

Donation Drive Fills a Need at Food Locker

RANCHO CORDOVA, CA (MPG) - Diapers, formula, and baby food are in constant demand at the Cordova Community Food Locker. The Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-day Saints (LDS) collected all these in its recent donation drive as well as non-perishable food items, for the benefit of the food locker and its patrons. The drive culminated on April 30th, when participants brought their donations to the central collection location at the Cordova Stake building of the church on Wisseman Drive in Sacramento.

Besides its many relief operations throughout the world and continuing local service projects, the LDS church chooses one day each year to provide coordinated service in an individual way in each Stake. The Cordova Stake this year chose to carry out the donation drive.

Throughout the month of April members gathered items and reached out to neighbors for their contributions. Michael Goold, local

public affairs director for the church, coordinated the effort. At the Stake building, vouth of the church worked hard for three hours sorting the goods into categories and load-

ing them up for transportation. The clothing and household items they loaded into two pods for Deseret Industries Thrift Store in Sacramento. They filled a trailer with food and baby supplies for the food locker. On May 2nd, Goold, along with Wayne Langford, president of the Cordova region (or Stake) of the LDS Church, brought the donations to the food locker located at St. John Vianney Catholic Church in Rancho Cordova and transferred them over to Deacon Walter J. Little, creator/director of the food locker.

"It was a great effort," Goold said. "We think it's a great way for our church to interact with the Catholic Church and the Acts of Mercy and to make our community a better place to live, and help those less fortunate than us."

Since its inception in 1987 through December of 2015, the Cordova Community Food Locker has provided 16,183,404 meals to 1.798.156 individuals. From the beginning, the food locker has been a community project rather than a Catholic Church project, said Little. "A large portion of the community came on board, and the City Council, and I think that's what makes it the success that it is," he explained. "That's where the success really stems from."

Two Programs Launched to **Aid Businesses**

RANCHO CORDOVA, CA (MPG) - Just in time for Small Business Week, the City of Rancho Cordova launched two online programs to help entrepreneurs receive information about permits and get fee estimates with the goal to apply and receive some local permits and licenses — all in one day!

It's all part of the City's "Startup in a Day" pledge, making Rancho Cordova the first City in the Sacramento Region to participate in this nationwide initiative led by the White House and U.S. Small Business Administration.

OpenCounter strives to make complex projects, like starting a new business, easier to understand and navigate in Rancho Cordova. The tool helps a business determine if its preferred location is zoned appropriately, answers questions it may not have thought to ask, provides an estimate of fees, and generates an outline of the permits and

ZoningCheck gives businesses streamlined access to zoning regulations that can often seem complex. The system lets businesses quickly select a new business location by exploring sites in the approved zoning areas. Once businesses have picked a location, they can peruse resources including grant information, support organizations, and helpful checklists.

"Small businesses are the engines of our local economy," said Rancho Cordova Mayor David Sander. she worked at the skating rink on Broadway. "Frankly, he was my biggest troublemaker," Jacobs said. Over a period of time Jacobs' nephew became friends with Dominic, invited him to attend church with him and his Aunt Tracey, and that became a regular occurrence.

When Dominic was about to fail 8th grade, Jacobs helped. "We had to go to tutors, and I had to get him counseling for a lot of issues," Jacobs said, "but we got him on track and he barely made it, but he was able to walk with his 8th grade class." Jacobs and Dominic bonded and Jacobs eventually gained



However, this is not where his story ends. Coming this May 21st, 2016, Elijha will be



Leadership Rancho Cordova Throws the Dog Park a Bone

RANCHO CORDOVA, CA (MPG) -Enhancing the current dog park at Hagan Park in Rancho Cordova is Leadership Rancho Cordova Class X's project. The revitalization will include adding play equipment for dog visitors and benches for their owners and is expected to be finished this summer. Hagan Community Park, located at 2197 Chase Drive in Rancho Cordova, is the largest park within the Cordova Recreation and Park District (CRPD).

In May, more than 25 trees, donated by the Sacramento Tree Foundation (STF), will be planted by Leadership Class members in the dog park and surrounding area. Sarah Saetern, STF Community Forester, selected the kinds of trees and where they should be planted. Rodney Fernandes, Heritage Community Credit Union's Assistant Vice President of Operations and a member of this year's Leadership Class, is coordinating the planting with Hagan Park and CRPD officials.

The current dog park includes three side-by-side fenced-in areas — one for large dogs, one for medium dogs, and one for small dogs. "There is a drinking faucet in each of the areas and space for the dogs to run in, but that's it," said Horacio Oropeza, CRPD Park Services Supervisor and a member of this year's Leadership Class. "Our class project will add shade, equipment for the dogs to exercise and play on, and places for their owners to sit."

