WEST SACRAMENTO, CA (MPG) - The Sacramento River Cats are proud to announce a new long-term partnership with the threetime World Champion San Francisco Giants as part of Major League Baseball's new Player Development License (PDL). The 10-year extension keeps the River Cats as the Giants' top minor league affiliate through the 2030 season.

"The San Francisco Giants are one of Major League Baseball's most respected and storied franchises and we are honored to continue what has been an incredible partnership both on the field and in our communities," states River Cats general manager, Chip Maxson. "The new PDL will allow the River Cats and Giants to focus on long-term player health, wellness, and development, which will lead to an even better fan experience and more championships!" This will be the seventh season since partnering with the Giants in September of 2014, compiling a record of 332-377 in the process including a championship run in 2019, becoming the only club to win three Triple-A Championships. "We are excited to continue our dynamic partnership with Sacramento for 10 more seasons," exclaims Giants president of baseball operations, Farhan Zaidi. "Sacramento has proven to be an important affiliate by providing our players an excellent place to play with a passionate fan-base, all in close proximity to San Francisco." Sacramento is one of San Francisco's four domestic minor league affiliates, alongside Double-A Richmond (Eastern League), Advanced-A Eugene (Northwest League), and Class-A San Jose (California League). Sutter Health Park is the West Sacramento home of the 2019 Triple-A Champion Sacramento River Cats. SACRAMENTO, CA (MPG) - The SMUD Board of Directors approved the SKK Developments and BlackPine Communities team as the developer for its 59th Street Reuse project, which will redevelop its 59th Street site into a multi-use, sustainable, transit-oriented, infill project that will help achieve SMUD's ambitious carbon reduction goals by serving as an all-electric development.

The proposed project consists of 108 homes, light-rail station relocation, an Olympic-sized swimming pool, commu-

SMUD's 59th Street Reuse project was purchased from PG&E when the company took over providing electric service to the community in 1946. City Appoints Interim Administrative Services Director

CITRUS HEIGHTS, CA (MPG) - At the February 11 meeting of the Citrus Heights City Council, City Manager Chris Boyd recommended the appointment of William Zenoni to serve as Interim Administrative Services Director. The City needs to appoint an interim director while they work to recruit and hire a permanent candidate for the position - which was recently vacated by former Assistant City Manager and Administrative Services Director Ronda Rivera, who abruptly retired on February 5, 2021.

Zenoni would be hired as a retired annuitant and, per CalPERS retirement rules, his salary would be restricted to the general

without any other compensation or benefits, which ensures that Zenoni retains

pay scale for the position his current retirement benefits. City Manager Boyd explained that hiring Zenoni as a retired

annuitant would benefit the City's budget: Based on the annuitant salary rules, the City will save approximately \$100,000 annually while Zenoni holds the interim position.

The Administrative Services Director plays a vital role in the City's functions, and City Manager Boyd explained that it is critical that an appointment be made swiftly to ensure there is no delay in services during the recruitment process for a permanent replacement. Boyd explained that when he started as City Manager in 2016, the City had six departments and six department heads. Now, there are just four departments and two department heads, so a vacant management Continued on page 3

Assemblyman Ken Cooley Introduces Equitable Campsite Reservation Bill

- On Monday, February 8, Assemblyman Ken Cooley (D-Rancho Cordova) introduced AB 472, the Equitable Campsite Reservation for All Act, which would extend consumer protections to campsite reservations for state and local parks by prohibiting the use of "bots" in securing reservations.

California State Parks are a cornerstone of the California Parks encompassing 1.5 million acres of land and 4500 miles of trails, these locations are some of the most visited places in the state. California parks and camping reservation are in such demand that in recent years people have struggled to reserve campsites.

The desire to reserve campsites at favorite parks led some consumers to use "bots" on reservation websites. Bots are pieces of software that can perform automated and directed tasks, which allows someone using a bot to unfairly reserve campsites at fasterthan-human speeds that leave honest campers out of luck. The use of bots continues to unfairly shutout individuals who do not have the technological prowess or money to achieve these faster bookings. Currently, campsite reserva-Experience. month increments on a rolling calendar and when in demand dates approach, the likelihood of securing the site diminishes. It has become evident that speed is of the essence to secure a campsite.

"California's parks are an integral part of our state's natural endowment, to be protected and shared with all our citizens. AB 472 ensures that all Californians have an equal ability to access their state and local parks," said Assemblyman Ken Cooley. "With so many aspects of life put on hold this past year, one of the few pleasures we should all be able to enjoy is the beauty of California's nature."

AB 472 ensures that bots are no longer able to be used to reserve camping venues and provides fair and equitable access to enjoy our unparalleled state and local park system.

