Over 3,000 Students Are Headed to the Airshow, Free!

RANCHO CORDOVA, CA (MPG) - The City of Rancho Cordova in partnership with the California Capital Airshow announced that 3,300 students in the City are heading to the California Capital Airshow free of charge! For the first time, all 18 Rancho Cordova elementary, middle, and high schools will receive exclusive "Operation #InspireTheFuture" student Airshow tickets – worth a total of nearly \$50,000 – plus a discount code for parents to attend with their students.

The California Capital Airshow will roar into Rancho Cordova on October 1-2, 2016 at Mather Airport, attracting over 100,000 spectators to the City for a heart-pounding lineup of performances and entertainment for the whole family. Yet many local students haven't had the chance to experience the Airshow firsthand.

"The City of Rancho Cordova is a vibrant community that values educational opportunities inside and outside the classroom," said Rancho Cordova Mayor David Sander. "It is our hope that these tickets will help ensure there are no barriers for students who want to attend the Airshow, an event that is filled with educational and inspirational opportunities."

These tickets will inspire the future of students by teaching them about Rancho Cordova's military history, introducing students to STEM (science, technology, engineering and math) through interactive exhibits, and providing an up-close opportunity to experience the thrill of the flight.

"The annual California Capital Airshow is more than the thrills of aircraft zooming overhead. This patriotic, family-friendly event uses

the power and magic of flight to inspire young people, creating an exciting educational environment that showcases science, technology, engineering and math as the tools needed to accomplish great things and change the world," said Darcy Brewer, Executive Director, California Capital Airshow.

Operation #InspireTheFuture kicked off at Riverview STEM Academy in Rancho Cordova with a special assembly. 295 students thought they'd just be learning about the Airshow, but they were surprised when, amid great fanfare, three military squadrons hand-delivered a "Top Secret" box filled with free tickets. The only person at the school in on the excitement was the principal.

"Our students and families couldn't be more excited. This experience makes what our kids learn in the classroom even more real," said Principal Tony Peterson. "Our school is grateful for this generous opportunity to inspire the future pilots, engineers, and innovators in our community."

The remaining Rancho Cordova schools received special visits from Rancho Cordova City Council members, military squadrons from the California Air National Guard, Beale Air Force Base, and U.S. Air Force, and Airshow representatives. Each school will decide how best to award the tickets to their students, but some examples are through contests, good behavior awards, and so forth.

"This is a great opportunity for the children in our community to come out to the California Capital Airshow, see some amazing technology in action, and be inspired to

achieve their own personal greatness," said Tom Keegan, Lt. Col., U.S. Air Force.

This year's Airshow features the world-famous US Navy Blue Angels, US Army Golden Knights, Royal Canadian Air Force CF-18 Hornet Demo, USAF F-16 Viper Demo, thundering pyrotechnics, theatrical WWII Tribute performances and so much more! From supersonic-speed jets to gravity-defying aerobatics to parachutists, and a host of on-the-ground displays and activities, a day at the Airshow is a fantastic and memorable experience for the entire family! Ribbon-Cutting Will Feature Rascal the Magical Dog at Renovated Dog Park

RANCHO CORDOVA, CA (MPG) - The ribbon-cutting ceremony for the renovated dog park at Hagan Community Park will be at 9 a.m. on Saturday, September 17th. Located at 2197 Chase Drive in Rancho Cordova, the three dog park areas now offer play and exercise equipment for dog visitors, benches for their owners, and 27 new trees for shade. The renovation was the project of Leadership Rancho Cordova Class X.

New play/exercise amenities include steps and weave posts in the large dog area, a hurdle and paws table in the medium dog area, and hoops and a crawl tube in the small dog area.

“Our class goal was to make some improvements to the existing dog park but thanks to our fundraising efforts and generous donors, we were able to make the Hagan dog park one of the best dog parks in the Sacramento region,” said Jacobe Caditz, chair of the Fundraising Committee.

Dog parks are becoming more popular all across the United States. Although they’re not for everyone, dog parks can benefit both people and their pets. According to its website, the American Society for the Prevention of Cruelty to Animals (ASPCA) “supports the development of community dog parks as a means for urban dogs in particular to exercise off leash and socialize with other dogs.”

