Students in FCUSD Schools Show Growth in Test Scores

RANCHO CORDOVA, CA (MPG) - Students in Folsom Cordova schools continued to make progress and, districtwide, perform above state averages in English-language arts and math, according to new state test results released on Aug. 24.

That included modest gains among the District's most vulnerable student populations, including English learners and socioeconomically disadvantaged students, though achievement gaps continue to persist. "Our teachers and staff are committed to ensuring all students have a personalized pathway to success, and our students continue to make progress in developing the skills they'll need to achieve in the years ahead," said Superintendent Deborah Bettencourt.

More than 10,500 students in grades 3-8 and 11 took the state's Smarter Balanced assessments last spring, part of California's comprehensive testing program. The scores are one tool designed to help teachers better understand how our students are performing under new state standards, measure student growth, and implement effective learning strategies tailored to individual children.

In English-language arts, 59 percent of students districtwide met or exceeded state standards, up four percentage points from last year, the first year of the state's new testing program. Similar growth was seen in math performance, where 50 percent of Folsom Cordova students met or exceeded state standards, up four percentage points from 2015.

Statewide, 49 percent of students met or exceeded English language arts standards, while 37 percent of students met or exceeded standards in math.

Under the new state standards, Folsom Cordova has begun to see an incremental narrowing of achievement gaps, though much work remains.

Low-income students - comprising about one-third of all of this year's test takers - improved in both English language arts (ELA) and math: 33 percent met or exceeded state ELA standards, up 5 percentage points from last year, while 23 percent scored at or above state math standards, a 4 percent increase.

About 9 percent of all of this year's test takers were English learners, and those students also saw growth in performance: 10 percent of English learners met or exceeded

ELA standards, up 3 percent from last year, while 13 percent of English learners met or exceeded math standards, an increase of 5 percent over the previous year.

"We recognize that we must all work harder to close achievement gaps," Bettencourt said. "In the last year, Folsom Cordova has invested more resources into new curriculum, intervention teachers, student data analysis, and staff training so that our dedicated teachers have the tools they need to support all learners."

In the coming days, Folsom Cordova families will begin receiving their child's individual score reports. These test results are just one tool teachers and families can use to better understand how well students are performing in school. The District encourages families to reach out to their teachers to better understand their child's performance, and how they can work together to support learning.

County Renewable Diesel Pilot Program Announced

SACRAMENTO COUNTY, CA (MPG) - Sacramento County announces its pilot program to migrate County fleet vehicles to the use of Neste Renewable Diesel, the first local government fleet in the region. In moving to renewable diesel, the County of Sacramento joins California's cleanest and greenest fleets that include the City of San Francisco, City of Oakland, City of Walnut Creek, City of Carlsbad, Google, and UPS.

By switching to renewable diesel, made from waste and residue fat fractions coming from food, fish and slaughterhouse industries, as well as from non-food grade vegetable oil fractions, the County of Sacramento aims to reduce greenhouse gas emissions from its fleet by up to 80 percent, or approximately 8,000 tons annually. In addition, the use of renewable diesel will reduce tailpipe emissions and will contribute to improve the local air quality in Sacramento. The renewable diesel will be used in a range of heavy-duty vehicles including more than 400

California American Water Identifies Off-Line Well With PFAA

Well With PFAA Has Been Out Of Service Since 2015

SACRAMENTO, CA (MPG) - California American Water announced it will be working with State regulators to seek immediate permitting of new treatment technology for a well in its Suburban Rosemont District containing elevated levels of perfluorinated alkyl acids (PFAAs). The well in question, which has been shut down for maintenance since October 2015, is the only well operated by California American Water with detected PFAA levels.

On May 19, 2016, the United States Environmental Protection Agency (USEPA) issued a new health advisory

level for PFAAs which set the new health level of 70 parts per trillion. The most current laboratory results from the affected well indicate PFAAs at 2.5 times that level.

There are several commonly used water treatment technologies that are effective in treating for PFAAs. California American Water is working with a team of in-house experts and consultants to determine the best treatment technology and have it installed at the wellhead as soon as permitting allows.

