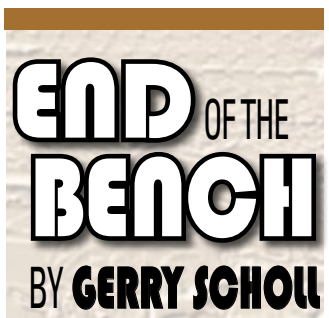

# Children Give Back to Cordova Meadows

Thirty-six students at Cordova Meadows Elementary School (at left) and Keep Cordova Meadows Beautiful group members participated in a cleanup event around the school.

**RANCHO CORDOVA, CA (MPG)** - Arabelle Stremel is one of 36 students at Cordova Meadows Elementary School who participated in a clean-up event around the school.

The students partnered with local residents to collect 400 gallons of trash, clear storm drains from leaves and debris, and learn how to keep the environment safe and clean.

Arabelle is concerned about trash in the neighborhood "because it sometimes pollutes our area, and hurts the animals." She learned that it is

important "to keep her neighborhood, house, and school clean." Arabelle wants to take another field trip that cleans up the community and is fun for the students.

The idea for the neighborhood cleanup was brainstormed by parents who live in the West La Loma apartments. The group of parents is part of the City of Rancho Cordova's Community Engagement Program, a process of building relationships between neighbors and drawing upon existing community strengths to build stronger, more sustainable

communities for the future.

The parents have children at Cordova Meadows Elementary and engaged with Principal Joseph Piazza to form a partnership. He identified a fourth grade class to participate in the cleanup effort.

"I hope that we feel proud today," said Principal Piazza at the event. "We accomplished something significant for our neighborhood, our school, and the students who participated. Thank you for the quality preparation."

The City works with the

residents in West La Loma in collaboration with the Keep Cordova Meadows Beautiful group to help organize and support community projects—such as the neighborhood cleanup—with resident leadership. The residents have learned to know their neighbors, identify their hopes and dreams for their neighborhood, and create a more inviting community to live in.

# Obamacare Co-Op Failures

## Majority of Co-Ops Have Collapsed Over the Past Two Years

**SACRAMENTO REGION, CA (MPG)** - President Obama may be able to veto attempts to repeal the Affordable Care Act (ACA), but the question is: can he forestall the eventual collapse of Obamacare due to financial mismanagement.

Recent news reports have focused on the enormous economic pressure under which Obamacare is operating, including the announcement by regulators in New York that the state’s Health Republic health care co-op is under investigation.

Regulators there are looking into charges that Health Republic underreported its debt and that it misrepresented its financial viability. The co-op is the largest of 23 such insurance providers that were established across the U.S. under the ACA. Thirteen of these co-ops, including Health Republic, have gone under over the past two years.

“It is estimated that the Health Republic debacle will cost tax payers \$355 million. The Obama administration provided an initial \$265 million for the establishment of the co-op and then an additional \$90 million in emergency funding,” according to Dan Weber, president of the Association of Mature American Citizens. “So much for reducing health insurance costs.”

The co-ops were among the Obamacare insurance companies being touted as examples of the success of the health care law in providing the kind of competition that would result in lower premiums across the board. Many of them exceeded their enrollment projections and then they failed because they got their customers by low-balling

premiums, according to the Wall Street Journal.

“You don’t have to be a bankruptcy specialist on par with Donald Trump to understand that loading up on clients who are consuming health care but aren’t paying close to full freight is unsustainable,” the Journal explained in an article this week.

Weber pointed out that the country, as a whole, will feel the impact of the collapse of the co-ops because taxpayers are picking up the tab. But those dependent on Obamacare for health care coverage will be hit the hardest because the co-op failures are, at least in part, responsible for the spike in 2016 Obamacare premiums.

“Of course, those who purchased health care insurance from co-op providers, particularly the poorest among

them, will be hurt the most, despite the claim that the ACA would make health insurance affordable. In the case of New York’s Health Republic, hundreds of thousands of policy holders were told on Oct. 30th that they had just about a month to find a new provider at new rates.”

