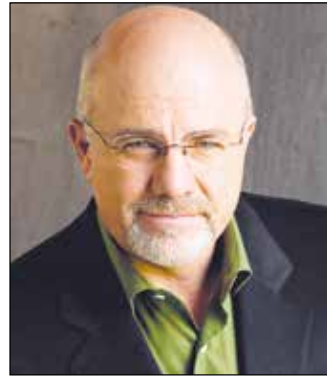

## Veterans Village Gives New Hope To Homeless



The grand opening event drew a large crowd of proud contributors to the project, as well as a strong showing of the general public. Many local political leaders appeared to show their support on a proud day for Rancho Cordova.

**RANCHO CORDOVA, CA (MPG)** - Dozens of dignitaries, citizens and news outlets gathered together August 31 for the opening ceremony heralding the newest phase of completion for the Mather Veterans Village, a new concept in housing for our military's veterans who have found themselves homeless or disabled.

Master of Ceremonies, Doug Shoemaker, President of Mercy Housing California opened the event, which continued with Presentation of the Colors by American Legion, Post 709 and the Pledge of Allegiance.

The multi-million-dollar project was conceived and funded in part by the city of Rancho Cordova, Mercy Housing, Sacramento County, Mogavero Architects and Veterans Resource Centers of America and other charitable groups.

"We as Americans made a promise to these brave veterans," said Marc Deal, Executive Director for Veterans Resource Centers. "We said, 'Fight our wars, keep the wolves at bay, stand the wall, and when your watch is done, we will take care of you.'" He continued, "This is the finest example of not only keeping a promise but giving the best gift you can give a veteran: hope."

One speaker and supporter who saw the need and benefit of Veterans Village back in the concept stage was Ami Bera, MD, Congressman, 7th Congressional District of California and resident of Elk Grove, who stated, "As a doctor, this was a no-brainer. As an American, this was a no-brainer."

Other speakers included Supervisor Don Nottoli and Rancho Cordova Councilmember and veteran Robert McGarvey, who presented veterans in attendance with lapel pins and his own

formal gratitude for their service to their country.

This phase provides 50 homes for veterans and their families in one and two bedroom homes. The site also utilizes various green technologies such as a solar hot water system, solar electric generation, 100% gray water landscaping irrigation, drought tolerant plants. Awnings outside windows also cut down on the summer sun's rays, saving on utility costs and helping keep the units cool.

"The City of Rancho Cordova is a vibrant community with a strong military heritage that values its veterans," said Mayor David Sander. "Once the site of an active Air Force base, it is still home to over 5,000 veterans and their families."

Ten years from concept to opening day ceremonies, ground was broken on the project in late 2014. This current phase is *Continued on page 2*

## City Council Moves Rio Del Oro Project Forward

*Project Would Grow the City's Population by 40 Percent over the Next 25 Years*

**RANCHO CORDOVA, CA (MPG)** - The Rancho Cordova City Council in a Special Meeting on August 29, 2016, approved amendments to the Rio Del Oro Specific Plan, the largest land development project in the City. These approvals move the project forward to the design and permitting phase, allowing for a ground breaking as early as 2018.

"This is a historic day for Rancho Cordova," said Mayor David Sander. "We are charting a path forward with one of the largest developments in the Sacramento region. Rio Del Oro sets a regional mark for how modern, suburban, upscale development can be done. This project places a variety of exciting new housing opportunities next to Rancho Cordova's existing region-leading job center, while adding more mixed use opportunities, the area's largest public

park, and what will be the most bicycle trail miles in the region."

Rio Del Oro covers 3,828 acres on a site bordered by White Rock Road to the north, Sunrise Blvd. to the west, and Douglas Blvd. to the south. The project includes 12,189 residential units, one high school, two middle schools, six elementary schools, 157 acres of commercial, 90 acres of business park, 269 acres of industrial park, 510 acres of wetland preserve, 121 acres of community park, 57 acres of neighborhood parks, and 16 miles of trails.

"The Council's approval of Rio Del Oro allows us the opportunity to transform the site from mine tailings to a complete community of neighborhoods with schools, parks and shopping," said Harry C. Elliott III, President of Elliott Homes. "We are excited to be a part of the next chapter of

Rancho Cordova's growth."

