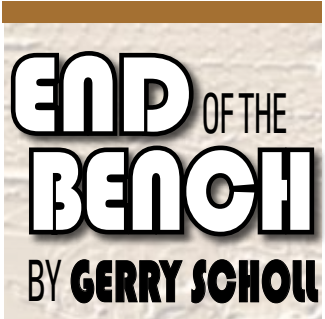

# Hail the Hometown Heroes

**RANCHO CORDOVA, CA (MPG)** - Around 10:30 a.m., on the morning of Thursday, Feb. the 18th, four members of the Valerio family of Rancho Cordova were taking it easy, waiting their turn to catch a boat to take them for a tour of the USS Arizona Memorial at Pearl Harbor, when their long-awaited Hawaiian vacation was abruptly interrupted.

Juan Ruben Valerio, his wife, Alicia, and their two sons, 12-year-old Benjamin and six-year-old Matthew, noticed something strange: "I heard a helicopter," Juan said. "It was making odd sounds and seemed to be hovering as if looking for a place to land."

The Bell 206 helicopter was about 50-feet from shore when it suddenly plunged into the harbor, its rotor slapping violently at the water, and it started to sink.

As many of the bystanders were running away from the crash out of fear of a possible explosion or pieces of metal flying off the rotor as it failed to a stop in the water, the Valerios were running toward the wreck. "We could see people in there," Juan said. "And I said, 'People are gonna need help.'"

If ever there was a case of the right help at the right place at the right time it was when the Valerios came onto the scene. Juan is a U.S. Navy veteran and certified scuba diver. Alicia is a pediatric nurse who works in the Intensive Care Unit at the Kaiser Permanente hospital in Roseville.

Without hesitation, Juan jumped into the water and swam through spreading aviation fuel leaking from the downed helicopter. He got to the craft and managed to get a woman out. He put a life preserver around her neck to keep her head above the surface.

"She was shouting: 'Please get my little boy, he's still in his seatbelt.'" The "little boy" was her 16-year-old son.

"I took a deep breath and got down into the helicopter, but I couldn't locate the boy," Valerio said. "The water was murky and I couldn't tell which direction was up. I couldn't hold my breath anymore. The helicopter was sinking with me in it."

Bystanders told him later that he had been under water for nearly three minutes.



Someone threw him a life preserver and five or six men continued the rescue effort. By the time they were able to cut through the seatbelt to free the teenager, the boy had been under water for about ten minutes.

As they hauled the young man to shore, Alicia Valerio shouted, "I'm a nurse!" The crowd cleared a space and Alicia immediately went to work. She performed CPR until the boy's skin color turned from blue to pink and he had a weak pulse. By that time an emergency crew had arrived with a first aid kit and oxygen and rushed the victim off to the hospital.

## Coolley's Bill to Bolster Transparency of Mental Health Funds

**RANCHO CORDOVA, CA (MPG)** - Assemblyman Ken Cooley's (D-Rancho Cordova) AB 2279 passed unanimously out of the Assembly Health Committee this week. AB 2279 bolsters transparency about how Mental Health Services Act (MHSA) funds are being used by requiring that information about state-wide and county-by-county funding for mental health programs be made available to the public to enhance accountability, outcomes, and facilitate mental health program improvement.

Proposition 63, the MHSA, was passed by the voters in 2004. Its purpose was to transform the mental health system by providing prevention and intervention services to those living with mental illness.

"According to the Center for Disease Control, one in four American adults suffers from a diagnosable mental disorder. AB 2279 will make it easier for consumers to identify services that best address their needs, provide a platform for counties to better share information and enhance accountability to the public," said Assemblyman Cooley.

Each county that receives MHSA funds annually reports information to the Department of Health Care Services that accounts for how funds were spent and allows for evaluation of mental health service strategies. Currently, this information is not consistently made publicly available in an easy to understand format, and the information shared is not up-to-date.

Mental health advocates agree that enhancing MHSA transparency is long overdue. "Over the years there have been requests for this type of information to ensure that MHSA funds are being efficiently and effectively utilized. This bill will provide transparency and will help assure the public that the funds are being used as intended," said Rusty Selix. Mr. Selix represents Mental Health America of California and the California Council of Community Behavioral Health Agencies.