# Solo Vehicle Collision Results in Fatal Injuries to Driver

- On Nov. 21st, 2015 at approximately 4:50 a.m., Clinton Gregory Tovar (28) of Rancho Cordova, was driving a 1999 Ford Mustang on the transition road from southbound I-5 to eastbound I-80. As the vehicle entered the on-ramp to eastbound I-80, Mr. Tovar lost control

of the vehicle and the vehicle struck a traffic sign. The vehicle continued out of control down an embankment and the driver’s side door of the vehicle struck a tree. The impact of the vehicle and the tree caused fatal injuries to Mr. Tovar. He was pronounced dead at the collision scene. Mr. Tovar was not

wearing a seatbelt.

At this time, it is unknown if drugs and/or alcohol were a factor in this collision.

# Health Centers Receive Nearly \$7 million for Outreach and Enrollment

**SACRAMENTO REGION, CA (MPG)** - Recently, the Health Resources and Services Administration (HRSA) announced that 24 new California health centers will receive \$1,803,287 in awards for outreach and enrollment assistance through the Health Insurance Marketplace. These funds will support health centers’ work in raising awareness of affordable insurance options and providing eligibility and enrollment assistance to uninsured residents in their communities. Open enrollment in the Marketplace began on Nov. 1st, 2015 and runs through Jan. 31st, 2016.

“Today’s awards build upon the work health centers across the country have done over the past three years to help Californians learn about and enroll in affordable health insurance coverage,” HRSA Acting Administrator Jim Macrae said. “With these funds, California health centers will be able to ramp up efforts to reach the uninsured members of their communities during Open Enrollment.”

Nationwide, HRSA announced approximately \$7 million in awards for health center outreach and enrollment assistance to 93 health centers. These awards build on HRSA’s annual \$150 million national investment in health center outreach and enrollment activities. Since July 2013, health centers have assisted more than 12 million people with their efforts to become insured. Visit <https://localhelp.healthcare.gov/> to find out who is doing enrollment in your community and which ones have translation services.

Health centers are community-based and patient-directed organizations that serve populations with limited access to health care. They provide comprehensive, culturally competent, quality primary health care services to medically underserved communities and vulnerable populations.

Through outreach into their communities and “in reach” to their uninsured patients, health centers are helping consumers understand their coverage options, learn what financial help they may be eligible for, and enroll in new affordable health coverage options through the Marketplace, Medicaid and the Children’s Health Insurance Program.

Raising awareness is especially important because the majority of uninsured individuals don’t know about the financial assistance available through the

Marketplace. This year, about 8 out of 10 uninsured people who are eligible to enroll in health coverage through the Marketplace qualify for financial help to make their monthly premiums more affordable. More than 7 in 10 returning customers can find a plan for \$75 a month or less in premiums after advance premium tax credits.

## Invasive Mosquitoes Detected

State Public Health Officer Warns Californians of Two Specific Species

SACRAMENTO REGION, CA (MPG) -

California Department of Public Health (CDPH) Director and State Public Health Officer Dr. Karen Smith is warning Californians to protect themselves from two invasive mosquito species recently found in California. Both species can transmit infectious diseases, such as dengue fever, chikungunya, and yellow fever. This warning comes as two more counties are added to the list of counties where Aedes aegypti (the yellow fever mosquito) and Aedes albopictus (the Asian tiger mosquito) have been detected.

"It is important to know these species of mosquitoes because they are not what we're used to in California, and they can transmit diseases such as dengue fever, chikungunya, and yellow fever," Dr. Smith said. "While the risk is still low in California, infected travelers coming back to California can transmit these viruses to mosquitoes that bite them. This can lead to additional people becoming infected if they are then bitten by those mosquitoes."

In September 2015, Aedes aegypti was detected for the first time in San Bernardino and Riverside Counties. Since 2013, when this species was first discovered in Madera, Fresno, and San Mateo counties, it has been found in Tulare, Kern, Los Angeles, San Diego, Imperial, Orange, and Alameda counties. Also in September, Aedes albopictus was detected in Kern and San Diego counties and has expanded in regions of Los Angeles County.

Neither of these mosquitoes is native to California. They are

known for their black-and-white stripes, biting people during the middle of the day and readily entering buildings. The more-familiar Culex mosquitoes bite primarily at dusk and dawn.

"There is no vaccine or treatment for chikungunya or dengue fever. To prevent these diseases from becoming established in California, it is important for everyone to take steps to keep these mosquitoes from spreading" Dr. Smith said. "If you notice that you are being bitten by mosquitoes during the day, or notice black-and-white striped mosquitoes, call your local mosquito and vector control agency. Your participation in mosquito surveillance greatly aids in efforts to detect new infestations."

