SACRAMENTO REGION, CA (MPG) - One hundred young people last month completed AmeriCorps National Civilian Community Corps training and were inducted into service. They now have begun 10 months of work on far-flung community projects.

"Your journey will be full of challenges." Predicted AmeriCorps team leader Jeremy Cooper at the induction ceremony in McClellan Park. "You'll be stepping out of your comfort zones. You can rely on each other. Your team will be your family."

Recruited from all 50 states, Pacific region members formed 16 teams during a three-week training stint. Each team will work in communities throughout Western United States. Missions will support such efforts as home building, school mentoring, food closets and disaster recovery.

In Sacramento, a team will work for more than a month on invasive weed management on the American River, in co-operation with children from John Still School, Meadowview.

Congressman Ami Bera commended the inductees. "AmeriCorps is an investment in our nation's young people," he said of the federally funded program. "The most important classroom is out there. You'll overcome challenges as teams and come to understand this country's communities and their diversity.

All Aboard the Sacramento Valley Live Steamers Santa Train!

SACRAMENTO REGION, CA (MPG) -

All aboard the Santa Train! Members of the Sacramento Valley Live Steamers Railroad Museum (SVLSRM) welcome the public to ride their annual Santa train, weather permitting, during the first and second weekends of December at Hagan Community Park in Rancho Cordova.

Club members also help kick off the holiday season with their participation in the 23rd Annual Rancho Cordova Community Tree Lighting at Village Green Park at 3141 Bridgeway Drive from 4 to 7 p.m. on Sunday, November 26 when a special train for young riders will loop around the brightly lit community tree.

Upcoming run times for the Santa Train at Hagan Community Park are 11 a.m. to 3 p.m. on Saturday, December 2, and Sunday, December 3, and the following weekend, Saturday, December 9 and Sunday, December 10th. The SVLSRM museum is located at 2197 Chase Drive, just past the petting barn in the rear of Hagan Park.

The Santa Experience train ride is \$8 per person. Children, ages two and under, ride free with a paid adult ticket. Advance tickets can be purchased on the SVLSRM web site at: www.svlsrm.org/

Personal keepsake photographs taken with Santa Claus are free. Guests will receive a login and password to an online gallery where they can later view and download their digital photos.

"This is the largest fundraiser for the SVLSRM each year," said club president Andy Berchielli.

Over the two weekends, well over 2,400 riders and visitors, both young and old, are expected to visit Santa, he said. "It's also a lot of hard work and a lot of fun."

"Our Santa Train is a yearly event that many have made their tradition," Berchielli said. "We continue to make small changes to improve the flow and wait time of our guests," he said.

This year, tickets are being sold for three individual trains which will pull five cars each around the 6,300-foot main line loop which is festively decorated by club members to enhance the holiday train ride experience. Passengers will pass under a large inflatable gateway on their way to meet Mr. and Mrs. Claus.

"We will also be handing out candy canes this year to everyone, and each group will receive a keepsake Santa train ornament," he said.

"Santa will also take time to talk to each child about their Christmas wishes before the train departs back to the main station. It's a special event that brings smiles to everyone, no matter the weather," Berchielli said.

An operating G-scale garden loop layout also gives youngsters

SVLSRM began in 1965 and trackwork was completed with a ceremonial Golden Spike ceremony in 1973. Track and guest improvements have continued ever since with new features added each year, Berchielli said. Live steam engines carry passengers through wooded areas and the nearby American River. The railroad also features wooden trestles, a 40-foot truss bridge as well as a girder deck bridge.





Don't Panic, You Have Plenty of Time

We would like to buy a house soon, but we know we need an emergency fund. It would take us over a year to build up an emergency fund, so since we're getting older, should we make adjustments to the Baby Steps?

Dear Debbie,

You've been making great progress, and you obviously have a good income to be able to pay off debt that quickly. But it shouldn't take you two a year to build up an emergency fund, considering the rate at which you've been paying off debt.

Yes, you need a fully funded emergency fund of three to six months of expenses set aside before you start saving a down payment for a home. Maybe in your case, you could lean a little more toward the three-month side with your emergency fund. Then, after you're all moved in, you could revisit the emergency fund and beef it up to six months.

Fifty isn't old, Debbie. Just stay on course and stick with the plan. You two have plenty of time to get your finances in order and find a great home!

Police Officer Convicted of Vehicular Manslaughter

SACRAMENTO COUNTY, CA (MPG) -Sacramento Police Officer Benjamin Jillson was convicted and sentenced for misdemeanor vehicular manslaughter without gross negligence. Over the objection of the District Attorney's Office, Jillson pled to an offer made by the court for 90 days in county jail. The 90 days is suspended pending the successful completion of 100 hours of community service involving veterans' services. The victim's family requested that the community service involve veterans' services in honor of the victim, Denzil Broadhurst.

On October 31, 2022, Officer Jillson was on duty driving his patrol vehicle on Bell Ave. east of Rio Linda Blvd. in Sacramento. Jillson made a U-turn onto westbound Bell Ave. Mr. Broadhurst was riding his motorcycle on westbound Bell Ave. and attempted to brake when Jillson's patrol vehicle drove in front of him. Mr. Broadhurst collided with Officer Jillson and passed away from his injuries.






