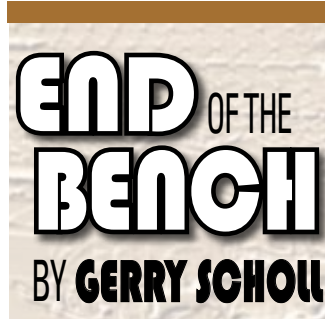

Protecting State Park Trademarks

Assemblymen Ken Cooley,
Adam Gray, and Frank Bigelow
Unite to Introduce New Legislation

RANCHO CORDOVA, CA (MPG) - Assemblyman Ken Cooley (D-Rancho Cordova), Assemblyman Adam Gray (D-Merced), and Assemblyman Frank Bigelow (R-O'Neals) announced recently the AB 2249 bill in response to the U.S. National Park Service's dispute with its concessionaire at Yosemite National Park.

The current concessionaire has operated at the Park since 1993, but after losing its bid to renew its contract it lost its claim to the names of several landmarks—which have existed for many decades more than the current contract—as its intellectual property. Unable to resolve the dispute, the National Park Service has re-named several historic landmarks.

On March 1st, the Ahwahnee Hotel will become the "Majestic Yosemite Hotel," Curry Village will become "Half Dome Village," the Wawona Hotel will become "Big Trees Lodge" and Badger Pass Ski Area will become the "Yosemite Ski and Snowboard Area."

Gregory Kondos 'River Bend Park' Unveiled

RANCHO CORDOVA, CA (MPG) - The artist reception for "Unreal & Imagined," the first Cordova Community Council juried art exhibit of 2016, was graced by the special guest appearance of well-known artist Gregory Kondos. The reason for his attendance was the unveiling of a special piece of newly acquired art, which will be on permanent display at Rancho Cordova City Hall.

According to Kondos's wife Moni, Mayor David Sander wished to have a reprint of Gregory Kondos's work "River Bend Park" after seeing a poster for Eppie's Great Race which featured the image. Marcy Friedman owns the original painting, and Gregory Kondos keeps rights to all his work. Both Kondos and Mrs. Friedman agreed to the sharing of the image.

So the work was reproduced as a giclée, which is a process that uses fade-resistant, archival inks and archival substrates to print on large format printers. It is said to have a much longer life than other methods used for printing original works of art. The unveiling of the giclée took place

after Kondos's address to the group, and after the introduction of the artists whose works were chosen for this show. At least 37 of the 44 artists in the show were present at the reception. Sander, with the help of City Council Member Linda Budge and City Manager Cyrus Abhar, carried out the unveiling ceremony of the giclée.

Kondos is considered one of the most respected landscape painters in the United States. He came to the Sacramento area from Massachusetts at three-years-old and has lived in the Greater Sacramento Area since. "My father, he was an immigrant from Greece," Kondos said. "He had nothing. He was a barber, two bits a haircut, two bits a shave, that kind of stuff. They never saw my work, and it was sad."

Kondos knew from his youth that he would have to take personal responsibility in order to achieve something with his life. "I knew I had to scramble to make things happen and so I burnt the midnight oil and did all I could," Kondos said. "I knew I had some talent, but in what direction I didn't quite know. I realized I was a good colorist, so I really pursued the impressionists, they made sense."

Kondos studied at Sacramento City

College and later earned a bachelor's and master's degree in art at California State University, Sacramento. He taught art at Sacramento City College for 27 years and was the founder and director of the campus gallery. Kondos was recently elected to the National Academy of Design and was featured in the fall of 1998 in a PBS documentary, "A Passion for the Land."

Now 92, Kondos said he is proud of

his two children, a daughter who is head gymnastics coach at UCLA, and a son who is a space engineer. "But it's a challenge to think that at my age, retired, I can still keep working, and I do my work at home," Kondos said. "Most of my day is painting, which is great." Kondos is now working on an oil painting of Sutter's Fort, commissioned by Ron Leineke to

Manufacturing Super Soil

RANCHO CORDOVA, CA (MPG) - It is estimated that more than \$160 billion worth of food is wasted in America every year in our homes, farms, and businesses. That is 40 percent of all the food produced in the United States.

