To kick-off the fun filled weekend, the Airshow will host a Performer Meet and Greet on Friday, September 30th, with a FREE 'Paint the Town Blue and Gold' block party from 6:30 p.m. to 8:30 p.m.

Orion Jettison Motor, the Journey to Mars

SACRAMENTO, CA (MPG) - Aerojet Rocketdyne successfully tested its third development jettison motor for NASA's Orion spacecraft at its facility in Rancho Cordova, California. Orion is being built to take humans farther into space than ever before, and the jettison motor is a critical element for ensuring astronaut safety. Leaders from NASA and Lockheed Martin, the agency's prime contractor for the Orion spacecraft, visited Aerojet Rocketdyne to witness this key test.

"The first crewed flight of the Orion spacecraft is just around the corner," said Roger McNamara, Lockheed Martin Launch Abort System director. "The Launch Abort System is such an important safety feature; it's great to see progress

happening across the country and right here in Sacramento."

In the event of an emergency during launch or ascent, Orion is outfitted with a Launch Abort

System (LAS) that can activate within milliseconds to propel the capsule away from danger and position the crew module for a safe ocean landing. The LAS consists of three solid rocket motors: the abort motor that pulls the crew module away from the launch vehicle; the attitude control motor that is used to steer the crew module following an abort; and Aerojet Rocketdyne's jettison motor, which separates the launch abort system from the crew module so that parachutes can be deployed for a safe splashdown.

Aerojet Rocketdyne's jettison motor is the only LAS motor that will be activated on Orion's next test flight, Exploration Mission-1 (EM-1), which is scheduled for 2018. During

the three-week EM-1 mission, Orion will travel about 40,000 miles beyond the moon and return to Earth.

"Reliability of the jettison motor is critical to the safety and execution of the mission. Unlike other launch abort system motors, the jettison motor operates every time," said Jim Paulsen, vice president of NASA programs at Aerojet Rocketdyne. "Astronaut safety and reliability of our exploration systems is paramount at Aerojet Rocketdyne. EM-1 is the first integrated flight of Orion and the new heavy lift Space Launch System rocket, and Aerojet Rocketdyne propulsion systems will be supporting the mission from liftoff to splashdown."

Domestic Violence Shelter Funding Extensions Signed by Brown

SACRAMENTO, CA (MPG) - The Governor signed two bills strongly supported by the Chairwoman of the California State Board of Equalization (BOE) Fiona Ma, CPA, to help victims of domestic violence and businesses devastated by natural disasters.

AB 1559 (Baker) will create a checkoff box on California personal income tax return forms which will allow Californian's to donate to the newly created Domestic Violence Victims Fund. Domestic violence shelters will be able to apply for a grant from the new fund, administered by the California Office of Emergency Services, to help provide much-needed assistance to victims.

being is most at risk during episodes of violence and when attempting to leave an abuser. Domestic violence shelters are a key part of safety planning to prepare ahead of time and be as protected as possible. "Women and children who have

partners. A survivor's safety and well-

endured physical, mental, and emotional abuse need our help putting their lives back on track. AB 1599 (Baker) will help keep the shelter doors open and provide a place where women and children can sleep soundly, without fear," said Chairwoman Ma.

During her six year tenure in the Legislature, Chairwoman Ma served as Chair of the Domestic Violence Select Committee and witnessed how many California domestic violence shelters were forced to turn away women and children because of a lack of funding. In 2013 NNEDV conducted a 24-hour survey of domestic violence programs across the nation and reported 66,581 adults and children had found refuge and assistance, while an additional 9,641 requests for services were unmet because of a lack of resources. Each one of those unmet requests is another lost opportunity to break the cycle of violence. Now that Governor Brown has signed AB 1399 (Baker), shelters will receive greatly needed financial resources. "California business owners who

have been severely impacted by natural disasters are focusing on the recovery of their business, which will affect their ability to file and pay their taxes," said Chairwoman Ma.

"The Board of Equalization can now grant tax relief to countless businesses across the state that have been impacted by natural disasters. I'd like to thank Governor Jerry Brown for recognizing the urgency of this bill and acknowledging that California needs to do more to assist victims in the recovery process," said Assemblymember Bill Dodd.