The project began in 2003 and "Tier One" of the plan was approved in 2010. On Monday, the City Council approved Tier Two, which included approvals of:

- Amendments to the Rio Del Oro Specific Plan
- Public Facilities Financing Plan
- Amended and Restated Development Agreements
- Large Lot Tentative Subdivision Map
- Master Phasing Plan
- Affordable Housing Plan
- Environmental Impact Report Addendum

"We are extremely pleased by the City Council action approving Rio Del Oro.

Many years and a tremendous amount of hard work have been invested. The Rio Del Oro Plan is truly world class, and will bring a variety of housing options, jobs, open space and will significantly contribute to the future success of Rancho Cordova. On behalf of Easton Development Company, LLC and Aerojet Rocketdyne, Inc. we are truly excited to be part of this opportunity," said David C. Hatch, Vice President & Chief Operating Officer of Easton.

Now that Tier Two of the entire Rio Del Oro Plan project is approved, the project can begin to process individual projects, which would include small-lot tentative subdivision maps, grading plans, design review and building permits.

# Veterans Village Gives New Hope To Homeless

one of three and puts Veterans Village residents in reach of many other badly needed support services, many of which are available at the Veterans Administration Hospital which is just blocks away.

The three-story, garden-style buildings also include 3,500 square feet of meeting rooms, staff offices, kitchen/lounge area, laundry facilities, and a computer lab.

For the opening day ceremonies, several residents opened their homes and gave tours. The apartment homes are light, bright and outfitted with accessible features and modern appliances. For most, this is a far cry from the crime and danger of living on the street.

Many of Veterans Village residents have been hit hard by some of life's toughest circumstances. Post-Traumatic Stress Disorder (PTSD) from military service or family loss frequently leave sufferers vulnerable to unhealthy habits and behaviors resulting in drug and alcohol issues, which then become even harder to cope with and overcome.

Viet Nam-era veteran Ernesto Hayles serviced in the Army from 1974-76 and came home to bear the brunt of a nation unhappy about the politics of the conflict. Instead of the thanks of a grateful nation, he was pelted by cries of "baby killer." After 40 years of suffering he was finally diagnosed with PTSD and began getting the help he needed. Along with his wife Roxanne and service dog Shadow, Ernesto now has access to job training, hope and a safe place to finally call home.

Another resident, George Thomas, whose mother attended, was a speaker at the opening ceremonies. He spoke eloquently about the ongoing struggles veterans face. Losing his father tipped the scales for George and he turned to drugs

in an effort to escape the pain. He realized finally that he was not alone. Not only did he still have family members who

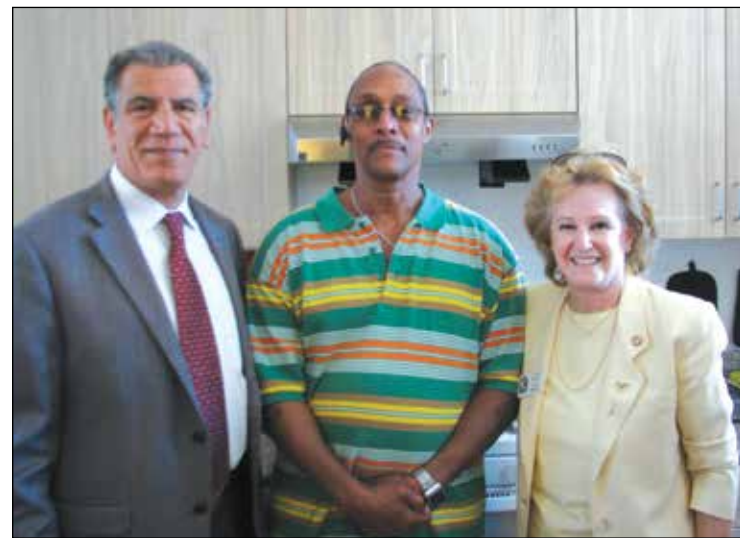
cared, but that Mather Veterans Village is also his family. He feels he has a new lease on life, as do the other residents, and said, "We have a reason to live."

