Breaking Ground at Heron Landing Park

Community Celebrates Landmark Achievement

RANCHO CORDOVA, CA (MPG) - Cordova Recreation and Park District (CRPD) held a groundbreaking ceremony on Tuesday, April 26th, 2016 to mark the beginning of construction for Heron Landing Community Park.

"Do you hear that sound? That is the sound of progress," said CRPD Board of Directors Chair Rick Sloan during his opening remarks and referring to the motor graders working in the background.

Heron Landing Park, located at Sunrise Blvd. and Justinian Way, will be the eighth community park in the district. The 20-plus acre park will feature various athletic fields and courts, two playgrounds, a splash park and shaded picnic areas. A community center is also scheduled to be built at a later date.

"The community has anticipated this park and has been very patient through this process," said CRPD District Administrator Jim Rodems.

"The District has turned the corner on the funding and is pleased to get this park accomplished for the community."

CRPD held several community visioning workshops in 2013 as a key part of the design process. CRPD worked with HLA Landscape Architects to ensure the final design addressed the concerns and desires of the community. The park will be built by Olympic Land Construction

Join the 27th Community-Wide Celebration of Children This Saturday at Hagan Park

Coming of Age During the Holocaust: A Day of Remembrance

RANCHO CORDOVA, CA (MPG) - There will be no shortage of giggles on Saturday April 30th, when Kids Day in the Park celebrates its 27th Anniversary at Hagan Park in Rancho Cordova.

Presented by the City of Rancho Cordova, Sacramento County Department of Health and Human Services, and a host of other sponsors, Kids Day will celebrate Sacramento County as a “Great Place to Grow” with more than 100 free things to do.

The event also marks the Sacramento County kick-off for National Children’s Mental Health Awareness Day.

Admission and all activities are free of charge. Food will be available for purchase.

This year’s event takes kids and their parents down on the farm, with plenty of animals to meet, farm chores to try and more. Crawling through a giant caterpillar, taking a hay ride, scrambling up a hay hill and a trip to Ag-Ventureland where kids will learn to do everything from milk a cow to rope a steer.

Kids Day began over a quarter-century ago and has evolved into a community-wide celebration of children which last year attracted more than 6,000 visitors. In addition to fun and educational farm attractions, kids can participate in a talent show and learn about bike safety at the popular Police Activities League (PAL) Bike Rodeo during which dozens of bicycles donated by the Sheriff’s Toy Project will be given away to lucky children.

While Kids Day is all about fun, children’s health is the primary objective. Organizers work with health providers from Sacramento County and the Folsom Cordova Unified School District to present free hearing, vision and school readiness screenings to help get kids off to a healthy start. Parents can get tips on how to prepare their children for school, how to obtain mental health resources, and how to access a wide range of public and private services for their kids.

More than 100 exhibitors whose focus is children and health will be providing a free activity for children, keeping little hands busy while parents access information.

Kids Day runs from 11 a.m. to 3 p.m. Saturday April 30th, 2015, with no admission charge. Free parking is available nearby.

Pack a picnic lunch to bring with you to the event, or purchase lunch from among a variety of gourmet food trucks. A hot dog meal including chips and a bottle of water can be purchased for \$3 from the RC Kiwanis.

SACRAMENTO REGION, CA (MPG) - Holocaust Remembrance Day is May 5th, 2016. On Sunday, May 1st, 2016 the Sacramento region will have an opportunity to learn about the experiences of two Holocaust survivors during World War II. This is a highly educational event and children and teens are encouraged to attend with their families.

The theme for this year’s Sacramento Yom HaShoah (Day of Remembrance) Commemoration is: “The Holocaust: Coming of Age during the Holocaust.”

The stories of survivors Gina Parker and Rita Rimalower-Nettler will be told by their daughters, Tamara Theodore and Michele Gold. Both survivors were 15-years-old when their stories began.