The ribbon-cutting will be part of the

festivities at the Cordova Recreation and Park District’s Doggie Day in the Park that will open at 8 a.m. According to event organizers, Doggie Day is a fun-filled day designed especially for dogs and the people who love them. Activities will include resource and information booths, an agility obstacle course, and other contests and prizes.

And Another Thing ...

Preparing Presentation Date for “Vietnam War Veteran” Lapel Pins to the Veterans Who Served from November 1, 1955 to May 15, 1975

The autumn leaves are beginning to “drift by my window” as the song says, and they are also beginning to be noticeable on lawns in our neighborhood. The stores are beginning to fill some of their shelves with Halloween costumes and decorations, and a few are moving ahead with Christmas decorations too. There are a few events and holidays that seem to be missed by different stores like the changing colors of the trees, Veterans Day, Thanksgiving, and some more that even I can’t think of at the moment. But even though it is a little early to prepare for turkeys and stuffing, and stocking stuffers, time waits for no man or woman, and before you know it we will be celebrating New Year’s Eve and wonder what happened to Christmas! I will be trying to get some things done before it gets too late, but with the holidays and birthdays and anniversaries, there just isn’t as much time as you may think. Good luck to us all in trying to get ready and cover all the bases.

I am working with our staff at City Hall to prepare a date for the next time I will be able to present the “Vietnam War Veteran” lapel pins to the Veterans who served from November 1, 1955 to May 15, 1975, regardless of the location(s) where they served. That means that the veteran

didn’t have to be in-country or in-theater, and could have been stationed elsewhere during the Vietnam War period. As some of us know the veterans who served and then came home were not always welcomed back. We, along with over 8,000 other organizations, are continuing to praise, commend, and welcome those who were not welcomed home during the Vietnam War period. It is the right thing to do. I will let you know in this column and in the regular newspaper when I have a solid date for the ceremony of presenting the lapel pins to the Vietnam veterans.

A few days ago, people across the country and around the world remembered the 9/11 attack. We not only remembered those who lost their lives during that assault on the innocent, but also remembered the heroes who gave up their lives that dreadful day while searching for any survivors in what was left of the World Trade Center and the Pentagon. Nearly another generation has been born since the September 11, 2001 attack. 15 years have gone by, and those who were able to remember any details are now about 20 years old. Unfortunately, it seems that every generation has a sad event to mark their lives. But not all terrible events that have happened are man-made; just ask the survivors of Hurricane Katrina.

Now here is another thing that may be helpful to people who use a hearing aid. For a while, there seemed to be quite a few bad hearing aid batteries

even though they were supposed to be new. I learned not too long ago that if you get the battery out of the package, take the little metal cover off of the back of the battery, and let it sit for about 2 minutes, it will work. You will find that leaving it open lets the battery build up the charge that is in it. I use hearing aids because of a motorcycle accident I had years ago. As I said, this isn’t of help for everyone, but when you spend quite a bit of money on batteries, you want them to work.

Today’s column is rather scattered, but I have something else to add, and that is to look very carefully at Proposition 57 which is on the ballot. It is titled “Public Safety and Rehabilitation Act of 2016”. From the information I have been able to gather about what the proposition will actually do, it will change some crimes from to a felony to a non-violent crime. There would be many prisoners who are currently serving time in prison that would become eligible for an early release. Take the time and read Proposition 57, because it isn’t what it’s title says it is. Some reforms in prison may be necessary, but I don’t think “reform” should be at the cost of victims and future victims because the governor wants to empty the overcrowding of the prisons. Look at the other 16 propositions too of course, but make the time needed to read and understand them.

