Brown Jr. created the Interagency Refinery Task Force in 2013 to facilitate statewide coordination among member agencies that help protect the public, nearby communities and refinery workers from risks associated with refinery operations throughout the state. CalEPA coordinates the task force among local, state and federal agencies.
