**RANCHO CORDOVA, CA (MPG)** - The “Farm to Fork” artists reception at Rancho Cordova City Hall took place on Thursday, July 21, with artists and art lovers alike sampling hors d’oeuvres, cookies, and enjoying the wine bar. The quarterly art exhibit is a juried show and will continue through October 2.

Local artist Ron Hall juried this show. “I think the show turned out great,” Hall said. “I came away with the feeling that these are the pieces that will work best here.” His choices included around 60 works of art in various media.

A watercolor by Annette Heacox, “International Inspiration” was inspired by the 2015 iFest. Heacox, who is originally from Paris, was working en plein air, that is, out in the open on the spot at that Rancho Cordova event.

“This iFest blows me away every single year,” Heacox said. “Just to see all these

cultures, all those children running together, the parents, and it’s like – finally! If it could be real, if we could all be like this. So every year it’s like big goose bumps, it’s like magic to me.”

Elizabeth Francisco teaches an art class at the Cordova Church of the Nazarene, and

Hall selected two of her pieces. One, titled “Pen to Pan,” is a whimsical painting in oil of hen and chicks done in toll painting style, with a lot of stroke work. “It’s very disciplined, you have to practice a lot,” Francisco said. Her other work is in acrylic, called

Adreana Rubio, Coordinator at Boys & Girls Club of Greater Sacramento, led the summer camp program with the goal of creating a welcoming space for students to express themselves.

“I feel having a program where kids can truly express who they are is important,” said Adreana. “After-school programs give kids that liberty and help them discover their talents. I think that’s the magic of the Boys & Girls Club.”

## Best Of The Best Celebrated at the State Fair

**SACRAMENTO, CA (MPG)** - Nearly 675,000 people celebrated the best of California during the annual California State Fair, the largest single event in Northern California. The California Exposition and State Fair has a positive \$300 million economic impact on the Sacramento region annually, and receives no funding from the government.

As a premiere State-wide event, the State Fair looks at a number of statistics in evaluating its success. For example, competitive entries increased this year by 21 percent to 21,441 entries compared to 17,753 in 2015. Representing the work of talented Californians, the new photography competition generated 2,256 entries. As the number of Craft Beer breweries continue to increase in California, the State Fair competition saw an 11 percent increase in Craft Beers vying for the coveted Blue Ribbon, with 1,204 entries. Sponsored by the Tractor Supply Company, the Junior Livestock Sale of Champions experienced a 20 percent increase in funds raised by youth selling the top 56 award winning animals. The \$236,400 raised for youth this year was the second highest amount in the past 10 years.

The 2016 California State Fair was packed full of more than 3,000 exhibits and events that featured technology and agriculture and celebrated the best of the Golden State. Advance admission sales were up by 7.2 percent. The Best of California Brewfest drew 2,015 guests, up 31 percent from the previous year’s 1,535 guests.

“For more than 160 years the California State Fair has remained the one constant setting for showcasing the best of California. From award winning wines, craft beers, fine arts, photography, horse racing, livestock, concerts and entertainment, to technology, science, farming and food, the 2016 State Fair was a huge success,” said Rick Pickering, CEO of the California Exposition & State Fair. Pickering added, “in the face of a heat wave and tragic events around the nation, hundreds of thousands of guests came out to celebrate the sense of community, good will and unity that the State Fair provides.”

Paid Attendance decreased by 11 percent to 511,224 from a record year of 577,646 in 2015. Total Attendance decreased by 14 percent to 673,237 from a record year of 787,833 total visitors in 2015. Yet through a period of national tragedy and a local heatwave, business and community pride at the State Fair remained strong during the 17-day run. According to exit survey data, 92 percent of visitors were satisfied with their State Fair experience, and more than 95 percent felt their State Fair was a good value, up from 74 percent in 2015. ★



# A True Water Emergency Threatens the Delta: Your Voice Matters

California decision makers are at a historic crossroads in the long-standing California water crisis. The outcome will permanently alter the Sacramento–San Joaquin Delta. Your voice can steer these decisions in the right direction and now is the time to speak up.

