AmeriCorps Force Dispatched

SACRAMENTO REGION, CA (MPG) - One hundred young people last month completed AmeriCorps National Civilian Community Corps training and were inducted into service. They now have begun 10 months of work on far-flung community projects. "Your journey will be full of challenges," Predicted AmeriCorps team leader Jeremy Cooper at the induction ceremony in McClellan Park. "You'll be stepping out of your comfort zones. You can rely on each other. Your team will be your family."

Recruited from all 50 states, Pacific region members formed 16 teams during a three-week training stint. Each team will work in communities throughout Western United States. Missions will support such efforts as home building, school mentoring, food closets and disaster recovery. In Sacramento, a team will work for more than a month on invasive weed management on the American River, in co-operation with children from John Still School, Meadowview. In exchange for their service, AmeriCorps members receive assistance for educational costs, a living allowance and room

and board. Congressman Ami Bera commended the inductees. "AmeriCorps is an investment in our nation's young people," he said of the federally funded program. "The most important classroom is out there. You'll overcome challenges as teams and come to understand this country's communities and their diversity. All Aboard the Sacramento Valley Live Steamers Santa Train!

SACRAMENTO REGION, CA (MPG) - All aboard the Santa Train!

Members of the Sacramento Valley Live Steamers Railroad Museum (SVLSRM) welcome the public to ride their annual Santa train, weather permitting, during the first and second weekends of December at Hagan Community Park in Rancho Cordova.

Club members also help kick off the holiday season with their participation in the 23rd Annual Rancho Cordova Community Tree Lighting at Village Green Park at 3141 Bridgeway Drive from 4 to 7 p.m. on Sunday, November 26 when a special train for young riders will loop around the brightly lit community tree.

Upcoming run times for the Santa Train at Hagan Community Park are 11 a.m. to 3 p.m. on Saturday, December 2, and Sunday, December 3, and the following weekend, Saturday, December 9 and Sunday, December 10th. The SVLSRM museum is located at 2197 Chase Drive, just past the petting barn in the rear of Hagan Park.

The Santa Experience train ride is \$8 per person. Children, ages two and under, ride free with a paid adult ticket. Advance tickets can be purchased on the SVLSRM web site at: www.svlsrm.org/

Personal keepsake photographs taken with Santa Claus are free. Guests will receive a login and password to an online gallery where they can later view and download their digital photos.

“This is the largest fundraiser for the SVLSRM each year,” said club president Andy Berchielli.

Over the two weekends, well over 2,400 riders and visitors, both young and old, are expected to visit Santa, he said. “It’s also a lot of hard work and a lot of fun.”

“Our Santa Train is a yearly event that many have made their tradition,” Berchielli said. “We continue to make small changes to improve the flow and wait time of our guests,” he said.

This year, tickets are being sold for three individual trains which will pull five cars each around the 6,300-foot main line loop which is festively decorated by club members to enhance the holiday train ride experience. Passengers will pass under a large inflatable gateway on their way to meet Mr. and Mrs. Claus.

“We will also be handing out candy canes this year to everyone, and each group will receive a keepsake Santa train ornament,” he said.

“Santa will also take time to talk to each child about their Christmas wishes before the train departs back to the main station. It’s a special event that brings smiles to everyone, no matter the weather,” Berchielli said.

SVLSRM began in 1965 and trackwork was completed with a ceremonial Golden Spike ceremony in 1973. Track and guest improvements have continued ever since with new features added each year, Berchielli said. Live steam engines carry passengers through wooded areas and the nearby American River. The railroad also features wooden trestles, a 40-foot truss bridge as well as a girder deck bridge.

SACRAMENTO REGION, CA (MPG) - St John the Evangelist School's blowout – "A Holiday Show of Hands" – will ensure a crafty Christmas for thousands of shoppers on December 1, 2 and 3.

Now in its 45th year and boasting more than 150 vendors, the market annually fills the entire Locust Avenue campus with up to 10,000 guests. Proceeds benefit the Catholic school.

Entrepreneurism annually soars during the fundraiser. Wares range from funky sweaters to metal sculptures and glittering ornaments. A preview (4-9 pm on December 1) requires an admission fee, but Saturday and Sunday browsing is free. Doors open at 9 am on both weekend days.

Organizers have this year added a prize opportunity for admission; guests will be included in a draw for a \$100 Visa gift card. A silent auction will offer hundreds of items; bids close on Sunday afternoon. Santa and Mother Claus will visit from 11

am to 2 pm, Saturday and Sunday.

The fair's gourmet pavilion has been enlarged to include more food vendors. "December is a cold month, so hot toddlers and Sister Margaret's famous Irish coffee will take the chill off," promises organizer Pat Holbus. Home-cooked lasagna and other hot dishes will be available as sit-down or take-out meals throughout the event. The fair offers a gift wrap service and Carmichael's Boulevard Coffee will host an Espresso bar, with specialty coffees.

St John the Evangelist School is located at 5701 Locust Avenue, in Carmichael. Because fair traffic clogs surrounding streets, free shuttles will run from Carmichael Elks Lodge parking lot to St John's Church.

"People come here from all over Sacramento – even from out of state," says Pat Holbus. "Our market is a Sacramento tradition. It's a weekend that says Christmas is here at last."