A Rancho Cordova composting program hopes to help solve the problem of this needless waste.

Salad greens, fruits, vegetables, and bread products account for most of the waste. Brit Schneider works for Rancho Cordova's Soil Born Farms as an instructor, whose goal is not only minimizing waste but also "getting food to people who need it."

Schneider hosted a free workshop at the Rancho Cordova facility to demonstrate how every household can create a composter and fill it with materials that would normally be discarded.

Composting is the process of naturally decomposing organic materials such as leaves, grass, and green kitchen scraps and turning them into what farmers and gardeners regard as "Garden Gold." When added to potting and garden soil, compost is a miracle growth supplement that will, in effect, find its way back into the food chain.

Schneider said composting is "an incredible, inexpensive tool" for saving money and getting the most out of this nation's food supply by producing "minerals and nutrients to grow healthy plants."

Composted materials need air, moisture, and a carbon-nitrogen balance (brown stuff: leaves, etc., and green stuff: green kitchen scraps, etc.). A composter should be a container which allows air to get to the scraps that will be put into it. A hardware cloth cage or a wooden frame structure with fence wire attached can hold the layers of organic materials that will fill it.

Schneider also works with children to impress upon them the value of composting. "We have composters at four elementary schools," she said.

Composting will go a long way toward solving the problem of wasted food. "Instead of going into landfills, it goes into the soil," Schneider said.

The composting workshop is just one of many agriculture-based demonstrations offered by the Rancho Cordova program.

Protecting State Park Trademarks

Assemblymen Ken Cooley, Adam Gray, and Frank Bigelow Unite to Introduce New Legislation

AB 2249 ensures nothing of the same occurs in a California state park. To keep concessionaires from co-opting state landmarks, this bill adds to state law a prohibition on concessionaires claiming ownership of a name associated with a California state park and declares such a claim disqualifies any bidders from future contracts if they attempt such trademark claims.

“AB 2249 clarifies that in our state parks, an awarded food or lodging contract does not entitle the concessionaire to any legal claim of a trademark,” said Assemblyman Cooley. “Moreover, this bill would disqualify them from further consideration as a bidder if they made any such statement.”

“Our state parks are not like football or baseball stadiums, trading sponsorship deals to the highest bidder,” said Assemblyman Gray. “The people of California protect and preserve these landmarks as a part of our history, and it is the people of California who own their storied names.”

“I have the privilege of representing Yosemite National Park and know first-hand how treasured these landmarks are by the people of our state,” said Assemblyman Bigelow. “I’m proud to co-author

AB 2249 to protect historic sites up and down California.”

California’s Yosemite National Park is on the short list of America’s most magnificent parks and is filled with historic landmarks built decades ago—some date back to the 19th century. The Ahwahnee Hotel was built in the 1920s in a valley meadow with the sheer granite of Half Dome as its backdrop; its filing for the National Register of Historic Places explains its name comes from a local Native American word meaning “deep, grassy meadow.” Nearby Curry Village is named after the couple

who established a summer camp there in 1899. The Wawona Hotel, in the southwest corner of Yosemite National Park, was originally constructed 140 years ago, in 1876. All three were placed on the National Register of Historic Places in the 1970s.

“Our state parks showcase the beauty and incredible history of California, and should always serve the interests of the people,” said Assemblyman Cooley. “This bill is a small but vital act to protect our parks for many future generations of Californians to enjoy.”

I had a conversation with a teenager the other day, and even with computers, iPads, smart phones, televisions that may be watching you as much as you watch them, cars that can drive themselves, and all the other modern technology that surrounds us, there is one thing that apparently hasn't changed. Today, just like yesterday, some teenagers are bullies and they threaten others teenagers who happen to be doing no more than being in the wrong place at the wrong time. It is also sad that the news media focuses on violence much more than focusing on compromise. Top RC Volunteers to Be Honored

RANCHO CORDOVA, CA (MPG) - Al Rogel, a longtime Rancho Cordova volunteer who began service during World War II and at age 90 is still going strong, will be honored as the Rancho Cordovan of the Year on March 11th during the 17th Annual Community Volunteer Awards hosted by the Cordova Community Council.