"The health and safety of our customers we serve is our top priority because they

are our friends, neighbors and families. We didn't cause this contamination but we are going to fix it," said California American Director of Operations for Northern California, Audie Foster. "Our commitment is to rapidly work with our regulators to gain the proper permits for the necessary treatment. Lower wintertime usage and drought reductions have allowed this well to be kept in standby to this point; we are racing to have treatment in place before it is needed."

The well in question is one of 29 wells that serve customers in the Suburban Rosemont system, which also receives

treated water from the City of Sacramento. Only one well near the former Mather Air Force Base has been impacted, out of more than 60 wells that were tested in several California American Water systems around Sacramento. PFAAs are a class of chemicals widely used for many decades in aircraft firefighting foams, non-stick cookware and water-resistant clothing. Chronic exposure to the chemical can increase health risks, and pregnant women and nursing babies are thought to be the most susceptible. Customers who are concerned may consult their physician.

Bera Urges FDA to Take Action in Response to EpiPen Prices

EpiPens Cost Upwards of \$600 for a Single Prescription

SACRAMENTO, CA (MPG) - On August 25th, 2016, Congressman Ami Bera, M.D. (CA-7) called on the Food and Drug Administration (FDA) to take immediate action to make lower cost alternatives available in response to exorbitantly priced EpiPens from the drug manufacturer Mylan. Currently, EpiPens have a virtual monopoly on the market for emergency allergy attack treatment. In the letter, Congressman Bera asks the FDA to address processes that may limit competition and allow some companies to drastically increase prices. Today, Mylan announced they would offer additional coupons for EpiPens, but have not addressed the underlying cost.



Congressman Bera has previously urged the FDA to regulate the prices of life-saving drugs.

“As a doctor, I know that in the case of an allergic reaction no time can be wasted and we can’t allow anything to stand in

the way of immediate access to epinephrine.” said Bera. “\$600 for an EpiPen is outrageous, and Mylan must be held accountable for their pricing on a life-saving drug. That’s why I’m calling on the FDA to make sure that families have other more affordable and safe options to EpiPens so that no one needs to make a choice between paying their bills or having a life-saving drug.”
Congressman Bera has previously urged the FDA to regulate the prices of life-saving drugs. He leads the push to ensure that drug companies are not able to charge excessive prices for drugs, like in the case of Martin Shkreli and Turing Pharmaceuticals.

municipal public works and specialty vehicles such as garbage trucks.

The contract comes through a corporate agreement with Sacramento Area Council of Governments (SACOG). Through the regional fuel corporate, SACOG enables regional agencies to have competitive access to fuel source. At the request of Sacramento County, SACOG created an addendum to their contract specifically for renewable diesel at a good price point.

“Sacramento County continues to be a leader in our efforts to reduce greenhouse gas and tailpipe emissions,” said District 1

County Supervisor and SACOG Vice Chair Phil Serna. “Working with SACOG, we will take the next step in that regard and fuel our fleets responsibly, and with minimal burden on taxpayers.”

“The County fleet has a substantial impact on our region through programs, services and employment,” said District 3 Supervisor and SACOG board member Susan Peters. “With the switch to renewable diesel our impact will remain strong in the region, but lessen on the environment.”

“We are proud that the regional fuel cooperative with SACOG allows Sacramento County to reduce greenhouse


emissions so dramatically with the use of renewable diesel,” said District 2 Supervisor and SACOG board member Patrick Kennedy. “Our goal is to continue to make an impact on our region’s environmental health through partnerships with our community.”

“Sacramento County has one of the most sustainable public fleets in the country. The move to renewable diesel provides us large and immediate gains in carbon emissions reduction in a fiscally responsible way,” said Keith Leech, Chief, Fleet Division & Parking, Sacramento County.

And Another Thing ...