Theodore will tell her mother, Gina Parker’s story in public for the first time. From the age of 15 to 22, Parker survived five labor concentration camps from 1939 to 1945, three in Poland and two in Germany. She also suffered through but survived two “death marches.” She was finally freed from the second march by Russian troops on April 23rd, 1945 at the age of 22. She weighed 65 pounds and was wearing only a prison dress, a high heel shoe and a boot. The march began with 10,000 prisoners but only 20 had survived from her group.

In 2007 Parker visited the classroom of

Janet Smith, a teacher at Lincoln High School. Her talk was readily received by the students. Theodore will have thank you notes from these students at her talk. Gina Parker died on February 19th, 2013 of COPD, a pulmonary disease, related to enforced testing done on her by doctors during her incarceration.

Theodore said that she often felt guilty when she asked her mother about her experiences. Even though those memories made her physically ill Parker maintained, “I will go to the grave with the pain I have and the loss I have. But I don’t have any bitterness towards

the Germans. They were duped.”

Michele Gold is an educator at the Los Angeles Museum of the Holocaust and author of “Memories that Won’t Go Away: A Tribute to the Children of the Kindertransport.” Gold’s mother was Rita Rimalower-Nettler who was 15-years-old when became one of 10,000 Jewish refugee children brought from Germany to Great Britain from 1938 to 1940 on the Kindertransport. She arrived in England on March 3rd, 1939 and was taken in and raised by a loving family. Gold uses the more than 40 post cards discovered in her

mother’s belongings following her death in 2008 to tell her story. The cards which had been written to her aunt and uncle in Switzerland tell the of Rita’s attempts to discover what had happened to her parents.

This special event will include a candlelight procession at 6:15 p.m., a poetry reading and recognition of the student winners of the “Tribute to the Rescuers” essay contest. The international contest, sponsored by the Institute for Holocaust Education, asks contestants to recognize an historical individual or group who showed moral courage with a tie into the Holocaust.

The commemoration is Sunday, May 1st from 6:30 to 8 p.m. at Mosaic Law Congregation, 2300 Sierra Boulevard, Sacramento. For more information: (916) 488-1122.

RANCHO CORDOVA, CA (MPG) - Leadership Rancho Cordova (LRC) launches a new class on a year-long exploration of our city this fall, and the search is on for eager participants.

In the spirit of developing community leaders the program, offered by the Rancho Cordova Chamber of Commerce, enters its eleventh year and now boasts more than 150 alumni — many currently serving in community leadership roles throughout the city and region.

The next class of approximately 25 will be selected to represent a broad mix of backgrounds, ages, ethnicities and employment — a key ingredient to a successful leadership program, said Rachele Burton, chair of the program’s governing board.

“Community leadership and engagement can be complex, and we want to encourage and support a pool of local people who have taken the time to dig deep and study the many layers of Rancho Cordova,” she added.

Class XI begins in October with a kick-off reception at City Hall, followed by a two-day retreat up in Tahoe to immerse themselves in leadership fundamentals and begin the process of

team-building.

In November, the class begins monthly “modules” and explores topics such as the state of volunteerism, local government, arts and culture, education, land use and economic development, recreation and tourism and public safety in Rancho Cordova, along with leadership lessons that pertain to each sector.

The group will also develop and execute a class project — the signature of their class. Past class projects have included the development of the Rancho Cordova International Festival (now “iFest”), a photographic history of Rancho Cordova, a summer family film series and refurbishing the dog park at Hagen Park.

The class is not free and does require time commitments for modules, project development and execution. But organizers believe the effort is worthwhile.

“LRC provides graduates who make a difference in the economic health and quality of life in our community through active community engagement,” said Diann Rogers, CEO and President of the Rancho Cordova Chamber of Commerce. “Leadership Rancho Cordova provides graduates with the

tools necessary to be an effective leader in their community, business or elected office.”

Leadership graduates agree. “LRC is a wonderful experience for those who want to get connected with the community and learn how to make a phenomenal difference in the lives of the citizens in Rancho Cordova” said Laurel Bane, alumnus of the program — Class XIII. “If you want to make an impact and have fun doing it, this program is for you.”