On July 26, 2016, the State Water Resources Control Board will begin a series of hearings that will help determine whether the Governor’s proposed twin tunnels project will continue to move forward. During these

proceedings, agencies and water contractors will suggest that the Governor’s proposed \$16 billion rate-payer funded twin tunnels project is a necessary improvement to a water system on the brink of collapse. They will also claim the project is necessary to improve the Delta ecosystem. These claims are simply not true. In fact, re-plumbing the Delta may actually accelerate the decline of its environment.

The 44-foot diameter, approximately 35-mile long twin tunnels will syphon millions of gallons of water per minute out of the Delta and send it south. If constructed, this project will harm local economies amounting to a loss of tens of millions of dollars annually. It will negatively affect family farms, agricultural operations, and Delta river communities disrupting a generations-old way of life. The project will also negatively impact recreation and water quality, degrade delicate environmental ecosystems, and harm fish and other endangered species.

The Delta Counties Coalition consists of local elected leaders from five counties whose communities will be permanently harmed if the twin tunnels are

built. The project was developed without adequate local input and would irreversibly damage the Delta by depleting its watershed, would benefit one region of the state at the expense of another, and will not produce a single drop of new water.

More cost-effective solutions exist that the Delta Counties Coalition supports, such as creating more surface and underground storage, improving Delta levees to help move water more efficiently through the Delta, and greater regional solutions such as stormwater capture, wastewater reuse, and local desalination. We urge decision makers to implement these solutions, which are good for all of California.

# State Water Resources Control Board Hearings on WaterFix Begin

**SACRAMENTO, CA (MPG)** - The State Water Resources Control Board began public hearings on the Department of Water Resources’ (DWR) request to add three new points of diversion for California WaterFix. The opening three days of the hearings began with policy statements from the Natural Resources Agency and U.S. Department of the Interior followed by public comment.

The questions before the Board, defined by the members themselves for Part I of the hearings, are narrow: Does the new point of diversion alter water flows or affect water quality such that there would be injury to any legal user of the water, and does the project in effect initiate a new water right? Part II of the hearing, expected to begin in early 2017, will address fish and wildlife, recreation, and other public trust issues.

DWR has presented evidence

showing that the proposed change will neither initiate a new water right nor injure any other legal user of water. DWR’s testimony regarding its petition for change to its water right permit and the petition for the new points of diversion include these key points

- WaterFix would create more flexibility to better balance water quality and water supply (and fish protection which will be discussed in Part II).
- DWR and the U.S. Bureau of Reclamation do not seek a new or expanded water right or any modifications to the water quality standards upstream or downstream of the proposed diversion points.
- DWR has a proven track record of meeting the Water Board’s Delta water quality standards and WaterFix would operate within the standards established by the Water Board. Meeting existing or future water

quality standards would be easier with the flexibility provided by California WaterFix.

- WaterFix will be operated in real-time. While modeling can perform an assessment of potential water operation effects, water project operators handle complex situations on a daily basis to stay in compliance with water quality standards.

Part I of the hearings is expected to take several months. For regular updates on the hearings, follow the new California WaterFix blog.

# Level 3 HazMat in Rancho Cordova



**SACRAMENTO COUNTY, CA (MPG)** - Just before 10:00 on July 26th, Metro Fire HazMat, firefighters, and other public safety agencies, responded to AMPAC Fine Chemicals on the Aerojet Rocketdyne campus in Rancho Cordova for a report of a chemical leak from a cylinder. The cylinder, located in a remote location on the Aerojet Rocketdyne grounds, was determined to have a small leak of

Anhydrous Hydrogen Bromide. As a precaution, all personnel not assigned to the incident were evacuated from the campus.

HazMat Team members train regularly for incidents such as this. Working closely with AMPAC, Aerojet Rocketdyne, Law Enforcement, and other public safety agencies on scene, the HazMat Team was briefed on the situation, developed a plan, donned specialized gear, and entered the hot zone to try to fix the leak in the cylinder. When they were not able to cap the leak, the cylinder was moved by truck to an isolated building with a scrubber (specialized chemical filter) in order to contain the leak. At that point, all evacuations on

Aerojet Rocketdyne campus were lifted. The fork lift and truck used to move the cylinder will both be decontaminated; the cylinder will be placed in a secure container to be transported off site and destroyed.

