Once upon a time, at the height of his career, Matthew McConaughey was a regular in Zachary. Swimming in locals' pools, attending a ZHS baseball game, eating at Subway on Church Street, getting a haircut at Shear Distinction, tossing a football in a Fennwood front yard. We realize this is a bewildering fact for newcomers; let me explain.

Lifelong Zachary resident John Chaney, who passed away in 2023, started a company with his brother to provide livestock, set decorating and movie props to the motion picture industry. While active in the movie business, Chaney joined j.k. livin, a foundation started by McConaughey to empower high school students to make healthy choices. The two became lifelong friends, with Chaney acting as somewhat of a manager/assistant/father figure for McConaughey. Movie productions took them across the globe; from 1999 to 2011, Chaney is listed on IMDB as "additional cast: assistant" in more than 20 McConaughey movies. In the downtime, McConaughey parked his airstream in Chaney's Fennwood driveway, where he stayed multiple times a year.

McConaughey also spent time in Zachary after Hurricane Katrina. Here's an excerpt from his Katrina diary, published on Oprah's website: We finally got gas and headed towards Zachary, Louisiana, population 12,000...in the last seven days, the population has more than doubled. At the Cornerstone Church in Zachary, we met Lois, who had no idea where her family was. We were able to contact Lois's daughter by telephone.

Growing up in Los Angeles, seeing celebrities was just part of everyday life for Zachary resident Charles Dohs. Long before the era of selfies and smartphones, celebs weren't as camera-shy as they are today, and for Dohs, meeting them became almost routine.






"I literally met hundreds over the years," Dohs says. "Some encounters were quick, just a handshake or a hello, but others turned into stories I'll never forget."

Among his favorites was Mr. T. "He was super nice," Dohs recalls. Then there was Henry Winkler—better known as 'The Fonz'—and boxing legend Sugar Ray Leonard. He met Pam Dawber from Mork and Mindy and even Dr. Dre. But perhaps one of the wildest run-ins happened not in Hollywood but on an "airport shuttle from hell."

"I was on this rental car shuttle, and it broke down. Total disaster," Dohs says. But one of his fellow stranded passengers? Eddie Money. "He was super cool, and we got to hang out for a while." No word yet on if Eddie broke into an impassioned rendering of "Take Me Home Tonight," but it would have been fitting.

Beyond random run-ins, Dohs' family life intersected with celebrity circles in ways he never anticipated. His children attended Sierra Canyon School, an elite private institution famous for its star-studded student body. "It was completely by accident—a story for another time—but they ended up at the same school where LeBron James sends his kids. Practically every celeb in LA sends their kids there," he says.

With only about 60 kids per grade, friendships naturally formed. "My oldest son went to school with Kendall Jenner, and my youngest with Kylie. They knew each other pretty well and are still friends today," Dohs says.

And then there are those surreal Hollywood moments—the kind that don't even register as shocking until later. "I was standing in the room next to Kim Basinger when Alec Baldwin left one of his famous voicemails for Ireland," which were leaked to the press.

There are countless other stories, Dohs says, some too wild to believe, others just a funny blip in a life lived at the crossroads of celebrity and normalcy. "That's just how it was in LA," he says with a laugh. "You never knew who you'd run into next."
