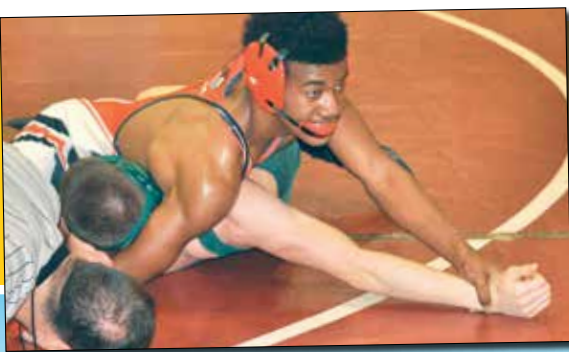

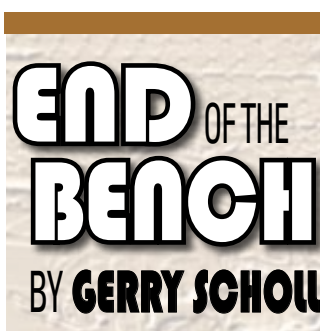

## First Block Grant Meeting Held

*Residents Shared Opinions on How \$2.5 Million Should Be Spent*

**RANCHO CORDOVA, CA (MPG)** - In the first of what is to be a series of meetings, Rancho Cordova officials met with city residents to outline the requirements for applying to receive a portion of the anticipated \$2.5 million in U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) block grant funds.

While that sounds like a lot of money, the sum shrinks significantly when it is spread out over the next five years and split many ways in Rancho Cordova's Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) program. Add to that the cliff-hanging fact that the funds have not yet been officially approved by Congress. However, Rancho Cordova Housing and Neighborhood Development Analyst Peter Ibrahim said it is expected that Washington will follow through on the commitment.

Local Government Consultant Jessica Hayes outlined HUD's requirements for

receiving and using the funds. Only non-profits may apply and those must meet rigid guidelines. It is difficult to become eligible and the follow-up procedure is even more demanding. HUD insists that the money be effectively spent toward achieving the goals stated in the original application.

Organizations that have benefitted from the federal program in the past were: Meals On Wheels; Sacramento Self-Help Housing; The Respite CLUB and the Folsom-Cordova Community Partnership.

Meals on Wheels provided 146 seniors with 15,679 meals during the previous round of funding. The Respite CLUB was able to provide day care to 24 seniors with Alzheimer's and other memory-related conditions.

According to Rancho Cordova Community Development Director Aaron Busch, HUD would prefer to award its funds to "agencies that have proven their ability to use the funds and meet the requirements." That does not mean that

other agencies do not have a chance, but they need to be aware that they do have a long road ahead.

It is a HUD rule that no more than 15 percent of any funds received may be spent on public services. Twenty percent may be applied to administrative services, and the remaining 65 percent to capital improvement projects.

Federal funds alone will not support the entire missions of all of the programs receiving aid from Washington. Most will partner with other organizations and funding sources to fulfill their individual goals.

Following the presentation, Jessica Hayes called on those present to build on the best of what Rancho Cordova can already be proud of and to make suggestions as to what is still needed. High on the wish list was street lights to promote after-dark safety. Longtime city resident Robert Cashatt compared Rancho Cordova at night to "London during the blitz," a reference to

## Free Tax Help Available for Rancho Cordova Families

**RANCHO CORDOVA, CA (MPG)** - Local households that earned \$54,000 or less in 2015 can receive free tax help at two Rancho Cordova sites through the Sacramento Coalition for Working Families, the local Volunteer Income Tax Assistance effort led by United Way. Help is available through the end of March at the Department of Human Assistance, 10013 Folsom Boulevard, on Tuesdays and Thursdays from 5 to 8 p.m. and Saturdays 9 a.m. to 1 p.m., and at the Folsom Cordova Community Partnership, 10665 Coloma Road, on Saturdays from 9 a.m. to 1 p.m.

"We want to make sure as many households as possible in the Sacramento area are financially stable, and that starts with not spending unnecessary money on tax preparation and making sure they receive the maximum refund to which they are entitled," said Stephanie Bray, United Way California Capital Region president and CEO.

