RANCHO CORDOVA, CA (MPG) - Joe Rich is the Committee Chair for Project 680, an organization geared towards helping students who are homeless in the Folsom Cordova Unified School District. "I was really struck by the

story of high school students that were separated from their parents, but still fighting to finish their education," says Rich.

That's why he joined the group in 2012, just a few years after it

started. "I realized that solving the problem was a big effort, but

I knew there had to be something I could do. So I searched the internet and found Project 680!" Project 680 started in 2008, after the Folsom Cordova Unified School District found they had 680 homeless students in their district. The number of homeless students has increased



RANCHO CORDOVA, CA (MPG) -Sacramento County has by far the largest veteran population of any county in the Sierra Pacific Network of the Veterans Affairs Northern California Healthcare

System (VANCHCS), according to statistics provided by John F. Majerle of that organization. While only a small number of those veterans are homeless or disabled, it is those veterans who need the most assistance. Mather Veterans Village has been designed to help.

"Homelessness among veterans has been a problem for a while, and the numbers actually are decreasing, but we still have work to do," says Tracy Cascio, Homeless Program Manager for VANCHCS. "I've been working with homeless veterans for my entire 24-year career. ... I think [Mather Veteran's Village] is going to be a great opportunity for veterans."

Phase 1 of Veterans Village will provide 50 apartments of permanent supportive housing. According to Tony White of Broward Builders, superintendent of construction at the Continued on page 6


all. Relay for Life events are community events where teams and individuals camp out at a school, park, or fairground and take turns walking or running around a track or path. Each team has at least one participant

Bill Gives Local Municipals Control of Marijuana Venders

RANCHO CORDOVA, CA (MPG) - In 1996, California voters approved Prop 215, which legalized marijuana for medicinal purposes, but that ballot measure failed to provide consumer protections and regulations to thwart criminal activity.

After nearly two decades of failed attempts in the state legislature to fix Prop 215, a three-bill package now sits on Governor Jerry Brown's desk awaiting approval. The bills are the Medical Marijuana Regulation & Safety Act (MMRSA). One of them, AB 266, will be a landmark action because it puts the licensing power to grow or sell marijuana in the hands of the cities and counties.

"It gives us local control so we can jump on problems immediately and nip it in the bud," said Tim Comartie, legislative representative for the League of California Cities, which cosponsored that bill."

At Monday night's Rancho Cordova City Council meeting, Assemblyman Ken Cooley (D-Rancho Cordova) updated the council on AB 266.

Rancho Cordova Mayor Robert J. McGarvey said the city had been on the front lines of this issue having to deal with the impacts from a lack of legal structure for the marijuana industry. "Hopefully the governor will sign that bill so we get control of the problems," McGarvey said.

One example of Rancho Cordova's issue is that in 2012 a

father of two girls, who lived a few yards from Mitchell Middle School, was doing his operation in the home. But police were only able file charges of child endangerment.

Parents and school officials throughout California have been expressing frustration at law enforcement and public officials for not stopping teens and children from having access to marijuana, and at the denigration of their communities.

Last year, Citrus Heights Police Chief Christopher Boyd asked Cooley to fix Prop 215's flaw. Cooley then co-authored AB 266 with Assemblymen Rob Bonta (D-Oakland) and Reginald Jones-Sawyer (D-Los Angeles).

"My interest in this matter comes from having been one of the founding members of Rancho Cordova cityhood and serving on the council for over a decade," Cooley told the Grapevine Independent. "I personally know from experience that local municipalities need more control over what is happening in their jurisdictions."

In April 2014, Citrus Heights police seized 850 lbs. of marijuana, cash, weapons, and ammunition from a drug operation that stretched to the L.A. region. Boyd, who at that time was also the president of the California Police Chiefs Association, had been aware that lawlessness from Prop 215 was epidemic around the state. Under MMRSA, the

California Department of Consumer Affairs would enforce health and safety standards

while the California Department of Agriculture would require marijuana growers to comply with the same environmental and health and safety standards that fruit and vegetable farmers must comply with to protect the public.