Numerous agencies, both public and private, worked seamlessly to ensure the situation was resolved in the most efficient manner, with the safety of the public always the top priority.

Sacramento Metropolitan Fire District (Metro Fire) serves an area encompassing 417 square miles that include Sacramento and Placer counties. Metro Fire is the seventh largest fire agency in the State of California. ★

Andrew McBride, a homeowner in the Cordova Meadows neighborhood, desperately needed help cleaning out his front and back yards. The 83-year old veteran, who is legally blind, had years of trash piled up in his backyard, and the interns filled up a dumpster with the debris.

"It was very rewarding to help Mr. McBride for the few



# Unsecured Property Taxes Due

**SACRAMENTO, CA (MPG)** - Annual bills for Sacramento County unsecured property taxes for fiscal year 2016-2017 will be mailed on July 22, 2016 and are payable without delinquent penalties through August, 31, 2016.

Unsecured property tax bills are mailed to all owners of unsecured property in July of each year. If you owned unsecured property in Sacramento County, such as a boat or aircraft, or if you leased or owned fixtures and equipment related to a business on January 1, 2016, and do not receive a tax bill by August 15, 2016, please contact the Sacramento County Tax Collector’s Unsecured Property Tax Unit at (916) 874-7833, between the hours of 9:00 a.m. and 4:00 p.m., Monday through Friday excluding holidays.

**NONRECEIPT OF A TAX BILL DOES NOT EXCUSE DELINQUENCY OR ALLOW THE TAX COLLECTOR TO CANCEL PENALTIES OR COLLECTION COSTS.**

Tax bills become delinquent if not paid in the Tax Collector’s Office by 5:00 p.m. on August 31, 2016, or received by mail bearing a postmark of August 31, 2016.

If the tax bill is not paid by the delinquency date, a 10% penalty and collection cost will be added. DMV registration may be withheld on boats if unsecured property taxes are reported delinquent. If a tax bill remains unpaid after October 31, 2016, additional collection costs and monthly penalties at the rate of 1.5% will be added to the base tax.

Payments may be made by mail or in person at the County Tax Collector’s Office located at 700 “H” Street, Room 1710, Sacramento, CA 95814,

# Brown Signs Bill Providing Help for Those Claiming Refunds on Tax

**SACRAMENTO, CA (MPG)** -A bill sponsored by the Board of Equalization (BOE) to streamline and simplify refunds on the governor and will become law January 1, 2017. AB 1856, authored by Assemblyman Matt Dababneh helps taxpayers making installment payments by only requiring they file one claim for refund, rather than one for each installment payment they have made on a single liability.

“Running a business is challenging enough without having


to keep track of multiple layers of paperwork,” said BOE and Legislative Committee Chairwoman Fiona Ma. “It is my goal and that of all our members to simplify and streamline our taxpayers’ dealings with government agencies so they can spend more time on achieving success in their business ventures.”

In several cases, BOE taxpayers have been barred by the statute of limitations from recovering all of the installment payments they made to the BOE, even though their tax debt

was cancelled or reduced to an amount less than the total payments received—because they made payments after the original claim had been filed, but did not file additional claims to cover the later payments. The new law will allow taxpayers making installment payments to file a single claim for refund before the entire liability is paid in full.

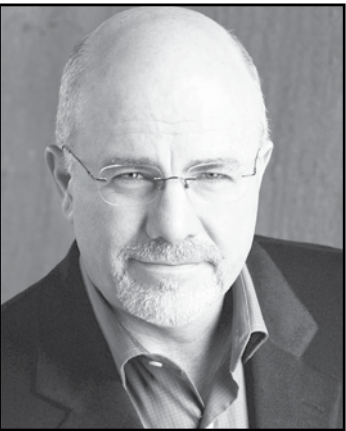

Our daughter is a special needs child, who doctors say will live about half as long as the average adult. There's also a good chance she will be under our care her entire life. We just finished Baby Step 3 of your plan, so we have all of our debt paid off except for the house, and we have an emergency fund of three to six months of expenses saved. We have health insurance, too. However, we were wondering how the situation with our little girl affects retirement planning and college funding?

