# Synopsis

## Act I Scene I – The Blessing

In a Majestic Palace governed by God's glory and might, a gathering is assembled to celebrate the birth of the promised child, Princess Victoria. The Palace Court is bubbling over with excitement and anticipation as they announce the arrival of God's Prophetic Council, Deborah, Esther, Eliana, Miriam and Shira. The Council arrives bearing gifts of Beauty, Song, Dance, Faith, Hope and Love to impart to Princess Victoria. They foretell the day when Victoria will rule over the land with Godly Wisdom, Love and Authority through Christ. Suddenly the sky darkens as an uninvited guest, Machia the evil Duchess, crashes the celebration! Machia is threatened by Victoria's promised future since it will ruin her secret plan to overtake the Kingdom. In her rage, Machia casts an evil curse upon the Palace causing everyone to fall into a deep slumber. Deborah confronts the Evil Duchess in order to create a distraction. The Queen quickly gives the princess and the sacred crown to Shira, Eliana, Esther and Miriam. The Queen then sacrifices herself to the Evil Duchess, protecting Victoria. God's Prophetic Council escapes the palace with Victoria as the Palace succumbs to the evil control of Machia.

## Act I Scene II – The Hideaway

Deborah and the Prophetic Council arrive safely in the Secret Hideaway, tucking baby Victoria away from the Evil Duchess. Now that little Victoria is safe and secure, her journey of growing up begins. Deborah mentors Victoria as she grows, teaching her God's faithfulness, love and wisdom. As Victoria's relationship with Jesus is cultivated, she is anointed with love, power and courage through the Fire of the Holy Spirit which prepares her to leave the Hideaway. Victoria is now mature in her understanding of God's true character and her identity through Jesus.

## Act II Scene I-Journey through the Woods

As Victoria travels home, she must cross through the woods to reach the Palace. She is greeted by beautiful butterflies, tulips and blue birds. When the Evil Duchess discovers Victoria is soon to return to the Palace, she unleashes the frogs, crows and wicked woodland creatures to confuse and agitate Victoria. The Evil Duchess and her entourage unleash their fury, hoping to destroy Victoria. The Princess is injured by the assault but not defeated. Soon the Holy Spirit appears with beautiful angels, shining light and illuminating God's love to her. They remind her not to give up as she is almost home. Victoria begins to prepare for the final battle by putting on her spiritual armour to defeat Machia.

## Act II, Scene 11 – The Final Battle

Victoria enters the Palace only to find that the Queen and her Court are still under the control of Machia's evil curse. Victoria engages the Evil Duchess and her wicked entourage for the final battle. Machia's powers are no match for Victoria as the Veil of Evil Control and Deception are stripped from the Palace and Machia is defeated. 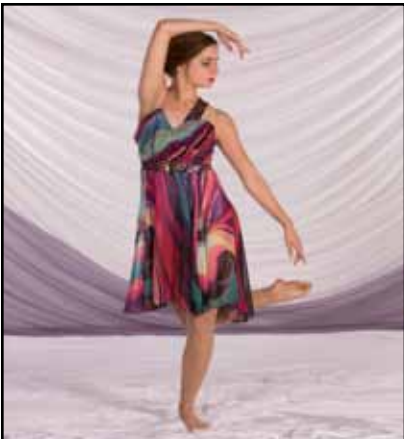