There was one clinker in building phase three, and that was an unknown underground tank found during the beginning of construction. Well, so far the tank has been removed and the soil around it has been

hauled out, but the Air Force still has to sign that location off as clean so it can be used. When any military installation is closed, the military who were there will be responsible for cleanup no matter how far into the future it may be. So now, quite a few people are looking for the Air Force signature needed. I'll let you know.

The people of Anatolia and other neighborhoods have been waiting since 2004 for the Raley's grocery store to be built, and now it is finally being done and will open next year. There will also be a gas station placed there at Douglas and Sunrise. I am sure the other retail locations will be filled very soon, and the Walgreens will continue to help the residents just like it has in the past.

And another thing...you have to remember, whether it is the changing weather, or another thing that has to be taken care of before you finish and reach your goal, or having to go a longer distance for a while before what you want is closer to home, like Jimmy Dean said, "I can't change the direction of the wind, but I can adjust my sails to always reach my destination." 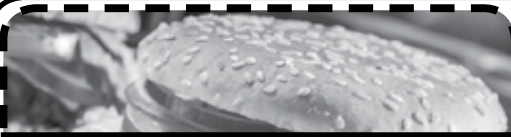

Sacramento County DA Reports



*Defendants Convicted of Multiple
Human Trafficking Related Charges*

*Father Convicted for First-Degree
Murder of Wife, Two Sons*

CASE: Quoc Pham & Amro Farhat
PROSECUTOR: Deputy District Attorney Sonia Satchell, Human Trafficking Unit

Twenty-eight-year-old Quoc Pham was convicted by jury of human trafficking, pimping a minor, and pandering a minor. Twenty-eight-year-old Amro Farhat was convicted of pimping a minor, pandering a minor, two counts of oral copulation of a minor, child pornography, and unlawful sexual intercourse with a victim more than three years younger.

The 16-year-old victim was a runaway from Contra Costa County. She came to Sacramento with a friend, who introduced her to Pham. Pham forced her to work as a prostitute on the stroll. He then took her to meet his friend, Farhat. Farhat took pictures of the victim and posted a prostitution advertisement on a website. Farhat also booked a room at the Travelodge so the victim could do dates. The victim was able to call her mom, who contacted law enforcement.

Pham faces a maximum potential sentence of 14 years, 8 months in prison. Farhat faces a maximum potential sentence of 8 years in prison. Sentencing is set for May 26, 2016, at 4:00 p.m. in Department 14 before the Honorable Donald Currier.

CASE: Kouei Saetern
PROSECUTOR: Deputy District Attorney Thien Ho, Homicide Unit

Fifty-three-year-old Kouei Saetern

was convicted by jury of three counts of first-degree murder. The jury also found true a gun use and a multiple murder special circumstance allegation.

On November 8, 2010, Saetern got into an argument with his wife, Chio Chong Saechao, and began beating her. Saetern's adult sons, Jerry Wang Saetern and Vern Cheo Saetern, held him on the ground to stop the beating. After the sons released him, Saetern retrieved a Russian SKS rifle, loaded it and shot his wife and his two sons, killing all three. Saetern also shot at his 12-year-old daughter, but missed as she ran out of the house with her 6-year-old sister and cousin. Saetern tried to flee the scene, but responding deputies apprehended him in his garage with the murder weapon.

Saetern was previously found incompetent to stand trial and sent to Napa Mental State Hospital on two different occasions. After several years at Napa, Saetern was returned to Sacramento and found competent to stand trial. After the jury found Saetern guilty, the court found Saetern was legally sane at the time of the murders.