Dear Jonathan,  
I know this may sound strange, but the situation with your daughter really doesn't affect things all that much. The only real difference is that it sounds like you'll be responsible for your sweet daughter for the foreseeable future — not just until she's 18 or 21.  
If you don't already have it, you and your wife should both buy 10 to 12 times your annual incomes in term life insurance. Make sure the money from the policies is set up to go into a special needs trust that would be managed for her

care. That way, your baby will be taken care of in the event something unexpected happens to you.  
Otherwise, just keep following my plan. Baby Step 4 means you start putting 15 percent of your income into pre-tax retirement plans, like Roth IRAs and mutual funds. Baby Step 5 is college funding, if that's a consideration for her, followed by paying off your home early. Then, of course, the last Baby Step is building wealth and giving.  
Financially speaking, you're looking at filling a need in the event of your deaths. This should be covered by life insurance or investments. If you reach a point where your investments are substantial, and money from those things can adequately cover her needs and the needs of your family, then you can always drop the insurance policies.

## Time to raise prices?

Dear Dave,  
My husband has his own one-man painting business, and I help him with the books. We were wondering how you know when it's time to implement a price increase. Also, what should the increase be?

Dear Lauren,  
I grew up in the real estate business, so I'll use the apartment-complex model as my example. If your building is completely full, then it's time to raise prices a little

bit until you have a vacancy. In this type of scenario, you want a healthy level of vacancy, meaning you're always going to be losing some customers as you go up in prices.  
In your husband's case, if he's booked through the end of the month, he's way underpriced. Just keep on turning in your bids, and don't make a big deal about things. It isn't like a tenant, in your case, where you're going back time and time again except in rare cases. You might start with a 10 percent increase, and see what happens for a while. If that goes well, wait a bit and raise them another 10 percent.  
There are only so many hours in a day this guy can work, so the only other option is to take on staff. But before I start staffing, I'm going to raise prices and cut the number of customers that way. In most cases with the construction business, if you show up when you say you will, complete the job when you say you will, and you do high quality work, there's almost no ceiling on what you can make!

# CDPH Announces Intent to Award \$13 Million in Grants to California Reducing Disparities Pilot Projects

**SACRAMENTO, CA (MPG)** - California Department of Public Health (CDPH) Director and State Public Health Officer Dr. Karen Smith announced today the intent to award nearly \$13 million in grants to help reduce mental health disparities in communities that have traditionally been underserved.

The funding will be distributed to 11 pilot projects statewide that provide mental health services to five target populations, including African American, Asian and Pacific Islander, Latino, Lesbian, Gay, Bisexual, Transgender, Queer and Questioning (LGBTQ), and Native American communities. The grant monies, which will be distributed over the course of five and a half years, are part of CDPH's California Reducing Disparities Project (CRDP). This will be the third release of CRDP grant funds. In all, CDPH will award \$60 million to 41 contractors and grantees between 2016 and 2022.

"The California Reducing Disparities Project recognizes that many of the promising mental health services in our most diverse communities need additional support in order to improve their effectiveness," said Dr. Smith. "CDPH is committed to funding organizations that are doing meaningful work in their communities to reduce mental health disparities but are not often considered for large grants."

Disparities in mental health

services are found among all races, ethnicities, sexual orientations, and gender identities and expressions. Even though they make up the majority of the state's population, communities of color are less likely to receive quality mental health care services than their Caucasian peers. Members of the LGBTQ community frequently report that mental health providers do not know how to address sexual orientation and gender identity concerns, or overemphasize these issues in treatment, even if it is not the reason the person sought care.

The primary goal of the CRDP grants is to invest in new and existing community programs that have shown promise in reducing mental health disparities in these underserved communities. The grants are awarded to small organizations that have annual budgets of less than \$500,000 and need organizational support in order to meet the Project's implementation and evaluation requirements. Each organization receives six months of technical support to develop a scope of work, detailed five-year budget, and an evaluation plan.