This is The Largest Land Development Project in Our City's History

The Rancho Cordova City Council voted unanimously to approve the “Rio Del Oro” Specific Plan, Tier 2 Project. Some of our residents may remember that on occasion, they would see the City Council working on that project, and then it would not be heard of again for a while. The original Rio Del Oro project was submitted to Sacramento County in 2003 before Rancho Cordova was officially incorporated later that year (July 1). The city took over the responsibility of the project. With the housing market taking off like a rocket in our first few years, I

thought that Rio Del Oro would be among the other developments. This is the largest land development project in our city’s history. (It is large enough to be able to place downtown Sacramento in the center of the planned area). With the technical and environmental studies that were required to be done and agreed upon, it was slow going. And then, in my opinion, the “Great Recession” that hit us and the rest of the world for about five years really slowed down the progress in our largest planned area with its new homes, parks, schools and retail stores. Whatever the reason, I am glad that on Monday, in our special City Council Meeting, we were able to move forward again. If everything goes as planned (and hoped), the first homes could possibly be started by the end of next year. Many things that are worthwhile seem to go very slowly, but

the end result will make all of us in the “City of Rancho Cordova” very glad that we were patient enough to complete the job. On Wednesday of this week, the Mather Veterans Village Grand Opening Dedication took place. The first 50 apartments are completed and are occupied with Veterans. All the members of our City Council and many of our City staff were in attendance, in addition to Congressman Ami Bera and a list of wonderful people who helped us celebrate. I don’t have a complete list of all the people who were in attendance, so rather than missing someone now, I will try to get that list and include them next week. The next 50 apartments will be built next year, and I am looking forward to bringing in more Veterans.

Federally mandated testing revealed six water systems in the State with levels of PFAA above the new health advisory level, none of the other systems are owned or operated by California American Water. Unregulated Contaminant Monitoring Rule 3 (UCMR3) is a study performed by USEPA to determine the prevalence of compounds in drinking water sources for substances that do not have health-based standards set under the Safe Drinking Water Act. USEPA uses UCMR3 data combined with information on

potential health effects to select substances for future regulation in drinking water. The testing for PFAAs was done as part of UCMR3 testing. “In this case, the regulations in the Safe Drinking Water Act are working to protect public health. The USEPA is changing standards as new science and technology is becoming available and utilities like California American Water are going to get treatment on our well as quickly as possible,” said Foster. “We have a national team of water quality scientists and experienced treatment operators supporting our efforts to address

Arrests Made for Gold River Vandalism

SACRAMENTO COUNTY, CA (MPG) - Shortly after 11:05 p.m. on August 15, 2016, the Sheriff’s Communication Center received a 911 call regarding vandalism at the 11000 block of Tunnel Hill Way.

Deputies and detectives responded to the scene, where they located multiple residences and vehicles that had been vandalized. In addition to the initial report of the neighborhood

vandalism, it was found that the Gold River Discovery Center, the local elementary school, had also been targeted. The vandalism included broken windows, damaged vehicles, racist graffiti and swastikas painted on walls, garages and doors. As a result of the investigation, arrest warrants were issued for six subjects. All of them have been charged for felony vandalism (594 pc) and

conspiracy to commit a crime (182 pc). Defendant Convicted for 1st-Degree
Murder of Rio Linda Man

Sex Offender Sentenced for Multiple
Child Sexual Assault Charges

Two Convicted of 1st-Degree Murder
in Birthday Party Shooting

DATE: August 23, 2016
CASE: Jacob Wilcoxon
PROSECUTOR: Deputy District Attorney Valerie Brown, Homicide Unit

Jacob Wilcoxon was convicted by a jury of the first-degree murder of Bill Stidman. The jury also found true the allegation that Wilcoxon personally used a firearm causing Stidman's death.

Bill and Jean Stidman lived in their Rio Linda home with their two female teenage foster children. On June 15, 2014, Wilcoxon and a 17-year-old associate went to the Stidman's home with a plan to sneak into the house after the Stidmans went to bed and have sex with the two female teenagers. Mr. Stidman found Wilcoxon in the 14-year-old foster daughter's bed and confronted Wilcoxon. When Wilcoxon attempted to leave, Mr. Stidman, who was a licensed security guard and former police officer, said he was going to arrest him. Wilcoxon then pulled a concealed .38 caliber revolver and shot Mr. Stidman four times, killing him. Mr. Stidman lived long enough to give the first responding deputy basic information, and ask paramedics to tell his wife he loved her.