The community is being built in three phases on a 3.65-acre site. Comprehensive on-site support services such as health care and wellness programs, veterans' benefits claims assistance, substance abuse and counseling and support groups, employment services, Sacramento Food Bank & Family Services food deliveries and social activities.

With Phase I complete, Phase II will include a 46-bed transitional housing program, the Veterans Resource Center supportive service programs and administrative offices, a

commercial kitchen and chef to provide three healthy, delicious meals daily to residents. Phase

II will also be the gathering place for the community. Phase III will provide an additional 50

permanent supportive homes on site.

Mather Veterans Village is a place for these wounded warriors to find peace and hope and the help they need and deserve.

The event, which began with a flyover by the West Coast Ravens, concluded with a community prayer, the retiring of the colors and a ribbon-cutting ceremony. Light lunch refreshments were also provided for attendees and residents alike.

A true community effort, Mather Veterans Village was developed and designed by Mercy Housing California and Veterans Resource Centers of America. Mogavera Architects, Warren Consulting Engineers and Broward Builders, Inc. Property Management is by Mercy Housing Management and resident services are provided by Veterans Resource Centers of America.

Financing and Community Partners include the California Department of Housing and Community Development, the California Tax Credit Allocation Committee, the City of Rancho Cordova, Sacramento County, the Home Depot Foundation, Sacramento Housing and Redevelopment Agency, Sacramento Steps Forward, the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development, the U.S. Department of Veterans Affairs, the VA Northern California Health Care System and Wells Fargo Bank.

For those seeking more information for themselves or loved ones, the process begins with referrals from community partners or from the homeless veteran himself, next there is an application and screening process through Veterans Resource Center, from there, applications are submitted to Mercy Housing and then continued by Veterans Resource Center and Mather Community Campus. ★

unions (labor) and manufacturers to come to agreements on working time, hourly wages, safety factors, etc., and sometimes there was violence between them before they came to a settlement.

According to history, some of the members of the Greatest Generation – who fought during WWII – came home and had to fight again on the picket lines. What came out of it was the creation of what we call the middle class in America. There were many families that were now able to live comfortably with only one member of the married couple having to go to work. After the 50s and 60s, many factories and plants were moved out of the United States, and the jobs went with them. Today, according to the encyclopedia, the vast majority of the families in the USA are quite different than they were in the past. Usually, both members of the married couples in families today have to work to make ends meet. Parents in the past felt that their children would be able to do much better than they ever did, but today that feeling seems to have been lost. We will have to see what happens to the next generation.

And another thing (or things) have been given to today's voters. There are 17 statewide propositions on the November 2016 ballot. Two of them (Proposition 62 and 66) are for or against the Death Penalty; two more (Proposition 65 and 67) are about single use plastic bags; two more (Proposition 51 and 58) are about bilingual education and the other about bonds for education and schools; and the rest are either not being mentioned on TV or are just beginning to be seen on TV or papers. There are still two months before the

November 8th election, so it would be worth our while to make the time to look at what is being asked of us before we decide to spend the money.

There is another item that is very interesting to me, and that is a book entitled "A Hobbit, a Wardrobe, and a Great War" by Joseph Loconte. It is about two authors that are very well known today in books and movies that were made about the books. J.R.R. Tolkien and C.S. Lewis, according to the book, rediscovered faith, friendship, and heroism in 1914-1918 (WWI). I learned about the book in the September 2016 issue of "The American Legion" magazine. J.R.R. Tolkien wrote "The Hobbit" and "The Lord of the Rings", and C.S. Lewis wrote "The Chronicles of Narnia" and "The Space Trilogy", among many other works.

"Tolkien, a second lieutenant, arrived in France in 1916 and fought at the Battle of the Somme, one of the bloodiest battles in military history. He contracted trench fever, which took him out of the war. Lewis, also a second lieutenant, arrived on the Western Front in 1917, on his 19th birthday. He was wounded by a mortar shell, and his injuries took him out of harm's way for the remainder of the war." Neither of them let war overwhelm their lives. I will bring this up again after I have had a chance to read some more of the book. "Both believed that war would sometimes be necessary. To preserve justice and protect the innocent." It is fascinating how life can change our lives in completely unexpected ways.