The CRDP is funded by the Mental Health Services Act (Proposition 63) that was passed in November 2004. This act imposes a one percent income tax on personal income that exceeds \$1 million.

# Bera Announces Nearly \$800k Grant for Runway Upgrades to Mather Airport

**SACRAMENTO, CA (MPG)** - Congressman Ami Bera (CA-7) announced last week a major grant from the Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) for upgrades to Mather Airport's runways. The grant of \$788,500 will be used to rehabilitate and upgrade the taxiway to FAA standards and to install runway lights along the taxiway. Congressman Bera was joined by Airport Director John Wheat and Airport Chief Administrative Officer for Planning and Development TJ Chen, and will discussed other ongoing projects to improve the safety and efficiency of the airport.

"This investment in Sacramento Mather Airport is great news for our community," said Congressman Bera. "Improving the conditions of the runway and safety with lights is critical to attracting, maintaining, and expanding private investment and economic development in the area. Making our airport more convenient and efficient to passengers and businesses has a positive impact on our community and our economy."

"Sacramento County is grateful of the efforts made by the Congressman to secure Federal funding from the FAA to

improve the airfield at Mather Airport, which is a vital component of the aviation and cargo infrastructure for the Sacramento region," said Airport Director John Wheat.

This grant will fund the rehabilitation of approximately 670 feet of the existing connector Taxiway B-North that is needed to maintain structural integrity of the pavement. It will also fund the installation of a new Taxiway B-North edge lighting system to enhance safe airfield operations during low visibility conditions.

# SB 1146 Turning Christian Colleges Upside Down

Democrats in control of the California Assembly Judiciary Committee have passed SB 1146 to redefine Christianity at Christian-format colleges by forcing support of the unnatural, unhealthy, unbiblical, and tyrannical homosexual-bisexual-transsexual agenda.

Thursday afternoon, SB 1146 was approved on a party-line vote, with Democrats in favor and Republicans opposed, with the exception of Republican Brian Maienschein of San Diego not voting.

"The First Amendment sets out religious and secular spheres, and we need to keep them separate," said committee member James Gallagher, a Yuba City Republican.

"We don't want government involved in religion and we don't want religion controlling government, right? But with this bill, no matter what you do, you're going to infringe on a religious sphere and have the government deciding what is religious and what is not."

Another Republican committee member, Donald Wagner of Irvine, said SB 1146 "betrays a fundamental misunderstanding of what faith

is." Wagner said, "Faith is a way of life. Faith comes first," adding that SB 1146 "derives from a thoroughly flawed perspective" by prohibiting and punishing Christian colleges' religious principles and practices.

SB 1146 allows students to file lawsuits against their religious-based colleges, challenging the colleges' right to have Biblical standards on sexuality, gender, and marriage in admissions, housing, employment, student counseling, and outside groups allowed on campus.

For example, the bill forces Christian colleges to allow homosexual and transsexual activists on campus to challenge students' moral beliefs. SB 1146 would permit homosexual-couple housing and transsexual-policy restrooms on campus, and likely prohibit counseling a student to overcome homosexuality. And SB 1146 would prohibit Christian colleges from firing a professor who becomes a homosexual or transsexual activist, indoctrinating students to support sin.

"SB 1146 is passing because too many colleges and other well-meaning opponents of the bill have made the mistake of lobbying the author, who's made his

tyrannical bill a little less onerous with each amendment, enabling it to advance by sleight of hand," said Randy Thomasson, president of SaveCalifornia.com, a statewide pro-child, pro-family organization that promotes moral virtues for the common good. "If Christian colleges want SB 1146 defeated, they need to unapologetically mobilize every single supporter to call and demand SB 1146 be defeated. In this election season, they must launch bold religious-freedom campaigns with students in key Assembly districts this summer."

SB 1146 will next be heard in the Assembly Appropriations Committee in August when the Legislature returns from its month-long recess.

# Sacramento County DA Reports



*Defendant Sentenced for Felony Grand Theft; Career Criminal Convicted for Carjacking, Evading Police; Defendant Sentenced to Life for Sexual Assault, Kidnapping Charges*

Nairi Kirakosyan was sentenced to 150 days in county jail and placed on 5 years formal probation. On June 3, 2016, Kirakosyan pled no contest to felony grand theft.

