facts.

Cordova Blows Out Galt to Win Homecoming Game

RANCHO CORDOVA, CA (MPG) -In what was expected to be a close Sierra Valley Conference opener at Lancers Stadium turned out to be a blowout.

From kickoff until the final seconds ticked off the clock on the north end of the field, the Cordova High School football team dominated Galt that led to a 46-0 win on Oct. 7th. The game was also the Lancers' homecoming game.

On offense, Cordova (1-0 in the SVC, 4-2 overall) racked up a combined 402 yards; 224 on the ground and 178 in the air. Leading the Lancers' ground attack was running back Deante McCullough, who had nine carries for 109 yards.

"We thought that their defense matched up really favorable to our game plan," said Cordova head coach Darrin Nill of the Warriors' defense. "We ran the ball, we passed the ball. We were able to do pretty much whatever we wanted to do."

The majority of the Lancers' offensive attack took place in the first half in front of large homecoming crowd. Cordova led 39-0 at halftime.

Cordova quarterback Xavier Johnson completed 13-of-23 passes for 178 yards and four touchdowns. Two of those scores went into the hands of wide receiver Alvin Banks, who finished the game with four receptions for 54 yards.

The Lancers' defense held

Galt running back Zach Orman, who needed only 118 yards to become the school's new alltime rushing leader. Cordova held him to only eight carries for 23 yards. He currently sits at 4,152 in his three-year varsity career. The current record is 4,247 yards.

"He's a really good runner," said Nill of Orman. "We focused a lot of attention on him. We had two weeks to prepare for him (Cordova had the bye two weeks ago before the start of conference play). Our defense knew where (Orman) was at all times."

Cordova held Galt to a combined 50 yards; 29 on the ground and 21 in the air. The defense accounted toward one of the touchdowns. Lancer defensive back Tyreke Tate had two interceptions, including one that turned out to be an 82-yard return for one of the Lancers' scores in the second quarter. His second pick was in the third quarter.

Another Cordova defensive back in Raymond Flite also had an interception in the game. The Lancers' defense picked off the Warriors three times in the game.

Lancer defensive back Terrill Johnson led in tackles at nine. Cordova defensive end Clifford Bright had three tackles, and had what Nill called a "break out" game in creating havoc on an opponent's offense. "I thought he played an outstanding game," said Nill of Bright. "The entire front seven really played good gap defense."

Cordova defensive linemen Zariahn Zimmer and Joseph Salcedo had five quarterback sacks each, another plus in keeping the Warriors' offense from gaining yards. Registering six tackles each for Cordova were linebacker Yusef Pugh, defensive end Kelechi Njoku and Tate. Lancer middle linebacker Kenny Haney had four tackles.

Tonight, Cordova continues SVC action but on the road. The Lancers travel into El Dorado County to play at Union Mine (0-1 in the SVC, 1-5), which lost to defending SVC champion Liberty Ranch, 56-14, in their conference opener in Galt last Friday.
