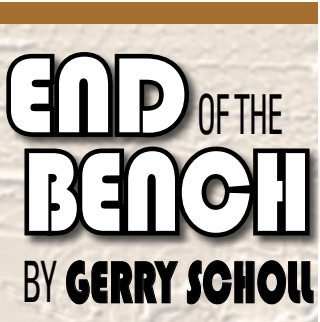

Celebrating All Weekend for Independence Day

Rancho Cordova Gears Up for the Fourth of July Festival

RANCHO CORDOVA, CA (MPG) - Exercise your freedom in a 5K fun run. Wave the flag at a hometown parade. Spend a couple of days along the beautiful American River, topped off with some of the most spectacular fireworks in the region.

The two-day Rancho Cordova Fourth of July celebration returns for its 31st year on July 3rd and 4th, and organizers say they're confident they have something for everyone.

No event captures the spirit of Rancho Cordova like the Rancho Cordova Fourth of July Festival. It may have something to do with the long affiliation with the nation's defense rooted at the former Mather Air Force Base or Aerojet company, which together gave birth to Rancho Cordova. Whatever the reason may be, no community puts more into their Fourth of July observance than Rancho Cordova.

Looking for some great Fourth of July fun? Here's what's happening in Rancho Cordova:

July 3rd Kick-Off

Independence Day fun gets a jumpstart on July 3rd when the Fourth of July Festival opens its gates at 4 p.m. with a full carnival, free Kids Zone with plenty of free activities, beer gardens, and more. Festival food, exhibits, pedal boat rides on the Hagan Park ponds, plus a spin for the kids on the Bobble Lagoon or an exhilarating ride on a Zipline make it a night to remember.

The BMX Freestyle Team will be presenting two exciting shows at 5:30 p.m. and 7:30 p.m. Watch their breath-taking tricks and get a free bicycle helmet autographed by the riders.

At 8:15 p.m., everybody heads to the outdoor Main Stage concert venue for music under the stars from "Hip Service," a 12-member stage team that is a Sacramento favorite. Be sure to bring a blanket or lawn chairs and be ready when the band rolls the crowd into the concert-ending fireworks minishow—an eye-popping assault on the senses to get you warmed up for the Fourth of July.

New Red Light Digital Camera System Location

RANCHO CORDOVA, CA (MPG) - The Rancho Cordova Police Department's Red Light Photo Enforcement Program has placed a new digital red light photo enforcement camera system on Sunrise Boulevard at Folsom Boulevard, within the City of Rancho Cordova. The new system is currently being tested and is scheduled to go "live" on Saturday, August 1st at 12:01 a.m.

For a period of at least 30 days, red light violators will be mailed a warning notice. On August 1st at 12:01 a.m., red light violators at this intersection will begin to receive citations by mail. When a citation is issued and received by the violator, it will include a referral to a website where the violator can view the still images and video footage of the violation. The violator should be able to clearly see where their vehicle was in relation to the intersection's limit line and the green, yellow, and red lights.

Increased traffic safety is the number one priority of the Rancho Cordova Police Department Red Light Photo Enforcement Program. Studies have shown a significant reduction in red-light related crashes at photo-enforced intersections.

SACRAMENTO REGION, CA (MPG) - Each year prior to "Eppie's Great Race," a three-person team and two "Iron People" who are regional celebrities, officials, media personalities, or community leader athletes set the "time to beat" for all of the competitors who participate in the following week's Eppie's Great Race, to be held this year on July 18th, 2015.

Known as "Eppie's Great Team,"

Eppie's pacesetters have included some of California's most respected government officials, media representatives, successful business leaders, renowned athletes, local celebrities and semi-celebrities throughout its 42-year existence. All Eppie's Great Race participants who beat the Great Team's pacesetter time receive a free breakfast coupon courtesy of IHOP Restaurants and the Eppie's Great Race Foundation.

Eppie's Great Team will be setting their time on Wednesday, July 8th. This year, Eppie's Great Team will feature Melissa Cabral (reporter for KMAX TV, "Good Day Sacramento," and KOVR TV/CBS 13) as the team's Runner, George Johnson (President of Eppie's Great Race Foundation and the son of race founder Eppie G. Johnson) as the Cyclist, and Richard Sharp (reporter for KCRA TV and My 58) as the Paddler.

Eppie's Great Team Iron People will be Ironman Angel Preciado (Senior Producer/Editor, Univision Communications) and Iron-woman Michelle Gaskill (Associate Producer at News 10 Sacramento ABC TV).