Dog parks are becoming more popular all across the United States. Although they're not for everyone, dog parks can benefit both people and their pets. According to its website, the ASPCA "supports the development of community dog parks as a means for urban dogs in particular to exercise off leash and socialize with other dogs."

To fund the project, Leadership Class members have participated in several fund raising projects but are also asking for donations from

public. There are five donation levels: \$10,000; \$5,000; \$2,500; \$1,000; and "you name the amount." "No amount is too small," stressed Dana Grossi, Storm Water Quality Program Coordinator for the City of Rancho Cordova and a member of this year's Leadership Class. She added that all donations are tax deductible as Leadership Rancho Cordova is part of the Rancho Cordova Chamber of Commerce Foundation, a 501c3 non-profit tax exempt organization. I always like to bring information about new stores, new ideas, new plans, and new information about our relatively new City. This year, the City of Rancho Cordova turns 13-years-old. Thinking about that is kind of scary, but I like to think that we are a little different than a 13-year-old teenager. They are still learning about life. Many of our citizens in Rancho Cordova have learned much more about life than 13 years. Either way, when July 1st, 2016 rolls around, we will be one of the newest cities in California.

Now we have new information about the numbers of our population. We just received the new numbers from the State Department of Finance, and they say our City's new population is 72,203. That is quite a nice jump from the numbers you see on the freeway sign which says 69,112. There are quite a few new homes being built in our City, and it doesn't seem to take very long for homes for sale in the established part of Rancho Cordova to be sold.

Something else that will begin in a very short time will be construction of a new elementary school in the Anatolia area south of Douglas Road. We had a meeting with the

And Another Thing ...

Rancho Cordova Is Growing Up

Elk Grove Unified School District a couple of weeks ago, and it was brought up because of the growth in that neighborhood. Sunrise Elementary School is a year-round school with four tracks to take care of the number of students who go there. That means that 3/4 of the students will be in school all year long. That allows the school to handle the number of students who go there even though it wasn't built to have that many students in a regular school year. They will be asking for suggestions this coming fall of what to name the new school

As I came into City Hall today, I noticed that we missed the 10th birthday of this City Hall. We opened this (our own) City Hall on January 17th, 2006 and dedicated it April 22nd, 2006. Our first City Hall was a building we first borrowed and then rented from the Sacramento Metro Fire District. It was their administration building that hadn't been used for a couple of years, and it worked out very well for us while we got ourselves established and shopped for our own. After our staff began working on this building (which we purchased from AT&T) and finished the tremendous job that it was, the only thing that was original was the bricks, windows, and winding stairway. I remember we gave away 32 tons of office equipment.

In December of 2005 while getting to open up the first floor, we had a public event in the City

Council Chambers. The carpet hadn't been put in yet, so organizations like the VFW, Boy Scouts, Rotary, and citizens who were happy to add their names on the history of our new city hall placed their names and insignia on the concrete floor. There were quite a few who showed up to be included, and then the carpet was placed on all those names and organizations and they became part of this City Hall's history.

And another thing that was something to remember is the approximately 55,000 residents of Rancho Cordova when we officially incorporated July 1st, 2003. I am sure that the 55,000 number is pretty close. If it isn't the exact number, please pass them on. It would be appreciated. But for now, using the 55,000 population of 13 years ago, and the 72,203 population we have today, means our population has increased by 17,203. The numbers are growing even faster now since the recession has eased and homes are being built again.

Most of these things are part of our history, and many people in Rancho Cordova lived through them. But since our population has grown over 17,000 people, I guess there are quite a few who just read something new about their own home town. And that is the City of Rancho Cordova.

Sacramento County DA Reports

Defendants Convicted of Human Trafficking, Insurance Fraud, and Sexual Assualt

CASE: Quoc Pham & Amro Farhat **PROSECUTOR:** Deputy District Attorney Sonia Satchell, Human Trafficking Unit

Twenty-eight-year-old Quoc Pham was convicted by jury of human trafficking, pimping a minor, and pandering a minor. Twenty-eightyear-old Amro Farhat was convicted of pimping a minor, pandering a minor, two counts of oral copulation of a minor, child pornography, and unlawful sexual intercourse with a victim more than three years younger.

The 16-year-old victim was a runaway from Contra Costa County. She came to Sacramento with a friend, who introduced her to Pham. Pham forced her to work as a prostitute on the stroll. He then took her to meet his friend, Farhat. Farhat took pictures of the victim and posted a prostitution advertisement on a website. Farhat also booked a room at the Travelodge so the victim could do dates. The victim was able to call her mom, who contacted law enforcement.