IRS-certified volunteers will provide free basic tax return preparation with electronic filing and inform taxpayers about special tax credits for which they may qualify, such as the federal and state Earned Income Tax Credits, Child Tax Credit, and the Credit for the Elderly or the Disabled. Households that made \$62,000 or less in 2015 can qualify to file their state and federal taxes online for free at MyFreeTaxes.com, thanks to a national partnership between United Way, Goodwill Industries and the National Disability Institute. The website helps people save an average of \$200 in tax preparer fees, guiding users through federal and state filing using software powered by H&R Block. Users will need a valid email address and income forms. The eight-year-old program is available in all 50 states.

Both the in-person and online filing opportunities are designed to help households receive the maximum Earned Income Tax Credits of \$6,000, now available federally and through the state. This is the first year that California is offering a state Earned Income Tax Credit to benefit California's working families, increase use of the federal credit, and increase availability of free tax preparation services.

United Way California Capital Region is leading the Sacramento Coalition for Working Families as part of its work to ensure more households in the capital region are financially stable and self-sufficient. Partners include California State Board of Equalization, City of Sacramento, Community Housing Opportunities Corporation, Folsom Cordova Community Partnership, Goodwill Industries of Sacramento Valley & Northern Nevada, Sacramento County Department of Human Assistance, SEIU Local 1000, SAFE Credit Union, Sacramento Food Bank & Family Services, Grant Union High School, Hiram Johnson High School and

**RANCHO CORDOVA, CA (MPG)** - On Feb. 1st, D Neath spoke at Rancho Cordova City Hall to the first meeting of Rancho Cordova's community arts group, in the first of the Art Speaker Series.

Rancho Cordova Art For Everyone, also known as RCAFE is a new group fed and nurtured by a small steering group of artists and volunteers who have been involved in the Cordova Community Council art shows and other local artist activities. The small group has had a key role in the development of artists and their activities in this area.

"We have a lot of emerging

artists here, they want to know how do I show, how do I frame, how do I price?" said group member, artist, and art teacher Victoria Smith. One thing the group thought of was to educate by having speakers, and D Neath was the first person Smith thought of. "She knows everybody, sees everybody, she's been around a long time, and she's so cute when she speaks; she's so entertaining."

Neath started working for Michael Himovitz Gallery more than 30 years ago at the age of 19. "It was the gallery here in Sacramento at the time," Neath said. She opened Archival Framing in 1983, though she had no formal art education, and no degrees. "I spent

10 years learning everything I could by working at the best galleries in town,” Smith said. “I was really lucky to find out what I love when I was really young. Through the Michael Himovitz Gallery I met some artists who have become world renowned since then and I still maintain friendships with them.”

Neath is the art curator of the KVIE Channel 6 Art Auction, and co-originator of Sacramento’s Second Saturday, which focuses on an evening of open house for art galleries and shops. Her Archival Framing and Gallery is well known in the arts community. She is also one of the founders of Chalk-It-Up sidewalk art festival in Sacramento.

At the RCAFE meeting,

Neath spoke for nearly an hour and shared a lot of practical advice and down-to-earth knowledge.

On getting your work out there: “I know a lot of you feel like: ‘How do I apply to a gallery? How do I get my stuff shown? I’ve got a garage full of masterpieces, and the only ones to see them are my husband and my cat.’ And the only way to do that is by getting involved in the community as a whole... Those little shops where people are in and out, in and out, there’s nothing wrong with approaching them and saying, ‘You’ve got some nice white walls here. We’ll put it up, all you’ve got to do is host my friends, we’ll have a little opening, and you can list in the Bee for free, as long as it’s something that changes

every month.’ I encourage you to start looking in Rancho for those spaces.”

On pricing: “Raise your prices really slowly. Because once you’ve established your price, if I bought your piece and it’s \$500, and I walk into a gallery and the same size piece is now \$250, I made a really bad art investment and I’m never going to buy another piece of yours again. Art doesn’t go on sale, people. This is not Walmart.”

The Art Speaker Series, Smith said, will probably start out with a total of three speakers in 2016, and then the group will reassess for the coming year. WWII when all lights were turned off at night in the British capital, throwing the entire city in total darkness to confound German bombing runs.

Another resident suggested public education programs, including a gun safety course. Business incubators was another idea offered.

Jessica Hayes said feedback accumulated at the series of public meetings will be used “to develop a strategy to address the needs identified through public meetings, the community survey,

and data from the U.S. Census Bureau.”