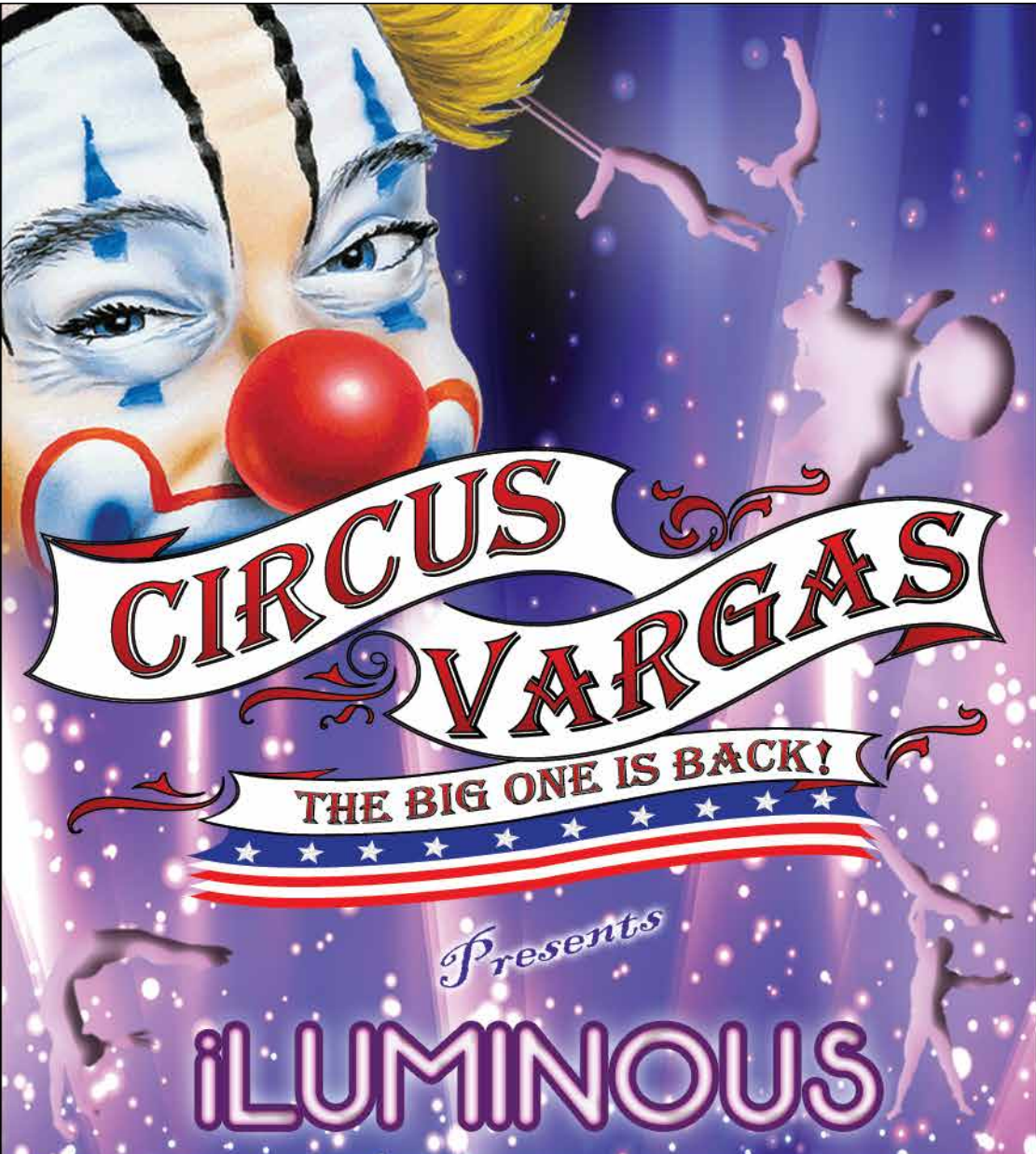
At this store you could buy a legal book that takes you step-by-step in qualifying to receive compensation for your disorder.

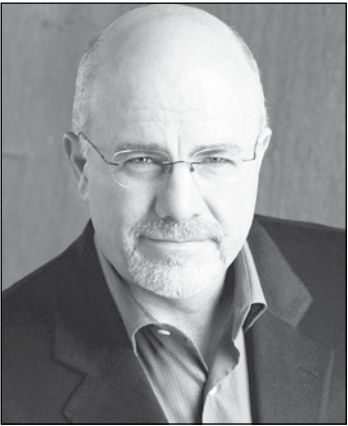

What's the deal with deferred comp?