"The lack of timely and accessible reporting does not align with the principles set forth by Proposition 63," said Anna Hasselblad, Director of Public Policy with the Steinberg Institute. "With no single repository for this information in place, it makes it difficult for law makers, taxpayers, mental health advocates, and consumers to see how MHSA funds are spent county-by-county and state-wide. AB 2279 will go a long way toward improving the way we provide mental health care in California."

Assemblyman Ken Cooley represents the 8th Assembly District which includes the communities of Arden-Arcade, Carmichael, Citrus Heights, Rancho Cordova, Rancho Murietta, Rosemont, Wilton and other portions of unincorporated Sacramento County. ## Grownup Toys for Grownup Boys

**RANCHO CORDOVA, CA (MPG)** - If you happen to stop by the radio controlled aircraft "airport" on 1000-acres at the Mather complex you are likely to see fully-vested adults with their scale model airplanes and helicopters. Don't call them toys though. Some of the gasoline and battery powered models are nearly as complex as their full-sized contemporaries. The skills of their pilots on the ground are also in the "amazing" category.

Two flying clubs share space at the 60-year-old site: The Mather Aerospace Modelers (fixed-wing aircraft), and the Sacramento Valley Rotary Wings (helicopters). The members of the two organizations share both air and passion, and are generally divided by age group; the rotorcraft flyers tend to be younger, the fixed-wing pilots lean toward the senior side and fly the type

# Enjoying Life After Loss

**SACRAMENTO REGION, CA (MPG)**  
- One person in every couple that stays married will lose their spouse to death and according to the Holmes and Raye Stress Scale, being widowed is 100 on a scale of 0 to 100. No other loss is that devastating, and until it happens to you, one cannot imagine the life changing impact. That's where WPAC (Widowed Persons Association of California) comes in.

In the thirty years that WPAC, which started in Sacramento, has been in existence, thousands of widows and widowers have gone through their six-week Grief Recovery Workshops. With this free, non-denominational program, they found that they could laugh and enjoy life again.

The leaders of the WPAC program are not professionals, but many professionals refer people to them because they know how valuable going through their bereavement program and relating to others who have gone through the same trauma can be. All the trained facilitators and speakers in these workshops and are widowed. Only someone who is also widowed could understand and empathize with the pain that the participants have.

Beginning with the first week of a workshop, the subject is: "Understanding Grief." In this session, the typical symptoms usually experience by those widowed, is discussed. Some of those symptoms are: inability to sleep, memory loss, feeling like their mind is in a fog, not being able to read and comprehend a paragraph, being confused, feeling lost, lonely and more. Because of some of these symptoms, wondering if they are going crazy is something that many of those who attend the first week of the workshops report. Finding that other people feel the same way is a relief, and relating to those on the same journey of recovery from grief is comforting.



In the thirty years that WPAC, which started in Sacramento, has been in existence, thousands of widows and widowers have gone through their six-week Grief Recovery Workshops. What they almost always get instead, said the coordinator of the program, is: "Thank You," or, "WPAC saved my life, or my sanity."

"Coping With Stress" is the subject of the second week. Whether it is the stress of a long drawn out illness, and caring for their dying spouse, or the shock of a sudden and unexpected death, stress is something that has to be dealt with. Not only can it increase blood pressure, stress can actually change a person's blood chemistry, and lower their immunity. If it does not cause illness, stress can make it harder to fight off illness.

Another thing that people who have lost their spouse to death usually experience, is that married friends they had, will at first express sympathy, and probably keep in touch for a few weeks, then tend to drift away, not knowing what to do with, or say to the now single half of the couple they knew. Even if the widowed friend is included in

their activities, he or she will feel like a fifth wheel around couples. In fact noticing that almost every other adult seems to be married emphasizes the fact that they are now alone.

The third week of a workshop, "Changing Roles and Relationships," covers that subject along with many other changes that the widowed person must face. One of the hardest things for the newly widowed person to accept is that their spouse is actually dead, and they are not just having a bad dream.