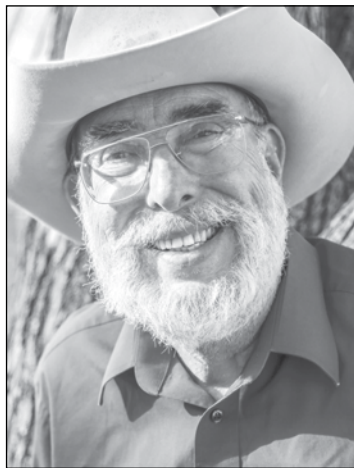

According to one released cable from 2009, the embassy in Spain sought “high-level U.S. government intervention” at the “urgent

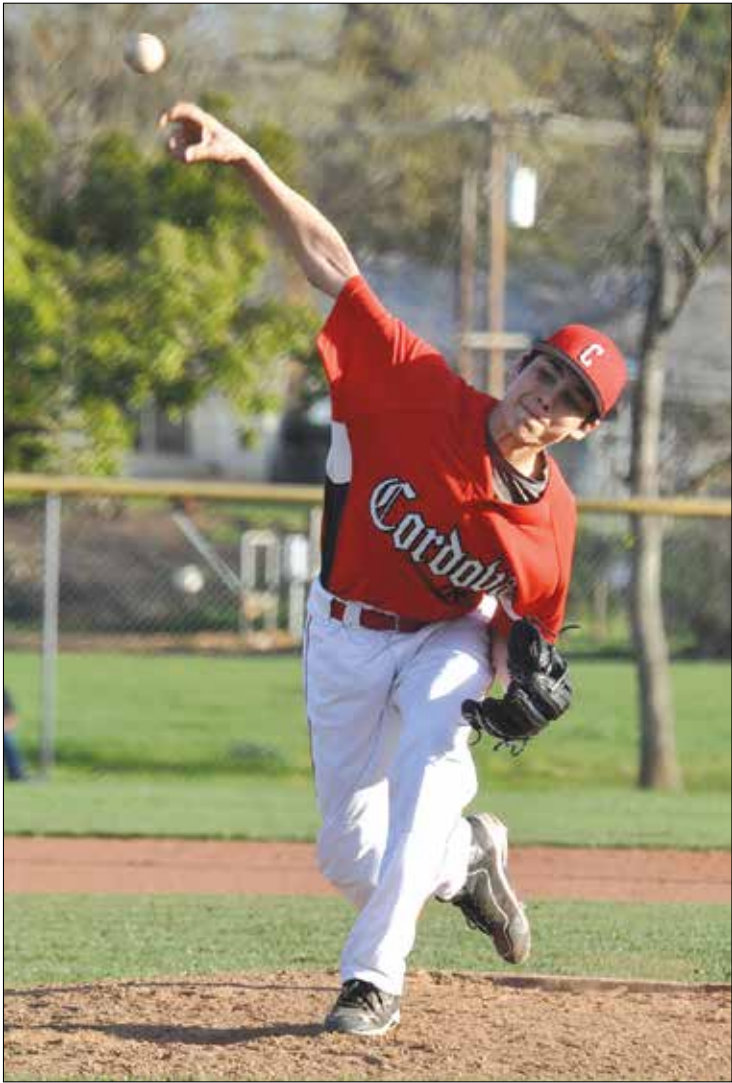

"Family is the most important thing," said Doug Hughes. For the last 20 years, Hughes has been on the diamond. He started coaching baseball at Terra Nova High School in

Hughes has 20 players on the Lancers' squad: 10 returning and 10 newcomers. There is no junior varsity team this year.

Newcomers are Jacob Larson, Nick Ravareau, Chris Wheat, Dylan Gates, Ryan Tipton, Trevor Ready, Austin Smith, Matt Williams, Alan Aguilar, and Elias Acevedo.

Hughes feels the strengths of this year's team are defense and speed.

"We are going to have to play small ball," Hughes said.