Threating to sue the state if it enacts those laws, the American Medical Marijuana Association (AMMA) issued a press release declaring the proposed laws would kill patients because a provision in one of the bills requires that a patient must have a legitimate prescription from a licensed primary physician.

"These bills are a mean-spirited attempt to thwart the will of the people and deprive them of medical cannabis," stated Steve Kubby, executive director of AMMA, in his press release. "The medical community is not up to speed with cannabis' medicinal properties. It is unacceptable and illegal infringement on our rights under Prop. 215."

By press time, no one at AMMA had returned the Grapevine Independent's telephone call.

Disagreeing with Kubby's assertions is Chula Vista Police Chief David Bejarano, who is also current president of state's police chiefs association. He counters that the proposed laws will solve problems. "With these bills, law-abiding people will be allowed to flourish while for the first time the same will not be said about illegal operators," Bejarano said to the Grapevine Independent.

Sacramento County DA Reports Recent cases of interest



CASE: Michael Eugene Addson PROSECUTOR: Deputy District Attorney Thomas Asker, Homicide Unit

Twenty-seven-year-old Michael Eugene Addson was convicted by jury of first-degree murder during the commission of an attempted robbery.

Marc Zhuchenko was an employee at the O'Reilly's Auto Parts store on Elkhorn Boulevard. On January 9, 2014, Addson attempt to rob the store. Mr. Zhuchenko tried to fight him off and injured Addson, who then shot Mr. Zhuchenko. Addson left a trail of blood as he fled the store. Due to the vigilance of the Sacramento County Sheriff's Department and its homicide detectives, Addson was detained within two hours at the Methodist Hospital. Detectives were also able to locate the murder weapon. Analysis by the District Attorney's Laboratory of Forensic Services linked Addson's DNA and his gun to the crime scene.

The jury also convicted Addson of five counts of robbery with use of a gun based on three separate incidents at O'Reilly's and Autozone stores in July, September, and October of 2013. Those robberies were solved by Sacramento County sheriff's detectives following Addson's capture on January 9, 2014.

Addson faces a minimum sentence of life in prison without the possibility of parole. Sentencing is set for October 16, 2015, in Department 16 by the Honorable Marjorie Koller.

CASE: Kareem AbdulMitchell

PROSECUTOR: Deputy District Attorney Allison Dunham, Special Assault & Child Abuse Unit

Forty-three-year-old Kareem Abdul Mitchell pled no contest to two counts of oral copulation with a person under 18 years old and one count of committing lewd and lascivious acts on a child.

Mitchell was a choir director for the New Testament Baptist Church. During that time, he molested three male choir members between 2001 and 2012.

Pursuant to the plea agreement, Mitchell will be sentenced to three years state prison and will be required to register as a sex offender for life. Sentencing is set for October 21, 2015, at 1:30 p.m. in Department 63 before the Honorable Michael Bowman.

This case was investigated by the Sacramento Police Department.

CASE: Randell Bryant

PROSECUTOR: Deputy District Attorney Samuel Alexander, Career Criminal Prosecution Unit

The Honorable Marjorie Koller sentenced 28-year-old Randell Bryant to 10 years plus 75 years to life in prison. On July 2, 2015, a jury convicted Bryant of three counts of residential burglary. Bryant has three prior strike convictions, all residential burglaries from 2005, 2007, and 2008.

On September 3, 2013, two homes in Land Park were burglarized. A passerby heard the house alarms and gave police descriptions of four males walking away from the scene carrying property. Soon after, another burglary occurred in Greenhaven. Witnesses there also described four males fleeing the scene. The residences were ransacked for cash, jewelry, electronics, and other items. The total loss was more than \$30,000.

An iPad from one of the burglaries was traced to an address in north Sacramento, where more items taken in the burglaries were found. After further investigation revealed Bryant was living at that residence, he was arrested. Bryant was picked from a live lineup by a witness.

Co-defendants Koleon Crawford and Dominque Spruill pled no contest to three counts of burglary and both were sentenced to five years, four months in prison. The fourth perpetrator was a juvenile at the time of the crimes.