Pham faces a maximum potential sentence of 14 years, 8 months in prison. Faraht faces a maximum potential sentence of 8 years in prison. Sentencing is set for May 26, 2016, at 4:00 p.m. in Department 14 before the Honorable Donald Currier.

CASE: Timothy Sean McCrystle **PROSECUTOR:** Deputy District Attorney Kelly Mulcahy, Insurance Fraud Unit

Forty-nine-year-old Timothy Sean McCrystle pled no contest to misdemeanor insurance fraud and misdemeanor reckless driving. He was sentenced to 30 days in county jail and 3 years probation. He will also be required to pay a \$250 fine plus penalties and fees.

On August 15, 2015, the victim drove past McCrystle, who was driving unusually slow with his two children in the vehicle. McCrystle sped up to catch the victim and then abruptly braked and slowed his car to match the victim's speed. As they continued to drive, McCrystle remained driving alongside the victim at the same pace for several blocks. Suddenly, he

edged into the victim's lane causing them to collide. He hit the victim's car a second time before exiting his vehicle. He then stood directly in front of the victim's car, blocking her way, and proceeded to yell at her and slam his hands on the hood of her car. McCrystle eventually let the victim leave when he became aware the incident was being videotaped with a dash-mounted video camera in a nearby

McCrystle returned home and called 911 to report a hit and run. When interviewed by CHP, he stated the victim flipped him off as she sped up and passed him. After the collision, McCrystle admitted trying to block the victim's car and stated he was unable to get her license plate number. He also gave a recorded statement to USAA insurance and repeated the same false version of facts. McCrystle obtained the dash camera video of the evidence and provided it to his insurance company. After viewing the video, the case was turned over to the District Attorney's Office, Auto Insurance Fraud Unit.

CASE: Miguel Ramirez

PROSECUTOR:Deputy District Attorney Matt Chisholm, Adult Sexual Assault Prosecution Unit

Thirty-three-year-old Miguel Ramirez was convicted by jury of 12 counts of sexual assault including continuous sexual abuse, committing lewd acts upon a child, unlawful sexual intercourse with a victim more than three years younger, oral copulation of a person under 18, and attempt to commit sodomy with a person under 18.

Ramirez molested a friend's daughter starting from when she was 13 years old until she was 16 years old. The victim's mother discovered the abuse when she returned home unexpectedly.

Ramirez faces a sentence of 22 years, 8 months in prison. Sentencing is set for May 13, 2016, at 8:30 a.m. in Department 21 before the Honorable Steve White.

custody. From being a child who almost didn't pass 8th grade, Dominic became student of the year his first year in high school. He is now 20-years-old, in the U.S. Army, and successful.

The faith that helped Jacobs rescue a troubled boy comes with her to work. Respect is part of that, and in police/public relations, Jacobs said, an attitude of mutual respect is an important

"Law enforcement officers are going to treat (a person) with respect until that person gives us a reason not to," Jacobs said. "A lot of the bigger incidents that have happened between law enforcement and the community are from lack of compliance and lack of respect for law enforcement."

Last December, Jacobs was

at the Rancho Cordova Walmart after a live morning broadcast for a local T.V. station when she was called over by a cashier because a woman couldn't find

her wallet and thought it had been stolen. Jacobs took what she felt the simplest and fastest solution: she paid for the two carts of already rung-up items herself. That allowed the cashier to proceed ringing up purchases for the long line of inpatient customers behind. The woman later found that she had left the wallet

at her house and tried repeatedly to repay Jacobs, who did not consider that to be necessary.

"That was an answer to prayer to me, to be put in a position to be able to help her," Jacobs said.

Jacobs didn't tell anyone at the Department about having paid for the woman's purchases. The woman, however, ran into Chief Goold and Assistant Chief Adams at a school where she worked, and crying with emotion, told them the whole story. Jacobs ended up receiving an "unsung hero" award from the City of Rancho Cordova. The woman did eventually succeed in reimbursing Jacobs by sending the money through Jacobs' lieutenant.

Of course a police officer's duties are not often so gratifying. "Any homicide, and anything happening to children or the elderly is very difficult,

especially abuse," Jacobs said. "By far the most difficult call that I've ever been on was a triple homicide out here involving a mother and two small children that were stabbed to death." She was first on the scene along with two other officers. "At the time, 10 years on, I thought I'd seen it all — that was pretty terrible."

Officer Jacobs came to Rancho Cordova at the age of 6 and attended Rancho Cordova schools through Cordova High School. She studied criminal justice at Cosumnes River College and completed the rigorous training required in the Sacramento Sheriff's Department Academy.

If she had it to do over, would she choose law enforcement again?

"Absolutely," Jacobs said. "I only regret not doing it sooner."