To prevent mosquito-borne illnesses present in California, such as West Nile virus disease, or abroad, such as chikungunya and dengue, Dr. Smith offers the following tips:

- Apply mosquito repellents containing DEET, picaridin, IR3535, and/or oil of lemon eucalyptus to your skin and clothing.
- Wear long sleeve shirts, long pants, socks and shoes when mosquitoes are most active.

- Use air conditioning, and keep mosquitoes from getting into your home by having intact window and door screens.

- Eliminate potential mosquito-breeding sources, such as water-filled containers, from around your home and where you work. Drain water that may have collected under potted plants, in bird baths and discarded tires. Check your rain gutters to make sure they aren't holding water, and clean pet water-dishes weekly.

- Aedes aegypti mosquitoes can lay eggs in containers holding as little as a teaspoon of water, and eggs, which are laid just above the water line, can survive dry conditions for months. This is why it is important to dump, drain, or eliminate unnecessary sources of standing water around your home and scrub containers to dislodge eggs.

If you travel to Mexico or other countries in Latin America, it is especially important to be aware of Aedes mosquitoes and the diseases that they can carry. This year, Mexico has had a dramatic increase in the number of chikungunya cases. So far, about one-third of the 120 chikungunya cases imported into California were contracted in Mexico, with 91 percent of cases coming from Latin America. Sixty-nine imported cases of dengue have been reported in California this year.

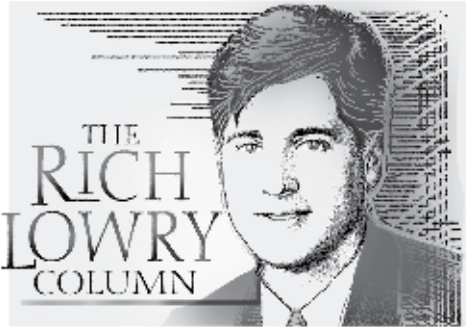
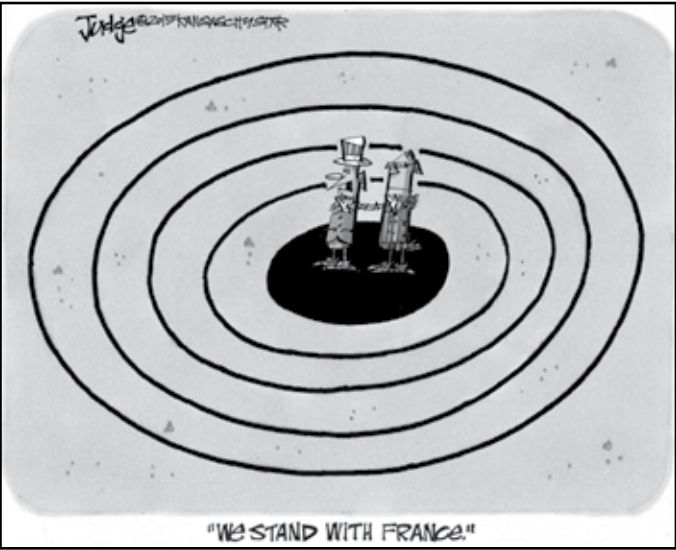

Obama’s Sanctimony on Syrian Refugees

President Barack Obama has seen the enemy, and it is the refusal to accept more Syrian refugees.

From the tone of his post-Paris remarks, you’d think that a sophisticated terrorist assault on a major Western city is a setback; sentiment in the U.S. against taking more Syrian refugees is an atrocity.

Obama warned against “that dark impulse inside of us,” as if we were debating whether Syrian refugees should be drawn and quartered. He said that “slamming the door in their faces would be a betrayal of our values.” He was joined by liberal commentators who scoffed and guffawed at worries over Syrian refugees after -- ho-hum, nothing to see here -- one of the Paris terrorists apparently posed as a refugee.

It’s remarkable that the president

feels justified in lecturing anyone on humanitarianism. He has stood by while Syria has descended into a hellish chaos, and hasn’t betrayed any guilty conscience. If you put those 10,000 Syrian refugees back in their native country and let them get gassed, barrel-bombed, shelled or shot, would he bat an eye at the ever-growing casualty count?