CDPH Urges New Tuberculosis Screening Recommendations

SACRAMENTO, CA (MPG)

California Department of Public Health (CDPH) Director and State Health Officer Dr. Karen Smith has urged health care providers to adopt new recommendations recently announced by the U.S. Preventive Services Task Force calling for adults 18 years of age or older who are at increased risk of tuberculosis (TB) to be screened for the disease.

Those considered to be at increased risk of TB include individuals born in countries with elevated rates of the disease and individuals who live in settings with a large number of people, like group homes or homeless shelters.

"I urge health care providers in the state to adopt these new screening recommendations as quickly as possible," said Dr. Smith. "Local health departments should work with providers to ensure that today's new recommendations are implemented.

universally adopted, can help us eliminate TB in California in the next few decades."

Evidence shows that screening of individuals at increased risk for TB is an effective method for preventing the development of TB disease. TB is a disease caused by

bacteria called Mycobacterium tuberculosis. The bacteria usually attack the lungs but can also attack any part of the body such as the kidney, spine and brain. It can be spread through the air from one person to another by coughing, sneezing or speaking.

When TB bacteria actively grow in people and cause symptoms, the condition is known as TB disease and can be deadly. People with TB disease can infect others. The bacteria can also be inactive, causing no symptoms and held in check by the immune system. This condition is known as latent TB.

Elimination of TB in

Today's recommendations, if California is possible by detecting and treating latent TB infection before it progresses to infectious TB disease.

In California, an estimated 2.4 million people have latent TB infection. In 2015, 2,137 people were diagnosed with TB disease in the state. Health care providers can

consult with their local health departments to develop specific plans for screening their patient populations. The CDPH Tuberculosis Control Branch provides technical assistance to local health departments and health plans to implement tuberculosis prevention efforts.

CDPH has developed the California Risk Assessment Screening Tool to help health care providers to quickly identify people at risk for developing the disease and also a fact sheet that offers suggested courses of treatment.

SACRAMENTO REGION, CA (PRWEB) - Eskaton's No Falls League recently got out on the football field and recorded a video for National Falls Prevention Awareness Day, coming September 22, 2016. The video, "Ready Steady Balance," was named after the National Council on Aging's 2016 initiative. Eskaton developed the video to highlight efforts in providing resources and programs to transform the aging experience while supporting larger efforts to reduce the number of falls. In the video, Eskaton's Fall Prevention Team shows their peers how to have fun

while exercising and prevent falls. "We take a fun and new approach to teaching fall prevention, which can help reduce the number of falls each year," said Eskaton Fitness and Wellness Coordinator Christy Barry. "The specially designed fall prevention exercises help strengthen muscles, improve coordination, and build faster reaction times, just in case you do lose your balance."

The No Falls League, comprised of Eskaton's independent living residents, are seniors aged 67 to 95, wearing football jerseys reflecting their age. Led by Barry, the seniors in the video demonstrate several exercises showing how easy it is to improve balance and strength, helping to reduce fall risk. Low-impact exercises include knee lifts, weight shifting, shoulder rolls, overhead arm reach, arm reach across the chest and more. Career Criminal Sentenced for Carjacking, Evading Police

Career Criminals Convicted for Series of Residential Burglaries

Former After School Program Employee Convicted of Child Molest

The Honorable Steve White sentenced Love Davis Jr. to 57 years to life in prison. On June 30, 2016, a jury convicted Davis of carjacking and evading an officer with willful disregard.

On March 24, 2015, Davis accosted a 58-yearold woman and pushed her away from her car, which was parked at a gas station on Auburn Blvd. and Watt Ave. The victim struggled with Davis, but Davis jumped into her car and drove away, dragging the victim several feet on the pavement. Soon after, Davis was spotted by the California Highway Patrol. A pursuit began that lasted nearly an hour and covered four counties, including Sacramento, Placer, Yolo, and Sonoma. Davis drove nearly 110 mph, drove the wrong way, ignored stop signs and stop lights, passed on the shoulder and center divider, wove in and out of traffic, and finally crashed into the concrete median near the intersection of 65th and Highway 50. He was arrested and positively identified by the victim.

Davis' criminal history includes two prior strike convictions for robbery and first-degree burglary. He also has multiple past convictions for possession of stolen cars, evading police, theft, resisting arrest, possession of stolen property, possession of tear gas, and possession of meth in prison.

