GALT, CA (MPG) - Though the year got off to a difficult start, with violent rain and winds battering the region, 2023 included many happy moments as well, with the community coming together to celebrate in both new ways and old. Read on for a selection of the various ups and downs of 2023.

January

Weeks of rain and wind storms dominated January, causing flooding throughout south Sacramento County. The storms started on the night of Dec. 31, 2022, swelling the Cosumnes River. Floodwaters and wind toppled trees and cut off power for more than 1,000 SMUD customers

in Galt. Drivers were stranded on Highway 99 when the Cosumnes overtopped the freeway. Backroads were even more treacherous. A Galt resident who attempted to drive home on New Hope Road that first night was plunged into deep water, along with many other vehicles. Cosumnes Fire Department and Galt Police Department responded to huge volumes of emergency calls. Ultimately, nearly 11 inches of rain was recorded over the month, and some roads, like New Hope, remained closed past January.

Sacramento County Supervisor Pat Hume was sworn in on Jan. 5, starting his first term representing District 5, which includes Galt. He replaced longtime supervisor Don Nottoli. Referencing Nottoli and Nottoli's predecessor Toby Johnson, Hume said, "I stand on the shoulders of giants that I've known my whole life."