The Syrian refugees are most useful to the president as a symbol of his alleged cosmopolitanism and of the supposed backwardness of his opposition.

The problem with the argument that our values compel us to take refugees is that it isn’t subject to any limit. We admit about 70,000 refugees a year. Is that the American level? Or would 700,000 be more American? And what’s the balance between prudential considerations -- cost, security, assimilation -- and American-ness?

By any reasonable standard we are justified in telling Europe that we have already done our part on migration, thank you very much. According to immigration expert Jessica Vaughan, since 2009 we have accepted 70 percent of all resettled United Nations-designated refugees worldwide.

It is true that Europe at the moment faces a migrant crisis. It’s not hard to see how it can begin to handle it. First, tell Germany’s foolhardy chancellor to stop encouraging more migrants to come; enforce national

boundaries like nation-states have from time immemorial; refuse to accept anyone who hasn’t been processed properly.

The U.S., already dealing with a steady migrant flow from south of the border, needn’t become part of the bidding for Syrian refugees.

Resources can be better spent in Middle Eastern countries that are hosting millions of Syrian refugees. The Center for Immigration Studies, which supports restrictions on immigration, estimates that the cost of settling one Syrian refugee here would support 12 Syrian refugees in the other Middle Eastern states.

While we don’t face the security risk of Europe, where the refugee flow is essentially uncontrolled, there is no reliable way to vet Syrian refugees.

Finally, assimilation is an obvious concern. The experience of the Somali refugee community in Minneapolis hasn’t been a happy one. Unemployment is high, and the community has provided dozens of recruits to radical Islamist groups.

Of course, that we are discussing a Syrian refugee crisis at all is another symptom of the president’s abject failure in the Middle East. So, please, Mr. President, spare us your sanctimony and condescension.



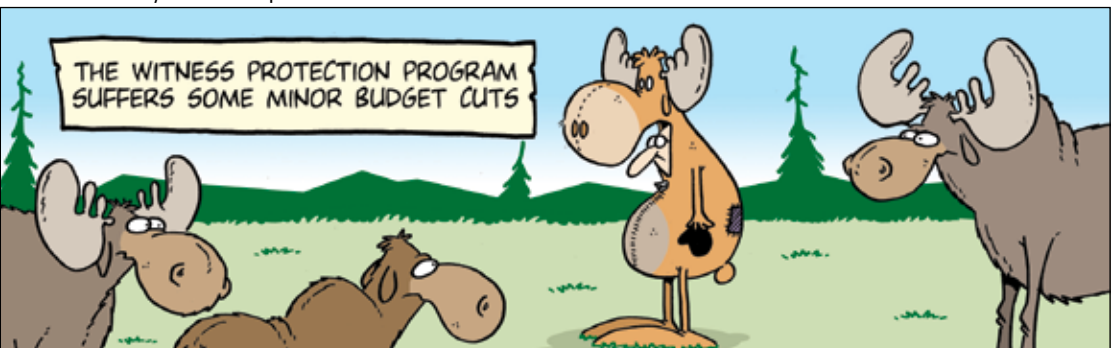

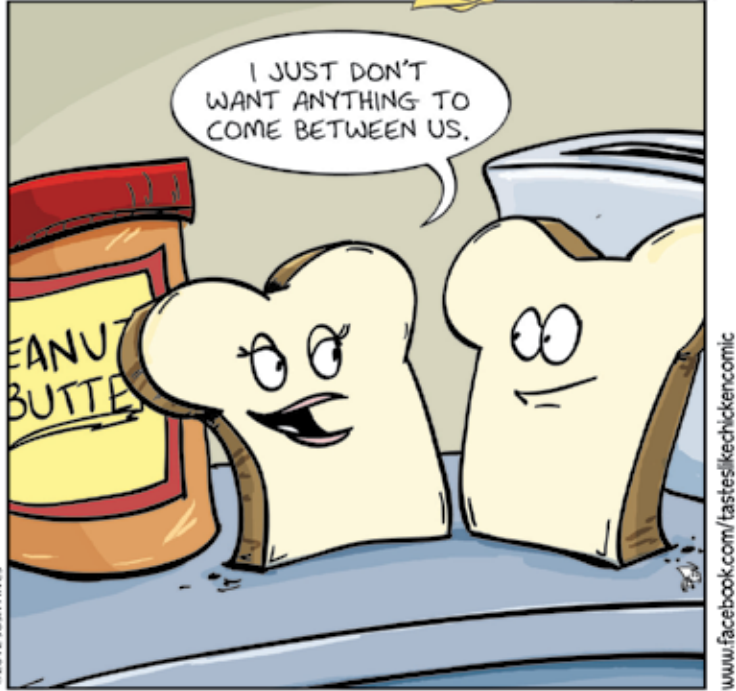

Guy Anderson Back in Baseball

RANCHO CORDOVA, CA (MPG) - Baseball has been a part of Guy Anderson’s life for a long time.

