
CCHS Knowledge Bowl took home the NE Minnesota Section Championship on March 15th! They are headed to the State Finals on April 13. Go Vikings!

Did you know?

The Affordable Connectivity Program (ACP) provides eligible households a discount of up to \$30 per month off their internet bills (or up to \$75 per month for households living on Tribal lands), as well as a one-time discount of up to \$100 off an eligible connected device like a laptop, desktop computer or tablet.

This announcement serves as a reminder that a household is eligible to participate in the ACP if a child in the household receives free or reduced-price school meals. Therefore, under the ACP rules, every household with a child attending a school participating in the Community Eligibility Provision (CEP) of the National School Lunch Program and School Breakfast Program is eligible for ACP benefits.