This case was investigated by the Sacramento Police Department.

CASE: Gregory Wyrick


PROSECUTOR: Deputy District Attorney Maria Wilson, Special Assault & Child Abuse Unit

Thirty-five-year-old Gregory Wyrick was convicted by jury of six counts of sexual intercourse and/or sodomy with a child under 10 years old and six counts of committing lewd and lascivious acts on a child under 14 years old. The jury also found true a multiple victim enhancement.

From 2012 to 2013, Wyrick molested two victims multiple times when they were staying at his house. The victims were five and seven years old at the time.


Wyrick faces a maximum potential sentence of 150 years to life in prison. Sentencing is set for October 9, 2015, in Department 33 before the Honorable Michael Savage.

This case was investigated by the Sacramento County Sheriff's Department.

Biden Being Biden

While Hillary Clinton's team of consultants is locked in a room somewhere trying to figure out how she can project authenticity, Joe Biden is out doing it.

The vice president's recent interview on "The Late Show With Stephen Colbert" was compellingly human, as Biden talked of the tragic loss of his son Beau and his decision whether or not to make a late entry into the Democratic presidential race.

It's rare for someone who has been at the pinnacle of our politics for decades to get a second look. But Biden's latest family tragedy (he lost his first wife and a daughter to a car accident in the 1970s) means that the vice president is viewed through a prism of sympathy, as a grieving father rather than just another politician. And Hillary's struggles, especially her woodenness, put an accent on Biden's let-it-all-hang-out,

true-to-his-self personality.

You can disagree with Biden, you can mock him, you can cringe at his miscues -- but it is impossible not to like him. Hillary's team can come up with the best, most elaborate plan for her latest makeover (it will emphasize spontaneity, The New York Times reports) and still not come close to matching the bizarre charm of Biden being Biden.

We are constantly assured by people around her that Hillary Clinton is warm in private." Biden is warm in public. His performance swearing in new senators earlier this year was a nonstop Bidenesque spectacle of selfies, folksy comments and general crazy-uncle antics, some of dubious appropriateness.

Their public personas are captured in the story of two parades. One of the enduring moments of the Hillary campaign so far is of reporters being corralled in a roped-off pen to keep them away from the candidate during a small July Fourth parade in New Hampshire -- creating an instant metaphor of arrogance and control.

When Joe Biden showed up at a Pittsburgh Labor Day parade, he broke into a trot, eagerly bouncing from one side of the route to another, shaking hands, dispensing hugs and kissing babies. Low energy, in Donald Trump's signature phrase, this was not. Biden was a joyous

retail campaigner in his element.

On paper, Biden is hardly a natural match for the populist, antiestablishment mood. He first got elected to the Senate in 1972, a year after Florida Sen. Marco Rubio was born. His resume includes 17 years as chairman or ranking member of the Senate Judiciary Committee, and 12 as chairman or ranking member of the Senate Foreign Relations Committee. This is a resume for a gold watch, not for a late-developing insurgent president campaign.

Yet Biden is a practiced and, unfortunately. fairly effective demagogue. He can denounce the rich with the best of them.

If he gets in, he will immediately be evaluated by a different standard. He'll be an actual candidate rather than the intriguing potential new entry. He'll be the old white guy trying to "stop history." But he'll also be a breath of fresh air in a Democratic race that was supposed to be the stultifying march to the nomination by one of the dullest politicians of our time.

DEAR PAW'S CORNER:

Whenever I'm away for several hours -- at work, mostly -- my dog tears up the house. "General" will knock over lamps, chew sofa cushions, destroy my shoes ... you name it. My boyfriend says he's got behavioral issues, and I need to be more dominant. How do I do that? -- Sara T., Philadelphia

DEAR SARA: Dominance, or showing a dog who's boss, isn't the issue here. (In fact, many dog behaviorists turning against the idea of using dominance or making yourself the "alpha dog" for any reason.) General is suffering severe separation anxiety. You do need to address it for his emotional and mental well-being. First, talk about his behavior with the veterinarian, who likely will recommend medication to calm him when you leave the house.