The local government consultant praised Rancho Cordova’s “can-do” attitude at the city government level as well as residents.” Unanimous among those who attended the meeting was admiration for the continuing efforts of City Council in making Rancho Cordova the best it can be.

When all the decisions have been made, officials plan to submit the completed document by the HUD due date of May 15th, 2016. ★

# And Another Thing ...

## Concerning the Zika Virus

virus is mainly transmitted to humans by the bite of infected Aedes mosquito species, specifically Aedes aegypti and Aedes albopictus. Some evidence suggests Zika virus can also be transmitted through blood transfusion and sexual transmission. The news media has been focusing on the evidence that the virus can also be transmitted through perinatal transmission and has shown that it could affect the size of a baby's head and affect the baby's brain development. That may happen if the mother is infected while pregnant. More investigation is definitely needed on those other modes of infection. Here are suggestions about ways to protect yourself and your family from mosquitoes:

- Always report any unusual number of mosquitoes especially if they are aggressive daytime biting mosquitoes.
- Drain and dump any unnecessary items that could hold water around your home and property.
- Cover empty containers with a lid or place under a roof that does not allow them to fill with water.
- Clean and scrub bird baths and pet bowls weekly.

- Dump the water from plant saucers regularly.
- Check that gutters are not holding water and cover rain barrels with tight screen so that mosquitoes cannot enter.

The best way to protect yourself from mosquito transmitted diseases is to avoid mosquito bites when going outdoors. Apply EPA registered insect repellents such as those containing DEET, picaridin, oil of lemon eucalyptus, and IR3535. These will provide effective protection against mosquito bites when used properly.

I think one of the suggestions that are provided by the Sacramento-Yolo Mosquito & Vector Control Board that I haven't thought of for a while is standing water in the gutters of our homes. That suggestion and others are part of the list I provided above. It only takes a few days for the mosquitoes to lay their eggs, and for the new mosquitoes to fly away, looking for breakfast, lunch, dinner, in other words you!

And another thing, even though it is late I hope everyone had a Happy Valentine's Day!

# Scalia and the Constitution

I had the great privilege to hear Supreme Court Justice Antonin Scalia speak on three separate occasions and once to meet him in person after hearing him announce a decision. You can learn a lot about someone by reading his or her work, but some things have to be seen to be fully understood. Scalia was known for his public role as an associate justice and a staunch originalist. But he should be appreciated for much more than that—as a man with a genuinely wonderful sense of humor, as a man who loved his family, and who loved God. However, most of us only really know Scalia through his public work on the Supreme Court, and his insightful, sometimes biting opinions.

Scalia was an originalist but he was very careful to define what he meant by that. To understand the Constitution as an originalist did not mean reading it strictly, or narrowly, or as a Republican—it meant recognizing that the Constitution was written by 18th century men in a particular time, context, and with a particular meaning. As an example, Scalia noted that if it were not cruel and unusual in the 1790s to sentence a convicted

murder to the death penalty, then the Constitution’s ban on cruel and unusual punishment in the Eighth Amendment should not be read as banning the death penalty. That, for Scalia, was an easy question for an originalist to answer.

There are much harder questions and Scalia would have been among the first to recognize that originalism has its weaknesses. He once wrote an essay titled “Originalism: The Lesser Evil.” But he long maintained that it was, quite literally, the only possible way of reading the Constitution for two important reasons. First, originalism requires careful historical and legal reasoning to determine what the terms and language of the Constitution meant when it was written. As Scalia loved to say, that sort of research is literally the only thing lawyers are particularly good at. The second reason Scalia said originalism was essential is because to read it any other way, as a living document or an aspirational text, is to expect lawyers to be something quite different than what they are—to expect them to be moral philosophers or policy makers. And really, Scalia asked with a twinkle in his eye, who would pick nine lawyers to be moral philosophers?

For Scalia, the only justification for the Supreme Court’s power of judicial review to strike down laws that violate the Constitution is that the Constitution has a specific meaning that we can know. If not, there is a real problem. By what authority can the Supreme Court strike down a democratically passed law, if not by an appeal to a specific, clear meaning of the Constitution?