Dear Dave,
I work for a fire department in Mississippi, and I've been trying to get information on the state's deferred comp plan. No one here seems to know a lot about it, so I was wondering if I should keep looking for information or is it not worth the bother?
- Brandon

Dear Brandon,
Deferred comp simply means you are electing to defer and receive a portion of your compensation at a later time or date. People who use these types of plans have a portion of their

compensation withheld and directed into an investment of some kind instead, and you aren't taxed on it immediately. It's sort of like a pre-tax investment, but it's not transferrable to an IRA or 401(k).
I would only do deferred compensation after I've done everything else in terms of saving 15 percent of my income for retirement, including a Roth IRA. These are funded by after-tax dollars, but they grow tax-free. But I wouldn't do any of this until after I had paid off all my debt, except for my home, and had an emergency fund of three to six months of expenses in place.

Carnival Sets Bar with Newest Ship

Clearly, the Fun Ship 2.0 upgrades Carnival Cruises has been making fleet-wide since 2011 are just a tease for something bigger and better. That something, the freshly christened, bar-raising Carnival Vista, comes to America in November.

It’s indeed bigger; Carnival’s first new ship in four years is the largest in the fleet for both passenger capacity (3,954) and tonnage (133,500). As for better, subjective as that descriptor is, the Vista makes a strong case having on one ship all the Fun Ship 2.0 refurbishments being added to the older vessels, ranging from concept bars and upgraded dining options to inventive entertainment offerings, along with industry firsts among the many new features on board.

At Carnival’s invitation, I checked out the bright, shiny ship one sail after its maiden voyage. Exploring and observing from bow to stern, starboard to portside, here are observations made during the 10-day Mediterranean cruise:

First Impressions: Disconcerting as it was to walk onto a Carnival ship and not be awestruck by towering glass elevators, the three-story, vortex-shaped DreamScape is a grand replacement of the atrium’s signature piece. The HD LED tube changes graphics several times during a cruise, and is just gorgeous. True to its name, the Vista was designed with views in mind; several dining venues have indoor-outdoor seating. Carnival’s fun for all ages reputation is bolstered by new offerings for often underserved older teens and the cruise line’s first-ever raft and watertubing adventure called Kaleid-O-Slide.

Industry Firsts: Carnival has found an innovative way to combine excitement with exercise with its brand-new, no extra cost SkyRide. Created by the founder of Rollerblade, it’s like riding a bike, only you’re pedaling while suspended on a rail above the deck. And the view! Breathtaking vistas are found inside the ship as well on the three-deck-high screen of the first IMAX at sea. The 187-seat IMAX, combined with the intimate Thrill Theater, a separate screen showing exhilarating multi-dimensional, shorter-length movies, makes the Vista the first nautical multiplex. The first brewery on a North American ship also is onboard, offering three craft beers.

From 2.0 to New.0: Besides cool industry firsts, Carnival Vista offers a “greatest hits” of the line’s newest features. SportsSquare, already on the Breeze, Magic and Sunshine, is a fresh and colorful take on such shipboard recreational mainstays as basketball, mini-golf, foosball and ping pong. The equally all-ages SkyCourse, also on those other three ships, is an elevated ropes course featuring two levels of challenge. The best of the Fun Ship 2.0 upgrades are all present and accounted for. Branded bars specializing in rum and tequila drinks, and a cocktail “pharmacy” called Alchemy Bar are

popular watering holes, and the best burgers on the high seas come off the grill at Guy’s Burger Joint, created in partnership with celebrity chef Guy Fieri.

The Food: Nothing on the ship beats those burgers, not even the surf and turf at the steakhouse,

That’s Entertainment: Playlist Productions-branded shows, coming out of Fun Ship 2.0, put an end to cheesy stage shows with dazzling use of LED screens, contemporary choreography and actual music from this decade. Playlist’s newest production, the movie-themed “Flick,” had a triumphant world premiere during our sail. Standards from over 25 movies, including “Titanic,” of all films, are sung and danced to with a mystical bent in Cirque du Soleil style. The talented cast and a live seven-piece Cuban-inspired band kill with “Amor

Cubano,” a hot new show featuring a refreshing playlist of Latin and Caribbean numbers. “America Rocks!,” the third new show on the Carnival Vista, invigorates well-worn cruise show favorites from the likes of Bruce Springsteen, Kiss and Lynyrd Skynyrd. Even if the songs are tired at least the technical aspects and high-octane energy of the singers and dancers are mind-blowing.