Eppie's Great Team will set their times on Eppie's Great Race Course: American River Parkway, Rancho Cordova, and Sacramento: The course begins at William Pond Recreation Area in the American

River Parkway. The Run-to-Bike Transition will occur at the east end of the Guy West Bridge off University Avenue across from California State University, Sacramento. The Bike-to-Paddle Transition will happen in lower Sunrise Parking Lot and Footbridge, between Fair Oaks and Rancho Cordova. The Finish Line will be at River Bend Park, American River Parkway, Sacramento.

The 42nd annual Eppie's Great Race—known as "The World's Oldest Triathlon"—is scheduled for Saturday, July 18th. Both teams and/or individuals can compete in divisions from "Junior" to "Iron Person." Eppie's Great Race participants run 5.82 miles, cycle 12.5 miles, and paddle 6.35 miles, on a racecourse located on and alongside the American River Parkway. New, modern elements have been added to this year's race, which

Homicide in Area of Sarament Court

RANCHO CORDOVA, CA (MPG) - At approximately 11:20 p.m. on June 20th, the Rancho Cordova Police Department responded to multiple noise complaints regarding a loud party within the 3600 block of Sarament Court in Rancho Cordova. Officers estimated approximately 100 people at the party and dispersed the crowd.

At 2:10 a.m. on June 21st, officers returned to the area of Sarament Court and Burline Street after receiving calls regarding a large fight and reports of gunshots. Upon their arrival, officers discovered a 17-year-old Hispanic male unconscious in the street, suffering from a gunshot wound. Officers provided emergency life-saving efforts to the victim; however, he was pronounced deceased at the scene by medical personnel.

Two other gunshot victims related to this incident were transported to area hospitals by private vehicle. One victim, a white male in his 20s, underwent immediate surgery with life-threatening injuries. The second gunshot victim, a black male in his 20s, is being treated for his injury, which was deemed non-life threatening. At least two other assault victims related to the fight during this incident were also transported to the hospital by private vehicle and treated for non-life-threatening injuries.

After officers originally dispersed the crowd, preliminary information suggests a large crowd of people came back to the party and became engaged in a violent fight and shooting. While they continue to track down party attendees who may have witnessed the assault and shootings, detectives ask anyone with information relating to this incident to please contact the Sheriff's Department at (916) 874-5115 or Crime Alert at (916) 443-HELP. Tip information may also be left anonymously at www.sacsheriff.com, by texting 274637 (CRIMES) and entering the keyword "SSD," or by calling (916) 874-TIPS (8477).

The homicide victim's name will be released by the Sacramento County Coroner's Office once his identity is confirmed and notification to next of kin has been completed.





- 1 egg

Note: Make and decorate cookies 1 day in advance to allow for drying time.

Heat oven to 350°F. In large bowl, beat butter and sugar with electric mixer until light and fluffy. Beat in egg and flavors. Mix flour, baking powder and salt; add to butter mixture 1 cup at a time, mixing after each addition. Do not chill dough. Divide dough into 2 balls.

On floured surface with rolling pin, roll each ball into a circle approximately 12 inches in diameter by 1/8 inch thick. Cut cookies with star nesting metal cookie cutter. Dip cutter in flour before each use.

Bake cookies on ungreased cookie sheet 8–11 minutes or until cookies are lightly browned.

Prepare Color Flow icing. Tint icing following color formulas above. Use tip 3, a parchment bag and full-strength icing to outline cookies: 32 in red, 21 in white and 16 in blue. Let cookies dry 1–2 hours.

Thin 1 cup red, 1/4 cup blue and 1 cup white icing. Use thinned icing and disposable decorating bag to fill in cookies. Fill in 8 of blue outlined cookies with white icing and remaining cookies with matching outline color. Let dry 8–12 hours.

To serve, arrange cookies on tray in stars and stripes design.

