Emergency transport may be critical to survival and recovery. In a region with a large, widely scattered rural population, rapid emergency air transport is essential.

Common Questions

How far will Careflight travel?

Careflight has helicopters in Aberdeen and Sioux Falls that will travel within a 125-mile radius. Our fixed-wing planes based in Sioux Falls respond to emergencies outside the radius as needed across South Dakota, Nebraska, Iowa and Minnesota.

Does the membership include my spouse and children?

Careflight covers you, your spouse and unmarried, dependent children up to age 26 based on guidelines of the Young Adults & Affordable Care Act.

Will the Careflight membership pay for transportation to another hospital once the patient is stabilized?

No. Careflight membership only applies to emergency situations.

Who determines if a situation is an emergency?

The treating physician typically determines if a situation is an emergency.

Will Careflight travel outside the 125-mile radius, such as to Texas or Arizona?

No, the Careflight membership is for emergency travel only.

For Medicare members, you must have Medicare Part B for Careflight services to be covered However, Medicare may only cover up to 80 percent of the bill, leaving you with a significant amount of out-of-pocket costs.

Careflight will bill your insurance carrier, and the payment will be accepted as paid in full. This means Careflight emergency air transport costs are completely covered. If you have no insurance, as a Careflight member we will cover the entire cost of your air transport in emergency situations.