Wilcoxon faces a maximum potential sentence of 50 year to life in prison. Sentencing is set for October 6, 2016, at 10:00 a.m. in Department 18 before the Honorable Cheryl Chun Meegan.

DATE: August 25, 2016
CASE: Avery Hill, Kelly Thomas & Orlando Rhinehart
PROSECUTOR: Deputy District Attorney Eric Kindall, Homicide Unit

Avery Hill and Kelly Thomas were convicted by two separate juries of first-degree murder with personal use of a firearm and three counts of first-degree attempted murder with the personal use of a firearm. Thomas was also convicted of being a felon in possession of a firearm. Rhinehart was acquitted of all counts.

On May 10, 2014, Orlando Rhinehart was at Peregrine Park in Natomas when he noticed members of the New Money gang were at the park attending a birthday party. Rhinehart called Avery Hill, who New Money gang members suspected of murdering one of their members. Hill then called Kelly Thomas, who believed he had been shot at by New Money members before. Hill and Thomas went to the park and met briefly with Rhinehart, who proceeded to leave. Hill and Thomas then opened fire on the partygoers, killing Jacoby James and wounding six others, including a then 7-year-old girl.

A court trial will be held at sentencing on prior strike allegations for Hill for a 2008 attempted robbery and for Thomas for a 2010 burglary conviction.

If the prior strikes are found true, Hill and Thomas face potential sentences of a minimum of 100 years to life in prison. Thomas will be sentenced on September 16, 2016, at 1:30 p.m. Hill will be sentenced on November 14, 2016, at 3:00 p.m. Both sentencings will be in Department 12 before the Honorable Maryanne Gilliard.



There are only two ways to shut the fuss up! Either get rid of it or put it away. If you get rid of it, throw it away or give it away. Why not sell those unwanted items? Simple – because you don’t want to give yourself another task to do! If you give yourself that

option, you set yourself up for a garage sale project with a mountain of pricing or a bunch of time spent on craigslist.org, both of which requires a lot of follow-through and dedication to the task.

There are different categories of clutter, but they all nag, taunt, shame, badger, heckle, scoff, jeer, and pester. You’ve tried to organize some of it, but most of it just gets moved around. Trying to organize clutter is like trying to get a bunch of tone-deaf people together to start a choir. You can’t clean when you have clutter because you can’t find your surfaces. So your house gets dirty.

Clutter is also insidious. If it’s left in one place for more than

21 days, it becomes invisible and it lowers its volume, becoming white noise in the background to which you become accustomed. Have you ever noticed the relief you feel when that white noise gets turned off? Your ears are suddenly enveloped by a silence you didn’t even know you were missing! You’ll get that same relief when you deal with your clutter. You’ll be amazed at the peace you’ll feel that you didn’t even know was possible!

Take a few minutes and look around you. Let what you see speak to you. Where is the most noise coming from? What’s clacking the loudest? What’s drumming in the background, more quietly,

yet persistently? By using your imagination to add make-believe sound to your clutter, you are actually sharpening your awareness of what you want to kick out or make a place for.

You’ll also begin shopping with a new awareness. Everything you bring into your home has a voice. Have fun with this new awareness. Talk back to your stuff and warn it of its pending eviction, and ask everything that comes into your life if you need it and love it. If you don’t buy it, it can’t talk to you.

Paying attention to the voices is fun and enlightening. There are also those tired voices of stale, outdated ideas from a stack of old magazines, chanting, “Read us read us! See what you missed in 2006!” We keep old magazines because we paid for them, haven’t read them, don’t want to miss anything, and we think we’ll actually take the time (at some point) to peruse their pages. Chances are really good you have last month’s magazines sitting there unread too, and they’re at least still current possibilities. So dump anything that’s outdated. If you’re still feeling guilty, know this: thanks to the

Internet, all the old information is archived online. Google it.