"Rebuilding Your Life and Moving On," is the fourth subject that a workshop covers. Rebuilding is the correct term, because when someone is widowed, the life that they lived with their now deceased spouse no longer exists. One day they were half of a couple, the next

day that couple is gone. Starting over is not easy, but with the help of WPAC, they can do it.

The fifth week of these workshops is a review and evaluations of the program. They want to know what the people who go through the workshops think,

and if they have suggestions for any changes. What they almost always get instead, said the coordinator of the program, is: "Thank You," or, "WPAC saved my life, or my sanity." That leads to the last session of each workshop, where the participants

are asked to be responsible for a social that all those involved with the past five weeks are invited to. This is usually a potluck, or they chip in money to bring in pizza or something similar. Starting to socialize again is often a problem, but it is a necessary part of rebuilding their lives, and doing it with people they have gotten to know, and made some friends with over the past five weeks is an easy way to start.

WPAC runs these free six week Grief Recovery Workshops four time per year. The next one starts on Thursday, April 21st, from 5:30 to 7:30 p.m. Signing up in advance is not necessary, but it gives them an ideal of how many to set up for, also if they have your phone number you will get a reminder call, usually the day before. The workshops takes place in their offices, at 2628 El Camino Avenue, Suite D-18 (the building in the back).

Widowed people do not have to wait for a workshop to start to get help. Every week WPAC has Sunday Support, a peer support group from 3 to 5 p.m., and it is also open to any widowed person.

# Christians Flock to State Capitol to Pray for America

**SACRAMENTO REGION, CA (MPG) -** American Christians are looking for a miracle to save this country through all levels of society and government: socially, economically, and politically.

On March 30th, 2016, a sea of 7,500 men, women, and children from all parts of California began to flow onto the Sacramento State Capitol grounds, hours before the noon starting time of the Decision America Tour 2016 with Franklin Graham. By mid-day the throng had wrapped around the front and sides of the capitol building. They were there to pray for America and to hear the Gospel message of evangelist Franklin Graham.

Since their first stop in Des Moines, Iowa, on January 5th, the Billy Graham Evangelistic Association has embarked on a journey of spiritual revival to all 50 state capitols. Sacramento was its 13th stop. Its mission is to provide Bible believing Christians a “real-world” means to bring about the miracle of restoration.

In this critically important election year, Franklin Graham (63) son of well-known evangelist of 67 years, Billy Graham (97) has set about to share the three vital components of this challenge with all who will listen: Pray, Vote, and Engage.

Graham’s program is modeled after the work of Nehemiah in the Old Testament whom God sent to Jerusalem to rebuild its walls and admonish the people to

repent, turn away from their sins, and come back to God. Graham stressed throughout the hour that the fate of America is in the balance and depends solely on how Christians stand up and take it back from the immorality and wrongdoing prevalent in today’s society.

As with the people of Jerusalem who, after finally repenting, again won favor with God, Franklin preached that God will give America favor once more when its people stand up for the truth and principles of the

Bible and the “old fashioned” values on which our founding fathers established in America.

Franklin stressed that this shows the need to first confess and pray fervently for one’s own sins, those of their community and country and even for those of their ancestors.

He also stressed that, next to prayer, the most important thing a Christian can do is vote; pointing out that in the last election only 20 to 30 million evangelical (biblical) Christians voted. Franklin quoted the words of his father Billy, from 1952, the year he was born: “It is the duty of every individual at election time to study the issues and candidates....and to vote.” He urged people to vote for those who are morally and spiritually in line with the Church and will protect the liberties we enjoy. Even if one must vote for the “lesser of two evils”...vote. “Unless America turns back to God, repents of its sin, and experiences a spiritual revival, we will fail as a nation. God honors leaders in high places who honor biblical truth and principles and

are willing to live by them,” Franklin recited.

In 1976, when Franklin was 27, two years after he became a Christian, his father preached that Christians need to get involved in the political process, including public service at all levels. He challenged all who have a good

foundation in Jesus and the Bible to step up and offer themselves for public office, regardless of their party. There are many places they can seek votes, from city council where they can become mayor to serving on commissions, and especially school

boards, on up to the federal level.