That is why Scalia said

that moving to any method of interpretation other than originalism would, in the end, destroy the Constitution. If justices are not bound to a specific understanding of the Constitution, we should not pick them on their legal qualifications. We should pick them based on their politics. Scalia was confirmed to the court unanimously in 1986, despite being known as a

thing, and candidates should be evaluated on their record and method of interpretation. Moreover, no justice has been appointed and confirmed in an election year since 1940. Senator Schumer, in his rush to insist Republicans rubber stamp Obama’s appointee, has apparently forgotten his own promise in 2007 when George W. Bush was president, that “We should

conservative. He liked to say that would never happen now, because the Senate has realized if they are not picking originalist judges, they are picking people to be judges who will behave rather like senators.

Given the politicized nature of the Supreme Court, it is no surprise that Washington is already squabbling over Scalia’s replacement, less than 48 hours after his death. Democrats are already declaring that Republicans are duty bound to confirm Obama’s replacement. Senator Chuck Schumer has been particularly insistent on this. But this is nonsense. Democrats have made it quite clear in the 30 years since Scalia was confirmed that a confirmation hearing is no longer a sure

reverse the presumption of confirmation.”

Scalia was right about the danger that the appointment of justices to the Supreme Court would be politicized if the court itself came to be seen as a political instrument. That, I think, is why it is so important that Scalia’s successor think about the Constitution as Antonin Scalia did: that is, as a document with a knowable, if imperfect, historical meaning—as an originalist.

## Taxpayers Aren’t Propping up Big Pharma

Like your iPhone? Federal officials designed it. Couldn’t live without the Internet? Thank Uncle Samhe invented it. Sick and need a new medicine? Don’t worry—the government is here to help.

This fantastical line of thinking—that because the government funded basic, early-stage research, it can claim credit for a final product decades later—underpins the latest calls for more federal control of drug prices. Such calls are grossly ill-informed and demonstrate a deep misunderstanding of the drug development process.

And if lawmakers listen to them, they could prove deadly.

With rare exceptions, the National Institutes of Health doesn’t create new medicines, nor does the government cut checks to pharmaceutical companies. Less than 10 percent of all new drugs—and less than 20 percent of the most innovative “priority-review” drugs—are patented by public-sector developers.

Instead, the NIH funds and conducts important but extremely early stage scientific research that may prove useful—or may not. For instance, NIH researchers might seek to

discover the structure of a protein found in the brains of Alzheimer’s patients. They’re not looking to create a medicine—just to better understand the possible cause of a disease.

Sometimes, the NIH’s research points the way to potential avenues of treatment.

Biopharmaceutical firms, large and small alike, then run with the NIH’s findings to research possible new medicines.

Small biotech start-ups are particularly good at this sort of technical work. But they often lack the financial wherewithal to conduct giant clinical trials and navigate the tremendously expensive, distressingly complex and lengthy process that leads to final FDA approval. Large biopharmaceutical companies can provide that kind of support, which is why the biggest pharmaceutical companies constantly purchase start-ups.

But even this later-stage research and testing is far from a fait accompli. Many pending drugs are removed from development or clinical trials when they don’t meet expectations.

Eli Lilly recently removed evacetrapid, a drug once considered extremely promising for treating cardiovascular disease, from late clinical trials. These failures represent hundreds of millions of dollars in lost investment.

Despite such setbacks, the pharmaceutical development system is working. In recent years, U.S. firms have produced over half of the world’s new prescription drugs.

Drug development is a symbiotic chain, with each link—the National Institutes of Health, the smaller biotech firms, and the large biopharmaceutical companies—supporting each other.

Federal interference in drug pricing, such as through the price caps and controls, would break this chain. Indeed, a National Bureau of Economic Research study concludes that reducing drug prices by 40 to 50 percent will cause new early stage R&D projects to decline by 30 to 60 percent.

If biopharmaceutical companies can’t earn a return on their investments, they won’t invest in the research or clinical trials that yield new drugs. That means fewer new treatments.

The NIH doesn’t focus on drug development—and doesn’t have the infrastructure or know-how to develop actual medicines. Less investment would mean fewer new treatments.

If lawmakers opt for short-term savings via price controls, America will lose its preeminence in biopharmaceutical research, and patients will lose out on dozens of new medicines that are never created and that provide hope and cures for diseases for patients now and in the future. That’s one disaster the government would be able to take credit for.