S'mores Crispy Cereal Treats

Yield: 20 servings

- 6 tablespoons butter
- 1 bag (16 ounces) regular-sized marshmallows
- 1/4 teaspoon Warm Cinnamon Graham Treatology Flavor Concentrate
- 10 drops Creamy Vanilla Custard Treatology Flavor Concentrate
- 1/4 teaspoon salt

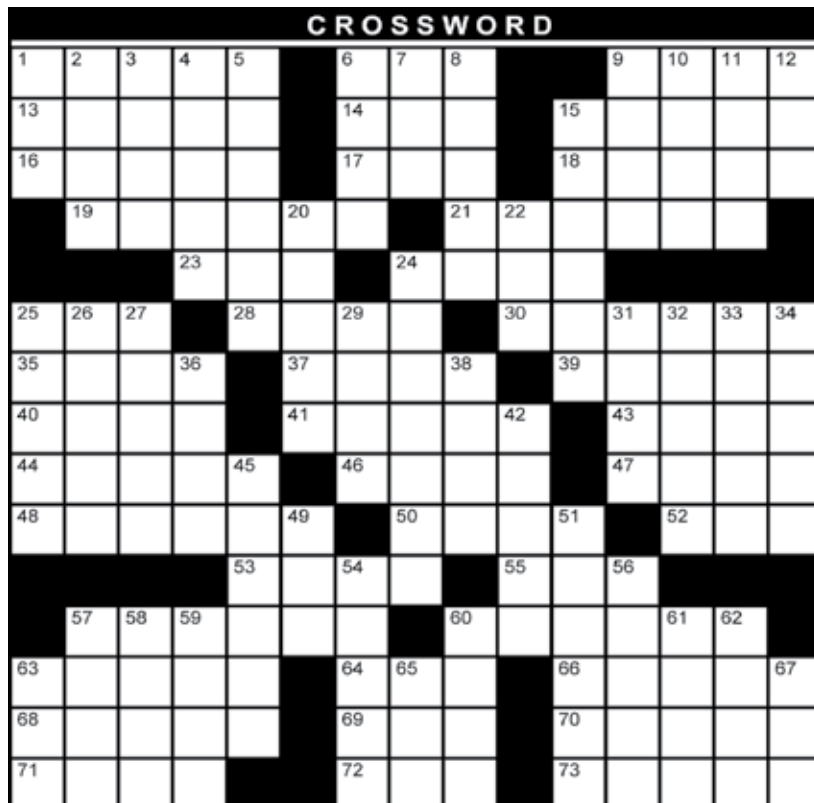

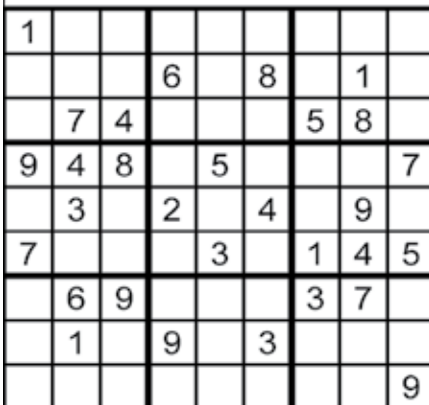

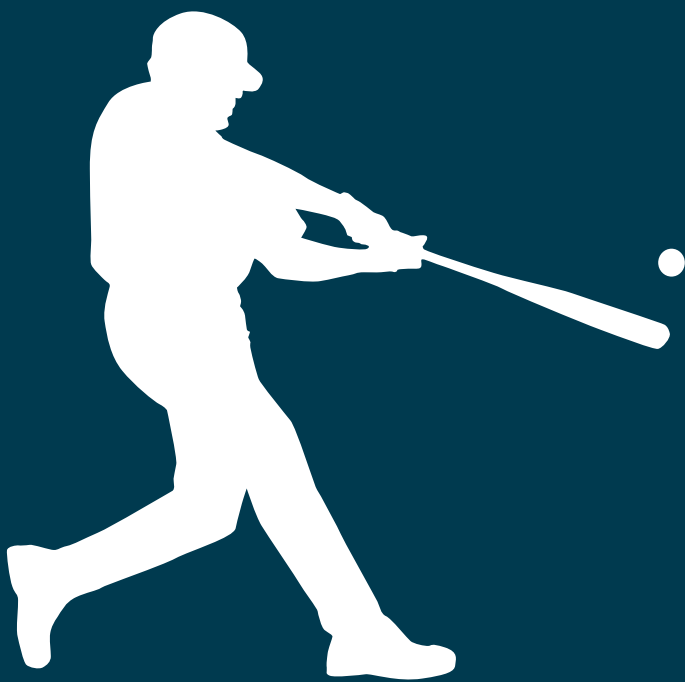

Cordova Football Extremely Competitive at Camp

SACRAMENTO, CA (MPG) - In the final three days of the Nor Cal Skills Camp on the Monterey Trail High School campus, the Cordova High School football team progressed on both sides of the ball, and new head coach Darrin Nill hopes these gains will pay off this fall.