Unique Accommodations: Carnival debuts two nifty “neighborhood” concepts with Vista.

Family Harbor on Deck 2 offers staterooms that sleep up to five people and an exclusive lounge stocked with large-screen TVs, games, refreshments and a concierge. Carnival marketing says the new Havana Cabana suites (for guests 12 and older) on Deck 5 will make you feel like you’re staying on an island resort. Believe the hype. The sense of going tropical is complements of special décor, a private lanai and exclusive access to the

lively indoor-outdoor Havana Bar that serves complementary Cuban-style food during the day along with specialty coffees and cocktails.

Development Areas: For a new ship with the latest systems available, ventilation inside the casino is surprisingly poor. Exacerbating the problem is the inability to walk around the cloud of smoke when heading from the lobby to key food and entertainment venues on Deck 4. I can’t recall

another megaship that doesn’t have an alternative path to circumvent the gaming area. Also, opting against traditional stadium seating in favor of individual chairs, the design of the 1,400-seat Liquid Lounge where the big production shows are staged is problematic. Without stationary chairs, people were configuring rows that essentially created barricades, removed natural aisles and gave some folks no leg room – a potential fire hazard. Also, only the two back rows are tiered and fastened, so line of sight was lousy for all but the very tall and those in the first rows.

Bottom Line: Overbrimming with novel features and others that improve on the familiar, Carnival Vista sets the bar for the company. Casino notwithstanding, the fleet’s biggest and brightest is a breath of fresh air, and ranks among the best ships this frequent cruiser has sailed. ★

Mistakes Costly for Cordova Football

RANCHO CORDOVA, CA (MPG) - At the beginning, the Cordova High School football team looked like it was going roll past Rio Linda. But in last Friday’s non-league home game at Lancers Stadium, the Lancers saw their fine performance in the first quarter end at that point. Then the Knights took over the rest of the way that led to a 31-29 win over Cordova (2-1). “We had a lot of confidence going into that game,” said Cordova head coach Darren Nill. “We came out firing on all cylinders.” The Lancers jumped out to a 23-7 lead after the first quarter. On offense, Cordova moved the ball without much competition from the Knights. “The quarterback (Lancer signal caller Xavier Johnson) was in his reads, the running backs were getting up the middle, the line was doing their job,” Nill said. “Everything was going really well.” But Rio Linda (1-2) saw the momentum swing to its side of the field toward the end of the first quarter. That’s when

Lancer wide receiver and line-backer Jason Johnson broke his foot. According to Nill, Johnson is expected to be out until the Sierra Valley Conference opener against Galt at Lancers Stadium on Friday, Oct. 7th. “He left the game,” said Nill of Johnson, who led the team with 30 tackles going into last Friday’s game. Cordova was whistled for five personal fouls in the game. The Lancers were flagged for 112 yards. Rio Linda lost only 70 yards. “We still have some players that put themselves above the team,” Nill said. “We’ve talked to these players all the time. We’d get a drive kill because they can’t control their emotions. We beat ourselves.” Cordova scored on its first three possessions of the game. Then the next six offensive opportunities, the Lancers had a combined 19 yards. On their possession of the game, the Lancers scored and had a chance to tie the game in the fourth quarter to send it into overtime. But the 2-point conversion failed. “Our team likes to make things

exciting,” Nill said. “(The) loss to Rio Linda really hurt because we thought that was a game we should’ve had.” Lancer runner back Deante McCullough had 11 carries for 95 yards and two touchdowns. Johnson completed 13-of-23 passes for 155 yards and one touchdown. The Lancers finished with 255 total offensive yards. Rio Linda had 372 total yards; 227 rushing and 145 passing. On defense, Cordova line-backer Kenneth Haney had 15 tackles. Defensive lineman Kelechi Njoku followed at 11, defensive back Terrill Johnson 10 and linebacker Yusef Pugh nine. Jason Johnson had four tackles before he left the game with his injury. In the junior varsity game, Rio Linda also came out with a 56-8 win over Cordova (0-3). Tonight, Friday, Cordova welcomes Vista del Lago of Folsom, and one of three 9-12 high schools in the Folsom-Cordova Unified School District; Cordova and Folsom the other two. The Eagles soar into the game with a 1-2 record. ★

New Class Inducted into Sports Hall of Fame

RANCHO CORDOVA, CA (MPG) - If there’s anyone who is familiar with Cordova High School athletics, it is Ken Rudolph. The 1985 CHS graduate played Lancer football and baseball. Rudolph, now co-host of Good Day Sacramento on KMAX, CW-31 and part of the weekday midday show on Sports 1140 AM, shared his stories of being a Lancer. “I bought into the Cordova way,” Rudolph said.