Saetern faces a maximum potential sentence of 150 years to life in prison, plus life without the possibility of parole. Sentencing is set for May 20, 2016, at 10:00 a.m. in Department 41 before the Honorable Helena Gweon. ★

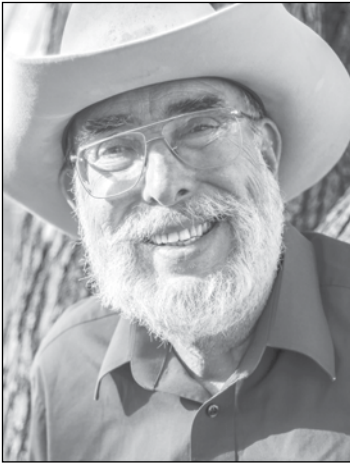

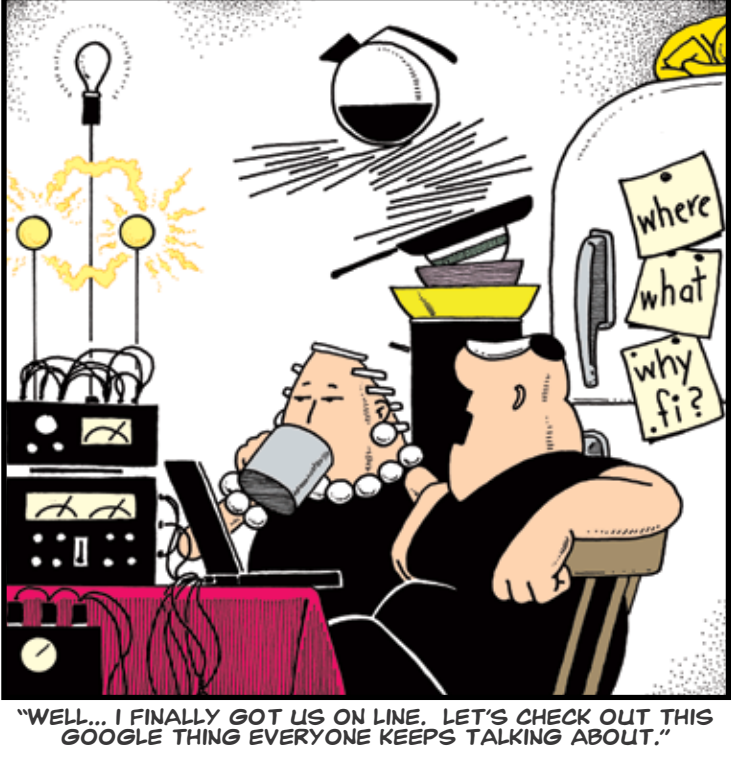

Lady Lancers Outhit by Opponents

RANCHO CORDOVA, CA (MPG) - To close out the second half of Sierra Valley Conference action on Monday, the Cordova High School softball team played at rival Rosemont.

One of the Lady Lancers’ big hits in the game was a home run off the bat of Mason Pittaro in the sixth inning. But that came after the host Wolverines did their damage that led to a 7-2 victory.

Cordova (4-5 in the SVC, 8-10 overall) had four hits in the game. But Rosemont finished with 10.

“We couldn’t match up against Rosemont (on Monday),” said Cordova head coach Tracy Cole, whose Lancers defeated the Wolverines 8-3 on April 13th.

Rosemont, which is battling Cordova for the conference’s third and final playoff spot, scored five runs in the bottom of the first inning. The last two runs came in the bottom of the fifth, prior to Pittaro’s blast.

Other Cordova hitters contributing in Monday’s game in Sacramento were Traci Mahony, Kai’lee Cole and Samantha Lutman, all of whom had one hit each.

Going into Wednesday’s road game at Galt, the Lancers are

in fourth place but one game behind the Wolverines for the final playoff spot. The SVC sends three teams into the Sacramento Section playoffs that start next month. Union Mine sits in first place at 10-0 and Liberty Ranch is second at 6-3.

Cordova has six games left, including a make-up game against El Dorado that was postponed due to rain. Tracy Cole estimated that his team needs to win four of the six games, if not all, to secure the final playoff spot.