The Lancers completed the five-day camp last Friday, June 26th with a lot of emphasis on techniques and scrimmages. Before the camp ended, Cordova had an “extremely competitive” scrimmage against Burbank. “The first [offensive] group moved the ball very well, both in the air and on the ground,” Nill said.

Leading the Lancers’ offense was returning quarterback Unique Perez, who passed for 1,695 yards and 17 touchdowns last fall. “Unique had an excellent camp,” said Nill of Perez.

Nill was also liked the play of the Lancers’ running backs, led by Seth Trujillo, another returning player who started four

games last year. “I thought our running backs played very hard,” Nill said.

Other key players returning this season who played at the camp were wide receivers Isaac

Black and Devin Baldwin.

On defense against Burbank’s offense, Nill admitted that his squad made “a lot of mistakes” in terms of tackling, missed assignments, and coverage. But he also pointed out that Burbank’s offense also made errors that forced the Lancers into mistakes as well. “We were able to restrict their ball movement well,” Nill said.

Returning to help guide the Lancers’ defense this season are cornerbacks Sam Nawalu and Matthew Giles, Nill pointed out. DeAnte McCullogh also “looked good” in the secondary during scrimmages.

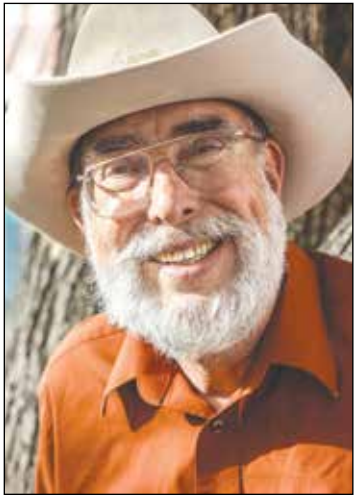
Development of Cordova coaches and players during the camp was positive, Nill noted. “As the week went on, our players got to view the film and coaches’ comments from the previous days’ efforts,” Nill said. “By the end of the week, we were coaching up the small details instead of the big flaws. That’s always a good sign.

“We always say that camp is the equivalent of one month of practice. I think that bears true. Those players who can see their mistakes on film and then get coached up the very next day are at least one month ahead of where they were [earlier in the week]. When we have 100% buy-in from players and their families in this regard, we will start to see the return of Big Red Football.”

Nill and his coaching staff gave the Lancers this week off. On Saturday, July 4th, the local gridders will be marching in the annual Rancho Cordova’s Fourth of July Parade.

On Monday, Cordova returns to its summer workouts through July 17th. Then the dead period runs through Monday, August 10th when practices begin for the season.

END OF THE BENCH

O Say Can’t You See, My Brother

It has become customary in our United States of America to have a performance of our National Anthem, the Star-Spangled Banner, before so many of our treasured major sporting events.

Some of these performances have been fantastic, some well-done, some sub-par, and sometimes the singers have screwed up the lyrics—typically American, diversity on display.

But above it all, our flag, the Stars and Stripes, yet waved—gallantly streaming, as it shall for as long as our nation marches forward through time with the flag as a symbol of our unity in triumph, strength, and perseverance well beyond the miseries of battle, from whence our Anthem was born.

Just as we might with regard to our athletes’ showings on the fields of play, we can sense a wide variety of sentiments with regard to our nation’s performance. We can feel so proud of success with dignity. We can accept resignation to some moral victory, feeling as though all best efforts were exhausted. We can admit to our disappointment when the results fall well short of our highest hopes.

We can admire the stature of our “team” in the world today, understanding the humble beginnings, and the struggles and strife endured along the way. We can sense both pride and shame regarding differing periods through our nation’s formation and growth. We are able to feel free to express our emotions and bravely move on, looking ahead while striving to continue to improve our “home” for another day, another game. We struggle with change, sometimes even over the idea of welcoming the tired, poor, huddled masses yearning to breathe free.

Years ago we welcomed one such man, a 7-foot-7 basketball player from a small tribal village in South Sudan named

Manute Bol. Bol considered his height to be his gift, and basketball was his ticket to America, where he eventually became the tallest player (and probably the thinnest) ever to play in the NBA. He overcame seemingly insurmountable obstacles to have a college career in the early 1980s and a 10-year NBA career, including two full seasons with the Golden State Warriors when he became the best of friends with Hall of Famer Chris Mullin.

Bol adventured from an existence as a cattle-herding Dinka, fighting off lions with spears to walk eight miles to see his girlfriend, to one in which he had to fight off hip-checks from Charles Barkley to fill his plate at the bountiful post-game spreads.