For 45 years, Anderson was the Cordova High School baseball head coach in which he racked up 927 wins, second among California high school baseball coaches. Anderson guided many Lancer teams to multiple league crowns and five Sac-Joaquin Section titles. His 2014 Cordova baseball team captured the Capital Athletic League crown.

Anderson also taught and eventually became Cordova’s athletic director before he retired from education in the early 2000s but continued as the Lancers’ head coach.

Last May, after Cordova posted a 6-21 record, Anderson was relieved of his duties from the Cordova baseball program. In a position where he was considered an at-will, year-to-year contracted coach, Anderson was given an option

of resigning or termination. When he refused to resign, he was relieved of his duties.

But next spring, Anderson will be back on the diamond.

Anderson, 82, was hired as an assistant coach for the Capital Christian High School

baseball team. He will be working with head coach Nelson Randolph, who led the Cougars to the section’s Division V crown last spring. Capital Christian has played in the last three section title games. ★

END OF THE BENCH BY GERRY SCHOLL The Man About Town

Finally, I had the opportunity to reintroduce myself to The Man. It wasn’t all that long ago. That last time I met “Coach” was the first time I had met him when he wasn’t the coach anymore.

We were just two grandpas standing along the sideline enjoying the action of a little boys’ soccer game at Community Park (though he might have been scouting for another Rolf Benirschke). We had a lot in common on that bright, beautiful morning in central Davis.

Though we didn’t really know each other personally, I had some history. Surely, I remembered it much more clearly than The Legend.

It was the years around the turn of the decade from the ’70’s into the ’80’s and Coach Jim Sochor and the UC Davis football program were in full stride (the Mike Moroski/Ken O’Brien years). “Coach” was on his way to greatness; I was a young, part-time sports reporter for a local newspaper.

We met “professionally” on only a handful of occasions, since the lead reporter got all of the best gigs. But one of my assignments was working the phones in the evenings, which included bothering the coach many times for tidbits of information and quotes to keep football in the news during the days between games. It’s likely he knew my voice better than he recognized my face.

When Sochor, 77, two days before Thanksgiving completed the pass from this life into the next --- in which his spirit will live on among those he touched --- even those, such as I, that only knew of him, knew about him, or that might have had some brief encounter with “Coach” were dropped for a loss.

The area papers were full of tributes and testimonials in the days following Sochor’s death. His many on-field accomplishments were recounted --- 19 years

leading UC Davis to a 156-41-5 record; 18 straight league titles; a 38-game conference winning streak; a 92-5 overall conference record; a number of playoff appearances that included a berth in the Division II championship game in 1982; and many others.

Several of his former players and assistants went on to successful college coaching careers. He helped advance several of his players into the professional ranks. He was inducted into the College Football Hall of Fame in 1999. He spent three years as athletic director, five as golf coach and three seasons as an assistant in NFL Europe.

Some of Sochor’s closest friends were quoted in the papers, expressing their admiration for The Man and using terms like “caring...loving...gracious...humble...loyal...teacher...mentor,” and phrases such as “a remarkable man...always gracious with his time...treated everyone with respect.”

During his successful run at UCD, Sochor was courted for positions beyond his domain in Division II, but always elected to remain local, loyal to his team, school, town, family and friends. He never made a big deal about his other offers. As he often liked to say in those early years, he played it “close to the vest.”

Through those many, many years between the early days and our final chance meeting some months ago, “Coach” would be spotted here and there, from time to time.

He would be seen heading into one of his favorite breakfast spots; I would imagine him sitting in there for hours over coffee drawing up plays on his napkins. He would be seen heading to the parking lot after an Aggie basketball game; he was probably there whenever he could. The last couple of years he would be spotted in the crosswalk at The Marketplace on his way into Noah’s; probably there to share

fresh bagels and football talk with a longtime buddy or two.