Los Rios Colleges to Offer Student Scholarships

SACRAMENTO, CA (MPG) - The Los Rios colleges - American River College, Cosumnes River College, Folsom Lake College and Sacramento City College - are offering \$735.000 in scholarships to students in 2021. with the application period opening January 15.

There are over 480 different scholarships offered, with each one focused on a specific major, program of study or subject area. Students have until March 5 to apply for the scholarships.

"The impact of a scholarship on a Los Rios student's life is transformational," said Los Rios Chancellor Brian King. "Scholarships allow students to take more units, work fewer hours, focus on school and complete their goals in less time. They also ensure groceries on the table and help to pay the rent. It is an investment in their plans and their futures."

Although community colleges provide the best value in higher education, the costs of books, supplies and transportation are still substantial. Estimated books, fees and tuition are \$2,500 per year for a full-time student, and the cost of attendance for a low-income independent student is \$19,821. Even for students who receive all the financial aid available to them, they still have \$6,674 in unmet need.

"The majority of our students are lowincome and eligible for less financial aid than students attending four-year institutions. Due to the high cost of living in the Sacramento region, most students work 20 to 40 hours per week just to make ends meet," King noted. "Scholarships bring higher education into the reach of students for whom an education might not otherwise be attainable."

Many scholarships were established by generous donors who want to support students. This philanthropic support has a great impact on countless students each year.

CITRUS HEIGHTS, CA (MPG) -The Citrus Heights Chamber of Commerce is off to a busy start in 2021. position threatens to slow the business of government. In addition to his responsibilities as City Manager and running Public Works, Boyd is currently overseeing the Administrative Services Department until an appointment is made.

Zenoni has over 35 years of experience in governmental finance and management (including experience working as a city manager). He has also worked with the City of Citrus Heights for several years as a financial consultant and is very familiar with the City's finances. City Manager Boyd said that Zenoni is "highly qualified" and "extremely experienced."

Councilmember Jeannie Bruins said, "I think we're very fortunate to have someone of Mr. Zenoni's qualifications ... who understands not only the responsibilities that are going to be facing us, but also understands our culture and will fit in very well."

Councilmember Tim Schaefer asked how many other annuitants were interviewed for this position. Since the appointment is for an interim director, City Manager Boyd answered, "None."

Councilmember Schaefer referred to the Council's recent financial study session, during which Mr. Zenoni highlighted unfunded City needs as part of his budget presentation, which focused on the need for continued service cuts and staff vacancies in order to balance future budgets. Schaefer characterized Zenoni's presentation as "misleading," even suggesting that the recommended budget cuts were "reprisatory [sic] for Measure M not passing." Schaefer stated that the budget recommendations have "shaken my trust in the city manager, and in Mr. Zenoni. So, it's no question that I will definitely be voting no on this."

Vice Mayor Porsche Middleton said that since the City is in the midst of reworking the budget, they need someone who is familiar with the City's financial challenges. "Mr. Zenoni seems like an obvious pick in the interim until we can find someone that can actually fill that position." She also suggested the City

is fortunate to get that level of expertise while saving \$100,000 annually.

"As for it being more of a reprisal for the lack of Measure M – I sincerely doubt that that's the case," said Vice Mayor Middleton. "As a Council, we stand here together to make sure we're doing the best job we can for the benefit of our community, and retaliation is not something that I have ever seen any of my colleagues participate in or anything that I've ever seen Christopher Boyd participate in. So, I don't really appreciate the comment."

Mayor Miller agreed, stating that Zenoni "knows our budget inside and out." Addressing Councilmember Schaefer's statements, Mayor Miller pointed out that Schaefer, as the newest councilmember, might be having trouble understanding the ten-year financial forecast and how it impacts decisions about the two-year budget. "I really believe we're proceeding as the voters asked us to. They gave us a mandate to tighten our belt and cut costs."

Councilmember Bret Daniels acknowledged Zenoni's qualifications, but said he felt the process was being rushed: "It has not been a week since the assistant city manager left abruptly. I don't know why she left. So, all of a sudden, now we're going to drop on our lap a replacement right away. And it may be the route to go, but it just seems to be awfully quick." While he did recognize the tremendous workload created by the vacancy, he said, "I would prefer to put this off for a few weeks, but I don't think we'll have that support from a majority of the Council."

Mayor Miller addressed Daniel's comments about Rivera's retirement, stating, "I'm sure it was a personal decision. It's none of my business, it's none of your business, it's none of anybody's business."

The resolution passed three to two, with Councilmembers Schaefer and Daniels dissenting. Zenoni's employment as Interim Administrative Services Director will run from March 8, 2021, until June 30, 2022, or until permanent candidate is hired.