Feeling the Holy Spirit standing amongst 7,500 hands joined in prayer gave attendees the assurance that they are not alone in this. Thunderous applause arose as Franklin sent the thousands of Californians home to their work by urging them to all “become community organizers for God and political activists for God!”

Instead of the traditional “altar call” the prayer rally ended with a call to text one’s decision to accept Christ, to make the Decision America Tour pledge and receive more information.

In an email, a spokesperson for the Billy Graham Evangelistic Association said, “Of the thirteen Decision America Tour events we’ve held so far, Sacramento was our largest with 7,500 people in attendance at the Capitol. This was a tremendous response. People really do care deeply about the direction of our country and believe that we need to pray for our nation and our leaders now more than ever.” ★

Although the father of the family suffered a serious back injury, he, an older son, and the pilot got clear of the sinking helicopter; lives had been saved, and everyone lived through the ordeal.

“We felt pretty good about it,” Juan said. Or so they thought.

Three days later they learned that the young boy had died. He had been under water too long.

The Valerio’s kids are their parents’ greatest admirers for what they did that day. “I feel very proud,” Benjamin said.

The stay in Hawaii for the remaining three days of their trip was more about answering questions by military, park and civilian police than enjoying the vacation they had planned for a long time.

“We had saved for a whole year to go,” Juan said.

They never did get to see the Pearl Harbor Memorial. The park was shut down as the investigation into the crash continued. They still have the unused tickets.


When they returned to the mainland they were greeted by an avalanche of adulation, including TV news interviews by local stations and the major networks. Rancho Cordova officials presented them with a proclamation and a key to the City. They also received a letter of commendation from a state Senator. Alicia Valerio was also awarded the American Heart Association’s “Heart Saver Hero” Award.

They said if they had it to do over again they would not do anything different.

“People needed our help,” Alicia Valerio said. “And we were there to help them.” ★



## Honoring Our Vietnam Veterans

At our Rancho Cordova City Council meeting on Monday night, we were privileged to be able to honor 95 living Vietnam War veterans at the Vietnam War Commemoration ceremony. Our Rancho Cordova Memorial and Veterans Day Committee joined more than 8,000 local, state, and federal organizations on October 2nd, 2013, and became Department of Defense Commemorative partners. The City Council Chamber was filled with Vietnam Veterans, but our fantastic staff had prepared the American River Rooms with tables, chairs, and dinner for the families and friends of the Veterans. The dinner was also for the veterans if they wanted dinner. After the ceremony, we had a break in the Council meeting, and gathered all the veterans in the lobby where a group picture was taken.

There are some veterans who

hadn't talked about the way they were treated when they came home from Vietnam or wherever they were stationed. As I have mentioned before, some of the veterans were called baby killers, were spit on, were blamed for a war they didn't start, and were blamed for the misdeeds of a few. They served their country and should have been praised and commended for serving with valor. Unfortunately, it was safer in some instances to wear civilian clothes instead of their military uniform because during that troubled time, the demonstrators didn't care if you had been in Vietnam or not. You were a soldier, a veteran, and that was enough to make you a target. Monday night, the veterans who were there were given the respect, the honor, and the welcome home that many of them had never received. For some, the lapel pin they received meant as much as some of the medals they had already received.

We still have some lapel pins and folders like the ones that were given out at the ceremony that will be given to more living Vietnam veterans in the future. According to the rules and regulations, only living United States veterans who served on active duty from November

1st, 1955 to May 15th, 1975 are eligible to receive the lapel pin. However, there are buttons provided by the Department of Defense Vietnam War Commemoration that are not limited to living veterans only, and the button says A Grateful Nation Thanks and Honors Our Vietnam War Veterans. We received a call this morning from the daughter of a Vietnam veteran who has passed away, but she asked if she could pick up or receive a pin for her father sometime in the future. We are already working on the next ceremony and how and when it will be set up. I will keep you informed about when we will have it done next.

And another thing that is going on this month is Kids Day in the Park. It will be held in Hagan Park on April 30th from 11 a.m. to 3 p.m. Admission is free. There will be farm animals, hay rides, music, and entertainment, and there will also be health care providers like Kaiser Permanente and Molina Healthcare. You will find everything this year that was there last year and more. It is a great event and is a volunteer-powered event. Don't miss this wonderful event!