# Sikhs Host Historic Forum with CA Legislators and Civic Leaders

**SACRAMENTO, CA (MPG)** - The American Sikh Public Affairs Association (ASPAA) hosted two groundbreaking events featuring state lawmakers, local elected officials, and Sikh civic leaders from across California. A noon program at the State Capitol offered legislators and their staff an opportunity to learn more about their Sikh constituents and a dinner program with close to three-hundred guests highlighted the accomplishments and goals of the American Sikh community.

The evening program entitled, "Inaugural Civic Engagement Dinner" held at the Mirage Banquet Hall in Sacramento, featured keynote presentations from Sacramento Mayor-Elect Darrell Steinberg and Republican National Committeewoman Harmeet Kaur Dhillon. Mayor-Elect Steinberg offered encouraging remarks on the accomplishments of Sikh leaders in California. "It is efforts like the American Sikh Public Affairs Association that help break down the barriers and uplift the young men and women in our communities," said Steinberg, who will succeed Sacramento Mayor Kevin Johnson in December of 2016.

Additional congratulatory comments were offered by Assemblymember Jim Cooper, Sacramento Sheriff Scott Jones, Former Assemblymember Mariko Yamada, State Senator Ted Gaines, and a representative for Assemblymember Susan Eggman.

served as Chairwoman of the San Francisco Republican Party, and was the first female Vice Chair of the California Republican Party. Today, she serves as the RNC National Committeewoman and made international headlines by offering Sikh prayers at the 2016 Republican National Convention in Cleveland.

Other elected guests at the Civic Dinner included Assemblymembers Kevin McCarty and James Gallagher, Sacramento District Attorney Anne Marie Schubert, and Elk Grove City Councilman Steve Detrick.

A slideshow showcasing the one-hundred year history of Sikhs in American public life was delivered by ASPAA board member Bhajan Singh. "It is important for this next generation to understand the challenges our parents have overcome to establish their

identity as both Americans and Sikh," said Singh. The slideshow and event program featured information commemorating Dalip Singh Saund; the first Indian, first Asian, and first Sikh Congressman elected in 1957, and Bhagat Singh Thind; who challenged American citizenship laws that barred Indian immigrants.

ASPAA proudly introduced a large list of Sikh civic leader from throughout California including Preet Dibal, Yuba City Council Member; Kash Gill, Yuba City Council Member; Amarpreet Dhaliwal, San Joaquin Mayor; Parveen Tumber, West Sacramento Planning Commissioner; Mandeep Grewal, Modesto City Council Member; Gary Singh, Manteca City Council Candidate; Sarb Takhar, Chair of the Sutter County Republican Party; Mikey Hothi, California Democratic Party Delegate;

and Amar Shergill, California Democratic Party Delegate.

Community leaders from other faith organizations also joined the event including Jon Fish from the Sacramento County Interfaith Council, Basim Elkarr from the Council on American Islamic Relations (CAIR), and Father Joshua Lickter from the Anglican Church in North America. Dr. Tom and Felicia Bhe were introduced as the organization noted its gratitude for the leadership of the Asian Pacific Islander American Public Affairs Association and the Organization of Chinese Americans.

Closing remarks were offered by Darshan Mundy, ASPAA board member and public relations officer for the West Sacramento Gurdwara Sahib, who thanked the event's attendees and sponsors for their generous contributions to the

association. His district office is also led by the only Sikh district director in the State Assembly, Mikey Singh Hothi. Hothi helped facilitate the capitol event which featured Assemblymember Cooper and guest speakers Amar Shergill from the American Sikh Public Affairs Association, Winty Singh of the Sikh Coalition, and Deep Singh from Jakara, a Sikh youth organization.

"This Sikh seminar is the first of its kind," says Amar Shergill, "It is the first step in truly embracing California's diversity and empowering minority communities like the Sikhs in the legislative process." Shergill, who serves as a board member for ASPAA is also a delegate for the California Democratic Party and hopes to partner with legislators to create Capitol internships and voter registration programs that engage the Sikh community in the civic process.