On April 9, 2014, Kirakosyan staged a car accident by purposely driving his vehicle off the road and into a palm tree. His accomplice, Artak Aghajanyan, acted as a lookout and then got into the front passenger seat after the accident. At the time of the accident, Kirakosyan had auto insurance with Bristol West Insurance Company.

Both Kirakosyan and Aghajanyan told the Rancho Cordova Police Department the accident was caused by another vehicle side swiping their car. Both of them sought emergency medical treatment for injuries they said they received from the accident. They were also treated by a chiropractor for their alleged soft tissue injuries. Unbeknownst to them, a witness had seen the staged accident and had seen Aghajanyan get into the car after the crash.

Kirakosyan and Aghajanyan hired an attorney who then filed a lawsuit on their behalf against Bristol West for their alleged medical injuries. They demanded \$50,000 from the insurance company for Kirakosyan's and Aghajanyan's alleged injuries. The insurance company paid Kirakosyan more than \$7,000 for the damages to his car, but refused to pay for Kirakosyan's and Aghajanyan's alleged injuries.

Aghajanyan fled the country and remains at large. This case was investigated by the Sacramento County Auto Theft Task Force and detectives from the California Department of Insurance Urban Auto Fraud Unit. This case was prosecuted by the Sacramento County District Attorney's Urban Auto Fraud Unit.

Love Davis Jr. was convicted by a jury of carjacking and evading an officer with willful disregard.

On March 24, 2015, Davis pushed a 58 year-old woman out of his way and jumped into her car, which was parked at a gas station on Auburn Blvd. and Watt Ave. The victim struggled with Davis, but he was able drive away, dragging the

victim several feet on the pavement. Soon after, Davis was spotted by the California Highway Patrol. A pursuit began that lasted nearly an hour and covered four counties, including Sacramento, Placer, Yolo, and Sonoma. Davis drove nearly 110 mph, drove the wrong way, ignored stop signs and stop lights, passed on the shoulder and center divider, wove in and out of traffic, and finally crashed into the concrete median near the intersection of 65th and Highway 50. He was arrested and positively identified by the victim.

Davis' criminal history includes two prior strike convictions for robbery and first-degree burglary. He also has multiple past convictions for possession of stolen cars, evading police, theft, resisting arrest, possession of stolen property, possession of tear gas, and possession of meth in prison.

Davis faces a maximum potential sentence of 55 years to life in prison. Sentencing is set for September 2, 2016, at 9:00 a.m. in Department 21 before the Honorable Steve White.

**CASE:** Joseph Lee Bonderer  
**PROSECUTOR:** Deputy District Attorney Quirina Orozco, Adult Sexual Assault Prosecution Unit

The Honorable Kevin McCormick sentenced Joseph Lee Bonderer to 100 years to life in prison. On June 9, 2016, a jury convicted Bonderer of two kidnapping charges and multiple sexual assault charges, including rape and sodomy. The jury also found true that Bonderer kidnapped and transported the victim to commit the sexual assaults – a one strike allegation.

On October 30, 2013, the victim was in her car and about to leave the Walmart parking lot on Greenback Lane when Bonderer forced entry into her car. He pointed something in the victim's direction under his shirt and told her to do everything he demanded or he would kill her. After forcing the victim to drive to a dark desolate field area in Placer County, he raped, sodomized, and digitally penetrated her. Bonderer then ordered the victim to drop him off at the Walmart where he first kidnapped her.

Sacramento Sheriff's deputies and detectives canvassed the vicinity. Employees at a bar across the street from Walmart disclosed that Bonderer had been inside the bar just moments before the incident. Walmart surveillance video showed Bonderer loitering in the parking for at least 30 minutes before the assault. He followed at least two other women before finally choosing to attack the victim. ★

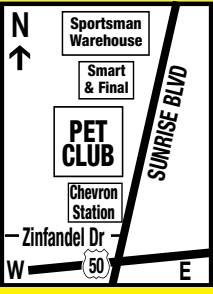