The better goal, however, is to help General get past his

anxiety. You may be able to help him see that you're not going away forever, and that each time you leave the house you will come back. A common way to do this is to dress as if you're going to work, say goodbye to General, and leave -- but only for about five minutes. Then come back inside and greet him. Repeat this frequently, slowly lengthening the time you're away until you can be out for an hour or more. You also can leave little treats or toys around the house for General to play with. Walking your dog before you leave can relieve some of his restless energy. If you're only taking General out to relieve himself before you head off to work, try going out much earlier and walking further or playing with General. If medication and/or desensitization training don't work, consult a trainer who specializes in separation anxiety.

Phase 2 will be the rehabilitation of the existing old officers' quarters, to provide 60 "beds" of transitional housing. "Our initial plans were to knock it down," says Reed Flory, reinvestment and housing opportunities manager for the City of Rancho Cordova. "We did some engineering studies and found that would be foolish, given the energy efficiency potential of the building. It has a lot of thermal mass to it and structurally...it will live forever." Flory has been instrumental since 2006 in getting the project funded.

Phase 3 will duplicate the Phase 1 construction of 50 apartments of permanent housing.

"We believe that the final application for its funding will occur in March of next year," Flory says. "Then, in June 2016, we will receive word that we've been selected, and then we'll located on some of the property formerly occupied by Mather Air Force Base, which closed in 1993

According to Clark Whitten. Mather program manager for the county of Sacramento, "When the federal government closes a military base, what they traditionally do is they look to the local community to transfer the property to the local community so they, in turn, can develop it in hopes of recapturing the jobs that are typically lost when you close a military base.

... In June of 2013 we took the Mather Veterans Village lease to the Board of Supervisors. In a unanimous vote, they approved us leasing the property to the City of Rancho Cordova for 99 years-it's free."

The Board's District 5, served by Supervisor Don Nottoli, encompasses the area of the project. "To know that we have a facility, housing, with some of

The fact that the Veterans Village is just down the street from the VA Medical Center makes the location ideal for access to healthcare services not provided by Veterans Village.

The program is an example of partnership and cooperation between agencies. The federal government and Air Force made it possible for the county to acquire the property. The project is co-sponsored by the City of Rancho Cordova, Sacramento County, and the Sacramento VA Medical Center. In addition, the developer, Mercy Housing, is the managing general partner, and Veterans Resource Centers of America is the services coordinator and co-general partner.

"[There are] a whole lot of folks, but all for a very good purpose," Nottoli says. "It shows that people working together can really achieve some very good things, and this is a very good thing, in my mind."







Erratic Lure Presentation Key to **Catching Big Bass**

When I think back about big bass I've caught, one thing comes to mind and that's lure presentation. An erratic retrieve, in most cases, has produced many of my biggest bass.

Why is that? Because this retrieve most closely mimics live forage. When danger threatens, they are going to do something different, like speed up, retreat, go crazy, play possum or try to hide. In most cases though, they will move out like a late freight train.

Lures such as plastic worms, jigs, spinnerbaits (slow-rolled), crankbaits (fished in a stop-and-go retrieve) and even tonwater lures can be worked erratically to imitate a frightened baitfish.

The best thing I can tell you is if you want to catch big bass, watch how baitfish react when a fish is after them, and then try to duplicate that reaction with whatever artificial bait you're using.

full-flight, having won the 2014 Super Bowl by smashing Denver, 43-8, and losing late by way of a dubious play call near the goal line in 2015 to New England, 28-24. They were figured to win the West Division again and to be in the mix for another playoff run this season, but have started out 0-2 without Chancellor in the lineup. Seattle has lost to St. Louis in overtime and to the Green Bay Packers, 27-17.