## County Budget Balances Reinvestment, Fiscal Stability

**SACRAMENTO, CA (MPG)** - During final budget hearings on September 7th, the Board of Supervisors reviewed and approved the Adopted Budget Documents for Fiscal Year 2016-17.

"The nearly \$4B budget, including \$2.4B in General Fund, is a good balance between investing in critical Health and Human Services and shoring up fiscal stability," said Chair of the Board Roberta MacGlashan. "We're also making a much needed General Fund investment of \$1.4 million towards a phased-in plan for improving roads in the unincorporated County."

The Health and Human Services areas slated for increased funding include Mental Health, Public Health, Child Protective Services, Alcohol and Drug Treatment, and Senior and Adult Services.

The fiscal stability funding includes meeting the Board's directive of placing 10 percent of the Available Fund Balance into a savings account for a rainy day, repaying transfers made at the height of the recession, and setting aside funds for major projects required in the coming years, including the mandated replacement of the Voter Registration IT system, and replacing the Assessor's Property Tax IT system.

"Funding for these investments comes from a variety of discretionary, federal and state funds," said County Executive Nav Gill. "In addition to putting aside prudent funds in reserves, we're making enhancements to key County services, including 72 positions in the Department of Health and Human Services, 40 of which are dedicated to Child Protective Services."

## Lancer Gridders Hang on to Beat Chavez Titans

**RANCHO CORDOVA, CA (MPG)** - At one point in the fourth quarter of last Friday's non-league road game, the Cordova High School football team held a sizable lead over host Chavez.

Then the Titans threw a scare into the Lancers.

Leading 34-6, Cordova survived the Titans' potential come-from-behind aspirations by posting a 34-32 victory on Chavez's field in Stockton.

"We had some secondary breakdowns," said Cordova head coach Darren Nill. "That momentum thing is either a great friend or a great enemy, and it was a great enemy to us."

Cordova survived three turnovers in the fourth quarter after building its big lead. Chavez had two successful onside kicks, plus an interception that led to touchdowns. The Lancers had the ball on only one offensive possession in the final 12 minutes of the game.

"They just kept coming down and scoring," Nill said. "We just had to hang on for dear life. Other than (the fourth quarter), defense was absolute dominate."

The Lancers scored four touchdowns in the third quarter that led to their 34-6 lead. The rushing game was paced

by running backs Deante McCullough and Calvin Augusta, both of whom scored two touchdowns each in the game. McCullough was the Lancers' leading ball carrier with 17 carries for 111 yards.

In the first half, Cordova was inside the Titans' red zone six times, but only coming out with one touchdown that led to a 6-6 halftime score. Nill feels if the Lancers had scored more than one touchdown, the final score would've been not as close.

"Drives were killed by a penalty, or a fumble or an interception," Nill said. "It could've been 63-0. Our guys have to learn to keep their foot to the throat of the opponent. It's something to learn from."

In the air, Cordova quarterback Xavier Johnson completed 17-of-35 passes for 199 yards and two touchdowns but three interceptions. Augusta was double threat for the Lancers; he hauled in seven receptions for 106 yards.

On defense, Lancer defensive tackle Kelechi Njoku had 11 tackles and two fumble recoveries. A bigger impressive number for the junior is six quarterback sacks for a loss of 55 yards, and batted down two passes.

"That kid was the difference in us winning the game," said Nill of Njoku. "He came up big every time on defense."

Cordova linebacker Jason Johnson had 14 tackles in the game. Middle linebacker Kenny Haney

followed with nine and defensive tackle Fidel Romero eight.

In the frosh/soph contest, Chavez posted a 34-15 win over Cordova (0-2).

Tonight, Friday, Cordova plays the first of back-to-back home games at Lancers Stadium, as Rio Linda (1-1) pays a visit. Game time is 7:30 p.m.

"We expect to see 85 percent runs," said Nill of the Knights, who run the Wing-T offense but with a player in motion on almost every play.

Next Friday, Cordova will host Vista del Lago of Folsom. ★

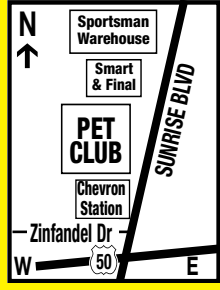