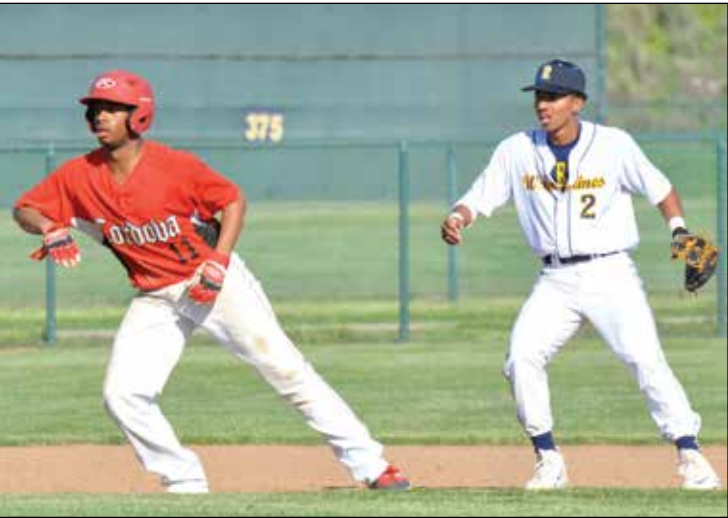
Harris went the distance, throwing a three-hitter in the game that lasted only one hour, 25 minutes.

of craft that was popular before helicopters were commonplace.

Make no mistake: these “toys” are not something most kids would find under the Christmas tree. They are expensive to buy and to maintain, and they are strictly for the serious hobbyist.

“You can spend anywhere from \$100 to \$8,000 on a fixed-wing aircraft. It’s like golf or fishing,” Mather Aerospace Modelers President Norman Poynter said, comparing cost and passion. “You have to find your comfort level in what you can afford.” Poynter owns 20 radio controlled fixed-wing aircraft.

On any given day visitors will see everything from small, single-engine planes to large turbojet models. “One has a 160-inch (13-foot) wingspan,” Poynter said.

And you have to prepare your mind for the occasional crash that can result in anything from a minor abrasion to a pile of mangled scrap. “You’re going to have to replace it someday,” Poynter said, apparently suggesting that it is not a matter of *if* a plane will crash, but *when*.

On the rotorcraft side of the facility, Rancho Cordova conveyor systems draftsman Bud Newhall says helicopter prices range from \$50 to \$3,000. The “hobby grade” models at the lower end of the scale are usually referred to somewhat disparagingly as “mall copters.” Those are the starter craft of the kind and cost the flyer won’t have a heart attack if it bites the dust.

The two three-foot-long battery powered choppers Newhall brought with him represent the upper end of the price range. He says they are not immune to crashes. “It does happen,” he said. “And it’s expensive when they do.”

Newhall’s wife, Linda, stands by in support, if not in passion.

“It gets me out of the house,” she said.

“They only fly for about four minutes on a charge,” Newhall said. He carries extra batteries and has a charging unit in his truck. “I can be flying with one battery while the other is charging.”

Edward Daniels and his eight-year-old son, Holden, live in Greenhaven. They make the trip all the way to the Mather complex to fly their helicopters where they have plenty of space. Daniels says he can only fly them to a limited degree in his own back yard.

One of his models is a tiny chopper that he looks very much like a mosquito on steroids. “It cost about \$100,” he said as he maneuvered the buzzing little craft around the patch. Two somewhat larger models sitting on his table are in the \$500 range. Flyers can be found at the site anytime, but the big days are the weekend, with Sunday being the busiest.

A three-day fly-in is planned for April 15th, 16th, and 17th. Radio controlled fixed-wing flyer

from far and wide are expected to attend, some with motor homes. The public is invited. The airfield is located on the Mather complex, just north of the intersection of Kiefer Boulevard and Eagles Nest Road.

### O Brother, There Thou Art!

What thoughts were going through Nate Britt’s mind as he stood near the North Carolina bench and watched the Villanova Wildcats inbound the basketball from the backcourt with the score tied and just 4.7 seconds left on the clock?