The Seahawks vaunted Legion of Boom defense --- without its Pro Bowl strong safety who is considered to be the best at his position --- has allowed 61 points in the first two games, third worst in the NFL, placing the team in a Region of Doom, in which only two of the 45 teams that have begun a season 0-2 since 2009 have reached the playoffs. Through it all, Chancellor has insisted on restructuring his contract. He apparently has decided, two years into his four-year extension, that \$28 million is not quite enough to feed his family. It is estimated he has already lost --- by not showing up --- more than the Seahawks may be willing to boost his salary. The franchise, his teammates, Chancellor himself and all those who are a part of Seahawks Financial Nation have also probably lost a sizable degree of earning potential that might have been forthcoming by way of another Super Bowl appearance. The San Francisco 49ers wish they had problems like those, rather than the kind they have been dealing with --- including their 43-18 blowout loss at Pittsburgh in the Steelers' home opener. After playing well while defeating the visiting Minnesota Vikings the previous game, on a short week the 49ers were buried by halftime, trailing 29-3, by QB Ben Roethlisberger and WR Antonio Brown and the longrange passing game. Brown had five catches and 128 yards by

The Oakland Raiders, on the other hand, rebounded from a blowout loss at home to Cincinnati to rally behind young QB Derek Carr for a last-minute, 37-33 victory over visiting Baltimore.

While an 0-2 start appears to be all but a knockout drop for NFL teams, that dreadful series three weeks ago in L. A. of three consecutive one-run losses looks more and more like the bitter knockout pill the San Francisco Giants will be choking on as the MLB regular season nears completion and the Giants come up short in defense of their World Series title. Still holding out in those two games," Nill said. "I think a lot of guys learned how to play team football. A lot of younger guys grew up a little bit; they see what they're doing wrong when we're watching [game] films and they responded.'



ROSEN CHOSEN TO LEAD UCLA pins its Pac-12 title hopes on true freshman quarterback

UCLA AT ARIZONA

This is the most intriguing of several key showdowns in the Pac-12. Arizona received a bit of a scare in the opener against UTSA but has posted some gaudy offensive numbers en route to its 3-0 start. The schedule has been soft, but the Wildcats lead the Pac-12 in both scoring offense (54.3 ppg) and total offense (584.7 ypg). Sophomore tailback Nick Wilson is the league's top rusher with 144.7 yards per game. UCLA is also 3-0, with home wins over Virginia and BYU sandwiched around a victory at UNLV. After a near-perfect debut against Virginia, freshman quarterback

Josh Rosen is showing signs of being, well, a freshman. In the past two games, he has completed just over 50 percent of his passes with two touchdowns and three interceptions. The Bruins will need Rosen to be sharp if they hope to successfully navigate a difficult league slate that includes trips to Arizona, Stanford, Utah and USC. The guess here is that Rosen will shine in his first Pac-12 road game. UCLA 37-30

USC AT ARIZONA STATE

Neither team has lived up to lofty preseason expectations.

TENNESSEE AT FLORIDA

This doesn't have as much national import as Tennessee-Florida games of yesteryear, but it's a crucial game for both programs. Tennessee fans are craving a statement win from Butch Jones, who has dominated on the recruiting trail but has yet to make the Vols nationally relevant. Florida is having some issues on offense - starting with the QB position - but the Gators are 3–0 and have an SEC road win (over upstart Kentucky) on their résumé. Florida's roster is far from elite, but the defense is good enough to keep this team in the SEC East race all season. Florida 20-17

TCU AT TEXAS TECH



Texas Tech is fresh off a satisfying win over an Arkansas team that physically dominated the Red Raiders in Lubbock last season. Tech still has to prove itself in league play, but there are early signs this could be Kliff Kingsbury's best team at his alma mater. TCU received a scare from SMU before pulling away for a 56–37 win over the Mustangs in Fort Worth. Quarterback Trevone Boykin is the leader of a

dynamic offense that will put a ton of pressure on the Texas Tech defense. The Raiders will need to force at least three turnovers to keep this one in range. TCU 44-30

Arizona State lost its opener to Texas A&M, 38–17 in Houston, and then looked less than impressive in wins over Cal Poly and New Mexico. USC cruised to wins over Arkansas State and Idaho by a cumulative score of 114-15 but lost its Pac-12 opener to Stanford, 41-31, at the L.A. Coliseum. The Stanford offense that did not score a touchdown