Another voice of clutter comes from the homeless. That’s all the stuff you love and use, but don’t have specific places to put it. It’s probably stuff you’ve had to look for in the past. You’ll catch yourself saying, “Oh, there you are! I was looking for you yesterday.” Just think how much time you spend each year looking for stuff! (It’s probably at least a couple of days.) It seems easier at the time to just put those items down somewhere, or out of sight in a drawer, because there’s not a dedicated place to put it.

To quiet the noise from your homeless stuff, you have to establish homes for each individual voice. Cramming a voice in the wrong closet, drawer, or cupboard, the basement, the attic, or under a bed, is like hushing a gossip and putting him or her out of sight. Clutter shoved out of sight may go out of mind, but the minute you open a drawer or closet that holds an assortment of muzzled clutter, you’ll be like Britney Spears opening her front door to a mob of ravenous paparazzi. It isn’t pretty.

If we minded the rule “A place

for everything and everything in its place,” we’d never have to search for our glasses, car keys, purse, coat, cell phone, shoes, scissors, or tweezers again.

Included in the homeless clutter is what I call IPODs—Important Piles Of Decisions. These IPODS are in strategic places throughout your home where you chronically dump your indecision. They are piles of miscellaneous items that you didn’t want to put away either because there was no “away” or because you were tired or just didn’t want to deal with them at the time. Piles are very personal and we don’t like to talk about them, but they need to be cured if we are to enjoy a peaceful home not one that’s out of order.

You’re not out of order when your house is in order. Start listening.

Adjustments, Big Offensive Yards Give Cordova Football Victory

RANCHO CORDOVA, CA (MPG) - Leading 27-20 at halftime of its home and season opener on Aug. 26th, the Cordova High School football team needed to find a way to slow down the visiting Rio Americano squad.

The Lancers made adjustments on defense that paid off, which led to a 55-20 victory at Lancers Stadium.

The Lancers’ defense held the Raiders to 24 yards on 23 carries in the game. Leading the way were linebackers Michael Gonzalez, Kenny Haney and Jason Johnson, who led the team with 12 tackles in the game. Gonzalez had nine and Haney seven.

“I thought our defensive scheme and general play was awesome,” said Cordova head coach Darren Nill. “I would say my front seven were extremely effective.”

Lancer defensive end Clifford Bright had five tackles in the game. Defensive tackle Kelechi Njoku and defensive back Terrell Johnson had four each.

As the Lancers’ defense put the hurt on the Raiders’ offense, Cordova finished the job when it had the ball in the second half. The Lancers scored two touchdowns in the third and fourth quarters each.

On offense, Cordova produced huge numbers. In his first varsity football start running the offense, Lancer sophomore quarterback Xavier Johnson completed 16-of-24 passes for 263 yards and three touchdowns. He had one touchdown each to wide receivers Alvin Banks, who had 9 receptions for 131

yards in his debut as a sophomore. Following were senior Angel Garcia (2-28) and Calvin Augusta (2-54). The Lancers had 522 total yards; 263 in the air and 259 on the ground.

“We were running on all cylinders,” Nill said. “The offense that we run is extremely hard to defend. The only people that can hurt us when we’re on offense is us.”

The Lancers’ offense had two hiccups in the game, both in the first half on two fumbles. One of those miscues led to a Raiders’ touchdown.

But Cordova continued to move the ball at will in the second half. One of Lancers’ touchdowns in the first half was set up on a 67-yard punt return from sophomore Raymond Fite.

The Lancers moved the ball well on the ground behind

McCullough, who finished with 13 carries for 180 yards and two touchdowns. Johnson was next in rushing with 8 carries for 40 yards and Njoku 4-31.

In the junior varsity contest, Cordova lost a tough one to Rio Americano by a 19-18 score.

Today, Friday, Cordova hits the road for its first road game of the season at Chavez of Stockton. The Titans lost their home opener to Gregori of Modesto, 55-14, also on Aug. 26th.

The Titans also like to run the spread offense, as does Cordova.

“They are going to pound the middle,” said Nill of the Titans’ offense. “They are a much improved team, passing, in a short game.”

Game time for the Cordova-Chavez contest is 7:15 p.m. ★