California Seeking Volunteers to Help Keep Waterways Clean

SACRAMENTO, CA (MPG) - California's Boating Clean and Green Program is looking for individuals to become Dockwalkers to help keep the ocean, lakes and reservoirs clean. Even during the COVID-19 pandemic, recreational boaters continue to recreate in California's waterways. The need to share clean boating practices with the recreational community, while abiding to COVID-19 guidelines, remains important.

For the past two decades, Dockwalkers have taught more than 100,000 boaters about keeping waterways clean from oil, fuel, sewage and marine debris. According the Division of Boating and Waterways, the level of recreational boating activity in California is one of the highest in the country with some 4 million motorized and non-motorized boats being operated annually. Dockwalkers raise awareness about clean boating practices by distributing educational materials and California boater kits at marinas, boat launch ramps and boating events, or wherever boaters are.

"Boating has been supportive and healing for many during the COVID-19 pandemic,' said Division of Boating and Waterways Acting Deputy Director Ramona Fernandez. "As Californians enjoy this form of outdoor recreation, it is important for them to do so in a way that protects public safety and the environment. We invite water enthusiasts to help us share these important messages by becoming a Dockwalker."

Free, three-hour virtual Dockwalker

trainings will be offered through the Zoom video conferencing system starting March 6 through June 12 on select Saturdays from 10 a.m.-12:45 p.m. Participants must be 15 years or older. The training qualifies as community service. Interested persons must register ahead of time online. Anyone who is interested in this effective educational program can view videos online to learn more about the program and view success stories.

Marinas and yacht clubs are also encouraged to participate in the Dockwalker Program. Participating facilities receive educational materials and tools to operate a clean boating facility and minimize water quality impacts. This program provides marinas with points towards a Clean Marina designation provided by Clean Marina Program. Participation in the Dockwalker Program counts towards the nomination of the Club of the Year, under the community service category. In addition, yacht clubs and marinas are essential in spreading awareness directly to boaters.

Partnerships with The Bay Foundation, U.S. Coast Guard Auxiliary, U.S. Power Squadrons, Save Our Shores, Lake Berryessa Partnership and many more organizations are integral to this program's success.

The Dockwalker Program is part of California's Boating Green and Clean Program. 

And you try to meet your own needs yourself. We do this all the time. We short-circuit God's will, God's blessing in our lives by going for the quick fix, the cheap thrill, the quick relief that's temporary. We do it all the time. We don't wait for God to fulfill that need.

Right now, you may be struggling with financial pressure in your life or maybe you're under enormous emotional pressure. But you're not turning to God. You're turning to other things. Maybe a drink, or you go to the medicine cabinet for those little pills. It's a quick fix, a temporary solution, but it doesn't solve the problem.

What's the antidote? "If you're walking in darkness without a ray of light, trust in the Lord, and rely on your God." This is a test! God is going to see when you're under stress are you going to turn to Him or are you going to turn to other things? It's a test. Will you trust Him? Wait for His timing, wait for His provision. He loves you more than you'll ever know, and He wants you to turn to Him, not other things that do not ultimately help you.





CITRUS HEIGHTS, CA (MPG) - Believing the COVID shutdowns are an opportunity to turn the State's current direction, the Citrus Heights Chamber of Commerce hosted a Reopen CAL NOW gathering on Monday, February 15, to represent the economic segments still affected.

The event featured local community and business leaders speaking at the commercial block at 7010 Sunrise Blvd., Citrus Heights-right next to the R Vida Cantina Mexican Restaurant. Kevin Miles, co-owner of the dining establishment joined the 30 people attending:

"We've been dealing with this all year, but after you put people in a corner," Miles said, "I could not look at the employees in the face and tell them they are all being laid off... so I took the decision to stay open."

Miles expressed his gratitude to the City of Citrus Heights for its efforts in being included in the Great Plates Program: "without [that] our business could not have survived."

Event organizer, Arcade realtor Lilian Fulton, told the crowd that the trickle-down effect had been devastating to many: "Parents are not capable of teaching new math to their children,

some have not received unemployment checks since June and July, and all that some have for socializing is Zoom!"

Citrus Heights Chamber of Commerce president Amanda Camacho commented, "None of us could have been prepared for how the COVID shutdown has affected businesses from the local mom-and-pop shops to national franchises... but I am glad we came out today to discuss... the next steps for our community."

Also attending the meeting was elected Sacramento County Fourth District Supervisor Sue Frost. She said that, as before, good data has been very hard to obtain from the State. Most of the information she sought was not available, too hard to understand or did not answer her questions.

"There is a very loose requirement for COVID deaths, and hospitals are receiving money for every COVID death," she said, "this really makes us question the data."

Assemblyman Kevin Kiley (R-Rocklin) supported the group and gave his view that Governor Newsom's handling of COVID-19 highlighted and "amplified all that was already wrong with California" from political partisanship to the teachers unions and Big Business.