Palmer Beverly was convicted by a jury of three counts of residential burglary and two counts of being a felon in possession of a firearm. Antoine Fulbright was convicted of one count of residential burglary.

Between September 8, 2015 and September 17, 2015, three burglaries occurred in the South Land Park and Pocket areas of Sacramento. Witnesses obtained a partial license plate number, which was traced to a Rancho Cordova

address and the arrest of Beverly. During a search of that residence, property from all three burglaries was found along with two firearms. Fulbright was arrested when he was found near the residence with some of the stolen property in his possession. Shoe prints from one of the burglaries matched the shoes worn by Beverly and Fulbright on the day they were arrested.

Beverly's criminal history includes two prior strikes for residential burglary, receiving stolen property, grand theft from person, and possessing a knife while incarcerated. Fulbright's criminal history includes two prior strikes for residential burglary and robbery, second-degree burglary, vandalism, and possession of a controlled substance.

Beverly faces a maximum potential sentence of 31 years and 4 months in prison. Fulbright faces a maximum potential sentence of 25 years in prison. Both defendants will be sentenced on October 14, 2016, at 11:00 a.m. in Department 16 before the Honorable Marjorie Koller.

Joshua Vasquez pled guilty to 6 counts of committing lewd acts upon a child involving six separate victims.

Vasquez was employed by the Sacramento City Unified School District in an after school program, where he developed friendships with all of the victims. The victims ranged in age from 7 to 13 years old. While on school grounds, Vasquez took the children into his classroom, locked the door, and blindfolded them while he played different "games" with them. The games included the "cool whip," juice," and "treasure chest" game, which were all designed to have the children touch Vasquez's genitals in a number of ways. Vasquez recorded these acts of lewd and lascivious conduct with the children.

Vasquez will be sentenced to 150 years to life in prison. Sentencing is scheduled for October 28, 2016, at 10:30 a.m. in Department 11 by the Honorable Trena Burger-Plavan. ★





35 Points Proves Not Enough Against Vista del Lago

RANCHO CORDOVA, CA (MPG) -

Three Cordova High School football players posted impressive offensive numbers against Vista del Lago in last Friday's non-league game at Lancers

That led to a high-scoring first half between the Lancers and visiting Eagles. But in the final 24 minutes of the game, the contest belonged to Vista del Lago, which posted a 52-35 victory over Cordova (2-2).

"The second half, I think, they just wore us down," said Cordova head coach Darren Nill of the Eagles. "They were a more physical team than we were. They were bigger, they were stronger."

Vista del Lago (2-2) led 32-29 at halftime. The signs showed that the second half could be a repeat of the first half.

"We were neck-and-neck," said Nill of the first half. "They came out with a different defense than anybody has really played us all year. Their game, I believe, was just to take away our run and make us throw."

In the third quarter, the Lancers looked like they had the Eagles grounded in terms of an offensive drive being stopped. But on third down, the Lancers were called for pass interference. That gave Vista another first down, and led to one of its two touchdowns in the quarter for a 44-29 lead.

"That really turned the momentum," Nill said. "They were able to continue their drive."

The Lancers' next offensive drive, following the Eagles' touchdown, resulted in a punt. But the punt was blocked, and the Eagles recovered the ball in Cordova territory. That led to Vista's next touchdown in the quarter.

"It was those two events that took the wind out of our sails," Nill said.

Both teams scored a touchdown each in the fourth quarter. But by that time, Vista secured the win.

The Eagles loaded the box on

defense. That allowed Cordova quarterback Xavier Johnson time to throw the ball, and was very successful. The sophomore completed 18-of-30 passes for 333 yards for four touchdowns. When he wasn't throwing the ball, he rushed 13 times for 121 yards.

"He had a great game," said Nill of Johnson.

Cordova wide receivers Calvin Augusta and Alvin Banks also had outstanding games. Augusta, a junior, had only three receptions but for 123 yards and two touchdowns. Banks was 7-122 and a touchdown.

On defense, Lancer middle

linebacker Kenneth Haney led the way with 15 tackles.

In the frosh/soph game, Vista del Lago was also winners over Cordova, 48-12.

Tonight, Friday, Cordova wraps up its pre-season schedule with a short trek to play at Foothill of Sacramento.