Britt’s Tar Heels teammate Marcus Paige had just made an improbable, double-clutch three-pointer to complete a furious UNC comeback in the final two minutes of the NCAA National Championship game in Houston, Monday night, setting the stage for a seemingly inevitable overtime period.

But there was Britt’s brother, Kris Jenkins, passing the ball into Villanova point guard Ryan Archidiacono. Naturally, no one wants to lose to his brother...at anything...ever. So an ominous sense of all the times his brother by a different mother had gotten the better of him through half a lifetime of competition stirred inside Britt as he could foresee the undeniable unfolding before him.

“When I saw him trailing, I knew he was getting the ball and would probably knock it down,” Britt told USA Today, after Jenkins’ buzzer-beating, three-point shot gave Villanova its first national title in 31 years, 77-74. “That’s like a lay-up for him,” Britt said.

As Archidiacono avoided a double-team by the Tar Heels, he flipped the ball back to Jenkins, who stepped in rhythm into his shot from four feet beyond the three-point arc and BANG! Family bragging rights now belonged to Jenkins as a result of the incredible finish to one the most memorable tournament finals of all time.

The two players became friends at 10 years old and Jenkins, who remains close with his birth parents, was legally adopted by Britt’s parents in 2007. The pair played together

on AAU and high school teams, before going separate ways in their college playing careers.

“It’s amazing how it worked out, all the dedication and sacrifice, to have this opportunity. It’s special to our family,” Jenkins told CNN as the big game approached. “There’s nobody in the world I want to beat more than my brother.”

The Wildcats had been a hot-shooting squad throughout their five tournament games, including a 71.4% mark in their record-setting, 44-point win over Oklahoma and Player of the Year Buddy Hield in the semifinals. In particular, Jenkins went 29 for 50, including 15 for 29 from beyond the arc.

The question for UNC coach Roy Williams must be, “Why wasn’t anybody hounding Villanova’s long-range sharpshooter up the floor with so little time remaining?” If asked, Williams might answer as he did while being grilled by the media after UNC’s 83-66 semifinal win over Syracuse, “I’m a lot smarter about basketball than you guys are.”

That may be true, but it doesn’t mean his tactics can’t be questioned. The guy’s just a little cranky of late because he knows he may soon have to be answering more questions about the ongoing NCAA investigation regarding accusations of rampant academic fraud at UNC (that supposedly does not involve members of this season’s team). O, brother.

A brother act in the NBA has become more interesting as guard Seth Curry, brother of reigning MVP Steph Curry of the Golden State Warriors, has made himself more deserving of a longer look. Seth has worked his way into the Sacramento Kings’ starting lineup by scoring in double-figures in five of his last six games, including a career-high 21 points twice.

Unfortunately, the Kings are closing out their tenth straight losing season. You might wonder how they would be doing if they had held onto the Hustling Husky, point guard Isaiah Thomas. Thomas was in the news for leading the way for the Boston Celtics in their huge upset over the Warriors last Friday, 109-106, breaking the Warriors’ record 54-game home winning streak.

The Warriors’ own brothers act, Splash Brothers Steph Curry (39) and Klay Thompson (21), bounced back quickly in Sunday’s 136-111 win over Portland that also featured Draymond Green’s 13th triple-double of the season (22 pts., 10 rebs., 10 asst.). At 69-8, the Warriors need four wins in their final five games to reach a new all-time record of 73 victories. They must face the five-time champion, 64-12 San Antonio Spurs twice during that stretch.

If anyone has the right to shout “O, brother!” as the Major League Baseball season has gotten underway it would be the pitching coaches for the Milwaukee Brewers and the San Diego Padres, and the fans of those two teams.

The Brewers’ Derek Johnson watched members of his staff give up 15 hits to the visiting San Francisco Giants, including four home runs, in their Opening Day 12-3 loss. The Giants’ Denard Span, Joe Panik and Buster Posey went back-to-back-to-back against Ariel Pena. San Diego pitching coach Darren Balsley and the hometown fans endured a 15-0 beat-down at the hands of the L. A. Dodgers on Opening Day.

The prospects for the season ahead for those two bottom-feeder teams looks like a toad. They’ll have to sell their souls to the devil to be any good. ★