"A lot of stealing, bunting, and hit-and-run."

Learning new schemes has grown with each practice, Hughes noted.

"We are still trying to get to know each other," Hughes said. "I'm trying to learn their strengths and weaknesses and who can play different positions. The players are still trying to learn my terminology, defensive, and offensive strategy. I'm happy with their progress."

Hughes feels Sierra Valley Conference foes, Galt and El Dorado, who won the conference title last spring, are the teams to beat. But he's not looking past other SVC foes: Rosemont, Liberty Ranch, and Union Mine.

"Anyone can be beaten on any given day," Hughes said.

Lancer baseball fans are encouraged to watch this spring's squad.

"Cordova fans can expect to see a team that plays hard, never quits, leaves it all on the field, has fun, plays as a team, and plays for each other," Hughes said.

On Feb. 27th, Cordova opened its season on the road with a 3-2 loss to West Campus in 10 innings.

The Lancers played their first home game of the season against Sierra of Manteca. The visiting Timberwolves produced a 10-2 win, as Cordova is now 0-2.

On Wednesday, Cordova hosted Burbank in another non-league game.

Next week the Lancers have three games in three days. The first game is next Tuesday at Franklin of Stockton. Next Wednesday Cordova plays at Inderkum. Both games start at 3:30 p.m.

Then the Lancers start SVC action at home against Union Mine on Thursday, March 10th. Game time is scheduled for 4 p.m. ★

Lancer Basketball Season Ends in Playoffs

RANCHO CORDOVA, CA (MPG) - After winning a Sac-Joaquin Section Division III outbracket home playoff game, the Cordova High School boys basketball team hit the road for its next game.

But the Lancers' season came to an abrupt end in Stockton on Feb. 24th. That's when No. 1 seed Weston Ranch wasted little time in producing a 75-39 victory.

In the first quarter, the No. 16 Lancers watched the host Cougars race to a 27-11 lead thanks to Cordova turnovers.

"We just did not shoot the ball well," said Cordova head coach Fletcher Johnson.

But in the second quarter, Cordova (17-12) closed the scoring gap when wing player Jose Hernandez came off the bench and scored six points. That was followed by Lancer guard Joseph Gomez, who canned a 3-pointer to cut the Cougars' lead to 33-22.

"We made a little run in the second quarter and then they (Weston Ranch) called a timeout," Johnson said.

The Cougars went on a 14-3 run to build their lead to 47-25. In the third quarter, Weston Ranch outscored the Lancers, 23-6 for a 60-31 advantage and ultimate win.

Although the season has ended for Johnson and company, there were bright moments this season. The seven seniors on this year's team—Damion Baldwin, DeAnte

Wilkins, Kyle Lorena, Gomez, Ben Danielyan, William Moore, and DeReginald Walker—finished their prep careers with back-to-back winning records that included winning the Sierra Valley Conference title last season.

Cordova took second place in the SVC with an 8-2 mark behind conference champions Liberty Ranch, which 29-0 and remains alive in the section's D-IV playoffs as of Wednesday night. The last two seasons, Cordova has a combined SVC record of 18-2.

In addition, the Lancers also won the Cordova Christmas Classic last December.

"Not a bad way to finish out their career," Johnson said.

Wilkins led the team in scoring with averaging 14 points per game. He was followed by another guard in Jason Novik, only a junior who averaged 10.5 per game. On top of that, players on the Cordova junior varsity boys basketball squad that posted a 21-6 record make the move to the varsity level.

"I'm very excited about what's coming up," Johnson said. ★

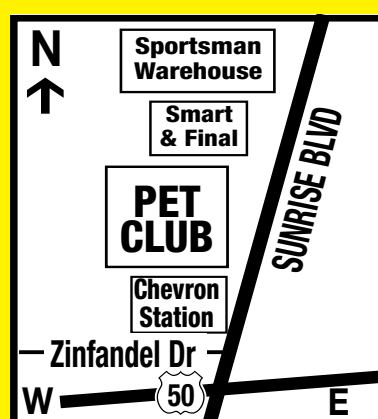