“We just got to get (the wins),” Cole said.

Union Mine 11, Cordova 1

In an SVC home game on April 20th, the visiting Diamondbacks banged out 16 hits against the Lady Lancers, who had only five. Union Mine also benefited from

three Cordova errors.

At the plate, the Lancers, who scored their only run in the bottom of the third inning when Union Mine led 4-0, were led by Pittaro, who had two of the team’s hits. One of her hits was a double. Kai’lee Cole and Vanessa Cain, along with Lancer teammate Nikki Jones, had one hit each.

Four of the D’backs’ hits came off the bat of Shyanne Winje. In the circle, Union Mine pitcher

Beth Hammer struck out five Lancer batters.

After Wednesday’s road game at Galt, Cordova will host Liberty Ranch today, Friday. Game time is scheduled for 4 p.m.

The third meeting between Cordova and El Dorado is scheduled for Wednesday, May 4th in Placerville. Game time is also scheduled for 4 p.m. According to Tracy Cole, no date has been set for the make-up game. ★

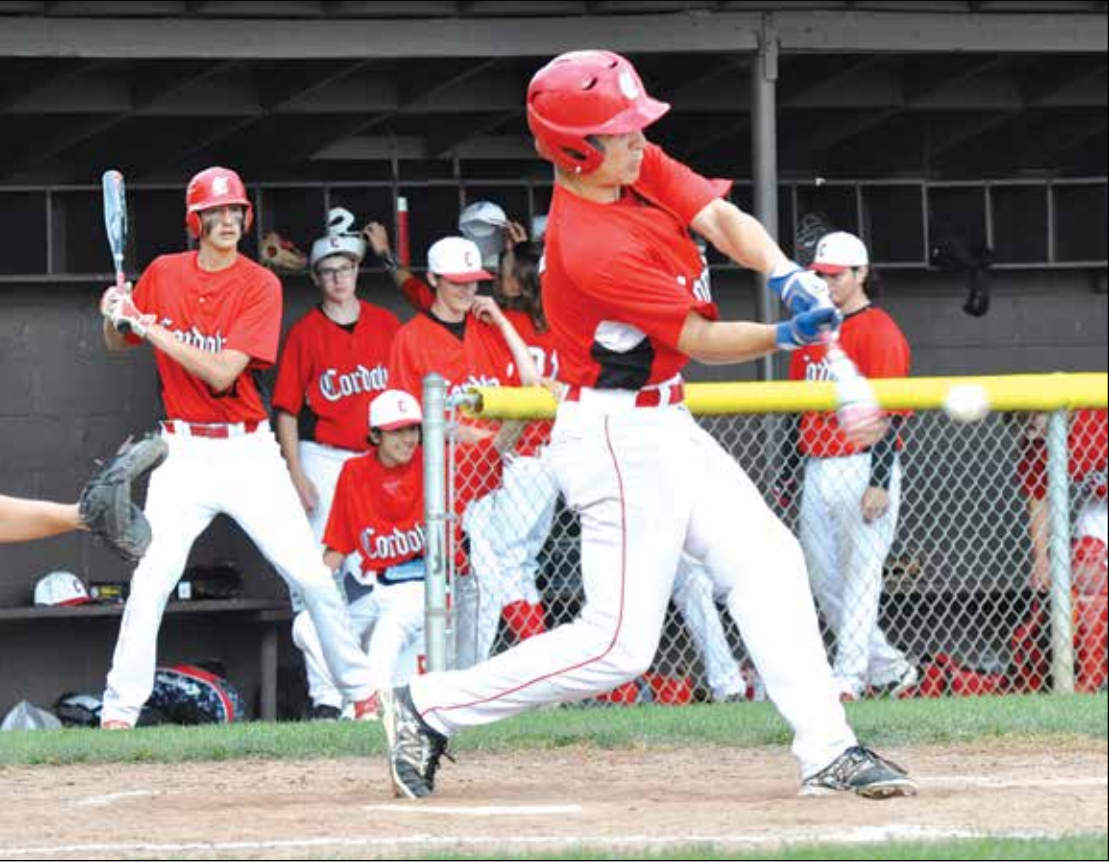

RANCHO CORDOVA, CA (MPG) - At the start of last week, the Cordova High School baseball team was in the thick of the race to grab one of the Sierra Valley Conference’s three playoff spots.