On Sept. 10th at the Rancho Cordova City Hall, Rudolph served as emcee for the second annual Rancho Cordova Sports Hall of Fame. Many former Cordova High School student-athletes, coaches and those who contributed to athletics in the city of Rancho Cordova were honored. In front of a packed house, Rudolph recalled one particular story of a game in 1984 in which teammate and quarterback Troy Taylor, who went on to have a stellar career at Cal and a brief stint in the National Football League, threw a pass to Rudolph that was intercepted in a 1984 game. But no harm was done to Taylor, who was part of the Folsom High School football coaching staff that has produced many league, Sac-Joaquin Section, Nor-Cal and California Interscholastic Federation titles since 2010. Taylor was one of the inductees. “We were down 20-6 at half-time, and we came back and won that game 24-20,” Rudolph told the crowd.

Speed up to the day before the Hall of Fame ceremonies. Rudolph told the crowd he and his son were playing MLB 2009 on their X-Box360. Playing for the Philadelphia Phillies, Rudolph battled against Geoff Jenkins, a former Lancer pitcher who was also inducted. “I know that guy,” Rudolph told the audience, referring to the conversation he had with his son. “I’m going to induct him into the hall of fame (last Saturday).” This year’s inductees were the following:

- The 1973 Cordova High School Mile Relay track and field team of **Darrell Smith, Gerald Smith, Fred Dawkins and Rod Connors**, all of whom the state championship.
- Former Lancer basketball star **Zach Andrews** (CHS graduate in 2003), who went on to play at Yuba College before an outstanding National Basketball Association (NBA) career with the Los Angeles Lakers.
- A 1977 Cordova graduate, **Brian Bailey** was a four-sport athlete, shining in football, wrestling, swimming and track and field. He went on to play football at Cal, and earned the 1979 Brick Muller Award, which is bestowed upon Cal’s most valuable lineman.
- **Jerry Bates** served as the Cordova High School junior varsity football coach, where he produced a record of 25-1-1 in the mid-1970s.
- **Joyce Bowles Brown**, another 1979 CHS graduate who starred in volleyball and track and field. In the long jump, she set the school record at 19 feet, 3 inches. After serving in the United States Air Force Reserves, she played on the Sacramento Sirens, a woman’s professional women’s football team that won three straight championships from 2002 to 2004.

- **Joe Brown**, a decorated World War II veteran who flew 32 missions. After the war, he became a teacher at Mills Junior High School, and was the school’s football head coach. He posted a record of 46-6-2. He passed away in 2005.
- **Chad George** is a former three-time CHS wrestling champion who practiced mixed martial arts. He’s won in Brazilian Jiu Jitsu, three-time MMA champion, plus three-time World Exchange Cage Fighter.
- **Geoff Jenkins**, a 1992 CHS graduate, had a standout baseball career as a Lancer and at University of Southern California (USC). He led the Trojans to the College World Series. He moved on to play in Major League Baseball (MLB) for the Milwaukee Brewers and Philadelphia Phillies, who he won a World Series crown in 2008.
- **Eppie Johnson**, founder and director of Eppie’s Great Race. Johnson passed away in 2013.
- **Tracy Rinderneck Kitz**, a 1976 Cordova graduate who was a volleyball standout, and was a three-sport athlete in basketball and softball. She went on to play volleyball at American River College and Sacramento State. At Cordova
- **Karen Nickerson Masterson** starred for Lancers’ track and field in the early 1980s. Competing in the discus, she won the 1981 Sac-Joaquin Section title in the event with a toss of 156’ 7” and took seventh place at the CIF state meet at 165’ 10”.
- **Nyls Nyman** was an early 1970s CHS graduate who also played professional baseball. He was named to the All-State Team and is listed among Sacramento’s top 100 High School Baseball Players from 1950-1999.
- **Steve Petuskey** booted his way into success as a former Lancer soccer player in the late 1970s. He went on to play at Cosumnes River College and Sacramento State, then turned pro and played for the Sacramento Knights, who won the Continental Indoor Soccer League crowns in 1993. In 1994, the Knights won the U.S. Open Cup.
- **Steve Pilcher**, a former Cordova wrestler who pinned opponents at University of California Los Angeles (UCLA) in the mid-1970s. He also wrestled Greco-Roman and freestyle wrestling.
- **Dawn Puhr** played three sports at Cordova toward the end of the 1970s into the early 1980s, but stood out in softball. She went on to play centerfield at Sacramento State, which won the Division II championship in 1981.
- **Helen Russell** was a heart of a champion, who volunteered her time as a medical trainer for CHS athletic teams.
- **Laurie Salo** played volleyball, field hockey, basketball and