Whenever or wherever it was, there just seemed to be something special about this man about town. Never aloof, he seemed to carry an aura of genuineness around him always; though he had accomplished so much within his domain of choice, the body language let it be known that he was a man of the people.

Certainly there is a huge number of people around the community and beyond that thought so highly of The Man they barely knew that they would be jealous of the family, friends, students, athletes, and all of those whom he loved dearest and with whom he shared so much more.

That The Man’s honest demeanor could leave such a lasting impression on those on the fringe speaks volumes about “Coach.”

A winner in everyone’s eyes, sadly, Sochor lost his long battle with cancer last week.

He likely was fighting that fight when we happened to meet again a few months ago near the pitch at Community Park. Our short, stroke-for-stroke greetings were pleasant and, of course, genuine. I tried to jog his memory about the long, lost days of our prior interactions, though I was sure he’d seen many a scribe come and go through the years.

His countenance expressed approval of the reintroduction, without letting on whether or not he truly recalled those earlier times we had shared. Now, after his passing, I think back on our handshake as one that represented admiration and gratitude from those of us on the fringe.

We returned our attentions back toward the young grandsons running in packs after the soccer ball, frolicking on the community green with their teammates. Another glance over at “Coach” told me that there was no place else he would rather be. ★

# New Red Cross CEO Stresses Value of Volunteers

**RANCHO CORDOVA, CA (MPG)** - In his first public speaking event as CEO of the Gold Country Chapter of the American Red Cross, Gary Strong presented the program at the November Rancho Cordova Luncheon. He talked about the Red Cross, and a little about himself as well. He has been involved with not-for-profit organizations for many years, with the Red Cross always being the “core” of his board memberships.

“It was the first board I was ever on,” Strong said. “That was over 25 years ago that I joined the Red Cross board and there’s only been two years in those 25 years that I’ve not been on a Red Cross board. I’ve loved the Red Cross forever, and now to be on the staff side is just really a blessing for me.”

Strong, 53, became CEO on Sept. 29th of this year. He gave some of his background pertinent to his work. He earned a Bachelor’s degree in economics from UC Santa Barbara. His work history in accounting and finance includes controller at the Los Angeles Times where he worked for 15 years, and 10 years with the Sacramento Bee, where he was CFO.

Strong told of the origins of both the international organization, started by Swiss businessman Henri Dunant, and the American Red Cross, started by teacher and nurse Clara Barton. The region to which the Sacramento area belongs is the Gold Country Region, which encompasses 48,327 square miles, and serves 24 counties in Northern and Central California.

“We have a staff of about 35 or 40 in our chapter, but we’re dealing with a territory that is really huge, and we can’t do it without the volunteers,” Strong said. “And nothing gets done without money, so we love the

donors, too.”

In fiscal year 2014/2015, in the Gold Country Region alone, Red Cross employees and volunteers responded to 589 single and multifamily fires, 739 families received financial assistance after a local disaster, and 43,250 individuals were trained in preparedness, first aid, CPR, and water safety. There were over 4 million Red Cross mobile app downloads, website visits, and social media connections.

For the American Red Cross as a whole, Strong had the following statistics: Every 60 seconds 44 people are assisted in some way by the American Red Cross; 190 times a day Red Cross workers help a family affected by a home fire or disaster; 1,000 times a day the organization provides services to military members, veterans, and their families; 5,600 times a day a person receives a Red Cross blood transfusion; 15,500 times a day a person receives lifesaving Red Cross health and safety training; and 308,000 times a day a child receives a measles or

rubella vaccination from the Red Cross and its partners.

The mission statement of the Red Cross states, “The American Red Cross prevents and alleviates human suffering in the face of emergencies by mobilizing the power of volunteers and the generosity of donors.”

“I’ve always loved this mission statement of the Red Cross,” Strong said. “It gets to the ‘what,’ which is that we’re all about people who are suffering and helping them out, and about the how—that we can’t do it without the work of volunteers.”

Kris Kirkpatrick, chief development officer for the region, was also at the luncheon. She has been with the Red Cross for three years, in the Gold Country Region, and has known Strong for that period of time.

“He has a tremendous compassion for people, which is a huge part of being a good humanitarian organization,” Kirkpatrick said. “He genuinely cares about the people we serve and our volunteers and staff.” ★
