Public Health Update

We have had a number of positive Covid cases at school. Symptoms have generally been mild – like a common cold. Please keep your child home from school with even mild cold symptoms and test for Covid. If a first test gives negative results, please test again 24-48 hours later. It can take time for the virus to build up enough to be detected by an at home test. There are test kits available in our front entry for families to pick up. Or give the office a call and we can send a test kit home in a student's backpack.