‘State of the Air’ Report Shows Progress in Greater Sacramento Region

SACRAMENTO REGION, CA (MPG) - The American Lung Association State of the Air 2016 released recently found that the Sacramento region continues to make significant gains in reducing pollution, reporting fewer particle pollution days and the lowest ever unhealthy ozone days.

“The State of the Air 2016 report shows us that our clean air laws are working but we must increase our efforts to cut pollution that puts lives in our community at risk,” said Olivia J. (Gertz) Diaz-Lapham, President and CEO of the American Lung Association in California. “Pollution from petroleum fuels and other sources is harming our residents, contributing to the incidence of asthma and other chronic lung conditions. Air pollution costs our communities in health care spending, lost productivity, reduced quality and length of life.”

Covering air pollution data collected in 2012 to 2014, the report measures the two most widespread pollutants, ozone and particle pollution, which are dangerous to public health and can be deadly. Unhealthy ozone days have fallen by 53 percent, and unhealthy spikes in particle pollution have fallen by 76 percent over the course of the State of the Air.

Moreover, annual particle pollution levels have dropped by 23 percent. These improvements were driven by passenger vehicle and diesel emission controls, along with strong local wood burning restrictions. The Sacramento metropolitan region includes El Dorado, Nevada, Placer, Sacramento, Sutter, Yolo and Yuba counties.

Despite these improvements, more still needs to be done as all counties in the region except Yolo County received a failing grade for ozone pollution, and both Placer and Sacramento failed for daily particle pollution. Drought weather conditions, combined with ongoing traffic, diesel and wood smoke pollution contribute to high levels of pollution in the region.

Climate change is a growing threat to air quality in California. Drought weather conditions and wildfires related to climate change are contributing to elevated levels of particle pollution in the San Joaquin Valley and other areas of the state. Key sources of soot include wood burning devices, transportation sources such as diesel engines in trucks, buses and freight, and smoke from wildfires. These soot particles are so small that they can lodge deep in the lungs and trigger asthma attacks, heart attacks and strokes, and can even be lethal. In the Sacramento region, more than 200,000 residents have asthma, including 52,000 children.

“Sacramento continues to have air quality challenges but we are making progress in cleaning up the air. We know that climate change factors are contributing to increased levels of ozone and particle pollution, and will make it harder to meet federal health-based standards,” said David Tom Cooke, MD, Head of the UC Davis Section of General Thoracic Surgery and member of the Lung Association’s volunteer governing board. “Our most vulnerable loved ones, including children and seniors and those battling lung diseases such as lung cancer, asthma, chronic bronchitis, or emphysema, suffer the greatest. We must redouble our efforts to transition off of fossil fuels for transportation and energy generation by investing in zero emissions solutions.”

To address the challenge of air pollution and climate change, the American Lung Association in California and major health and medical organizations urge the public and policy leaders to strongly support the federal Clean Air Act and the federal Clean Power Plan as well as California’s strong clean energy and clean air policies. This year the lung association is also calling for support of Senate Bill 1383 (Lara) to set clear targets for reducing “super pollutants” like black carbon from diesel

exhaust and wood burning that threaten public health locally and are accelerating climate change.

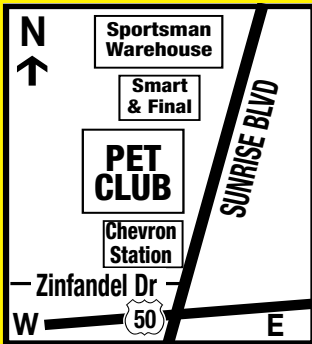