All the while that Bol was blocking shots and making his way in the NBA, topping out at a \$1.5 million salary, his homeland was perpetually on his mind. Sudan had once again plunged into civil war due to a number of factors, including differences between the north and south, ethnic and religious conflicts, elitism, and resource-based exploitation of oil, water, and land. The poorest suffered most; the rural, pastoral life that Bol had known was destroyed. As the atrocities escalated, his village ceased to exist and many relatives were among the eventual two million civilians to die in the south through the course of the war.

In the book *Manute: The Center of Two Worlds* (1993, by Leigh Montville of Sports Illustrated), Bol said, “If I were in the Sudan right now, I would be starving with the rest of my people.” Bol made one trip home to witness his people’s plight in a hastily rebuilt plane that landed before thousands of hungry refugees with a reporter aboard who described a horrible scene: “They are more bones than flesh and they are dressed in rags or nothing at all

and they are staring at you anxiously because you have just stepped out of an airplane and an airplane means to them one of two things: They will either be fed or bombed.”

This plane brought them a brother, Manute, who dedicated himself to their cause. Bol died in 2010, a year before South Sudan became an independent nation still engulfed in perpetual power struggles, violence, and misery. Bol, in his lifetime, had become a beacon of hope for peace. Last week in the capital, Juba, the inaugural Manute Bol Tournament was held. An organizer and cousin of Manute said, “The theme of this tournament is that sport can unite us...these spectators are from all races of South Sudan. That is what it means: bringing them together to share something they love, which is basketball.”

Take a look around on the playing surfaces and among the crowds in our arenas, stadiums, sports bars, and other venues across our land from sea to shining sea—diversity reigns—sports brings us together, too, despite our differences. We sing together and pay respect to our symbol of unity, and the vast spectrum of what it stands for—realizing there are both good and bad elements to enduring and always many hurdles to overcome. We’ve never given much attention to the other three verses of the Anthem, but there is a line in there... “...conquer we must when our cause is just.” And, we might consider incorporating some other patriotic lines into our thinking, like “...crown our good with brotherhood.”

An area newspaper ran a picture of a homeless man holding a sign, “FOOD,” and a story about how to deal with such a problem. If brother Manute were alive today, he would probably say, “Give him some food, a place to stay, and let him see a doctor.”

The New York Mets' hitters weren't exactly torching the league over the first few months of the season. But the team is trending in the wrong direction, bad enough to drive even Casey Stengel batty. Over their last 13 games, the Mets are batting just .188 with 29 runs. They've whiffed 94 times and have only 80 hits. But thanks to excellent pitching efforts, the team managed to win six of those 13 games... The Boston Red Sox are on the cusp of being completely out of the playoff race in the American League. The lack of pitching has been the primary culprit for the Red Sox woes, but designated hitter David Ortiz is in the midst of a struggle of his own. This season, Big Papi is batting just .115 against left-handed pitching, with no home runs, only four RBIs and one walk... Paul Goldschmidt of Arizona is putting together another tremendous season. With 20 homers and 13 stolen bases, he has accomplished something that's been done only 13 times since 2000 by a first baseman. This marks the third season that Goldschmidt has as many as 20 home runs and 13 stolen bases. Albert Pujols and Derrek Lee have done it three times each. Ryan Klesko has pulled it off twice and Joey Votto has one 20-13 season. If Goldy reaches 30 home runs and 20 steals (both totals likely), he will join Klesko and Lee as the only 30-20 first basemen this century...Unlike every other team in the American League, the Minnesota Twins don't seem to mind facing Chris Sale of the Chicago White Sox. The ace lefthander is 1-3 with a 6.46 ERA against the Twins this season. He's 5-1 with a 1.88 ERA against every other team...Last week, Nick Markakis booted a single, allowing Denard Span to move up an extra base. That ended a 398-game errorless streak for Markakis, a major league record... On June 25, starting pitchers Rubby De La Rosa of Arizona and Jorge De La Rosa of Colorado opposed each other. It marked the first time two De La Rosas had faced each other in the majors. Neither factored in the decision but Rubby left after seven innings with a 2-1 lead. According to Elias, the surname of pitchers to face each other most would be Smith, which has happened 21 times. Shocker.

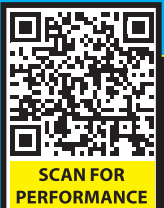

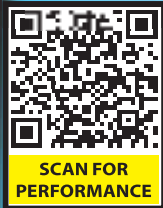