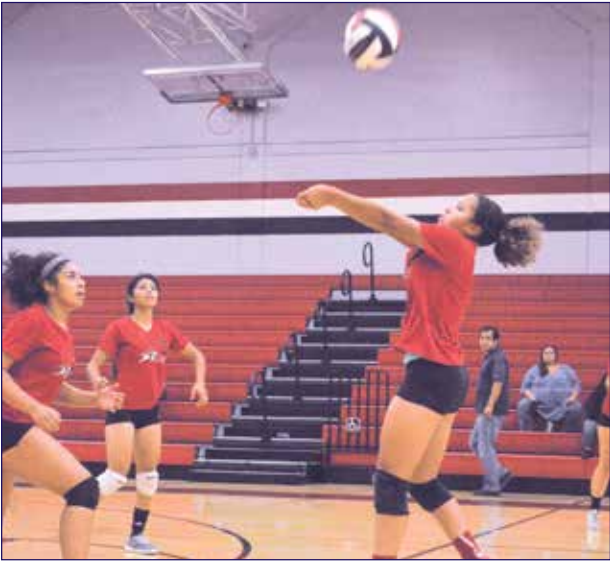
softball at CHS. She was recruited by UC Davis to play softball, and earned MVP honors in the mid to late 1980s.

- **Mike Sedillo** is a California Boxing Hall of Famer who was a multi-sport athlete at CHS and Mills Junior High School in the late 1970s. He played basketball at the University of Seattle, and invited to the Seattle Mariners’ baseball camp before opting to become a boxer, winning his first seven matches that included three by knockout. Most notable bout for Sedillo was beating Diamond Jim McDonald at, then, Arco Arena (now Sleep Train Arena), in 1988.
- **Bill Shiftlet**, a 1972 CHS graduate, played football, wrestling and track and field for the Lancers. But after high school, he switched to rugby. He played for the USA Football Union Eagles from 1983 until 1987.
- **Judy Shipman**, a former CHS coach, battled and defeated cancer twice to compete in many well-known races. At age 50, she has competed in many races that included the Boston Marathon, and is a 10-time Eppie’s Great Race Ironwoman winner. She was recently honored, now at 75, as the Woman’s Ultra Veteran Athlete of the Year.
- **Troy Taylor**, after his playing days with Rudolph and the Lancer football program, shined as quarterback at Cal, then the pros with the New York Jets from 1990 to 1992. After working as an assistant coach in the Christian Brothers High School football program, he moved to Folsom High School that has won many titles. He’s now coaching at Eastern Washington University.
- **Randy Veres** played football, basketball and baseball at CHS until he graduated in 1984. He moved on to play baseball, which took him to Sacramento City College and the Brewers. He played for five more MLB teams toward the end of the 1980s.
- **Ryan Yantis** swam to success at CHS. He was a four-time All-American, and set national and section high school records in 1979. Those marks were broken in 2007.

The event was organized by the Rancho Cordova Athletic Association in partnership with the Cordova Community Council. “Our Hall of Fame acknowledges and memorializes that incredible history and will inspire our current and future youth athletes as well,” said Rancho Cordova Mayor David Sander and president of the Rancho Cordova Athletic Association in a press statement. To be elected to the Rancho Cordova Sports Hall of Fame, inductees were judged to have attained significant achievements in or contributions to athletics, as well as exhibiting high standards of character and sportsmanship. ★