Thriving as a Team, Focusing on Greatness

SACRAMENTO REGION, CA (SPORTSTARS/MPG) - Practice can't necessarily make perfect, particularly in golf. But, practice can make permanent — and that kind of consistency on the course is what makes players great.

Jesuit senior David Laskin has been practicing and playing since he was 6-years old, and that dedication is paying dividends as his final high school season begins to wind down. Laskin is among the Sac-Joaquin Section's top golfers and his steady game gives him a chance to do great things at the Section Masters tournament and beyond.

"The strength of my game is consistency," he said. "A lot of junior golfers can shoot 64, 65, 66, but then they might shoot in the 80s. I generally don't shoot in the 80s and stay around par all of the time, but I can go low."

Earlier this week, Laskin shot a season-best 66 at Wildhawk Golf Club in Sacramento to earn individual medalist for the second time in as many Delta League Tournaments, helping the Marauders take top team honors after Davis won the first league tourney at El Macero. He shot a 70 in the first Delta League tournament and currently leads the points race for Delta League MVP.

But, despite the individual honors that he earns in high school and junior amateur competitions, Laskin's primary focus right now is the Jesuit team. Under the direction of first-year coaches Pete Baichtal and Father Aaron Engebretson, the Marauders rely on Laskin for more than just his low scores.

"He is obviously a very good golfer, but what we have been most impressed with is his leadership," Baichtal said. "He has embraced his role as a leader, and he is a team-first guy." While some junior golfers cruise through their final high school season after accepting a college scholarship, Laskin has been more focused on his team than ever, according to his coaches.

"He embodies what we want in a leader at Jesuit," Engebretson said. "He is humble; he gives himself to his team; and he is a solid student. He finds a way to fit this in and makes it a priority to help the younger guys."

When the Jesuit golfers were asked to list their goals for the 2016 season, Laskin's top three goals were team goals, and he has never wavered on those priorities despite signing to play golf at the University of Arizona next year.

The process of earning a Division I golf scholarship goes through junior amateur tournaments rather than high school matches, but Laskin wants to enjoy his final season as a Marauder with his teammates.

"As a team, I want us to make it as far as we can," he said. "We have had some good finishes of late, and I think that maybe we can make a deep run in the postseason. I want to make it to state, but I would love to make it there as a team."

Laskin has his own team at home that has played a huge role in his success on the course. His parents, Alan and Julie, have guided both David and his older sister Emily—a 2014 St. Francis-Sacramento grad who is playing at the University of San Francisco—through the trials—and tribulations of junior golf with impressive success.

"My wife is amazing with the organization and coordination to get them everywhere they need to be," Alan Laskin said. "I'm more concerned with how he handles himself as a gentleman on the golf course than I am if he shoots 62 or 82."

That support has helped David thrive as a student-athlete, and allowed him to spend the needed time practicing and refining his game. Laskin practices or plays four days during the week with Jesuit, and then practices with either private coach Phil Dawson or on his own for about six-to-eight hours a day on weekends. Well, weekends when he is not competing in junior amateur tournaments.

"He is a determined player," said Dawson, who coaches numerous high school, college and amateur golfers. "He puts in the time to be great, and that's what separates him from

the pack."

Laskin has always strived to separate himself from the rest of the field, admitting to first dreaming of playing on the PGA Tour — and especially at The Masters — before he even turned 10. But, it was not until he started high school that

he realized his dreams could come true with plenty of hard work and sacrifice. The senior still finds time to succeed in the classroom and give back to the community. Laskin has fulfilled community service hours required by Jesuit by volunteering at a South Sacramento after-school

program, serving meals to the homeless and less fortunate, and to helping rebuild homes destroyed by Hurricane Katrina in New Orleans this past Summer. He believes that his friends and family understand his need to give lots of time and energy to golf.

"To be the best, you have to work hard and make (golf) your focus," Laskin said. "I think that my friends understand that and know that's what I need to do to achieve my goals." If he does not achieve his goals of individual and team recog-

nition as a senior at Jesuit along with success at the collegiate and professional level, it will certainly not be for a lack of work. Because Laskin is determined to practice to make permanent and to realize his golf dreams.

"David is redundantly good from tee to green all of the time," Dawson said. "This game is all about organization and discipline. He takes a holistic approach to the game that makes him a highly proficient player."





A large size tree five years after planting returns \$22 to \$23 dollars a year. That same tree 40 years after planting returns \$63 to \$73 dollars a year. This means the 100 trees in Lincoln Village will add from \$2,200 per year to \$7,300 per year as the trees increase in size!

The neighborhood will come together on Saturday, May 21st for the tree planting event. Volunteers are needed to help plant the trees from 8 a.m. to noon.
